AROUND THE HORN

RECORD-SETTING 50/50: The D-backs Give Back 50/50 Raffle supported by Avnet Cares generated a record jackpot of \$712,332 on Saturday, surpassing \$560,331 on Father's Day 2025...this season's 50/50 Raffle jackpots totaled \$5.0 million with \$2.5 to winning fans and \$2.5 to charity.

RACE AGAINST CANCER THIS SUNDAY: This Sunday, Sept. 27, the D-backs Foundation will host their 13th annual Race Against Cancer, presented by Dignity Health Cancer Institute...the charitable 5K, which begins and ends at Chase Field, brings together community members in support of Arizona nonprofit organizations dedicated to cancer screening, treatment, and support for individuals and families affected by all types of cancer.

HERE’S THE STORY: The D-backs are 5-1 in their last 6 road games and 8-4 in their last 12 road games.

- Merrill Kelly** tossed his first career complete game in a 9-1 win on May 15 @ Rockies (9.0 IP, 1 R, 4 H, 0 BB, 3 K).
- Kelly is 1 of 4 D-backs to throw a complete game at Rockies, along with Omar Daal (May 22, 1999), Armando Reynoso (Sept. 28, 2000) and Patrick Corbin (May 20, 2013).
- Nolan Arenado** has reached base safely in 16 straight games, batting .379 (22-for-58)/1.248 OPS with 3 doubles, 7 homers, 14 RBI and 7 walks.
- His 7 home runs in September are tied for fourth in the Majors.
- The bullpen, in their last 5 games, has a 1.29 ERA (4 R-3 ER in 21.0 IP), an opponent .169 AVG (12-for-71)/.522 OPS, 6 walks and 14 strikeouts.
- Geraldo Perdomo** has reached base safely in 14 straight games, hitting .354 (17-for-48)/.865 OPS with 1 double, 1 triple, 5 RBI and 8 walks.

LAST GAME: The D-backs won 7-2 @ Rockies.

- Michael Soroka** had a quality start, working 7.0 innings with 2 runs (1 earned) on 2 hits and 1 walk with 9 strikeouts...it was his third career start, second of the season, with 7.0-plus innings and 2 or fewer hits.
- Nolan Arenado** had a first-inning single, third-inning double and seventh-inning home run, falling a triple shy of his third career cycle.
- Tim Tawa** had a ground-rule, RBI double and a sac fly.
- Geraldo Perdomo** was 3-for-5 with 1 RBI and **Ildemaro Vargas** had 2 singles and 1 walk.

WILD CARD RACE: The D-backs are fourth in the NL Wild Card race, 4.0 games behind the Cubs (WC T-1, trail 2-4), Phillies (WC3, tied 3-3) and Padres (WC T-1, season tied 5-5, 3-game series from Sept. 25-27).

WINNING AT HOME AND ON THE ROAD: The D-backs, who are 45-36 at home and 38-38 on the road, are looking to post their ninth season all-time with .500 or better records at both home and on the road, along with 1999 (H: 52-29, 48-33), 2001 (H: 48-33, R: 44-37), 2002 (H: 55-26, 43-38), 2011 (H: 51-30, R: 43-38), 2017 (H: 52-29, R: 41-40), 2019 (H: 44-37, R: 41-40), 2023 (H: 43-38, R: 41-40), 2024 (H: 44-37, R: 45-36).

- The D-backs’ .567 (45-36) home win pct. was their highest since 2017 (.642, 52-29).

ANSWERBACKS: The D-backs’ 47 comeback wins lead the Majors, ahead of the Padres (44), Dodgers (44), Cubs (42), Brewers (41) and Braves (41).

- Their 22 comeback road wins lead the Majors, ahead of the Red Sox (20), Braves (20), Brewers (18), A’s (18), Cubs (18), Reds (18).

MORENO RACKING UP HITS: **Gabriel Moreno’s** 140 hits are the most by a D-backs catcher in a season (min. 100 games played at catcher):

- Moreno’s 117 hits when in the lineup as a catcher are the sixth-most by a D-backs backstop behind Miguel Montero (138 in 2012), Miguel Montero (137 in 2011), Johnny Estrada (122 in 2006), Miguel Montero (118 in 2014) and Miguel Montero (118 in 2009).

GABI EYEING .300: **Gabriel Moreno’s** .306 AVG is fourth in the Majors, behind Yordan Álvarez/HOU (.314), Luis Arráez/SF-PHI (.314) and Chandler Simpson/TB (.309) and ahead of Otto López/MIA (.304).

- Looks to become the first catcher qualified for the batting title (min. 81 games at catcher and min. 502 PA) to hit .300+ since:
 - 2017: Buster Posey/SF hit .320
 - 2016: Yadier Molina/STL hit .307, Wilson Ramos/WSH hit .307 and J.T. Realmuto/MIA hit .303.
 - 2015: Buster Posey/SF hit .318
 - 2014: Buster Posey/SF hit .311 and Jonathan Lucroy/MIL hit .301.

STRONG SEPTEMBER ‘PEN: The bullpen’s 2.29 ERA (25 R-21 ER in 82.2 IP) in September is second in the Majors to the Guardians (2.18) and ahead of the Red Sox (2.61).

- In 18 games in September, have posted a .202 AVG (59-for-292)/.573 OPS with 25 walks and 81 strikeouts.

COMFORTABLE @ COORS: **Corbin Carroll** has reached base safely in 20 straight games @ Rockies, the third-longest road streak @ Rockies in club history behind a 23-gamer from Luis Gonzalez (June 18, 2000-Sept. 21, 2002) and 25-gamer by Paul Goldschmidt (Sept. 20, 2013-Sept. 3, 2016).

- During his streak, is batting .329 (25-for-76)/1.090 OPS with 4 doubles, 1 triple, 6 homers, 12 RBI, 15 walks and 1 hit by pitch.

SHUTTING IT DOWN: **Justin Martinez** has not allowed an earned run in his 12 games (2 R-0 ER in 11.1 IP) since returning from the 60-day Injured List on Aug. 18.

- Brandyn Garcia** has held road foes scoreless in 6 straight games (5.0 IP, 1 H, 1 BB, 8 K) and 10 of his last 11 outings (2 ER in 9.0 IP, 2 H, 3 BB, 16 K).
- Juan Morillo** has held opponents scoreless in 12 of his last 13 road games (2 ER in 12.2 IP) with opponents hitting .178 (8-for-45) with 2 walks and 17 strikeouts.

SNAKEBITES: **Gabriel Moreno** has hit safely in 14 of his last 16 games at a .361 clip (22-for-61)/1.060 OPS with 4 doubles, 4 homers, 10 RBI and 8 walks.

- Brandyn Garcia** has a 13-game scoreless streak (13.1 IP, 4 H, 3 BB, 16 K).

VS. ROCKIES: The D-backs are 7-4 vs. Rockies this year, including taking 2 of 3 @ Rockies from May 15-17.
