



# New York Mets (12-9) vs. San Francisco Giants (10-13)

**TODAY'S GAME:** The Giants will take on the Mets tonight for the first of a three-game set...SF is in the midst of a 10-game homestand that started last Thursday (2-2) and will continue as they host New York-NL through Wednesday and will see the Pirates come to town from Friday-Sunday...the homestand is SF's longest this season.

- ▶ San Francisco is 5-5 through its first 10 home games this year, averaging 3.3 runs/game (33 runs in those 10 games) in the early going...last season, SF averaged 3.8 runs/game and went 45-36 by the bay.
- ▶ Giants hitters have homered just four times here at Oracle Park this season...the four homers at home are the fewest in MLB.

**ROSTER MOVES:** The Giants made the following roster moves prior to tonight's game:

- ▶ **RHP Luke Jackson** (#77) returned from rehab assignment and reinstated from the 15-day Injured List.
- ▶ **RHP Nick Avila** optioned to Triple-A Sacramento postgame yesterday.

**EVEN STEVES:** The Giants last hosted the Mets exactly a year ago, splitting a four-game series on April 20-23...in fact, SF has won or tied its last four home series against the Mets dating to 2019...the stretch is SF's longest such streak in the matchup since they won or tied their first five series here at Oracle Park between 2000 and 2005 (*Stats, LLC*).

- ▶ Since Oracle Park opened in 2000, SF is 42-35 vs. New York-NL in the shores of McCovey Cove and have averaged 4.4 runs per game...SF pitchers have a 3.84 ERA in that stretch.
- ▶ The Giants have gone an even 76-76 overall against the Mets since 2000.

**DOWN THE ROAD....:** So far this season, the Mets and Giants have been two different offensive clubs when playing at home vs. on the road, as demonstrated in the chart below:

- ▶ SF's -.094 slugging differential between home and road is the largest negative difference in MLB, with the Mets having the second largest (-.089).

**PATIENCE IS KEY:** The Giants are hitting .248 (104x420) after getting a first-pitch strike to them this season, second-best in MLB behind only the Orioles (.248, 90x363)...SF's 104 base hits after getting into an 0-1 count this season are most in MLB, with no other team reaching 100 such hits this year (Rockies are second with 98) (*Stats, LLC*).

**WINNING WAYS:** **RHP Keaton Winn** takes the bump for SF tonight and is slated to face the Mets for the first time in his young career...the right-hander has made nine career Major League starts and has thrown at least 4.0 innings and allowed six hits or fewer in each of those outings.

- ▶ Winn's nine starts are the third-longest such streak by any player to begin their MLB career with the Giants in the modern era (since 1901)...only **Albert Suarez** (12) and **Jeff Brantley** (10) had longer streaks.

**SEND HELP!:** Winn hasn't been lucky in terms of offense this season, receiving a total of four runs of support through his first four starts of the season...his 1.64 run support average is fifth-lowest in MLB (min. 20ip) this season.

- ▶ Overall, the Giants have scored just seven runs in Winn's four starts this season (1-3).

**GOT 'EM: C Patrick Bailey** picked off Arizona's Gabriel Moreno yesterday to end the 6th inning, catching his fifth attempted base stealer of the season...Bailey has caught 25 basestealers since the start of 2023, third-most in MLB behind only Cal Raleigh (29) and Shea Langeliers (28).

**JHL DELIVERS: OF Jung Hoo Lee** has reached base in each of his last 12 games and hit safely in 11 of those...he's slashing .340/.389/.460 with three doubles, one home run, three RBI, two walks, two steals and 10 runs in that stretch (since April 7).

- ▶ Lee leads all Giants with 24 hits this season...he is the only rookie leading their team in base knocks this year.
- ▶ The last Giants rookie to lead the team in hits in a season was **Robby Thompson** in 1986 (149).
- ▶ His 24 hits are tied with SD's Jackson Merrill for the MLB lead among rookies.

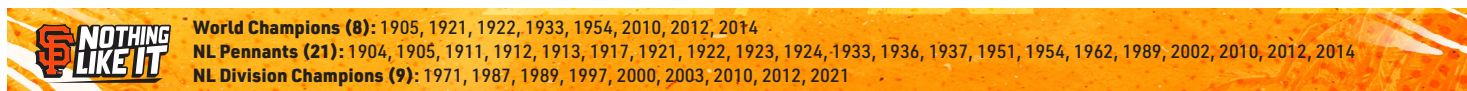
**WADE'S WORLD: IF/OF LaMonte Wade Jr.** remains one of MLB's best on-base machines in 2024.

- ▶ Wade has reached base in 18 of 22 games where he's had an at-bat this season, and is slashing .358/.453/.472 with 10 runs, three doubles, a home run and six RBI.
- ▶ His .358 batting average is second in MLB and his .453 OBP is third-best in the Majors (min. 60 PA).

**NOTHING LIKE IT:** The Giants have drawn an attendance of 324,230 through their first 10 home games...the figure is SF's second-highest through 10 games in the post-pandemic era, just short of 2022 (329,515) following SF's record-breaking 107 win season in 2021.

**AT THE FARM:** High-A Eugene Emeralds pitcher **RHP Dylan Cumming** was named Northwest League Pitcher of the Week earlier today...Cumming served as the starter in Eugene's combined no-hitter last Wednesday and threw 3.0 shutout innings with just one walk and four strikeouts.

- ▶ Cumming made another start yesterday, throwing another 3.0 scoreless innings with just one hit and five strikeouts.
- ▶ The right-hander has a 0.64 ERA in four games (three starts) this year, striking out 18 batters in 14.0 innings and holding opponents to a .116 average (5x43).

**IT'S IOWA:** The rookie made his first career Opening Day roster and is slated to face the Mets for the first time in his young career...Winn was selected by the Giants in the fifth round (136th overall) of the 2018 draft out of Iowa Western Community College and made his debut last season.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Snagged his first win of the season last Wednesday at Miami...matched a career-best 6.0 innings and held Marlins batters to just one run (solo homer) on four hits with a walk and four strikeouts.

**WINNING WAYS:** Has made nine career Major League starts and has thrown at least 4.0 innings and allowed six hits or fewer in each of those outings...Winn's nine such starts are the third-longest such streak by any player to begin their MLB career with the Giants in the modern era (since 1901)...only **Albert Suarez** (12) and **Jeff Brantley** (10) had longer streaks.

**SEND HELP!:** Winn hasn't had much luck in terms of offense this season, getting a combined four runs of support across his four starts this year...his 1.64 run support average is fifth-lowest in MLB this season (min. 20ip).

**BANANA SPLIT:** Winn's trademark is his splitter, which he's been using 42.8% of the time this season...six of his 17 strikeouts this season have come off the pitch and he's limiting opponents to a .182 (6x33) clip with just two extra-base hits (.273 SLG)...Winn's 42.8% splitter usage this season is the highest of any starting pitcher in MLB.

**GOT 'EM:** Has been very successful at retiring batters when he gets ahead of the count in his young career...in 98 career plate appearances ending with Winn ahead in the count, opponents are hitting .147 with a .323 OPS...this season, he's held opponents to just five hits in 28 such at-bats (.179).

**SPRING TRAINING:** Missed most of the spring while dealing with right elbow soreness...saw Cactus League action twice (one start) in late March and went 1-0 with a 3.18 ERA (2er, 5.2ip) and three strikeouts for SF.

**2023 SEASON:** After starting the year in Triple-A Sacramento, Winn made his Major League debut on June 13 at St. Louis in relief, firing 4.0 innings and picking up the save...he joined SF's rotation two weeks later and made five starts for the Giants, going 1-3 with a 6.04 ERA as a starter...overall, the right-hander posted a 1-3-1 record with a 4.68 ERA and 1.04 WHIP across nine MLB appearances.

**SAVING THE DAY:** After collecting the save in his Major League debut on June 13, 2023 at St. Louis, Winn became the third MLB pitcher since 1969 (when saves became an official stat) to pitch at least 4.0 innings and earn the save in his debut (*Elias*)...the other pitchers to achieve the feat were St. Louis' Zack Thompson (June 3, 2022) and Boston's Bob Stanley (April 16, 1977).

### #75 CAMILO DOVAL ▶ RHP

**Pitch Arsenal:** Slider, Cutter, Sinker

**Last Game:** 4/20 vs. ARI; 1.0ip 3k (16 pitches)

- ▶ Since allowing two runs in 0.2 innings in his first appearance of the year on March 30 at SD in a non-save situation (SF won 9-6), Doval has made five appearances and gone 1-0-3 with three hits allowed, one walk, 11 strikeouts and no runs allowed (5.1ip).
- ▶ Earned his first career All-Star selection last season after posting a 2.63 ERA and converting 26 of his 28 save chances in 41 first half games...was the winning pitcher for the NL team after working a scoreless 7th inning.
- ▶ Wrapped up the 2023 season with 39 saves, tied for the most in the NL and second-most in MLB behind CLE's Emmanuel Clase (44).
- ▶ The 39 SVs were also most by a Giant since **Brian Wilson** (48 in '10).

### #64 SEAN HJELLE ▶ RHP

**Pitch Arsenal:** Four-Seam FB, Changeup, Slider

**Last Game:** 4/21 vs. ARI; 2.0ip, h (21 pitches)

- ▶ Returned from his rehab assignment with Triple-A Sacramento and reinstated from the 15-day IL on Friday...made season debut yesterday, tossing 2.0 shutout innings...missed SF's first 21 games with a right elbow strain he suffered early in spring.
- ▶ Made five rehab appearances between San Jose (A) and Sacramento (AAA)...threw 5.1 innings and allowed two runs on five hits with seven strikeouts...threw 4.0 scoreless innings with six strikeouts while on his rehab stint with Sacramento (three games).
- ▶ Made 15 appearances for SF at the Major League level last year, posting a 6.52 ERA...had a really nice end to the '23 season with SF, working 7.0 scoreless innings with six strikeouts over the season's final 10 days.
- ▶ 6'11" right-hander is tied for the tallest pitcher in MLB history with RHP John Rauch.

### #77 LUKE JACKSON ▶ RHP

**Pitch Arsenal:** Four-Seam FB, Slider, Curveball

**Last Game:** 4/20 vs. MOD (w/A San Jose); 1.0ip (8 pitches)

- ▶ Returned from his rehab assignment and reinstated from the 15-day IL today...veteran reliever suffered a low back strain on Opening Day against the Padres back on March 28.
- ▶ Was placed on the IL the next day...made two rehab appearances for Single-A San Jose totalling 2.0 innings last Thurs. and Sat.
- ▶ Made his fourth Opening Day roster, first with SF...the previous three came with Atlanta (2019-2021).
- ▶ Appeared in 33 games for SF in 2023 and posted a 2.97 ERA with 43 strikeouts over 33.1 innings of work (11.61 SO/9).
- ▶ Made his Giants debut on May 31 after he missed the entire 2022 season recovering from TJ surgery.
- ▶ Held right-handed hitters to a .182 average in 2023, compared to a .263 average against lefties.

### #68 ERIK MILLER ▶ LHP

**Pitch Arsenal:** Four-Seam FB, Changeup, Slider

**Last Game:** 4/21 vs. ARI; L, 1.0ip, 2h, 2r, er, k (22 pitches)

- ▶ Over his last eight outings dating to April 3, Miller has allowed three runs (two earned) over 8.1 innings (2.16 ERA) with 13 strikeouts, one walk, a 0.48 WHIP and a .107 opposing batting average (3x28).
- ▶ LHBs are 2-for-15 off him early on...RHBs are 3-for-23.
- ▶ Has appeared in 11 games for SF, allowing eight runs (seven earned) in 11.0ip.
- ▶ The southpaw made his debut on Opening Day.
- ▶ Is ranked the Giants No. 28 prospect according to *MLB.com*.
- ▶ Made 48 appearances for Triple-A last year and converted 14-of-17 save opportunities while striking out 73 batters (12.63 K/9ip).
- ▶ His 14 saves were tied for fifth-most in all Triple-A.
- ▶ Was acquired from the Phillies on January 9, 2023 in exchange for RHP Yunior Marte.
