THE TWINS: Completed their six-game, seven-day homestand with a record of 2-4, going 0-3 vs. the Dodgers and 2-1 vs. the Rockies...tonight, they will begin a six-game, seven-day roadtrip with the first of three against the Astros through Wednesday night...after this series, Minnesota will travel to New York to spend an off-day on Thursday, then play the Yankees in the Bronx over the weekend.

☞ The Twins have won eight of their last 13 and 10 of their last 17.
☞ Twins have won four of their last five series, taking series from St. Louis (6/12-14), Texas (6/15-18), Arizona (6/19-21) and Colorado (6/26-28)...their only series loss was a sweep by Los Angeles-NL (6/22-24).

SUNDAY'S ARE FOR PRIELIPP MAGIC: The Twins beat the Rockies yesterday afternoon at Target Field by a score of 3-2, winning the three-game series...Connor Prielipp was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing two runs on six hits in 6.0 innings pitched, with no walks and a career-high 10 strikeouts...Andrew Morris (1.1 IP) earned the win, Anthony Banda (0.2 IP) earned a hold and Yoendrys Gómez (1.0 IP) earned the save...the offense recorded eight hits, including home runs from Kody Clemens (13) and Ryan Kreidler (5)...Kreidler's was a solo shot in the seventh inning, that broke a 2-2 tie and proved to be the game-winner.

☞ For Prielipp, his 10 strikeouts and no walks made him the third rookie in club history with double-digit strikeouts and no walks...the others were Trevor May (September 14, 2014 at CWS) and Frank Viola (August 12, 1982 vs. CAL)...also the 11th rookie in club history with 10-plus Ks in a game.

ROSTER MOVE: Twins announced today that they have placed left-handed pitcher Anthony Banda on the 15-day Injured List with a left lat strain...Banda, who was removed from yesterday's game in the ninth inning against Colorado with the injury, has gone 2-0 with a 4.46 ERA (34.1 IP, 17 ER), two saves, 10 holds, 15 walks, 33 strikeouts and a .235 opponent batting average in 39 games for the Twins this season.

☞ To replace Banda on the 26-man roster, the Twins have recalled right-handed pitcher Cody Laweryson from Triple-A St. Paul...Laweryson, who was optioned to the Saints on June 23, made one Triple-A relief appearance on June 28 at Louisville, working 1.0 inning and allowing two runs on three hits...the 28-year-old has gone 1-0 with a 5.06 ERA (16.0 IP, 9 ER), one save, two holds, seven walks, 18 strikeouts and a .213 opponent batting average in 14 games for the Twins this season.

GO FOR LAUNCH: The Twins and Astros are playing the fourth of six games in 2026...these two met for three games at Target Field from May 18-20 as the Twins took the first and third games of the series...in that series, they outscored Houston 11-6.

☞ Brooks Lee is hitting .419 (13-for-31) with one double, one triple, three home runs, seven RBI and a 1.226 OPS in eight career games vs. Houston...he has hit safely in all eight.
☞ Byron Buxton is hitting .316 (12-for-38) with four doubles, one home run, four RBI, a .381 on-base percentage, a .500 slugging percentage and an .881 OPS in his last 10 games against the Astros...he has reached base safely in all 10.

☞ Irving, TX native, Josh Bell, is hitting .292 (28-for-96) with six home runs, 11 RBI and an .879 OPS in 26 career games against the Astros...in three games vs. Houston earlier this season, Bell went 5-for-11 (.455) with two home runs, four RBI and one walk.

☞ Victor Caratini played two seasons with Houston from 2024-25, playing in 201 games...he set a single-season career-high in home runs last season with 12.

WE'VE GOT ALL THE CONNECTIONS: Twins hitters struck out just one time yesterday, marking the seventh time in their last eight games in which they have struck out five times-or-fewer...last time the Twins struck out once in a game was September 20, 2019 vs. Kansas City (Ryan LaMarre vs. Kevin McCarthy)...Minnesota has struck out just 159 times this month, the fewest in baseball...by comparison, in May, they were tied for fourth-most strikeouts in baseball (252) and in March/April they ranked tied for ninth-most in MLB (279).

☞ Brooks Lee leads the AL this month in lowest strikeout percentage at 7.8%.

MIGHTY MUSCLES: Through 25 games this month, the Twins are slugging .475, which ranks second-best in baseball, trailing only Colorado (.490).

☞ This month, Minnesota ranks third in baseball in OPS (.810), trailing Colorado (.842) and Milwaukee (.820).

☞ Twins have homered in all but four of their last 22 games since June 4, hitting 39 in that span...since that date, they rank second in baseball in homers, trailing the Athletics (42).

I AM THE ONE WHO 'NACHS: Over his last 11 games, Trevor Larnach is hitting .452 (19-for-42) with five doubles, two home runs, 10 RBI, a .477 on-base percentage, a .714 slugging percentage and 1.192 OPS.

☞ In 21 games this month, he is hitting .362 (25-for-69) with seven doubles, two home runs, 11 RBI, six walks and a .972 OPS...his batting average is third-highest in baseball among players with at least 75 plate appearances this month.

I GOT A FEVER AND ONLY PRESCRIPTION IS MORE JOSH BELL: In 25 games this month, Josh Bell is hitting .299 (26-for-87) with six doubles, one triple, four home runs, 19 RBI, a .351 on-base percentage, a .529 slugging percentage and an .880 OPS.

☞ He leads the club with 51 RBI for the season...19 of those RBI have come in his last 21 games.

KREI ME A RIVER: Over his last 11 games, Ryan Kreidler is hitting .433 (13-for-30) with one double, one triple, two home runs, 10 RBI, a .469 on-base percentage, a .733 slugging percentage and a 1.202 OPS.

☞ On the season, he is now hitting .290 (77-for-93) with three doubles, two triples, five home runs, 21 RBI, a .365 on-base percentage, a .527 slugging percentage and an .892 OPS.

☞ He has started six of the Twins last eight games at shortstop.

☞ He now has a streak of 27 plate appearances without a strikeout — tied for the third-longest active streak in baseball entering today.

BAILEY DOSE: Bailey Ober made his first rehab start yesterday with High-A Cedar Rapids at Wisconsin, allowing three runs on seven hits in 3.1 innings pitched, with no walks and one strikeout, while throwing 57 pitches.

ONCE UPON A TIME: National Baseball Hall of Famer Harmon Killebrew was born on this date in 1938 in Payette, Idaho...Killebrew signed with the Senators at age 17 and made his MLB debut on June 23, 1954 and would finish his career with 2,086 hits, 573 home runs and 1,584 RBI...he was a 13-time All-Star, the AL MVP in 1969, a six-time home run champion and three-time RBI champ...Killebrew passed away in 2011...also, on this day in 1994: Manager Billy Heywood led a miraculous comeback as the Twins tied the Seattle Mariners, forcing a one-game playoff to decide the final Postseason berth in the American League, with the game to be played in the Hubert H. Humphrey Metrodome...Game No. 163 headed to extra innings, but the Mariners took the lead in the top of the 10th...with two outs in the bottom half, Lou Collins cracked a ball deep to centerfield, only to watch as Ken Griffey Jr. robbed the game-winning, potential walk-off home run, ending the Twins' season...Heywood would never manage again, as he decided to retire and return to junior high.

- Zebby Matthews is slated to make his 34th career start tonight and second career start against the Astros.
- In his most recent start on June 22 vs. Los Angeles-NL, Zebby took his fifth loss of the season in a quality start effort after allowing two runs on six hits (2 HR), with two walks and five strikeouts in 6.0 innings pitched; Twins lost, 2-1.
- Zebby's first career start against the Astros came on May 19 of this season; in that start went 6.0 quality innings and gave up two runs on five hits (1 HR), with one walk and six strikeouts in a 2-1 Twins defeat.

LAST TIME OUT: On June 22 vs. Los Angeles-NL, Zebby made his eighth start of the season opposite Dodgers opener Will Klein...Matthews took his fifth loss of the season, but it came in the form of a 6.0-inning quality start effort in which he allowed two runs on six hits – including two solo home runs by Shohei Ohtani (lead off homer) and Freddie Freeman (sixth inning) – with two walks and five strikeouts in a 2-1 Twins loss...on the night, Matthews threw a career-high 108 pitches, 67 of them for strikes; his previous career high was 100 (done three times in his career – all this season).

HIGH QUALITY: Zebby notched another quality start, his sixth of the season in eight starts for Minnesota; since making his major league season debut on May 14, his six quality starts are tied for third in MLB (eight others with six) and tied for second in the American League (three others) during that span...the only two pitchers with more quality starts than Zebby in baseball are Jacob Misiorowski (ML) and Sonny Gray (BOS), both with seven...the three other pitchers he is tied for second with in the American League are Tanner Bibee (CLE), Drew Rasmussen (TB) and Michael Wacha (KC).

RISPY BUSINESS: Held Dodgers hitters to a .000 (0-for-5) BAA with two strikeouts (Chuckie Robinson twice) with runners in scoring position; came into the start with an opponent batting average of .257 (9-for-35) with two doubles and two home runs with runners in scoring position...through his eight starts this season has yet to allow a walk with RISP (0 BB/11K).

NOT A COINCIDENCE: After giving up two more home runs in his start against the Dodgers, Matthews has now given up 10 home runs this season (third on Twins staff, trailing Bradley and Ober – 12) and has allowed at least one home run in five of his eight starts...below is a breakdown of Zebby's stats this year in games he gives up one-or-more homers compared to when he does not allow a homer:

TWO STARTS AGO: On June 16 at Texas, Zebby made his seventh start of the year opposite Rangers right-hander Kumar Rocker...Matthews earned his third win of the season in a quality start and turned in his third start this season of 7.0 innings, allowing two runs on eight hits, with zero walks and four strikeouts in a 12-2 Twins win...gave up only two extra-base hits (both doubles) to Brandon Nimmo (2nd inning) and Elias Díaz (5th inning) in the outing.

BULLDOG: Zebby has now recorded three 7.0-inning outings in his seven starts with the Twins, which is the most outings of 7.0-or-more innings by a Twins starter this season (second: Joe Ryan and Taj Bradley – two).

HOUSTON, YOU HAVE A PROBLEM: Matthews will face off against the Astros for the second time in his career and second time this season...went 6.0 quality innings, but took the loss, allowing two runs on five hits – including an Isaac Paredes two-run homer in the first inning – with zero walks and five strikeouts in his May 19 start at Target Field...excluding Paredes, held Houston hitters to a .200 (4-for-20) BAA with zero walks and six strikeouts.

HOME/ROAD SPLITS (SEASON): Matthews has made four road starts this season, going 1-3 with a 7.33 ERA (23.1 IP, 19 ER), four walks, 21 strikeouts and a .292 (28-for-96) BAA, compared to 2-2 with a 2.08 ERA (26.0 IP, 6 ER), seven walks, 18 strikeouts and a .213 (20-for-94) BAA in four home starts.

LEFT/RIGHT SPLITS: Through eight starts this season, lefties are slashing .269/.328/.481 (29-for-108) with five doubles, six home runs, eight walks and 23 strikeouts, while righties are slashing .232/.259/.427 (19-for-82) with four doubles, four home runs, three walks and 16 strikeouts.

THE ARSENAL: Zebby has used a six-pitch mix in his eight starts with the Twins this season...here are some of his numbers and results, per Baseball Savant.

GIVE 'EM A CHAIR: Matthews has a breaking run value of four this season which ranks in the 87th percentile among all MLB pitchers...his run value of three on the slider and .175 (10-for-57) BAA both rank first (run value tied with Prielipp and Ober) on the Twins staff (min. 50 PA), while his .150 (3-for-20) BAA on his curveball also ranks first on the team (min. 10 PA).

PINPOINT: Zebby continues to keep his walk rate low, at a miniscule 5.4%; that number ranks in the 92nd percentile among all pitchers in baseball.

TOMORROW'S STARTER - RHP JOE RYAN (2026: 5-4, 3.18 ERA // CAREER: 51-40, 3.71 ERA)

Right-hander Joe Ryan is slated to make his 18th start of the season tomorrow night in game two of a three-game series at Houston...in his last start on June 24 vs. Los Angeles-NL, Joe was saddled with his fourth loss of the season after going 6.0 innings and allowing four runs on eight hits (1 HR), with one walk and a season-high-tying nine strikeouts in a 4-3 Twins loss...over his last seven starts since May 20 vs. Houston, Ryan has a 3-1 record with a 3.16 ERA (42.2 IP, 15 ER), five walks and 56 strikeouts; his 56 strikeouts rank second in MLB during that span, trailing only Milwaukee's Jacob Misiorowski (58)...tomorrow will be Ryan's ninth career start against Houston (excluding Postseason); in his first eight career starts, is 3-4 with a 5.91 ERA (42.2 IP, 28 ER), 14 walks, 53 strikeouts, a 1.15 WHIP and a .219 (35-for-160) BAA...is 0-2 with a 6.75 ERA (16.0 IP, 12 ER), seven walks and 17 strikeouts in three starts in Houston; the Twins are 0-3 as a team in those three starts.

CAREER NOTES

- On May 14, 2026, tied his major league career high by pitching 7.0 scoreless innings and earning the win against the Miami Marlins in his first MLB start of the season; the 7.0 scoreless innings was the longest scoreless start in his major league career.
