LAST START

Alvarez tossed 6.0 scoreless innings, allowing just two hits with six strikeouts against the Miami Marlins on August 30 at Nationals Park...He took the no-decision in the 6-2 defeat.

vs. LOS ANGELES (NL)

A graduate of nearby Los Alamitos High School, Alvarez is set to make his first career start against the Los Angeles Dodgers.

REGENCY BIAS

In his last seven games (six starts) starts, Alvarez has pitched to a 2.41 ERA (10 ER/37.1 IP) with a .176 opponents' average...He ranks in the National League in opponents' average (4th, .176), opponents' slugging (3rd, .275), opponents' OPS (4th, .545) and ERA (T10th, 2.41) over this stretch since July 27.

TROUBLE WITH THE CURVE

Opposing batters are hitting .175 (21-for-120) with six extra-base hits off Alvarez's curveball...He's fanned 54 batters with the curve this season, the most of any of his pitches.

ROAD WARRIOR

Alvarez has pitched to a 2.95 ERA (13 ER/39.2 IP) in nine road games (7 starts) and a 3.88 ERA (22 ER/51.0 IP) in 12 home games (6 starts).

- In his last three road starts, Alvarez has held opposing batters to a .155 average (9-for-58, 2 2B, 2 HR) and a 2.65 ERA (5 ER/17.0 IP).

2025

Tall left-hander ranked second in Washington's system (4th in all of Triple-A) with 123.0 innings and third in the organizaton (10th in Triple-A) with 114 strikeouts at the time of his Major League debut.

- Pitched to a 1.15 ERA (2 ER/15.2 IP) in his first three career starts...Only Tanner Roark (0.95) produced a lower ERA in his first three career starts in Nationals history (2005-pres.).
- Matched the Major League record for a starting pitcher in his first five career games by not allowing a run in three of his first five games (22nd overall)...He was the first National (2005-pres.) to do so.
