REDBIRD RUNDOWN: The defending 2019 NL Central Champion Cardinals continue their 12-game homestand tonight with the opener of a three-game series against the cross-state rival Kansas City Royals ... St. Louis is in the midst of playing 53 games over the final 44 days of the season, which includes 10 doubleheaders (55 games in 45 days, if necessary) ... The Cardinals have sported records of 3-3, 4-4, 5-5, 6-6, 7-7, and 8-8 this season.

I-70 SERIES: The I-70 interleague series resumes tonight as the Cardinals and Royals play the first of six meetings in 2020 ... St. Louis topped Kansas City, 6-3, in a Summer Camp Exhibition at Busch Std. on July 22, marking the first time two MLB teams played an exhibition in St. Louis since the Cardinals faced the Seattle Mariners for a two-game series at Busch Std. II (April 24-25, 1995) prior to the labor-shortened 1995 season.

CROWNING ACHIEVEMENT: St. Louis has won 11 of their last 14 Interleague matchups over the Royals dating back to August 7, 2017. **SIX IS A SERIOUS NUMBER:** The Cardinals have scored six or more runs in 10 of their last 11 wins over the Royals.

ROYAL PAINS: Three current Cardinals have a 1.000 or better OPS against the Royals while wearing the birds on the bat: **Dexter Fowler** (1.250), **Harrison Bader** (1.120) and **Matt Carpenter** (1.022).

HOMEWORK ASSIGNMENT: The current 12-game, 11-day Cardinals homestand against the Reds (3-1), Royals (3G), Pirates (2G DH), and Indians (3G) is the club's longest since playing a 13-game, 14-day homestand from May 26-June 8, 2003 at Busch Stadium II ... The last time St. Louis played 12 or more consecutive home dates without an off day was from June 25-July 7, 2002 (13 straight games).

WELCOME BACK MIKE: The Cardinals welcome back former Gold Glove and winning manager **Mike Matheny** to Busch Stadium for his first regular season game since managing the club ... The last time a former Cardinals manager faced St. Louis was **Joe Torre**, who piloted the Cardinals for parts of six seasons from 1990-95 ... Torre's New York Yankees faced the Redbirds in 2003 and 2005, while later managing the Los Angeles Dodgers from 2008-10 ... Matheny's 591 managerial wins rank 5th all-time for Cardinals as he posted a winning record each year with St. Louis ... He also led St. Louis to the postseason in each of his first four seasons, becoming the first manager in MLB history to accomplish that feat.

BACKSTOP BRILLIANCE: In 3,256 total Cardinals games since 2000, the top three players to start at catcher for St. Louis have been **Yadier Molina** (1,890 games, 58%), **Mike Matheny** (561 games, 17.2%) and **Tony Cruz** (129 games, 3.9%) ... Molina (9) and Matheny (3) are responsible for 12 of 20 total Gold Gloves earned by Cardinals backstops during that time, while Matheny won another in 2005 with the Giants.

TOMMY BOY: **Tommy Edman** (.323/.389/.631, 21-65) has reached base safely in his last 17 consecutive home games (Sept. 4, 2019-present), for the 9th-longest active home on-base streak in MLB ... The last Cardinal to reach base safely in 18 or more home games was **Dexter Fowler** (25 games from July 31-Sept. 18, 2019) ... Among all-time Cardinals to have played in 50 career games at Busch Stadium III (since 2006), Edman ranks 1st in batting average (.335, 57-170), 9th in on-base percentage (.376), 4th in slugging percentage (.529), and 2nd in OPS (.905).

GOLDY WALKS: **Paul Goldschmidt** enters today's game leading all of MLB in on-base percentage (.485) and ranking 6th in batting average (.340, 18-53) ... Goldschmidt has reached base safely in 16 of 17 games this season (18 hits, 15 walks) and drawn a walk in his last eight consecutive (August 17-present), which is the longest active walk streak in MLB, tied for 2nd-longest in MLB this season, and his longest streak since a career-best nine in 2014 with Arizona ... In Goldschmidt's first 17 games to start any season of his career, he is riding career highs in batting average and on-base pct., and walks ... Goldschmidt's 15 walks in his first 17 games are most by a Cardinal since **Matt Carpenter** (15 in 2018).

9 HOLE MAGIC: Yesterday, **Harrison Bader** became the first Cardinal to homer in consecutive games this season (4th time of career) and the first to homer in consecutive games out of the No. 9 slot since rookie second baseman **Paul DeJong** at Baltimore (June 16-17, 2017). This also marks the fourth straight year a Cardinal has homered in his consecutive game while batting 9th in the lineup, although **Matt Wieters** (C-7/4/19 at SEA, PH-9/18/19 vs. WSH) and **Matt Carpenter** (PH-7/8/2018 at SF, 1B-7/21/18-2 at CHI) appeared in other lineup spots between appearances at No. 9.

MOLINA MILESTONES: **Yadier Molina** needs one RBI to tie **Joe "Ducky" Medwick** (923) for 8th all-time in Cardinals history and two more doubles to tie **Johnny Bench** (381) for 8th all-time among primary catchers in MLB history ... Molina is six hits shy of tying **Red Schoendienst** (1,980) for 6th in Cardinals history, and is 26 hits away from becoming the 11th primary catcher in MLB history to reach 2,000 career hits.

Dakota Hudson resides in Leawood, Kansas.

Miles Mikolas pitched his first career complete-game shutout against the Royals on May 21, 2018 with a career-high nine strikeouts.

Kolten Wong's first MLB home run was a grand slam vs. Kansas City (June 2, 2014).

Hall of Fame manager **Whitey Herzog** managed the Royals for three seasons (1976-78)...piloted the club to three straight American League Western Division titles.

Royals Hitting Coach **Terry Bradshaw** played in 34 games over two seasons for the Cardinals (1995-96)...selected by St. Louis in the 9th round of the 1990 MLB Draft and spent his first eight seasons in the Cardinals organization.

Mike Matheny was Cardinals Manager from 2012-2018 and played five seasons (2000-04) as an Gold-Glove catcher for the Cardinals...his 591 managerial wins rank 5th all-time.

Royals Pitching Coach **Cal Eldred** pitched for St. Louis for three seasons (2003-05)...served as Cardinals Special Asst. to the GM (2013-15).

Royals Assistant Pitching Coordinator **Jason Simontacchi** pitched for St. Louis in parts of three seasons (2002-04)...was a Cardinals minor league pitching coach for parts of six seasons (2012-17).

Cardinals broadcasters **Rick Ankiel** (27 games) and **Brad Thompson** (16 games) both appeared on the 2010 Kansas City Royals squad.

Cardinals broadcaster **Al Hrabosky** pitched in 116 games over two seasons (1978-79) with Kansas City...traded to Kansas City for pitcher **Mark Littell** and catcher **Buck Martinez** (Dec. 8, 1977).

Cardinals Asst. Athletic Trainer **Jeremy Clipperton** worked one season (2001) with the Rookie-level Northwest League Spokane Indians of the Royals organization.

Greg Holland pitched in 32 games for St. Louis in 2018.

Royals Special Asst. to the GM **Tim Conroy** worked as an area scout and an East Coast regional supervisor with St. Louis (1994-2000)...pitched for St. Louis for two seasons (1986-87).

Trevor Rosenthal pitched parts of six seasons with St. Louis (2012-17) where he was a 2015 NL All-Star when he set the franchise single-season saves record (48)...ranks 5th all-time in franchise history with 121 saves...drafted by the Cardinals in the 21st round of the 2009 MLB Draft.

Royals Senior Advisor to the GM/Scouting & Player and Development **Mike Arbuckle** was selected by the Cardinals in the 1969 MLB Draft.

Royals Special Assistant to the GM **Jim Fregosi** Jr. was originally selected by the Cardinals in the 2nd round of the 1985 MLB Draft.

Royals Coach **John Mabry** served as a Cardinals hitting coach for six seasons (2013-18) and assistant hitting coach in 2012...selected in the 6th round of the 1991 MLB draft and played parts of eight seasons with St. Louis (1994-98, 2001)

Royals Asst. Dir. of Scouting **Dan Ontiveros** worked in the Cardinals Scouting Department from 1998-2004.

Royals Bullpen Coach **Larry Carter** was originally selected by St. Louis in the 10th round of the 1986 MLB Draft.

Cardinals broadcaster Brad Thompson pitched part of the 2010 season with Kansas city.

FOX Sports Kansas City reporter **Joel Goldberg** covered the Cardinals for FOX Sports Midwest for three seasons (2005-07)...worked parts of six years for KTVI FOX 2 in St. Louis.

Royals broadcaster **Steve Stewart** is a St. Louis native...called Cardinals games on KMOX in 2002.

Royals broadcaster **Rex Hudler** played three seasons in St. Louis (1990-92).

TONIGHT'S GAME

- Makes his third start of the 2020 season and his first against the Royals this season. Today marks his 70th career appearance and 69th start.
- Went 25 days in between starts from Opening Day until his last start August 19 at CHI [1]. Threw only 41 pitchers against the Cubs exiting in the 2nd inning.
- in four career home starts in August, is 4-0 with an 0.35 ERA, allowing just one run on 11 hits, with the run coming on a Colin Moran single to score Josh Bell (8/28/18).
- Is 8-1 with an 1.00 ERA in 12 career starts in August. Has posted a .142 opp. BA and allowed just 34 hits in 71.2 innings with 88 strikeouts (0.75 WHIP; 11.05 K/9 IP).
- Since 1920, Flaherty has the lowest career ERA (1.00) and opponent BA (.142) in the month of August (min. 10 starts).
- Enters today with a .201 opponent BA since his MLB debut on Sept. 1, 2017, 4th-lowest in MLB over that period (Hader .141, Verlander .183, Cole .196).

LAST TIME OUT

- Made his second start of the 2020, with 25 days of rest between his first career Opening Day start on 7/24.
- Was the shortest start of his career, coming out after 1.2 innings (previous: 2.0 IP on 9/19/17 @CIN)
- Surrendered a home run to Ian Happ to lead-off the game, exited with two outs in the second inning with the bases loaded.

- Finished 4th in the National League Cy Young award voting, 13th for NL Most Valuable Player award, and was one of five starting pitchers on the All-MLB Second Team.
- Finalist for the Rawlings Glove Glove award. Was one of eight NL pitchers (and three Cardinals) to record a perfect fielding percentage.
- Established single-season career highs in wins (11), innings pitched (196.1), strikeouts, quality starts and starts.
- His 231 strikeouts ranked 6th in franchise single-season history, trailing only Bob Gibson (1964, 1965, 1968, 1969, 1970).
- Set Cardinals single-season records in strikeouts/ 9 IP (10.59) and percentage of swings that missed (30.7) (in data since 1988). His .192 opponent batting average was 2nd to only Bob Gibson (.184) in 1968.
- Struck out 231, walked 55 and recorded a 2.75 ERA. Since 1885, became only the third pitcher younger than 24-years old to record a season of at least 230 strikeouts, while permitting 55-or-fewer walks to go along with an ERA of 2.75-or-better, joining Clayton Kershaw (2011) and Mark Prior (2003).

CAREER

- In 68 career starts, is 19-7 when receiving 2 runs of support or more, and 15-1 when receiving 3 runs or more.
- Has the 4th-lowest day game ERA (2.51) among active pitchers with 20 or more starts, trailing only (Jacob deGrom 1.85, Clayton Kershaw 2.39 & Mike Clevenger 2.50).
- At age 24.283, was the 16th youngest Cardinal to make an Opening Day start (since 1904) and youngest since Joe Magrane (Age 24.275) on April 3, 1989 vs. the New York Mets.
- Has struck out 442 batters over his first 69 career games, the most ever by a Cardinal and 12th-most in National League history (since 1908).
- Recorded five double-digit strikeouts games in 2019 and has eight for his career. His eight games with 10+ strikeouts in his first 67 career games are a Cardinals record.
