TODAY'S TILT...the Mariners continue their 9-game road trip (1-3) with the 2nd of 3 games against the Miami Marlins (0-1)...Seattle started off the trip with a 3-game series against the Cleveland Guardians (1-2) and will finish the trip visiting the Tampa Bay Rays (3 G, June 24-26)...the Mariners are coming off a 7-game homestand (6-1) against the Chicago White Sox (3-1) and Texas Rangers (3-0)...today's game will be televised live on **ROOT SPORTS** with **Aaron Goldsmith** and **Mike Blowers** on the call...the game will also be broadcast live on **Seattle Sports (710 AM)** with **Rick Rizzos** and **Dave Sims** on the call.

ODDS AND ENDS...the Mariners dropped last night's series opener in Miami by a score of 3-2 in extra-innings...despite 3 consecutive losses, the Mariners are 13-7 (.650) over their last 20 games (5/31-c) and 17-8 (.780) over their last 25 games (5/26-c), tied for best record in the Majors during that span...Seattle is 34-3 when out-hitting its opponent.

- **#TexasVoteEm** - MLB All-Star Voting is live, with the first phase of voting ending on June 27...you can vote for Mariners at Mariners.com/Vote...the 2024 All-Star Game is set for July 16 in Arlington, Texas.
- **Series-Iy Sensational** - The Mariners own a 13-5-1 series record over their last 19 series (4/15-c).
- **Taking Care of Business** - Seattle is 28-14 (.667) against below-.500 teams, 7th-best in MLB.
- **No Fly Zone** - **Julio Rodríguez** made a pair of plays on balls with a catch probability below 65% in last night's game...since the beginning of the 2022 season, Julio has amassed 25 Outs Above Average according to *Baseball Savant*...his 25 OAA are tied for 3rd-best among MLB outfielders, trailing only Daulton Varsho (38 OAA) and Jose Siri (29 OAA).

BEST IN THE WEST...the Mariners (44-34) hold 1st place in the American League West Division by 7.0 games over the 2nd place Houston Astros (36-40) and 7.5 games over the 3rd place Texas Rangers (35-40)...the Mariners have held 1st place for 41 consecutive days (5/12-c)...Seattle's 7.0 game lead over the division is the tied for the largest gap in the American League and 2nd-largest gap in the Majors, trailing only the Dodgers' 8.0 game lead over the Diamondbacks and Padres in the NL West.

KINGS OF QUALITY...the Mariners pitching staff leads the Majors in quality starts (47), with Seattle going 36-11 (.765) when its starter goes 6.0+ innings while allowing 3-or-fewer earned runs...the Mariners have 4 starters with 8+ quality starts this season: **Logan Gilbert** (12 QS), **Luis Castillo** (10), **George Kirby** (8) and **Bryce Miller** (8), the only team in the Majors with 4 pitchers recording 8+ QS this season...only the Phillies have even 3 pitchers (Aaron Nola, Ranger Suarez, Zack Wheeler) with 8+ QS.

ANDRÉS MUÑOZ: WORTHY OF BEING AN AL ALL-STAR...right-hander **Andrés Muñoz** has 13 saves and a 1.42 ERA (5 ER, 31.2 IP) with 42 strikeouts and 10 walks in 30 appearances this season...Muñoz has posted a 0.95 WHIP and limited opposing hitters to a .179 batting average...the 25-year-old is 1 of 2 American League pitchers with 13+ saves and a sub-2.00 ERA this season, along with Emmanuel Clase-CLE...Muñoz has recorded 5 saves of 4+ outs, most in the Majors this season.

PURE BLISS...Ryan Bliss went 3-for-3 with an RBI triple in last night's game, picking up the first 3-hit game of his career...Bliss has reached base safely in 5 of his last 6 plate appearances, going 4-for-5 with 1 double, 1 triple, 2 RBI and 1 walk during that span...since the beginning of June, Bliss holds a .757 OPS, ranking 8th among AL second basemen (11th in MLB).

CAL DOES IT ALL...Cal Raleigh leads Major League catchers in catcher caught stealing (15), ranking ahead of Gabriel Moreno-ARI (12), Carson Kelly-DET (12) and Will Smith-LAD (12)...the Mariners backstop has hit 12 home runs this season, tied for 3rd-most among MLB catchers with Ryan Jeffers-MIN, trailing Adley Rutschman-BAL (14 HR) and Shea Langeliers-OAK (14)...Raleigh has 71 career HR (2021-c), making him one of 8 catchers in MLB history with 71+ home runs through his first 4 seasons, despite appearing in just 47 games during his rookie campaign (2021)...the other 7 catchers are Mike Piazza (92 HR), Rudy York (88), Johnny Bench (87), Earl Williams (83), Will Smith (72), Gary Sánchez (71) and Carlos Santana (71).

GOOD THING IT'S NOT A BUS TRIP...Seattle's home ballpark T-Mobile Park is approximately a 3,324-mile drive from loanDepot park, home of the Miami Marlins...the distance between Seattle and Miami is the farthest between 2 MLB teams...according to *Baseball Savant*, the Mariners will travel 47,438 total miles during the 2024 regular season, 3rd-most in MLB and most among teams only traveling in the U.S. and Canada...only the Padres (51,690 miles) and Dodgers (49,131) are scheduled to travel more than the Mariners...San Diego and Los Angeles-NL's miles traveled includes their series played in South Korea.

THE BONE YARD...Seattle's infield defense (1B/2B/3B/SS) has a .987 fielding percentage (18 errors in 1,379 total chances), tied for best in the AL with Minnesota...**Josh Rojas'** 6 Outs Above Average are the most among third basemen via *Baseball Savant*...**J.P. Crawford** leads MLB shortstops in fielding percentage (.994), committing just 1 error across 169 total chances.

MUÑOZ CHASING HISTORY...Andrés Muñoz is approaching 150 career appearances with Seattle, entering today's action with 147 outings in a Mariners uniform...he holds a 2.40 ERA (39 ER, 146.1 IP) with 49 walks and 206 strikeouts in his Mariners career...Andrés has a chance to become the 7th reliever in MLB history age 25-or-younger to post a sub-2.50 ERA with 200+ strikeouts over his first 150 appearances with a club...he would join Josh Hader-MIL (2.39 ERA, 347 K), Aroldis Chapman-CIN (2.20 ERA, 233 K), Kenley Jansen-LAD (2.21 ERA, 248 K), Craig Kimbrel-ATL (2.36 ERA, 258 K), Francisco Rodriguez-LAA (2.36 ERA, 259 K) and Bruce Sutter-CHC (1.87 ERA, 268 K)...of that group Muñoz would be the first in MLB history to eclipse those numbers (sub-2.50 ERA/200+ K), while also allowing fewer than 60 walks.

THE NEXT HOMESTAND...following the current road trip, the Mariners will return home for 9-game homestand from June 28-July 7, hosting the Minnesota Twins (3 G, June 28-30), Baltimore Orioles (3 G, July 2-4) and Toronto Blue Jays (3 G, July 5-7)...upcoming promotions on the homestand include **J.P. Crawford "City Connect" Bobblehead Night** on June 28, **Aloha Shirt Night** on June 29, **Bark at the Park** on July 2, **Patriotic Fireworks** on July 3 and **Patriotic Cap** on July 4.

AS YOU KNOW...Logan Gilbert tossed 8.0 scoreless innings in his last outing on June 16 vs. Texas, surrendering only 2 hits with 9 strikeouts in a 5-0 Mariners win, and...**AS YOU MAY KNOW...**Logan's last outing was his 15th start of the season...he holds a 2.93 ERA (32 ER, 98.1 IP) with 20 walks and 93 strikeouts, but...**DID YOU KNOW?**...Logan is the first Mariners pitcher with a sub-3.00 ERA, 90+ strikeouts and 90.0+ innings pitched over his first 15 starts in a season since Félix Hernández during the 2014 campaign (2.29 ERA, 106.1 IP, 112 K)?...overall, only 6 players in Mariners history have reached the mark: Logan Gilbert (2024), Félix Hernández (4x, 2008, '09, '13, '14), Hisashi Iwakuma (2013), Michael Pineda (2011), Randy Johnson (3x, 1997, '95, '93) and Erik Hanson (1993).

ABOUT LOGAN GILBERT...

- The 27-year-old right-handed pitcher is scheduled to make his 16th start of the season and 1st against Miami...he will also make the 104th start of his MLB career and 2nd career start against the Marlins.
• Selected by Seattle in the 1st round (14th overall) of the 2018 MLB First-Year Player Draft; signed by Mariners scout Rob Mummau.
• Spent 3 seasons at Stetson (FL) University, 2016-18...in 2017, was ASUN Pitcher of the Year and ASUN 1st-Team All-Conference.
• Was named the 2022 Mariners Most Valuable Pitcher by the Seattle Chapter of the BBWAA.

LAST TIME OUT...W#4 on 6/16 vs. Texas...he pitched 8.0 scoreless innings and only allowed 2 hits with 0 walks and 9 strikeouts...earned his 12th quality start of the season...was his 2nd time pitching 8.0 innings and not allowing a run this season and 3rd time in his career...he and Max Fried-ATL are the only pitchers to do so in 2 games this season.

OUT IN MIAMI...Has only made 1 appearance against Miami during his career...in his last outing against the Marlins (5/1/22) he threw 5.2 innings and held batters to 1 run, 3 hits (1 home run) with 4 walks and 5 strikeouts...his .150 opponent batting average is the 2nd lowest batting average against a team in his career.

AMONG THE AL'S BEST...among qualified AL pitchers this season, Gilbert ranks T-1st in quality starts (12), 1st in innings pitched (98.1), 3rd in WHIP (0.92), 6th in Opp. AVG (.198) and 6th in strikeouts (93).

EATING INNINGS...in each of his last 7 outings (5/14-c), he has gone 6.0+ innings...this the 4th-longest active streak in the Majors...during that span he has 6 quality starts.

GET AHEAD, STAY AHEAD...he is posting a 69.3% 1st pitch strike rate, the highest of his career...among pitchers with 80.0+ IP, this is the 3rd-highest in the Majors behind Tarik Skubal-DET (72.3%) and Joe Ryan (70.4%).

FAR FROM HOME...has gone 6.0+ innings in 6 of his 8 away starts this season...in those 8 starts, he has a 3.18 ERA (18 ER, 51.0 IP) with 6 quality starts and 41 strikeouts.

ALL I DO IS WIN...over his career has made 54 starts away from T-Mobile Park...in those starts he is 24-7 for a .774 win percentage, the best in MLB history (min. 50 GS)...the next closest is Shane Bieber-CLE (37-14, .725).

FEELING SUPPORTED...Gilbert is 33-0 in his career when the Mariners score 3 or more runs while he is in the game...in those games the Mariners are 41-9.

100 AND COUNTING...made his 100th career start on 5/30 vs. HOU...he had the 4th-most strikeouts (562) in a players' first 100 games with the franchise...behind only James Paxton (603), Randy Johnson (593) and Félix Hernández (575)...only 14 pitchers in franchise history have had each of their first 100 appearances be starts.

MARINERS MILESTONES...currently is 13th in franchise history with 584 strikeouts...Matt Young is 12th in the ranking with 597 strikeouts...he moved into the top-15 after striking out 5 batters on 6/5 at OAK.

STRONG BEGINNINGS...Gilbert was the 4th pitcher in Major League history to have recorded 500.0+ innings, 550+ strikeouts and 140-or-less walks in their first 100 career games...the list includes Noah Syndergaard-NYM, Masahiro Tanaka-NYY and Michael Pineda-NYY/SEA.

QUALITY MIDSET...12 of his 15 starts have been quality starts...he has gone 6.0+ innings in 13 of his 15 starts...the Mariners are 8-5 when he pitches in 6.0+ innings.

SITTING THEM DOWN...recorded 6+ strikeouts in each of his first 7 starts this season (3/30-5/4), tied for a career-best streak (also: 4/1/23-5/8/23)...has 4+ strikeouts in 14 of 15 starts this season...he is the only other Mariners pitcher to do so this season...ahead of Luis Castillo who has 13 in 15 starts.

LEFTY-RIGHTY...this season left-handed batters are hitting .196 (31x158) with 8 doubles, 3 home runs and 49 strikeouts.

GOOD STRETCH...went 3-0 with a 1.02 ERA (4 ER, 35.1 IP), 11 walks and 35 strikeouts over 5 starts (4/10-5/4)...recorded a quality start in each outing during the span and limited opponents to a .137 (16x117) average and a .442 OPS.

INNINGS EATER...2nd among American League pitchers with 466.2 innings pitched since the start of the 2022 season (Framber Valdez-HOU, 467.0 IP)...during that span he also ranks among qualified AL leaders in BB/9 (5th, 2.03), WHIP (6th, 1.10), Opp. AVG (12th, .230), ERA (T-11th, 3.41), SO/BB (7th, 4.26), fWAR (T-6th, 7.7) and LOB% (8th, 76.4%).

GOING THE DISTANCE...pitched his first career complete game shutout on 7/4/23 against San Francisco...this was the Mariners second complete game thrown last year...George Kirby threw his first career complete game on 4/27/23 at Philadelphia.

7 STRAIGHT STRIKEOUTS...he struck out 7 consecutive batters from the 2nd-4th innings on 5/8/23 against Texas...the streak of strikeouts tied a franchise record shared by Mark Langston (6/15/84) and Luis Castillo (9/7/22)...Logan finished the game with a season-high 10 strikeouts which was 1 off from his career-high.
