**RAYS REPORT**—The Rays continue a seven-game road trip against the Reds (0-3) and Yankees (4G) tonight in the Bronx...have dropped four straight, six of seven, 10 of 13, 14 of 19 and 18 of their last 25 games...are 500 for the first time since entering play on May 28 (27-27)...started 21-26, went an MLB-best 25-9 from May 20-June 26 and are an MLB-worst 7-18 since June 27, their worst 25-game stretch since June 28-July 27, 2016 (7-18)...have lost seven of their last eight series...are tied for fourth in the AL in run differential...are fourth in the AL East, a season-high 10.0 GB the division-leading Blue Jays and 3.5 GB the third-place Red Sox for the AL's third and final Wild Card spot...have spent 17 consecutive days in fourth...including off days and the All-Star break, they have spent two days in first, 37 in second, 32 in third, 47 in fourth and four in fifth.

- ★ The Rays dropped yesterday's series finale in Cincinnati, 2-1, marking their fifth time being swept this season and third on the road...they hit .152 (14-for-92) in the set and scored only five runs, their second fewest in any series this season, ahead of only April 29-May 1 vs. KC (3R).
- ★ Rays pitching retired 16 straight batters to conclude the game...the bullpen recorded three scoreless innings (or more) without yielding a baserunner for the second time this season, joining April 16 vs. BOS (3.0IP).
- ★ It marked Tampa Bay's seventh consecutive road loss, its longest skid since losing 10 straight from June 15-July 3, 2021...the Rays, who are 3-11 in their last 14 road contests, are 0-3 on a stretch of 19 road games in 22 games from July 25-Aug. 17.
- ★ The Rays are seeking their first road series win since June 24-26 at KC, having lost each of their last five, their longest streak since Sept. 9-Oct. 5, 2022 (5).
- ★ The Rays' 6-15 record in July is tied with the Braves for the worst in MLB...the 286 winning pct. would be their worst over a calendar month since July 2007 (7-20/.259).
- ★ Tonight, the Rays will be opposed by a rookie starting pitcher for the 19th time this season, going 8-10 in the previous matchups, including four straight losses (June 27-pres.) on the heels of six straight wins...entering play tonight, only the Mariners (20G) and Twins (19G) have faced rookie starters more often than the Rays (18G).
- ★ Tampa Bay has lost seven of its last eight series openers on the heels of a 10-game winning streak (May 23-June 24), including five straight setbacks in road openers.

**PINSTRIPES PUNISHER**—In five career appearances (4GS) against the Yankees, **Drew Rasmussen** is 2-1 with a 0.34 ERA (26.2IP, 1ER), a 0.75 WHIP, 33 strikeouts, five walks and a 160/202/170 (15-for-94) opp. slash line...min. 25.0 IP, only **John Morris** (0.31ERA/29.1IP, 1ER; 1968-71) has a lower career ERA against the Yankees since earned runs became an official statistic in 1913...he has yielded only one extra-base hit to New York, a **Gleyber Torres** double in his first career outing against them in a relief appearance on July 28, 2021 at NYY...Rasmussen is the only pitcher in MLB history to open his career as a starter against the Yankees with four consecutive starts of 5.0 IP or more without allowing an extra-base hit.

**TOUGH LUCK**—The Rays (53-53, +54 run diff.) are the 12th team since 1901 to be .500 or worse through 106 games despite holding a +50 run differential or better...they are one of five clubs to do so over the last 48 seasons since 1978, joining the 2023 Cubs (53-53/+56), 2023 Padres (52-54/+63), 2019 Diamondbacks (53-53/+66) and 2018 Nationals (53-53/+59).

**BRING THE BOOM**—**Yandy Diaz** (183) has the most hard-hit balls (95 mph or more) in the majors, outpacing **Tor B. Bichette** (178), **SD Manny Machado** (175) and **LAD Shohei Ohtani** (169)...it already marks the eighth-highest total by a Ray over a full season under Stastek (since 2015), including his 2023 (1st, 234), 2024 (2nd, 230) and 2022 (4th, 203) campaigns, Diaz has four of the top eight seasons in Rays history in terms of total hard-hit balls...he has 850 since 2022, fourth most in the majors, trailing **TOR Vladimir Guerrero Jr.** (969), **NYM Juan Soto** (871) and **Ohtani** (863).

★ Between Diaz (53.5%) and **Jonathan Aranda** (55.5%), the Rays have two of the AL's top four leaders in hard-hit rate (see table to the right).

**MEN OF STEAL**—The Rays lead the majors with 138 SB, 17 more than the second-ranked Cubs (121SB), and have stolen a base in seven of nine games since the All-Star break, including five multi-steal efforts...they are on pace for a franchise-record 210 SB, which would surpass the 2009 club (194SB)...according to FanGraphs, the Rays are the fourth-best team on the basepaths in the majors based on their 7.7 baserunning runs above average, an all-encompassing baserunning metric that turns stolen bases, caught stealings and other baserunning plays (taking extra bases, being thrown out on the bases, etc) into runs above and below average...they trail the Brewers (11.9), Rangers (11.1) and Cubs (8.2).

★ **José Caballero** (33SB) and **Chandler Simpson** (32SB) are the first pair of teammates in the majors to both record 30 SB before the end of July since **Carl Crawford** (48SB) and **B.J. Upton** (32SB) did so for the Rays in 2009.

**CHAN CAN**—**Chandler Simpson** has hit safely in four straight and 22 of his last 24 games with a PA, batting .352/.394/.418 (32-for-91) with 4 2B, 1 3B, 4 RBI, 7 BB, 5 SO and 13 SB...over that span (since June 25), he leads the majors in steals and is tied for fourth in average (see table to the right)...he has struck out only twice in his last 11 games (48PA), good for a 4.2 pct. strikeout rate...his 32 SB on the year are third in the majors despite appearing in only 61 of the Rays 106 games—it equates to an 84-steal pace over a full 162-game season.

**LA MÁXIMA**—**Junior Caminero's** 26 HR are tied with **Logan Morrison** (2017) and **Carlos Peña** (2009) for second most before the end of July in club history, trailing **Jose Canseco** (31HR) in 1999...he is 2 RBI shy of becoming the first Ray with 25 HR and 70 RBI before the calendar flips to August...Caminero, who ranks third in the AL in homers behind **SEA Cal Raleigh** (41HR) and **NYA Aaron Judge** (37HR), is 11-for-36 (.306) with 1 2B, 3 HR, 8 RBI and a .942 OPS in nine games since the All-Star break.

**MILESTONE WATCH**—**Yandy Diaz** is four hits away from 900 for his career and seven runs away from tying **Kevin Kiermaier** (410R) for fifth on the Rays all-time list...his 242 multi-hit games with the Rays are tied for fourth in club history with **Aubrey Huff**, and his 64 three-hit games are one shy of Huff (65G) for third...**José Caballero** is 3 RBI shy of 100 for his career and needs 3 SB to tie **Randy Winn** (80SB) for eighth in club history...**Danny Jansen** is one walk shy of 200 for his career and 1 RBI shy of 250...**Christopher Morel** is 4 RBI away from 200...**Pete Fairbanks** needs 5 SO to tie **Grant Balfour** for third most by a reliever in franchise history...**Edwin Uceta's** next appearance will be his 100th of his career.

**NEW YORK, NEW YORK**—The Rays and Yankees meet for the third of four series in 2025 this week, with the Rays going 3-4 thus far across sets in Tampa (1-3, April 17-20) and the Bronx (2-1, May 2-4)...they need to sweep this set to secure a season series win over the Yankees and need at least a split to prevent a season series loss...the Rays are 1-6-5 in their last 12 four-game sets with the Yankees dating back to 2016, with the lone win coming from Aug. 7-9, 2020 at Tropicana Field...despite losing seven of 13 games in 2024, the Rays have claimed three of the last five season series (2020-24)...their 44-37 (.543) mark vs. the Yankees since 2020 is the best among AL teams...the Rays hold a narrow 17-16 lead in head-to-head matchups since in the last three seasons since 2023, outscoring the Yankees by one run, 141-140...Tampa Bay's 39 HR vs. New York over that span are its most against any opponent and are second most by any AL club against the Pinestripes, trailing Boston (43HR).

★ **Yandy Diaz** has reached base safely in 36 of his last 38 games vs. New York dating back to June 21, 2022, slashing .306/.396/.497 (45-for-147) with 10 2B, 6 HR and 24 RBI.

**DOWN ON THE FARM**—Class-A Charleston INF **Larry Martinez** was named Carolina League Player of the Week for July 21-27 after hitting .481 (13-for-27) with 3 2B, 8 RBI, 2 SB and a 1.093 OPS in a six-game series at Salem, the first weekly honor of his career.

★ Rays affiliates have the second-best winning pct. among AL organizations (.556), trailing only the Tigers (.585)...the Rays are one of two organizations (Mariners) with all of their minor league affiliates currently holding a .500 or better record.

**TONIGHT'S START**—Drew Rasmussen will make his 21st start of the campaign and his second against the Yankees...marks his 71st start (120G) of his career and fifth (6G) against the Yankees...min. 90.0 IP, ranks among AL leaders in WHIP (7th, 1.03), opp. OPS (10th, .613) and opp. average (11th, .219/75-for-343)...signed a two-year contract extension through 2026 with a club option for 2027 on Jan. 7, 2025.

**LAST TIME OUT**—Rasmussen went 4.0 innings on July 22 vs. CWS, his longest start since June 25 at KC (5.0IP)...marked the second time in his career he has made 20 or more starts in a single season, joining 2022 when he made 28 starts...he allowed two runs on three hits and one walk with five strikeouts against the White Sox...threw 3.0 perfect innings to begin the game before allowing a double to Mike Tauchman to open the 4th inning...the double was followed up by a pair of singles, a walk and a sac fly before a fielder's choice and a ground out ended the inning.

- ✦ It marked the fifth time in 20 starts this season he completed fewer than five innings, joining May 6 vs. PHI (4.1IP), June 30 vs. ATH (3.0IP), July 6 at MIN (2.0IP) and July 11 at BOS (2.0IP).
- ✦ He has allowed three runs or fewer in 17 of 20 starts this season and one or zero runs in 11 of 20.

**THE UNSLEEPING CITY**—Rasmussen has made five career appearances (4GS) against the Yankees, with his last outing coming on April 18 (L, 5.2IP, 3H, R, 3BB, 7SO)...in his career against the Yankees, he is 2-1 with a 0.34 ERA (26.2IP, 1ER)...opposing hitters are slashing .160/.202/.170 (15-for-94) and a 0.75 WHIP...in his last visit to Yankee Stadium on May 11, 2023, he earned the win after throwing 7.0 scoreless frames with two hits allowed and seven strikeouts.

- ✦ Against the AL East in his career, he is 7-7 with a 2.35 ERA (138.0IP, 36ER) in 34 appearances (24GS)...he has allowed three runs or fewer in 11 straight outings, dating back to May 6, 2023 vs. NYY.
- ✦ When facing AL East opponents on the road the Rays are 10-3 when Rasmussen pitches since acquiring him on May 21, 2021.

**CATCHING FLIGHTS**—The Rays are 5-2 when Rasmussen starts on the road this season, having won five straight from April 24—July 6...over that five-start span, he was 3-0 with a 3.52 ERA (23.0IP, 9ER) and 20 strikeouts to four walks...across his seven road starts this season, opposing hitters are slashing .243/.288/.396 (27-for-111) with five doubles and four home runs...he has allowed one or zero runs in five of the seven contests and spun one quality start on May 17 at MIA...in 36 career road starts, he is 14-5 with a 2.93 ERA (160.0IP, 52ER), a .239 (143-for-598) opp. average and 130 strikeouts.

**RASON A ROLL**—Of his last 12 starts, he has allowed two runs or fewer in 10 of them and zero runs in five...Rasmussen is 6-1 with a 2.60 ERA (55.1IP, 16ER) and 1.01 WHIP in that span, holding opponents to a .218/.272/.320 (43-for-197) line with 47 strikeouts...over that stretch (since May 17), he has the sixth-best ERA and the sixth-best WHIP in the AL (min. 55.0IP).

**SLUG STOPPER**—Rasmussen has allowed only nine extra-base hits across his last nine starts (5 2B, 4HR) holding opponents to a .335 slugging pct. in that span...min 90.0 IP, his .338 opp. slugging pct. on the season ranks 10th in the AL...he has recorded eight starts of 5.0 IP or more with no extra-base hits allowed, tied with DET Tarik Skubal for the most in the majors.

**FROZE HIM**—Rasmussen is ninth in the majors with 35 called strikeouts behind STL Sonny Gray (44), SD Nick Pivetta (44), NYY Will Warren (43), CLE Tanner Bibee (41), HOU Hunter Brown (39), ATH Luis Severino (36), TOR José Berríos (36) and BOS Garrett Crochet (36)...over his last 12 starts, 20 of his 47 strikeouts have been looking...his 18 called strikeouts on sinkers are fifth most in the AL and 13th in the majors.

**HEAT CHECK**—Rasmussen throws fastballs (cutter, sinker, four-seamer) 89.3 pct. of the time, the highest rate among major league starters (min. 500 pitches thrown in starts)...among all pitchers with 500 or more pitches thrown this season, only NYY Tim Hill (95.1%) and BOS Kenley Jansen (91.0%) have a higher usage rate on heaters than Rasmussen.

- ✦ Opponents are hitting .219 (70-for-320) against his fastballs in 2025, including a .175 (18-for-103) clip against his cutter...min. 450 cutters thrown, the .175 opp. AVG is the lowest in the majors.

**GOING STREAKING**—Rasmussen's 23.0 scoreless inning streak from May 17—June 3 was tied for the fifth-longest single-season run in club history, trailing runs by J.P. Howell (27.1IP, 2012), Alex Cobb (24.2IP, 2014), Kevin Kelly (24.1, 2024) and Taj Bradley (24.0IP, 2024)...only Cobb's and Bradley's streaks came as starting pitchers...Rasmussen tallied five scoreless innings or more in a franchise-record four consecutive starts during the streak.

**BEST OF THE BEST**—Min. 350.0 IP, Rasmussen's 2.77 ERA (373.2IP, 115ER) since debuting with the Rays on June 19, 2021 ranks third in the majors behind NYY Max Fried (2.70) and SD Michael King (2.77)...under the same parameter, he also leads the AL in opp. slugging pct. (.324), is second in opp. OPS (.591), second in WHIP (1.03) and opp. on-base pct. (.267) and ninth in opp. average (.219).

- ✦ Rasmussen (2.93 ERA/402.0IP, 131ER) is one of 12 active major league pitchers with 400.0 IP or more and an ERA of 3.00 or better in his career...he is one of four to accomplish the feat while starting in at least half of his appearances.
- ✦ Rasmussen did not yield an extra-base hit in 21.2IP from March 31—April 24...per Stats Perform, his streak with 0 XBH was the longest by a starting pitcher to begin a season in Rays history, and tied for second longest by any Rays pitcher with Kyle Farnsworth (21.2IP) in 2012, trailing only J.P. Feyereisen (24.1IP) in 2016...it marks the fourth-longest streak by a Rays starter at any point in a season.
