**RECENT REDBIRDS:** The St. Louis Cardinals and visiting Washington Nationals continue with the third game of a four-game series tonight at Busch Stadium ... St. Louis is 4-1 on its seven game homestand after sweeping the division-rival Cubs over the weekend and splitting the first two games with Washington.

**FLIGHT PATTERN:** The Cardinals are currently in first place in the NL Central, 8.5 games in front of Milwaukee (71-64) ... St. Louis currently holds the No. 3 seed in the NL postseason standings, 5.5 games behind the Mets (No. 2) ... The Cardinals have gone 10-1-1 in their last 12 series with wins in each of the last seven, and have gone an MLB-best 29-11 (.725), the last time the club lost back-to-back games (July 24-26). **WHAT'S THE DIFFERENCE:** The Cardinals +135 run differential (666-531) ranks 3rd in the NL behind the Braves (+156) and Dodgers (+294).

**UPDATING THE ROSTER:** Before tonight's game, the Cardinals announced that they placed OF **Dylan Carlson** on 10-day Injured List (left hand thumb sprain), selected the contract of OF **Alec Burleson** (#41) from Memphis (AAA), and designated OF **Conner Capel** for assignment ... Additionally, RHP **Junior Fernández**, who was designated for assignment on Sept. 5, has been claimed by Pittsburgh.

**BABY BIRDS:** With his first appearance, **Alec Burleson** would become the 13th different Cardinal to make their MLB debut this season, most for St. Louis since the COVID-shortened 2020 season (13) and tied for 6th-most in MLB this season (Oakland leads with 18) ... The last time St. Louis had 14+ debuts was 1924 (14) ... 2013 is the only time in franchise history when St. Louis won its division and had as many MLB debuts (97-65 record and 12 MLB debuts) ... Burleson would also become the 9th MLB player overall to debut from the 2020 MLB Draft.

**JOINING THE FLOCK:** Overall, **Alec Burleson** would become the 2,063rd player to appear in a game in franchise history and the 24th to debut this season with St. Louis, most since the total of 23 different Cardinals in 2011 (9 MLB debuts).

**Q IN THE LOU:** According to *Elias*, **José Quintana** last night became the first Cardinals pitcher since 1912 (the first year earned runs were officially tracked in the National League) to allow two earned runs or fewer in each of his first seven starts with the team.

**VICTORY FORMATION:** St. Louis is a collective 24-4 (.857) in games that trade deadline acquisitions **Jordan Montgomery** (6-0), **Chris Stratton** (9-2), **José Quintana** (6-1) and **JoJo Romero** (3-1) have appeared in.

**NATIONAL NEWS:** Since Busch Stadium III opened in 2006, the Cardinals' .688 home winning pct. (33-15) against the Nationals is their 3rd-best against any opponent, trailing the Rockies (.768, 44-13) and Padres (.704, 32-16) ... St. Louis has won the home series vs. the Nationals in 12 of 15 visits.

**EAST HAS BEEN A BEAST:** The Cardinals hold a 16-17 mark vs. the NL East (4-4 vs. Braves; 4-2 vs. Marlins; 2-5 vs. Mets; 3-4 vs. Phillies; 3-2 vs. Nationals) and are combined 7-9 vs. the AL East (1-2 vs. Orioles; 0-3 vs. Rays, 2-2 vs. Blue Jays; 1-2 vs. Red Sox; 3-0 vs. Yankees) ... St. Louis sports winning records against the NL Central (38-20), NL West (17-9), and AL Central (3-1).

**MR. SEPTEMBER:** Since 2019, **Tommy Edman** 102 hits and 59 runs in September rank 2nd and 5th in MLB ... Edman has hit safely in his last nine games since Aug. 28 (.412/.429/.912, 14-34), 4th-longest active in the NL and one shy of his 2022 season best 10-gamer (April 7-20).

**CORE' VALUES:** **Corey Dickerson's** .415 (34-82) batting average after the All-Star Break this season currently ranks as the 5th-highest post-ASB average in MLB single-season history (since 1933) ... 1953 Red Sox **Ted Williams** (.453, 78-172) is the highest ... Dickerson led MLB with a .411 batting average in August and has hit safely in 12 of his last 15 games (.444, 24-54) with four three-hit efforts.

**A PAIR BEYOND COMPARE:** **Adam Wainwright** and **Yadier Molina** have made 323 career starts as batterymates, one shy of the all-time MLB record of 324 established by **Mickey Lolich** and **Bill Freehan** of the Detroit Tigers (1963-75) nearly 50 seasons ago ... Waino and Yadi are projected to tie the Tigers duo on Thursday vs. Washington and break the record with their 325th start on Sept. 14 vs. the Brewers.

**BEACH BIRDS:** For the first time since 2018, the Single-A Palm Beach Cardinals punched a ticket to the Florida State League postseason with last night's victory ... Palm Beach will play the St. Lucie Mets in a best-of-3 series from Sept. 13-16 ... Managed by **Gary Kendall**, notable Beach Birds include top 100 prospect RHP **Tink Henge** (No. 28), FSL wins leader RHP **Trent Baker** (9), OF **Joshua Baez** (No. 11 Cards prospect), and 10 players from the recent 2022 MLB First-Year Player Draft.

**HOMEWORK ASSIGNMENT:** The Cardinals are in a stretch where they are home for 17 of 23 games from Aug. 26-Sept. 18 ... Their lone road games remaining over the three-week period consist of a three-game series at Pittsburgh (Sept. 9-11) ... The Cardinals have won 19 of their

**Andrew Knizner** was born in Glen Allen, Va... graduated from Hanover (Va) High School, where he was a quarterback and punter for the football team and was an All-State shortstop on the 2013 Virginia AAA State Championship team.

**Mike Maddux** was Nationals pitching coach for two seasons (2016-17) prior to St. Louis...also pitched parts of two seasons (1998-99) for the Expos.

**Corey Dickerson** made his MLB debut at Washington (June 22, 2013)...doubled in his first two career plate appearances off Dan Haren...Became the 37th player in MLB history to hit two doubles in his first game and the first by a Rookie.

**Ildemaro Vargas** was signed by St. Louis as an international free agent (June 26, 2008) and played seven seasons in the Cardinals minor league organization (2008-14).

**Bryan Eversgerd** pitched in 25 games for Montreal in 1995...became an Expo via trade with St. Louis (April 5, 1995), packaged with pitcher Kirk Bullinger and outfielder DaRond Stovall to Montreal for pitcher Ken Hill.

**Steve Cishek** pitched in 27 games for the Cardinals in 2015 after being traded by the Marlins in exchange for **Kyle Barraclough** (July 24, 2015).

**Dave Martinez** made his MLB debut vs. St. Louis (June 15, 1986) while with the Chicago Cubs.

Nationals broadcaster **Bob Carpenter** worked 10 seasons with the Cardinals on both radio and television before joining Washington...graduated from nearby McBride (Mo.) High School...his sister, **Judy Carpenter-Barada**, previously served as Cardinals Director of Major League Admin.

Nats Comm MGR **Daniel Kurish** was born in St. Louis.

**Lane Thomas** played in 84 games over parts of three seasons for St. Louis (2019-21)...traded to Washington for **Jon Lester** (July 30, 2021).

**Luke Voit** played in 70 games for St. Louis, where he made his MLB debut (2017-18)...selected by the Cardinals in the 22nd round of the 2013 MLB draft out of Missouri State University...attended Lafayette High School in Wildwood, MO...traded by St. Louis with international bonus slot money to the Yankees for **Giovanny Gallegos** and **Chasen Shreve** (July 29, 2018).

Cardinals Hall of Famer and broadcaster **Tim McCarver** played in 92 games for Montreal (1972).

**Joe Ross's** older brother, **Tyson Ross**, pitched in nine games for the Cardinals in 2018.

Nationals broadcaster **Charlie Slowes** worked three years at KMOX in St. Louis (1984-86).

- Makes his 17th start for the Cardinals, 28th of the season and the 104th of his career.
- Is 5-0 and the Cardinals 6-0 in his starts since joining St. Louis at the trade deadline. Last Cardinals starting pitcher to start 5-0 was **Miles Mikolas** (6-0 in 2018).
- The Cardinals are a combined 12-1 in starts made by Montgomery (6-0) and **José Quintana** (6-1) since they were both acquired at the trade deadline.
- Has held the opposition scoreless in four of his six starts as a Cardinal. He's first Cardinals lefty since **Jaime Garcia** (4 in 2010) to win four games while allowing no runs.
- Including tonight, 6 of his first 7 starts with St. Louis have come at Busch Stadium.
- Is one of four MLB starters with 1.000 win pct. in home games this season (min. 10 GS), going 6-0: **Cal Quantrill**-CLE (7-0); **Zac Gallen**-ARI (6-0); **Tyler Anderson**-LAD (7-0).
- His 1.76 ERA in August (30.2 IP) was his lowest in any month of his career with more than one start and the lowest by a Cardinals southpaw since **John Tudor** posted a 1.74 mark in 1985. **Bill Sherdel** holds the August franchise mark with a 1.00 ERA in 1918.
- Became the 2nd MLB pitcher in the modern era to go 4-0 with no more than 1 run allowed over his first 4 starts with a team. Rookie **Fernando Valenzuela** is only MLB pitcher to yield one run over his first five starts (45.0 IP) with the 1981 LA Dodgers.
- Is one of three starting pitchers to have won each of their first four appearances to begin a Cardinals career, joining 1927 rookie **Fred Frankhouse** (5-0 in first 5 starts) and 1941 mid-season acquisition **Harry Gumbert** (4-0 in first four starts).
- The last MLB starting pitcher to win his first 5 appearances with a franchise was **J.A. Happ** with the 2018 Yankees (July 29-Aug. 25). **Adam Wainwright** (Aug. 22-Sept. 13, 2021) was the last Cardinals starting pitcher overall to win five consecutive appearances.
- Logged season-best 13.1 scoreless innings over his first three starts with St. Louis, tying **Alex Reyes** (2016) and **John Urrea** (1977) for 5th-longest to begin a Cardinals career. Also was the longest by a starter since **Kyle Lohse** (15.0 IP) in 2008.
- Limiting left-handed batters to a .213/.231/.270 slash with just one HR (Rafael Devers on July 15), three extra-base hits, and just one walk.
- Has worked 6.0+ IP, allowing 2 runs or fewer, in a career high 11 starts, besting his previous high in such starts for a single season (8 in 2017).
- At the time of being acquired on August 2 in trade from the Yankees in exchange for OF **Harrison Bader**, was among AL leaders in innings pitched (114.2), starts (21), opponent BA (.236), WHIP (1.10), walks/9 IP (1.81), HR/9 IP (1.18) and hits/9 IP (8.08).

- Improved to 5-0 with the Cardinals in an 8-0 win over the Cubs last Friday (9/2), as he worked 6.0 scoreless innings. Stretched his scoreless innings streak against the Cubs to 22.0 IP. It was his 4th win without allowing a run since joining the Cardinals.

- Is making his first career appearance/start vs. the Washington Nationals.
- The Nationals are one of six teams he's yet to face in his MLB career. The others include ARI, LAD, STL, SF and SD.
- Has a career mark of 2-4, 6.53 ERA in 9 career games vs. NL East teams. His last win vs. NL East club came on 8/23/21 at Atlanta.
- Has one career quality start vs. NL East clubs, that coming on 8/11/20 in a 9-6 win over the Braves at Yankee Stadium.

- Drafted in 4th round by the Yankees in 2014 out of the University of South Carolina.
- Finished 6th in AL Rookie of the Year voting in 2017 and was named to the Topps MLB All-Star Rookie Team. Led AL rookies in starts (29), strikeouts (144) and innings pitched (155.1) his rookie season.
- At time of his trade, had 2nd most starts for the Yankees (97) among pitchers in the organization, trailing only Luis Severino (104). His 61 starts from 2020-22 ranked T6th most in the American League in that time span & T18th in the majors among all pitchers.
- Set career highs for innings pitched (157.1) and strikeouts (162) in 2021.
