MIAMI MARLINS (24-33) vs. PITTSBURGH PIRATES (23-34)

June 6, 2021 at PNC Park, Pittsburgh, PA -- GAME #58/HOME #29

RHP SANDY ALCANTARA (2-5, 3.68 ERA) vs. RHP CHAD KUHL (0-2, 6.41 ERA)

THE PIRATES... have won a season-high tying three straight games and have gone 5-3 in their last eight after losing six in a row...Have gone 11-23 in their last 34 games after winning three straight games to go above .500 (12-11) on 4/27...Were 18-39 after 57 games in 2020 (18-40 after 58).

CHECKING THE BROOM CLOSET: A victory today would give the Pirates their first series sweep of the 2021 season and their first four-game sweep of any team since August 29-September 1, 2019 at Colorado...Pittsburgh's last four-game sweep at PNC Park came against the Reds in 2019 (April 4-7) and the last time the Pirates swept a four-game series from the Marlins came during the 1994 season (June 9-12 at Three Rivers Stadium).

YESTERDAY'S NEWS: **Jacob Stallings** recorded his second walkoff hit of the season and the fifth of his career Saturday afternoon to help the Pirates improve to 4-1 in extra innings this season (the Bucs went 1-5 in extra innings last year)...The Pirates have now won three straight games and five of their last six played at PNC Park...Since 1961, only three other Bucco catchers have had more walkoff hits than Stallings; **Jason Kendall** (8), **Manny Sanguillen** (7) and **Tony Pena** (7).

PEN POWER: Pittsburgh's bullpen allowed one earned run in 7.0 innings on Saturday after working a combined 7.0 scoreless innings against the Fish on Friday...Pittsburgh's bullpen enters today with the fourth-best batting average against (.221) and sixth-best ERA (3.76) among all National League teams.

KUHL RUNNINGS: This afternoon's start will be **Chad Kuhl**'s second since being reinstated from the injured list on 5/31; he was sidelined since 4/19 due to right shoulder discomfort...His lone start at PNC Park this season came in an 8-4 Bucco victory over the Padres on 4/13 (3.2ip/4r/3er)...Kuhl has posted a 13-11 record in his 38 career starts at home, having won seven of his last 10 decisions (the Pirates have gone 21-17 in the 38 games).

LA STORY: Following a day off Monday, the Pirates will be hosting the Dodgers in a three-game series beginning Tuesday night...It will mark Los Angeles' first visit to PNC Park since winning all three games here from May 24-26, 2019...The Pirates have lost 10 straight games to the Dodgers since winning for the last time on 6/5/18 at PNC Park.

CASHING IN AT PNC: **Ke'Bryan Hayes** has hit safely in each of his last eight games at PNC Park, dating back to September 19, going 13-for-33 (.394) with two doubles, a triple, three home runs and 1.216 OPS in that time.

COMING THROUGH IN THE CLUTCH: **Adam Frazier** has seven hits in his last 14 at bats with runners in scoring position and is hitting .421 (16-for-38) in that department this season...The only player in all of Major League Baseball with a higher average with runners in scoring position (minimum 35 at bats) is Toronto's Vladimir Guerrero Jr. (.444).

ON THE MEND: **Colin Moran** (left groin strain) and **Phillip Evans** (left hamstring strain) began rehab assignments with Indianapolis Tuesday night...Moran homered Thursday vs. Columbus and went 3-for-9 with six RBI in his three rehab games while Evans has hit safely in each of his first four contests, going 5-for-10 with a pair of doubles and an RBI.

THE LIFE OF BRYAN: **Bryan Reynolds** has homered four times in his last nine games (30 at bats) and leads the team with eight this season...He has reached base safely in 10 straight games and in 22 of his last 23 starts, dating back to 5/10...His 98 total bases while playing the outfield rank fourth among N.L. players and his 25 extra-base hits rank third behind Nick Castellanos (31) and Ronald Acuna, Jr. (27).

CATCH THIS: **Jacob Stallings** has seven RBI in his last four games and a career-high 25 this season, which are the second-most among all catchers in the N.L. behind Yadier Molina (27)...Pittsburgh's catchers rank fourth in MLB with 31 RBI, trailing only Arizona and Tampa Bay (37 apiece) and Oakland (33).

THE HITS KEEP COMIN': **Adam Frazier** has hit safely in nine straight games, 19 of his last 20 and 31 of his last 34 (dating back to April 28)...Over the last 15 games, he has gone 8-for-14 with three doubles and a homer in the first inning...Frazier enters today's action tied for the Major League lead in hits (75) and first in doubles (19).

THE COMFORTS OF HOME: **Adam Frazier** has hit safely in 11 of his last 12 games at PNC Park (19-for-49, .388) and is hitting .339 (38-for-112) overall at home this season...**Jacob Stallings** is hitting .312 (24-for-77) and has produced 18 RBI at home in 2021...**Clay Holmes** has posted a 0.54 ERA (16.2ip/1er) in 14 games at PNC Park this season and **Chasen Shreve** is unscored upon in his first eight games (5.2ip) here.

SLINGIN' SAMMY: Lefty **Sam Howard** has held left-handed batters to two hits in 35 at bats this season and they have gone hitless in 26 straight at bats since San Diego's Jake Cronenworth singled on 4/13...Howard has stranded all 15 of his inherited runners and held opposing batters hitless in 20 at bats with runners in scoring position.

NOTHING SHORT OF THE BEST: **Kevin Newman** is the only Major League shortstop without an error this season (min: 40 games played)...He has gone 48 consecutive games without making an error at shortstop (he made one in his final game there in 2020)...Newman holds the club record for most consecutive errorless games at shortstop in a single season, having gone 54 straight games without a miscue in 2019 from May 24 to July 23.

ON THIS DATE IN PIRATES HISTORY

June 6, 1894: The Pirates set a club record by scoring 27 runs in a game in a 27-11 victory over the Boston Beaneaters in Pittsburgh. Boston actually led 2-0 in the second inning and the score was tied, 3-3, before the Pirates erupted for 12 runs in the bottom of the third and nine more in the fourth.

JT BRUBAKER: The 27-year-old righthander is expected to make his 11th start of the season when he takes the mound Tuesday against the Dodgers...Made his last start on 5/29 vs. Colorado and pitched 6.0 scoreless innings for the win...Was on the Bereavement List from 5/30 to 6/3...Has lost two of his last three starts after winning a 7-2 decision on 5/11 vs. Cincinnati...Has been charged with two earned runs or less in seven of his first 10 starts...Has surrendered at least one home run in six of his last seven starts, including a season-high three on 5/23 at Atlanta...Went 1-3 with a 4.94 ERA (47.1ip/26er) in 11 games (nine starts) with the Pirates in 2020 and ranked second among National League rookies in strikeouts (48)...Made his Major League debut on 7/26 at St. Louis and pitched 2.0 scoreless innings of relief.
