PITTSBURGH PIRATES (56-92) vs. MIAMI MARLINS (62-86)

September 19, 2021 at IoanDepot park, Miami, FL -- GAME #149/ROAD #74 RHP MAX KRANICK (1-3, 7.66 ERA) vs. RHP SANDY ALCANTARA (9-13, 3.10 ERA)

THE PIRATES... have won six of their last eight games and eight of their last 11 after losing six in a row (three by one run)...Have gone 14-13 in their last 27 games after losing 13-for-14...Collected a season-high 19 hits and 14 runs against the Brewers on 8/14 (game 1)...Have won a season-high three straight games on four occasions (last time before and after the All-Star break from 7/11-17).

SERIES-LY SPEAKING: The Pirates have won each of their last four series and have gone 6-2-1 in their last nine.

MAD MAX: RHP Max Kranick is making his seventh start of the season with the Pirates - his first since 9/1 at Chicago (AL)... He pitched 5.0 perfect innings while winning his Major League debut on 6/27 at St. Louis, becoming the first pitcher since 1893 with a perfect completed start of at least five innings in his big league debut...Kranick's most recent start came with Triple-A Indianapolis last Sunday (9/12); a 3-0 win at Louisville (6.0ip/2h/1bb/8so)...In his last four starts with Indy, Kranick went 3-1 with a 1.61 ERA (22.1ip/4er).

HOW SWEEP IT IS: A victory today would give the Pirates their first three-game sweep of the Marlins in Miami since their inaugural season of 1993 (September 14-16)...Pittsburgh's last sweep of the Marlins overall was a two-game sweep at PNC Park in 2018 and the last three-game sweep came May 25-27, 2015 at PNC Park...It would also be the Pirates first series sweep of any team since taking two at St. Louis last year on 8/27 (DH sweep)...Pittsburgh's last three-game sweep came over the Brewers at PNC Park last season (August 21-23)...The Pirates are making their 15th attempt at a series sweep this afternoon; they are the only team in MLB without a sweep of a series of any length this season.

LEADING THE WAY: Ke'Bryan Hayes has led off each of the last 12 games and the Pirates have gone 8-4...Hayes is hitting .308 (16-for-52) with nine runs scored and four RBI in the 12 games.

<u>60 BUCS:</u> With his appearance Saturday night, RHP **Enyel De Los Santos** became the 60th different player to appear in at least one game for the Pirates in 2021, a club record for most players used in one season (previous mark was 55 players in 2016)...In addition, there has now been a club record 36 different players who have pitched in at least one game in 2021 (previous mark of 34 was established in 2019).

WINNING THE CLOSE ONES: Three of Pittsburgh's last four wins, and five of the last seven, have been decided by one run... Since beating the Cardinals, 11-7, on 8/26, each of the last nine Bucco victories have been by three runs or less...The Pirates have posted a 20-20 record in one-run games this season after going 8-15 in 2020, 19-25 in 2019 and 29-22 in 2018.

FISH FRY: The Pirates are 5-1 against the Marlins this season, winning three of the four games played at PNC Park in June and the first two here...Dating back to the 2017 season, the Pirates have posted a 16-8 record against the Fish.

NEXT STOP - THE QUEEN CITY: The Pirates are 2-0 on this scheduled 10-game road trip following the first two games in Miami...The trip coninues with three games in Cincinnati beginning Monday night and concludes with four in Philadelphia beginning Thursday...The Bucs have won back-to-back road games after losing seven in a row.

<u>POSTSEASON BOUND:</u> Two of Pittsburgh's minor league affiliates have advanced to the postseason...The Greensboro Grasshoppers (73-45) will be facing the Bowling Green Hot Rods (81-35) in the best-of-five High-A East Championship Series and the Bradenton Marauders (71-46) will be facing the Tampa Tarpons (72-41) in the Low-A Southeast best-of-five League Championship Series...Both series are scheduled to begin Tuesday.

THE DEPARTMENT OF DEFENSE: The Pirates have committed three errors in their last 14 games and enter tonight's tilt with the second-best fielding percentage in the National League (fourth-best in all of baseball)... Dating back to 5/9, the Pirates have made the fewest amount of errors in the Majors (42); the Marlins have made the most (86).

STRATTON HIS STUFF: Chris Stratton has made a career-high 62 appearances and co-leads all National League relief pitchers with 73.1 innings pitched this season...<u>His 103.1 innings pitched over the last two seasons are the most among all Major League relievers</u>...Stratton has earned a win and four saves in his last five appearances.

<u>SEPTEMBER REIGN:</u> Ke'Bryan Hayes is hitting .308 (16-for-52) in 12 games played this month and holds a career average of .350 during the month of September...In his 36 career games played during the season's final month, Hayes has gone 48-for-137 with 10 doubles, two triples, five home runs and 15 RBI.

THE YOSHI SHOW: In his 29 games with the Pirates, **Yoshi Tsutsugo** is hitting .300 (24-for-80) with six doubles, a triple, seven home runs and 19 RBI while producing a 1.056 OPS...Yoshi is also hitting .467 (7-for-15) and has produced 12 RBI while batting with runners in scoring position with the Pirates.

COMING THRU IN A PINCH: Wilmer Difo has a Major League-leading 15 pinch-hits this season, the most by a Pirates player in a season since **Delwyn Young** had 16 in 2010...As a team, the Pirates rank seventh in MLB with 51 pinch hits, seventh in pinch-hit RBI (30) and are tied for fifth with eight pinch-hit home runs.

ON THIS DATE IN PIRATES HISTORY

September 19, 1978: Dave Parker capped off a four-hit game with a game-winning home run off Bruce Sutter in the 11th inning as the Pirates beat the Cubs, 12-11. Parker also homered in the first inning as the Bucs built a 10-2 lead after six innings. The Cubs scored five runs in the seventh inning and tied it with four in the ninth. Odell Jones pitched the final 2.0 innings for the win, striking out three batters in the 11th.
