THE TWINS: After completing their final roadtrip of the 2024 season with a record of 2-5 (1-3 in Cleveland and 1-2 in Boston), the Twins began their six-game homestand with a loss to the Marlins last night...tonight, the Twins will continue the homestand with the second of three against Miami and wrap the series tomorrow night...after this series, the Twins will host the Orioles over the weekend for the final three games of the season.

♣ At 81-76, the Twins need one win in their final five games to secure a winning record for the second-straight season (87-75 in 2023) and fourth time in six seasons under Rocco Baldelli.

BATS QUIET AGAIN FOR MINNESOTA: The Twins lost to the Marlins last night at Target Field by a score of 4-1, suffering their 23rd loss in their last 34 games, since August 18...Bailey Ober (12-8) was the starter and was dealt the loss, allowing four runs on eight hits in 5.0 innings pitched, with two walks and seven strikeouts...all four runs allowed came in the second inning, highlighted by a Jonah Bride solo home run...the offense recorded eight hits, two apiece from Carlos Correa and Byron Buxton, who both doubled and singled...Minnesota's only run scored came on a Royce Lewis RBI-single in the third inning.

GONE FISHIN': Twins and Marlins are playing each other for the 20th, 21st and 22nd times in their history this week...Twins are 10-10 against the Marlins, going 5-4 in Minnesota (2-1 at Metrodome and 3-3 at Target Field) and 5-6 in Miami.

◆ 20 games against the Marlins is the fewest for Minnesota against any opponent in their history (Colorado, San Francisco and Washington all next fewest with 24 each).

MISSING: HOME RUNS: The Twins have not homered in six-straight games, their longest homerless stretch since August 18-24, 2012, when they went seven-straight...their last home run came in the eighth inning on September 17 at Cleveland, a Willi Castro two-run insurance homer off Nick Sandlin...in terms of plate appearances, they have gone 246 PAs since their last homer...additionally, Minnesota's last home run off a starting pitcher came on September 13 vs. Cincinnati, when Byron Buxton took Julian Aguiar deep in the fifth inning.

The longest homerless drought in club history is 12 games in 1981.

ROSTER MOVES: The Twins have reinstated right-handed pitcher Justin Topa from the 60-day Injured List, and recalled right-handed pitcher Jorga Alcala and utility player Austin Martin.

**Topa has missed the entire season with left patellar tendinitis...the 33-year-old was one of four players acquired in January from Seattle in the Jorge Polanco trade and made 75 relief appearances for the Mariners last season...over those 75 games, he went 5-4, 2.61 ERA (69.0 IP, 20 ER), three saves, 23 holds, 18 walks, 61 strikeouts and a 1.14 WHIP, setting single-season career highs in virtually all categories...his 75 appearances were tied for second most in baseball.

**Alcala, who was optioned to Triple-A St. Paul on September 16, made two appearances during his most recently stint with the Saints, pitching 2.0 scoreless innings with no walks and four strikeouts.

**Martin, who was optioned to St. Paul on September 11, played in nine games upon his return to the Saints, hitting .333 (11-for-33) with one double, one RBI, seven walks and an .840 OPS.

**To make room for Topa, Alcala and Martin on the 28-man roster, the Twins have placed outfielder Matt Wallner on the 10-day Injured List with a left oblique strain, optioned left-handed pitcher Brent Headrick and designated left-handed pitcher Cole Irvin for release or assignment.

NATIONAL NEWS: The Twins are 17-27 in Interleague Play this season, going 1-3 against Milwaukee, 1-2 vs. Los Angeles, 2-1 at Washington, 1-2 at Pittsburgh, 2-1 vs. Colorado, 2-1 at Arizona, 1-2 at San Francisco, 2-1 vs. Philadelphia, 1-2 at New York-NL, 1-2 at Chicago, 1-2 at San Diego, 1-2 vs. St. Louis, 0-3 vs. Atlanta, 1-2 vs. Cincinnati and 0-1 vs. Miami...Twins are just 7-18 against NL opponents since July 14.

◆ By comparison, the Twins have gone 64-49 against American League opponents.

◆ Byron Buxton is hitting 327 (34-for-104) with four doubles, nine home runs, 19 RBI, a .625 slugging percentage and a 1.008 OPS in 29 games against the NL this season...he ranks tied for seventh in baseball in slugging in IL Play, 10th in OPS and tied for sixth in batting average (min. 100 PA).

◆ Buxton has 28 career home runs in Interleague Play, second most in Twins history, trailing only Torii Hunter (33).

C4. EXP-'LOS-IVE: Carlos Correa has reached base safely in 21 of his last 22 games...over those 22 games, dating back to June 26, he is hitting .338 (27-for-80) with five doubles, five home runs, 16 RBI, 12 walks, a .436 on-base percentage, a .588 slugging percentage and a 1.024 OPS.

ROCTEMBER: Twins manager Rocco Baldelli is celebrating his 43rd birthday today...he shares a birthday with actors Michael Douglas, Donald Glover, Bella Ramsey, Will Smith and Mark Hamill, rapper T.I., and former NBA stars Chauncey Billups and Scottie Pippen.

ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: In 1965, Jim "Mudcat" Grant threw a complete-game one-hitter, as the Twins defeated the Senators in the first game of a doubleheader...the win marked Grant's 20th of the season, becoming the first African-American pitcher in the American League to win 20 games in a season...in 1985, Bert Blyleven led the Twins to a 5-1 win in Texas, the 2,000th win in Minnesota history...in 2019, the Twins celebrated Rocco Baldelli's 38th birthday and first season as the club's manager with an American League Central title, winning 5-1 over the Tigers at Comerica Park (also a White Sox 8-3 win over Cleveland).

LAST TIME OUT: Last pitched September 19 at Cleveland, opposite Joey Cantillo, and didn't factor into the decision of Minnesota's 3-2, 10-inning walk-off loss...allowed one run on five hits (1 HR) in 4.2 innings, with one walk and six strikeouts...only run came on Kyle Manzardo's first-inning home run... was pulled with one on and two outs in the fifth; Cole Irvin entered and escaped the jam.

© Induced 10 whiffs on 36 swings (27.8%)...ranks in MLB's 24th percentile with a 22.2 percent

- ₱ Allowed three hard-hit balls (95.0+ mph)...ranks in MLB's 69th percentile with a 36.5 percent hard-hit rate.
- ◆ Has failed to complete 5.0 innings in five-straight starts since August 27, posting a 5.75 ERA (20.1 IP, 13 ER) and averaging 74 pitches per start during that span.
 ◆ Minnesota is 16-11 in his starts this season despite losing three straight.

TWO STARTS AGO: Started September 14 vs. Cincinnati, opposite Nick Martinez, and took the loss in Minnesota's 11-1 defeat...allowed three runs on five hits in 3.0 innings, with three walks and three strikeouts...escaped a bases-loaded, no-outs jam in the third...was pulled after allowing a walk, two singles and a run to begin the fourth; Louie Varland entered and allowed both inherited runners to score.

Threw 69 pitches, his second fewest in a start this season (66, 6/2 at HOU).

Induced four whiffs on 24 swings (16.7%) and allowed two hard-hit balls, both singles.

MEETING MIAMI: Making first career start and appearance vs. Miami...has made nine Interleague starts this season, going 2-3 with a 4.22 ERA (42.2 IP, 20 ER), 16 walks and 38 strikeouts.

HOME/ROAD SPLITS: Making 13th home start of 2024…is 1-2 with a 3.90 ERA (62.1 IP, 27 ER), 8.66 K/9, 3.47 BB/9, 0.87 HR/9 and a .601 opponent OPS at home, compared to 4-3 with a 4.09 ERA (70.1 IP, 32 ER), 7.04 K/9, 2.94 BB/9, 1.15 HR/9 and a .737 opponent OPS in 15 road starts.

◆ In five home starts since the All-Star break, is 0-2 with a 4.38 ERA (24.2 IP, 12 ER).

PLATOON SPLITS: Through 27 games this season vs. Woods Richardson, left-handed hitters have hit .243 (51-for-210) with a .357 slugging percentage, .671 OPS, 20.3 percent strikeout rate and 8.5 percent walk rate, while righties have hit .234 (68-for-290) with a .383 SLG, .679 OPS, 20.7 percent strikeout rate and 8.4 percent walk rate.
