TONIGHT'S GAME: The Braves and Phillies continue a three-game set tonight with the 18th of 19 meetings between the teams this season... The two clubs will conclude the season series with the three-game set this week, and are not scheduled to play again until next February, when the teams will meet for a Spring Training game in Clearwater, FL.

A The Braves need to win these final two games to take the season series from the Phillies for the second consecutive year and for the seventh time in the last eight years.
A The clubs concluded a four-game set in Philadelphia just five days ago, and are in the middle of an 11-day stretch in which they play each other seven times

A After getting swept in a season-opening, threegame series in Philadelphia, the Braves have won eight of the last 14 games with the Phillies, outscoring their division rival 102-66 over the stretch.

A RHP Julio Teheran is set to face the Phillies for the second consecutive start after the righty allowed five runs, earned, over 4.0 innings to take a $9-5$ loss last Thursday at Citizens Bank Park...For his career, Teheran is $9-8$ with a 3.92 ERA ( 64 ER/147.0 IP) in 25 games, 24 starts, against Philadelphia.

A RHP Zach Eflin is $0-3$ with a 11.57 ERA (12 ER/9.1 IP) in three starts against the Braves this season...He dropped a 3-1 decision to Atlanta in his last start on September 11 in Philadelphia, allowing three unearned runs over 3.2 innings... He threw 95 pitches in his outing, while allowing three hits and three walks.

HOME RUN RECORD: Adeiny Hechavarría's pinch-hit, eighth-inning solo shot last night was Atlanta's 236th homer of the season, establishing a new single-season franchise home run record...The club tied the old mark set by the 2003 team last Friday.

A Adam Duvall added another solo shot in the ninth inning, and Atlanta is currently seventh in the majors with their 237 homers.

PLAYOFF BOUND: The Braves clinched a postseason berth Saturday at Washington and enter tonight with a magic number of three to clinch the National League East, which would give the club their second consecutive division title.

A The Braves are looking for their 19th division title in franchise history, and they are currently tied with New York (AL) for the most in MLB history.

A Atlanta is one of just two teams in baseball to have already clinched a spot in the 2019 Postseason... The Dodgers have also done so.

A The Braves have lost eight consecutive playoff rounds, dating to the 2001 League Championship Series against Arizona.

40-20-10?: 2B Ozzie Albies collected his eighth triple of the season in the first inning last night, and he is now two away from the first 40 double, 20 homer, 10 triple season in franchise history.

A With two more triples, Albies would become the fifth player this century with such a season and the first since Arizona's Stephen Drew in 2008.

A Cleveland's Grady Sizemore (2006), Chicago's Ray Durham (2001) and Philadelphia's Bobby Abreu (2000) all reached the marks.

A Other than Durham, the only other second baseman in history to reach those marks was Hall-of-Famer Rogers Hornsby...He did it four times, first in 1921, and then again in 1922, 1924, and 1925.

40-40?: OF Ronald Acuña Jr. needs one home run and three steals to become the fifth player in baseball history to collect a 40 -homer, 40-steal season.

A OF José Canseco was the first player to go 40-40, reaching 42 home runs and 40 steals in 1988...Barry Bonds then matched those numbers in 1996, while Alex Rodríguez had 42 homers and 46 steals in 1998...Alfonso Soriano then had 46 and 41 in 2006.

A Acuña Jr. is the 15 th player in history to have 35 home runs and 35 stolen bases in a single season, and the youngest to accomplish the feat...The last player to reach those marks was Matt Kemp in 2011 with the Dodgers.

SERIES PLAY: The Braves need to win the final two games of this series to avoid dropping a multi-game set for the first time since losing both games to Kansas City, July 23-24, here at SunTrust Park...They have gone 11-0-4 in multi-game series play since that sweep.

A The Braves' streak of 15 straight multi-game series without a loss is the longest such streak in the majors this season...The Astros went 13 straight from May 4-June 14.

A With last night's loss, the Braves fell to 27-23 (.540) in the first game of a series...In all other games, they are 66-36 (.647)...Additionally, Atlanta dropped to 9-12 (.429) in games that followed an off day.

A The 15 -series streak is tied for the third longest by a Braves team with one fashioned by the 1916 Boston Braves from June to the middle of August.

A Only two Braves team in the modern era (since 1900) have had longer such streaks than this year's club: the 2002 club had a franchise-record 22 -series streak, while the 1996 team went 17 without a loss.

RUNS: The Braves scored four times last night, moving this club into a tie for the fifth most single-season runs in the franchise's modern era with 810...The 2007 and 2000 Braves also scored 810 runs.

A The 2003 team holds the record with 907 , while the ' 06 club had 849 ...The 1999 team scored 840 , while the 1998 team had 826.

## Tonight's Game

A Makes his 32nd start of 2019...Is the 228th appearance of his career, and his 225th start.
A Set for his 25th career start against the Phillies, his third this season, and his 26th career appearance...Is 9-8 with a 3.92 ERA (64 ER/147.0 IP) over his first 25 turns.

A In two starts this season, is 0-2 with an 8.00 ERA (8 ER/9.0 IP)...Pitched against them just six days ago at Philadelphia, and allowed five hits and five runs over 4.0 innings.
A Started against Philadelphia in his last turn, September 12, and allowed five hits and five runs over 4.0 innings...Faces the same opponent in back-to-back starts for the 11th time in his career.
$\mathcal{A}$ Over his first 10 sets of consecutive starts against the same opponent, has a better ERA in the second start...Is 5-2 with a 3.86 ERA ( $25 \mathrm{ER} / 58.1$ IP) in the first start, and 4-3 with a 3.39 ERA ( 22 ER/58.1 IP) in the second.
Allowed three hits and one run, September 7 vs. Washington, his 17 th start this season allowing one or fewer earned runs.
A The 17 starts allowing one earned run or fewer are tied for most in the majors among traditional starters...Houston's Gerrit Cole and the Dodgers' Hyun-Jin Ryu also have 16 such starts.

A The Atlanta-franchise record for such starts is 20, set by Greg Maddux in 2002.
( Since July 1, has gone 5-3 with a 2.85 ERA (23 ER/72.2 IP) over 13 starts, while Atlanta is $8-5$ in his turns.

A Since that date, Teheran's ERA is 11th lowest in the majors, and seventh best in the National League.
A In 18 starts to open the season, from Opening Day through June 30, Teheran went 5-6 with a 3.99 ERA (42 ER/94.2 IP).

## 2019 Recap

A Made his 30th start of the season, $9 / 7 \mathrm{vs}$. WSH, and allowed three hits and one run over 6.0 innings to earn his 10 th win.
A Has made at least 30 starts in each of the last seven seasons dating to 2013, and is the only pitcher in the majors to do so...Mike Leake (29 starts this season), Jon Lester (28), Max Scherzer (24) and José Quintana (28) are the only other pitchers to make at least 30 starts in every season from 2013-2018.
( Made his fifth start of the season against Miami, $8 / 21$, and pitched 7.0 scoreless innings...Allowed just one earned run in 32.0 innings ( 0.28 ERA) against the Marlins on the season.

A The 32.0 innings marked the most such innings in a season by a Braves pitcher against a single opponent allowing one earned run or less...Pat Jarvis held the previous record, holding Houston to one run over 31.1 innings in 1971.
A Became the 11th pitcher in the live-ball era to allow one or fewer runs in at least that many innings against a single opponent in a season...The last to do so was Chicago-AL's Britt Burns, who did not allow a run in 32.0 innings against the Indians in 1985

Started against the Mets on 8/15 at SunTrust Park and allowed eight hits and six runs over just 1.1 innings, the shortest start of his career.
$\mathcal{A}$ Was his 219th career start, which passed Rick Mahler for sixth most in Atlanta franchise history...Only Phil Niekro (594), Tom Glavine (518), John Smoltz (466), Greg Maddux (363) and Tim Hudson (243) have started more games.

A Started against the Marlins, $8 / 9$, and allowed five hits and one run over 7.0 innings.
$\mathcal{A}$ Allowed a home run leading off the seventh inning to snap a 24 -inning scoreless streak against Miami to open the season.

A Pitched exactly 6.0 scoreless innings in each of his three starts against the Marlins to open the season...Teheran's run was just the fourth time since 1908 that a Braves starter had three straight such starts against one opponent in a single season.

Allowed eight hits and six earned runs, $6 / 18$ vs. NYM...The outing stopped a streak of eight straight starts in which he allowed one earned run or less.
A His run of one-run starts spanned from May 5 to June 13, during which he ranked second in the majors with a 0.81 ERA (4 ER/44.2 IP)...Trailed just Hyun-Jin Ryu of the Dodgers (0.53 ERA).
A Teheran's eight-game streak was tied for the longest in the majors by a traditional starter this season, mathing a run by his rotation-mate Mike Soroka...TB's Ryne Stanek has a 14 -game run while opening for the Rays.

A Made his 200th career start, $4 / 30$ vs. SD...Allowed five hits and four runs over a season-most 7.0 innings.

A Became the ninth Braves pitcher to make 200 starts for the club since the team moved to Atlanta in 1966...Joins Phil Niekro (594), Tom Glavine (518), John Smoltz (466), Greg Maddux (363), Tim Hudson (243), Rick Mahler (218), Ron Reed (203) and Steve Avery (201).
