BIENVENIDOS A MIAMI

The Washington Nationals take on the Miami Marlins tonight in game one of this three game set from loanDepot park...Washington defeated the Twins yesterday, 7-5, to earn their first home series win of the season...Washington has now won three of their last four series overall.

- **Keibert Ruiz** led the offense yesterday, tallying a pair of doubles and a home run...He became just the third catcher in Nationals history (2005-pres.) to record a three-extra-base hit game since **Riley Adams** (May 21, 2023 - 2 2B, HR).
- A pair of Minnesotans bookended the victory with Edina, MN native **Jake Irvin** making the start and Maplewood, MN native **Gus Varland** earning a 1.1-inning save.
- Following this series, Washington will enjoy an off day in Cincinnati before starting a three-game series with the Reds from Tuesday-Wednesday.

ROAD SWEET ROAD

The Nationals come into tonight's game with a 12-7 record on the road, tied for the second-highest win total away from home in Major League Baseball, trailing only the Atlanta Braves (14 wins)...Washington has taken at least a share of five of their first six series away from home, including four straight.

- The Nationals rank fourth in MLB (third in NL) with 105 runs scored on the road.
- Washington's pitching staff is seventh in MLB (fifth in NL) with a .234 opponents batting average away from Nationals Park.

OUT OF THIS WORLD

CJ Abrams is 12-for-34 (.353) with three doubles, two homers, 12 RBI, four walks, two stolen bases and six runs scored over his last nine games...He's reached safely in seven of the nine (.421 OBP) and has hits in six of the nine.

- He ranks among National League hitters in RBI (2nd, 33), on-base percentage (6th, .391), OPS (10th, .933) and slugging (10th, .542).

PRETTY OFFENSIVE

The Nationals rank fourth in Major League Baseball (3rd in NL) with 205 runs scored this season.

- Washington has scored 33 runs in the first inning, the most in Major League Baseball.
- The Nationals lead Major League Baseball with 78 runs in the seventh inning or later.
- Washington has scored at least five runs 23 times this season, second-most in Major League Baseball.

GOOD WOOD

James Wood leads Major League Baseball with an average exit velocity of 96.5 MPH ahead of **O'Neil Cruz** (95.7).

- Wood is one of three players Major League Baseball with more than one batted ball greater than 116.0 MPH this season with **Yordan Alvarez** (3) and **O'Neil Cruz** (3).
- Wood's 46 batted balls over 100 MPH rank tied for third in Major League Baseball.

PITCH PERFECT

Simon Mathews' pitching staff ranks third in the National League (6th in MLB) with a 3.08 ERA in 12 games since April 24...The staff has pitched to a 3.85 ERA in 22 games since April 14 after entering play that day with a 6.21 ERA through the first 15 games of the season...Since April 25, the staff has surrendered just seven home runs, third-fewest in Major League Baseball over this span (0.63 HR/9.0 IP).

- The starters rank fifth in the National League (16th in MLB) with a 3.42 ERA since April 24.
- The bullpen has pitched to a 2.14 ERA in 10 games since April 26, the second-best mark in the National League.

SPECIFICALLY...

Some pitching performances of note include:

- **Foster Griffin** ranks sixth in the National League with a 2.27 ERA, while **Cade Cavalli** ranks 10th in the NL (min. 30.0 IP). with 10.38 strikeouts per 9.0 innings.
- **Richard Lovelady** has offered scoreless relief in his last seven games (6.2 IP), going 1-0 with a save, three holds, seven strikeouts and just five hits allowed.
- Left-handed batters are 3-for-22 (.136) with zero extra-base hits against **Mitchell Parker** this season.
- **PJ Poulin** has been The Opener five times...He's allowed just one earned run on five hits with five strikeouts and one walk in 6.1 innings pitched.
- Over his last 10 games, **Gus Varland** has pitched to a 1.69 ERA (2 ER/10.2 IP) with three holds, four saves, 11 strikeouts and one walk.

HIGH DEGREE OF DIFFICULTY

Per Baseball-Reference.com, the Nationals have the hardest strength of schedule in Major League Baseball with their opponents averaging 0.4 runs per game more than the league average team...Washington has played 23 games against teams with a record of .500 or better, the most in Major League Baseball.

- 13 of the Nationals 19 home games have come against teams .500 or better.

WELCOME TO THE TOP 100

Two Nationals infielders joined the *Baseball America* Top 100 Prospects list in their latest update on May 6...**Seaver King** (No. 99) and **Ronny Cruz** (No. 96) now join **Eli Willits** (No. 24) and **Jarlin Susana** (No. 59) on the List...Cruz leads all Nationals Farmhands in average (.340), OBP (.449) and hits (36)...King leads the Nationals organization in total bases (64) and extra-base hits (17).

Lefty starter returns to Major League Baseball after spending the last three seasons with the Yomiuri Giants of Nippon Professional Baseball...Was a first-round pick by the Kansas City Royals in 2014 and their Minor League Pitcher of the Year in 2017.

Took his first loss of the season...Pitched 6.0 inning and gave up three runs on three hits and four walk with three strikeouts against the Milwaukee Brewers on May 2.

WINNING WAYS

Griffin won three of his first five starts without taking a loss, becoming just the third pitcher in Nationals history (2005-pres.) to win at least three of his first five starts with Washington without suffering a loss...He joins **Luis Atilano** (3-0 in 2010) and **Micah Bowie** (3-0 in 2007).

STREAKIN'

Foster Griffin has not allowed an earned run in his last 14.0 innings pitched. Per Elias Sports Bureau, it is tied for the 8th-longest active streak in Major League Baseball (4th in the NL).

LUCKY 7

Griffin has the ability to throw seven pitches, including: cutter (30.1%), four seamer (16.0%), sweeper (13.8%), changeup (11.3%), curveball (8.3%), split finger (8.2%) and sinker (12.4%).

Made two starts allowing four earned runs on eight hits striking out nine batters across 8.0 innings.
