RAY REPORT—The Rays open a season-long 10-game, 10-day homestand against the Nationals (three to play), Royals (four to play), and Diamondbacks (three to play) tonight at Tropicana Field...are coming off a 1-5 West Coast road trip against the Angels (1-2) and Dodgers (0-3)...tonight marks the start of a stretch of 23 games in 24 days leading into the All-Star break (June 19–July 12), with the lone off day coming on June 29...have lost three straight and five of their last six games...are 7-15 in their last 22 games (May 24–pres.), tied with the Padres (7-15) for MLB's worst record over that span, on the heels of a 22-4 stretch (April 22–May 22)...have lost 8.5 games on the AL East-leading Yankees during that timeframe, whom they now trail by 3.0 games for the division lead...could fall a season-high-tying 4.0 games back with a loss tonight and Yankees win vs. CIN...had the best record in the AL for 35 straight days between May 9–June 12, which included eight consecutive days atop the majors from May 18-25...have spent 41 days in first place in the AL East, 31 in second, six in third, four in fourth, and three in fifth.

★ The Rays scored all of their runs in the 5th inning and blew a 4-2 lead in Wednesday's 5-4 setback at Dodger Stadium, concluding a three-game sweep...it was their 13th blown lead loss, tied for second fewest in the AL—only the Rangers (11) have fewer...they have been swept three times, all of which have come in their last seven series (May 25–pres.).

★ The Rays have committed one error across their last nine games compared to 10 in their previous 12 games (May 25–June 7)...they have 18 errors in 41 games since the start of May, tied for third fewest in the AL behind the Tigers and Yankees (both 16), after entering the month with an AL-most 25 errors.

★ They have lost five straight games vs. NL opponents, their longest skid since July 4-8, 2023 (5G)...their last longer streak was a seven-game stretch from June 28-Aug. 10, 2022...the Rays 11-16 mark in interleague play ranks 23rd in the majors, but their 30-14 intraleague record leads MLB.

★ **Griffin Jax** has not yielded an earned run in his last 11.0 IP...excluding a 6-ER, 4.0-IP outing on June 1 vs. DET, the right-hander has a 1.16 ERA (4ER, 31.0IP) across his other eight starts.

★ The Rays are 16-8 (.667) in series openers, tied with the Braves and Yankees for second in the majors behind the Brewers (19-5/.792)...they are 3-4 in their last seven openers since winning nine straight from April 24–May 18...they have won seven of their last eight openers at home.

RECENT TRANSACTIONS—Today, the Rays reinstated **OF Jonny DeLuca** (right hamstring strain) from the 10-day IL and optioned **OF Austin Slater** to Triple-A Durham...DeLuca went 4-for-11 (.364) with 1 2B, 1 RBI, 4 BB, 2 SO, and 3 R on a four-game rehab assignment with Durham, reaching base safely in nine of 16 PA (.563 OBP)...he started a pair of games in both center field and right field...DeLuca hit .300 (6-for-20) with 2 2B and 4 RBI in his final five games before the IL stint (May 17-22).

WEST COAST BLUES—The Rays went 1-5 on their Southern California road trip, with four of the five losses coming by one run...according to Stats Perform, the four one-run setbacks tied the most in franchise history on a two-series road trip, matching July 2-7, 2002 (at TEX, at ANA)...last series against the Dodgers marked the Rays fifth time being swept in a three-game series, with each loss coming by exactly one run, joining Aug. 3-5, 2018 vs. CWS; July 21-23, 2017 vs. TEX; July 5-7, 2002 at ANA, and June 21-23, 2002 at COL...it marks their longest string of one-run defeats since another three-game stretch from Sept 14-16, 2025 and is one game shy of the franchise record (4G from July 22-26, 2016)...the Rays have lost four straight and six of their last seven one-run affairs after starting 9-1...their 10-7 (.588) mark in one-run contests still ranks third in the AL, trailing the White Sox (14-6/.700) and Astros (11-7/.636).

★ Seven of the 10 runs the Rays allowed last series at LAD came on 4 HR...over their last 17 games (May 30–pres.), 49.4 pct. (41) of the 83 runs against the Rays have come on 26 HR, the third-highest percentage in the AL over that span behind the Yankees (54.3%) and Blue Jays (50.6%).

SHO-STOPPERS—The Rays pushed across four runs on five hits, a walk, and a sacrifice fly in the 5th inning Wednesday against LAD **Shohei Ohtani**, who entered the outing with an MLB-best (min. 60.0IP) 1.06 ERA...the frame snapped a 20-inning scoreless streak for the Rays, who were the first club to tally a four-run inning off Ohtani since the Athletics scored five off the then-Angels right-hander in the 4th inning on April 27, 2023 in Anaheim...it was just the seventh time Ohtani (602.1 career IP) has permitted four runs or more in a frame...it also marked the third time he has allowed five hits or more in an inning, joining Aug. 20, 2025 at COL (6H, 4th) and July 22, 2022 at ATL (5H, 7th)...overall, the Rays tagged him for season highs in hits (7) and runs (4).

HOME SWEET HOME—The Rays MLB-leading 24-9 home record marks the second-best home start in franchise history behind 2023 (27-6)...they have won 20 of their last 25 games at Tropicana Field, their second-best home stretch in club history behind a 21-4 run from March 30–May 21, 2023...since May 13, the Rays are 9-5 at home (2nd in AL/4th in MLB) compared to 3-12 in road affairs (30th in MLB)...on the year, the 280-point discrepancy between their home (24-9/.727) and road (17-21/.447) records is the largest in the majors...they rank second in MLB in home RISP average (.289), third in batting average (.264) and on-base pct. (.344), and fifth in OPS (.760)...the Rays are in a stretch of 19 home games within a 28-game span from May 29–June 28, going 7-11 thus far (5-4 at home).

★ They have recorded 12 hits or more in back-to-back home games (June 9-10) for the first time since May 25-26, 2025...their last longer streak was three games from June 8-10, 2013.

★ The Rays are 12-0 against the AL East at Tropicana Field, MLB's longest season-opening, home winning streak over division rivals since the 2009 Dodgers won their first 12 home games vs. the NL West...among AL clubs, only the 2003 Royals (13-0) have had a longer streak...they are 12-9 against all other opponents at home.

★ **Junior Caminero** has hit safely in a career-high 14 straight home games (May 16–pres.), MLB's second-longest active home hitting streak to **ATH Zack Gelof** (17G) and tied for the fourth-longest streak by an AL batter this season behind Gelof, **NYC Cody Bellinger** (16G, April 13–May 20), and **HOU Yordan Alvarez** (16G, March 27–May 4)...the last Ray with a longer single-season streak was **Avisail Garcia** (16G) from May 10–June 29, 2019.

★ Caminero is batting .408 (20-for-49) with 9 XBH, 11 RBI, 14 BB vs. 7 SO, and 11 R during the streak, reaching base safely in 34 of 63 PA (.540 OBP)...min. 50 PA, he leads MLB in home on-base pct. since the streak began on May 16 while ranking fourth in OPS to **NYM Juan Soto** (1.319), teammate **Yandy Diaz** (1.318), and **CHC Pete Crow-Armstrong** (1.264).

★ Diaz has reached base safely in 16 straight home games (May 5–pres.), tied for MLB's third-longest active streak behind **SD Fernando Tatis Jr.** (19G) and **Gelof** (17G)...he is slashing .387/.451/.790 (24-for-62) with 4 2B, 7 HR, and 20 RBI at Tropicana Field during the streak.

★ **Kevin Kelly** has recorded 15 scoreless outings (16.2IP) at Tropicana Field, tied with **Joe Bowerski** in 2005 for the third-longest season-opening streak at home by a Rays reliever behind **Jake McGee** (19G) in 2012 and **Trevor Miller** (17G) in 2008...per Stats Perform, the 16.2-IP streak is the third longest to begin the season in MLB this year, trailing **MIA Tyler Phillips** (18.1) and **NYC Brent Headrick** (17.2 active) and the second longest to open a campaign in Rays history (see table on the right).

FROM D.C. TO TB—The Rays and Nationals meet for their lone series of 2026 this weekend...the Rays swept a three-game set last year from Aug. 29-31 at Nationals Park, their fifth time sweeping Washington, first since April 3-5, 2023 at WSH...they have won a franchise-record-tying four straight (also: April 3, 2023–June 30, 2024) over the Nationals dating back to June 30, 2024 and eight in nine since the clubs began meeting annually in 2023...the 8-1 (.889) record vs. the Nats since 2023 is the best in the majors, outpacing the Cardinals (15-7/.682)...the Rays have won all three series in that span and are 5-3-3 in series play under **Kevin Cash** (since 2015)...since losing their first series with the Expos from June 5-7, 1998 in St. Petersburg, the Rays are undefeated (4-0-3) in their last seven home sets against the Nationals/Expos franchise.

★ Nationals Manager **Blake Butera** served as the Rays senior director, player development from 2024-25 as part of an eight year stint working in the club's farm system (2018-25) before joining Washington this past offseason...he spent two seasons as a player in the Rays system from 2015-16 after the Rays selected him in the 35th round of the 2015 First-Year Player Draft...Nationals General Manager **Anirudh Kilambi** began his career working in the Rays front office (2015-21).

★ **Zack Littell** (2023-25), **Curtis Mead** (2023-25), and **Richard Lovelady** (2024) are former Rays.

★ Bench coach **Michael Johns** was the Rays first base coach from 2024-25 following over 15 years holding various roles in the organization's player development system, guiding Triple-A Durham (2023) and Class-A Charlotte (2015) to league championships as manager...catching coach **Bobby Wilson**, a Dunedin, Fla. native who attended Seminole High School and St. Petersburg College, played 53 games for the Rays from 2015-16...assistant hitting coach **Shawn O'Malley**, a 2006 Tampa Bay draftee (5th round), played eight seasons in the Rays minor league system (2006-13).

★ **Nick Fortes** is a career .298 (28-for-94) hitter with 8 XBH and 16 RBI in 34 games against the Nationals...**Ben Williamson** is 5-for-11 (.455) in three games.

BIRTHDAY WISHES—**Casey Legumina** celebrates his 29th birthday today...the right-hander has never pitched on his birthday in his career...the last Ray to pitch on his birthday was **Mason Montgomery** (June 17, 2025 vs. BAL), and only three Rays have earned the win in relief on their birthdays: **Wade Davis** (Sept. 7, 2012 vs. TEX), **Kyle Farnsworth** (April 14, 2011 vs. MIN), and **Dan Micelli** (Sept. 9, 2006 vs. OAK).

DOWN ON THE FARM—With a 3-2, rain-shortened win at Asheville last night, Class-A Bowling Green concluded the first half at 47-18 (.723), the second-best first-half winning pct. by any full-season minor league team since at least 2005, trailing 2011 Class-A San Jose (.729/.51-19)...the Hot Rods have clinched their third straight playoff berth and fifth in six seasons since joining the South Atlantic League in 2021.

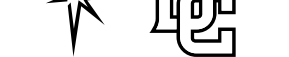

TONIGHT'S START—Griffin Jax will toe the rubber today for his 10th start and 21st appearance of the year, including his fifth start and eighth outing at Tropicana Field...marks his 10th straight start after pitching out of the bullpen in each of his first 11 appearances...is the 26th start of his major league career...is seeking his first win since April 18 at PIT and first since joining the Rays starting rotation...acquired from the Twins for RHP Taj Bradley on July 31, 2025.

LAST TIME OUT—Spun a season-high-tying 5.0 innings on June 13 at LAA with five hits allowed, one run allowed (OER), and five strikeouts...became the 12th Ray to suffer the loss despite allowing no earned runs and the first since Taj Bradley (1R-OER) on June 1 at HOU...the lone run he allowed came on a Nolan Schanuel batted ball that left the bat at 101.4 mph and was scored an error after hitting off of the heel of Taylor Walls' glove...in his nine starts this season, he is 0-3 with a 2.57 ERA (35.0IP, 10ER) and 31 strikeouts to 11 walks...he has allowed two runs or fewer in five of his six starts of 4.0 innings or more, including one run over his last 11.0 innings of work.

THE DISTRICT—Jax has appeared in five games opposite the Nationals in his career, all as a relief pitcher...he holds a 0-1 record and a 3.86 ERA (4.2IP, 2ER), with nine strikeouts in those outings...has limited opponents to a .222 (4-for-18) clip and his teams have gone 4-1 in those affairs.

✦ Jax has a 3-11 record with three saves and a 4.85 ERA (94.2IP, 51ER) with 118 strikeouts across 86 appearances (five starts) against NL clubs...against the NL this season, he is 1-2 with a 5.68 ERA (12.2IP, 8ER) in nine games (two starts).

BACK IN THE BAY—At Tropicana Field this season, Jax holds a 4.86 ERA (16.2IP, 9ER) in seven games (four starts) with 21 strikeouts to six walks and a .217 (13-for-60) opp. average...six of his nine earned runs at home came in his last outing at Tropicana Field on June 1 vs. DET (L, 4.0IP, 7H, 6R, BB, 5SO, 3HR)...in his career, he holds a 4.52 ERA (199.1IP, 100ER) in home games compared to a 3.49 ERA (201.1IP, 78ER) on the road.

GET JAX UP AND MOVING—This marks the first time Jax has been a regular starter since his 2021 rookie season with the Twins, when he made his final 14 appearances as a member of the Twins rotation after his first four came in relief...he started two games for the Rays last season, working as an opener for Ian Seymour on Sept. 5 vs. CLE before starting a bullpen game on Sept. 10, 2025 at CWS...both starts lasted 1.0 scoreless frame...for his career, he is 3-8 with a 4.82 ERA (106.1IP, 57ER) in 25 starts compared to 21-28 with a 3.70 ERA (294.1IP, 121ER) in 294 relief appearances.

✦ Jax spent his first five professional seasons (2016-19, 2021) as a starter...he first transitioned to a full-time relief role in 2022...from 2016-21, 50 of his 55 minor league appearances were starts.

CAPTAIN JAX—Jax is currently a Captain in the U.S. Air Force Reserve, earning the promotion in June 2021, and remains the only Air Force Academy graduate to play in the majors...after his graduation from the Academy in 2017, he made five starts with Class-A Cedar Rapids and Rookie-level Elizabethton during his 60-day leave ahead of his first active duty assignment, departing on July 22 to begin his role as an acquisitions officer working with civilian contractors such as SpaceX and Boeing...the following year, he was accepted into the Air Force World Class Athlete Program, which allows soldiers to train for the upcoming Olympic Games as their active duty job responsibility for a two-year period, allowing him to continue his baseball career while completing his active duty requirement...became eligible for the program when baseball was readmitted for the scheduled 2020 Tokyo Olympics.

✦ He completed his active duty requirement and was admitted to the Air Force Reserve in November 2019...was notified of his promotion to Captain on June 5, 2021, the same day he was selected to the Twins major league roster ahead of his MLB debut three days later.

MLB CAREER RECAP—Last season, made a career-high 73 appearances (2 starts), tied for sixth most in the AL, between the Twins (50G) and Rays (23G), going a combined 1-7 with a 4.23 ERA (66.0IP, 31ER)...also set career bests in strikeouts (99) and holds (28)...acquired at the July 31 trade deadline for RHP Taj Bradley...of his 99 strikeouts, 97 came as a reliever, fourth most in the AL behind HOU Bryan Abreu (105), CLE Cade Smith (104), and teammate Edwin Uceta (103)...min. 250 BF, ranked second in the majors in chase rate (38.1%) behind CIN Graham Ashcraft (38.3%) and was fifth in whiff rate (37.3%)...joined Abreu as the only pitchers in the majors to make 70 appearances or more each season from 2023-25...his 216 appearances in that timeframe ranked third to SF/NYM Tyler Rogers (226G) and Abreu (220G).

✦ In 2024, received the Joseph W. Haynes Award as Twins Pitcher of the Year, as voted on by the Twin Cities chapter of the BBWAA...became the first Minnesota pitcher to record 10 saves and 20 holds in a season.

✦ In 2023, made the Twins Opening Day roster for the first time and spent the year in the club's bullpen...tied for ninth in the AL with a team-leading 23 holds...led the majors with a 3.3 pct. barrel rate (min. 250BF).

✦ In 2022, transitioned to a relief role for the first time after spending his first six professional seasons (2016-21) as a starter...led the Twins bullpen in innings (72.1), tied for the team lead in holds (18), and ranked second in appearances (65)...began the season with Triple-A St. Paul after spending spring training with the Twins...made one appearance before being recalled April 12 when Jorge Alcala was placed on the injured list, remaining with the big-league club through season's end.

✦ Made his major league debut in 2021 across four stints with the Twins: June 5-16, June 24-July 7, July 19-20, and July 30-end of season...maintained a regular spot in the rotation during his season-ending stint with the club...named the recipient of the Bob Feller Act of Valor Award, given annually to the major leaguer who best embodies the spirit of the late Hall of Famer, both in terms of commitment to country and love for baseball.
