**BIRDLAND BITES:** The Orioles fell in the series finale to the Royals yesterday, 4-1, dropping their second straight rubber match this season...The Birds continue their six-game road trip this evening in Arizona (3 to play) before enjoying their second off-day of the season on April 10.

👉 **Ryan Mountcastle** tallied his first game of three or more hits this season yesterday at Kansas City, which included his sixth career triple...He had 12 games of at least three hits in 2024.

👉 **Cade Povich** became the second Orioles starter (third occurrence) to complete at least 6.0 innings in a start this season, joining **Zach Eflin** who has done so in both of his starts on the year...Marked Povich's fourth career start of 6.0 or more innings pitched.

👉 The Birds have registered one home run or fewer in seven straight games (1 HR overall), marking their longest run since September 20 to October 1, 2023 (11 G).

👉 The Orioles have not recorded a save through the first 10 games of the season for the first time since 2002 (12 G)...The Braves, Twins, and White Sox are the only other clubs in the majors that have yet to tally a save.

**KNOCK(S) ON WOOD:** The Birds have recorded 88 hits, ranking third in the AL behind the Red Sox (101 H) and Yankees (92), and sixth in the majors...The 88 hits are the most by a Baltimore club through 10 games since the 2016 O's (99 H).

👉 **Tyler O'Neill** is one of 10 players in the AL with two games of three or more hits...Of the 10, seven reside in the AL East (BOS' Wilyer Abreu/Alex Bregman, NYY's Paul Goldschmidt/Aaron Judge, TB's Jake Mangum, and TOR's Bo Bichette).

**OFF AND RUNNING:** **Adley Rutschman** has reached base safely in each of his first nine games, the longest season-opening streak by an Oriole since **Anthony Santander** (18 G) from April 8-27, 2022...**Aaron Hicks** reached base safely in each of his first 12 games from May 31 to June 14, 2023, but did not sign with the club until May 30 that season.

**SOUTHPAW SUCCESS:** Since 2024, **Tyler O'Neill's** 1.126 OPS against left-handed pitching ranks third in MLB behind NYY's Aaron Judge (1.296) and SF's Heliot Ramos (1.170)...During the same time frame, **Ryan Mountcastle** (.326, 47-for-144) and **Adley Rutschman** (.324, 56-for-173), rank seventh and eighth respectively in batting average against lefties among AL batters...Last season, the Orioles' .253 batting average against left-handers ranked second in the AL and eighth in the majors...Baltimore's 59 homers versus lefties were tied for the most in the AL and for fifth in MLB.

**GONE SNAKE HUNTING:** **Tyler O'Neill** has played in a team-high 16 games at Chase Field and produced a .527 slugging percentage, having gone 14-for-55 at the plate with six doubles and three home runs with eight runs scored, 10 RBI, and one walk.

👉 In three games at Chase Field, **Ramón Urías** has gone 5-for-11 with a double, three runs scored, and two walks.

👉 **Cedric Mullins** has gone 5-for-12 with a home run, two runs scored, four RBI, and one walk in three games at Arizona.

👉 **Zach Eflin** has pitched in three career games (2 GS) at Chase Field, producing a 3.68 ERA (6 ER/14.2 IP) on 15 hits (2 HR) with 12 strikeouts.

**SHAKE AND BAKE:** **Bryan Baker** has tossed 5.1 scoreless innings to open the season, scattering three hits with no walks and seven strikeouts across five appearances.

👉 **Gregory Soto** has thrown 4.0 scoreless innings over his first four appearances, allowing two hits, two walks, and one hit batter while fanning eight...In 24 appearances since August 8, 2024, Soto is 1-0 with a 0.89 ERA (2 ER/20.1 IP), 0.93 WHIP, and 28 strikeouts.

👉 **Seranthony Domínguez** has gone 1-0 across 4.2 scoreless innings pitched this season, allowing just one hit and four walks with six strikeouts...He has struck out multiple hitters in consecutive outings and at least one in each of his last four games.

**FOLLOW THE LEADER:** In Baltimore's four wins this season, **Cedric Mullins** is 7-for-16 (.438) with one double, two home runs, 10 RBI, five runs, two walks, one steal, and one hit-by-pitch...In the O's six losses, he is 3-for-16 (.188) with one double and one home run.

**ON THE ROAD AGAIN:** Baltimore is an MLB-best 102-67 (.604) on the road since 2023, ahead of Houston (95-69, .579) and Los Angeles-NL (96-71, .575).

👉 **Cedric Mullins** has reached base safely in 10 straight road games since September 25, 2024, going 14-for-36 (.389) with two doubles, two home runs, and six RBI in that time...It is tied for the third-longest streak of his career.

👉 **Ryan O'Hearn** has reached base safely in eight straight road games since September 27, 2024, batting .393 (11-for-28) with two doubles, two homers, and four RBI in this stretch.

**RISPY BUSINESS:** The O's are batting .362 (17-for-47) with runners in scoring position in their four wins, compared to .125 (3-for-24) in their six losses...**Cedric Mullins** paces the club with a .625 (5-for-8) RISP average.

👉 O's pitching has limited the opposition to a .216 (19-for-88) clip with RISP, the fourth-lowest mark in the AL behind the Rangers (.202, 17-for-84), Angels (.206, 14-for-68), and Royals (.213, 16-for-75).

**SMALL SAMPLE:** Oriole batters have a 11.2 percent barrel rate, the fourth-highest mark in the majors behind the Yankees (16.4%), Mets (11.8%), and Red Sox (11.4%).

👉 O's pitching has produced a 30.5 percent chase rate, the fourth-highest mark in the AL behind the Rays (32.3%), Twins (31.5%), and Red Sox (31.1%)...Baltimore also owns a 62.6 percent first pitch strike rate, the sixth-best mark in the AL.

**THE SKIPPER:** Manager **Brandon Hyde** moved into sole possession of fourth place in Orioles history with his 408<sup>th</sup> win on March 29 at Toronto...The victory broke a tie with **Hank Bauer**...The 2023 AL Manager of the Year trails **Earl Weaver** (1,480), **Buck Showalter** (669), and **Paul Richards** (517).

**THE VALLEY:** The Orioles and D-Backs commence a three-game set this evening at Chase Field...The O's won the 2024 season set, 2-1, taking the first two games before dropping the series finale in Baltimore...Since 2016, the Birds have gone 3-1 in their last four series against Arizona, including a three-game sweep at Oriole Park in 2016...The O's have compiled an 8-4 record against the D-Backs during this stretch.

👉 In 2024, **Corbin Burnes** became the first Baltimore pitcher to start an All-Star Game since **Steve Stone** in 1980.

👉 Orioles Head Athletic Trainer **Scott Barringer** was a minor league athletic trainer with the Diamondbacks at Rookie-level Missoula (2011) and Class-A Visalia (2012).

**QUICK HITS:** Set to make his third start of the season, including his second on the road...Made four Grapefruit League starts, going 0-1 with a 5.40 ERA (7 ER/11.2IP) on 13 hits, nine total runs, and five walks with nine strikeouts...Was acquired by the O's from the Tampa Bay Rays in exchange for minor leaguers RHP Jackson Baumeister, INF/OF Mac Horvath, and OF Matthew Etzel on July 26, 2024...In his final start of 2024 on September 25 at New York-AL, surpassed the 1,000.00 career inning mark... Started Game 2 of the 2024 ALWCS vs. Kansas City and did not factor into the decision, allowing one run on four hits, one walk, and one hit batter with three strikeouts across 4.0 innings.

**OPENING DAY RECAP:** Eflin became the 44<sup>th</sup> Opening Day starter in Orioles history (since 1954)...According to the *Elias Sports Bureau*, he became one of six starting pitchers since 1882 to make back-to-back Opening Day starts against the same opponent as a member of two different teams, joining Madison Bumgarner (2019 w/SF & 2020 w/AZ vs. SD), Wes Ferrell (1937 w/BSA & 1938 w/WAS vs. PHA), Sad Sam Jones (1921 w/BSA & 1922 w/NYY vs. WAS), Duke Esper (1894 w/WAS & 1895 w/BAL vs. PHI), and George Derby (1882 w/DET & 1883 w/BUF vs. CLE).

**SNAKE PIT:** Eflin has made five career appearances (4 GS) opposite Arizona, going 0-2 with a 3.18 ERA (10 ER/28.1 IP) on 24 hits (2 HR), 11 total runs, and two walks with 24 strikeouts...Last faced the Diamondbacks on June 28, 2023 at Chase Field and earned the victory (W, 7.0 IP, 7 H, 2 R, 0 BB, 7 K).  
👉 Is 6-13 with a 4.74 ERA (93 ER/176.2 IP) on 183 hits (31 HR), 99 total runs, 44 walks, and four hit batters with 140 strikeouts in 34 career appearances (31 GS) against the NL West.

**WE'RE GOING STREAKING:** Eflin has conceded three runs or fewer in a career-best 12 straight starts overall since July 24, 2024...It is the second-longest active streak in the AL behind Toronto's Bowden Francis (13 GS) and tied for the fifth-longest run in the majors.

**RIGHT THE WRONG:** In his last start on April 2 vs. Boston, Red Sox right-handed hitters went 7-for-12 (.583) with two doubles and one home run off Eflin...He held Blue Jays righties hitless (0-for-11) in his Opening Day start on March 27.  
👉 Through two outings, Eflin has limited lefties to a .143 (3-for-21) clip, including 1-for-12 (.083) against the Red Sox.  
👉 Overall, right-handed hitters are a combined 4-for-5 (.800) on Eflin's four-seam fastball and changeup, compared to 3-for-18 (.167) on his curveball, cutter, sinker, and sweeper.

**STARTING STRONG:** Through two starts, Eflin has limited the opposition to a .130/.130/.304 (3-for-23) clip when his pitch count sits from 1-45...From pitch 46 and on, opponents have found greater success, slashing .333/.364/.571 (7-for-21)... Six of his seven strikeouts have come between pitches 1-45, while tallying only one punchout from pitch 46 and on.

**IN CONTROL:** Eflin produced a 3.51 pct. walk rate in 2024, fourth lowest among all qualified MLB pitchers behind SEA's George Kirby (2.96%), CIN's Nick Martinez (3.16%), and STL's Miles Mikolas (3.47%).  
👉 From June 14, 2022-July 10, 2024, Eflin issued two walks or fewer in 51 consecutive starts, the eighth-longest such streak in MLB since 1901 behind MIN's/PHI's Carlos Silva (99), BOS' Cy Young (85), SEA's George Kirby (64, active), MIN's Phil Hughes (64), MIN's Brad Radke (62), NYG' Carl Hubbell (61), and BOS/SD' David Wells (59).

**LAST TIME OUT:** Suffered the loss on April 3 vs. Boston, allowing five runs on six hits, two walks, and two home runs with 10 strikeouts across 5.0 innings...At 41 years, 142 days old, became the oldest pitcher to record 10 strikeouts in a game in franchise history (*Sarah Langs*).

**VS. ARIZONA:** Has made 15 career starts opposite Arizona, going 5-3 with a 4.27 ERA (41 ER/86.1 IP) on 78 hits (7 HR), 34 walks, and six hit batters with 87 strikeouts...He has worked 5.0+ innings in each of his last 12 starts against the Diamondbacks since September 20, 2011.
