THE PIRATES:...were walked off yesterday for the third time this season after falling 1-0 to the Cubs.... Have played in 10 games decided by one or two runs in their last 15 contests (are 12-13 overall this season in one- or two-run games)...Are 4-5 in a stretch of 10 straight games against the National League Central...Have gone 18-3 when scoring at least four runs in a game (one of those three losses came last Sunday against the Cubs at PNC Park)...Won each of their first four extra inning games before losing for the only time last Sunday against the Cubs...Are 17-1 when leading after eight innings (their only loss came on April 9 against the Tigers)...Rank fifth in the National League and ninth in all of MLB with a .988 fielding percentage this month.

GIMME FIVE: Mitch Keller tossed 6.0 scoreless innings Monday night at Milwaukee, giving him 40 straight starts of working at least 5.0 innings in a game...It's the longest active streak in all of MLB coming into today...It's also the longest streak by a Pirate since A.J. Burnett made 49 straight starts of at least 5.0 innings from May 8 , 2012, to August 10, 2013.

MITCH IN MAY: Mitch Keller brings an 0.60 ERA (15.0ip/1er) into today in his two starts this month....Keller allowed one run while tossing the second complete game of his career against the Angels on May 6...Monday night at Milwaukee, Keller struck seven batters in 6.0 scoreless innings while winning his second straight start.

LET'S GET IT STARTED: Bailey Falter tossed 7.2 shutout innings yesterday following Paul Skenes' 6.0 shutout, hitless frames on Friday...It marks the seventh time in the last 21 seasons the Pirates have had starters go 6.0-plus shutout innings while allowing three hits or fewer in consecutive games and the first time since May 14-15, 2022... Dating back to the sixth inning on Thursday, Pirates starters haven't allowed a run in 14.2 consecutive innings (Jones scoreless sixth inning Thursday, Skenes 6.0 scoreless Friday, Falter 7.2 scoreless Saturday).

FOUR YOUR INFORMATION: The Pirates are 1-0-2 in their previous three four-game series of this season heading into the deciding game of this series with the Cubs...Pittsburgh swept the

CLOSING IN ON 700: Bryan Reynolds comes into today two hits shy of 700 in his career... Since the beginning of the 2019 season, Reynolds' 698 hits are the second-most among all switch hitters in MLB behind Jose Ramirez (721).

NAILBITERS: The Pirates have played in a total of 12 games this season decided in the last at-bat (the Bucs are 6-6 in those games)...That's tied for the fourth-most games in all of MLB along with the Orioles...The only three teams to be involved in more last at-bat decisions are the Tigers (18), Mets (15) and Cubs (13).
