TODAY'S GAME: SF looks to secure at least a split in this four-game series with a win tonight after dropping last night's game 10-3...tonight marks the second Gigantes night of the 2026 season...for more on SF's new Gigantes jerseys, see page two.

- ▶ With last night's defeat, the Giants are 1-4 through their first five home games to start the 2026 campaign...the last time the Giants went 1-4 (or worse) through their first five home games was 2015 when they lost each of their first five games to go 0-5 (swept by Colorado and lost the first two games of a series to Arizona).
- ▶ It's only the fourth time since this ballpark opened in 2000 that SF has started 1-4 (or worse) through five home games to begin a season...the other years were 2000 (0-5), 2007 (1-4) and the aforementioned 2015 year.
- ▶ SF is now 1-5 versus the Mets in its last six games here at home dating to April 24, 2024...they have been outscored 35-17 in those six games.

ROUPP THERE IT IS: RHP Landen Roupp makes his second start of the young season tonight (first at home)...the North Carolina native was superb in this ballpark a season ago, posting a 2.63 ERA (14er, 48.0ip) in nine starts...the Giants, however were 5-4 in those nine starts.

- ▶ Roupp led SF to its first win of the 2026 campaign on Monday in San Diego, firing 6.0 innings of shutout ball while striking out seven and allowing just two hits and two walks.
- ▶ Over Roupp's last 15 starts dating to May 17 of last year, the 27-year-old owns a 2.97 ERA (24er, 72.2ip) with SF going 9-6 in those games...he's thrown at least 6.0 innings and allowed two or fewer runs in six of those 15 starts.
- ▶ Since the start of 2025, Roupp's 36.1 hard hit percentage allowed is 13th lowest in MLB (min. 110.0 innings pitched).
- ▶ He does not have much experience against these Mets, having faced them only once in a relief stint back in April of 2024 (his rookie season)...he allowed three runs on three hits (two walks) in 1.1 innings.

FEAST...OR FAMINE: SF's offense has been a bit all or nothing through the first eight games...in three wins the Giants have scored 19 runs on 35 hits, while in five losses they have scored five total runs on 22 hits, averaging one run per game and 4.4 hits per game.

- ▶ In the wins, the trio of **IF Willy Adames**, **IF Matt Chapman** and **IF Rafael Devers** are slashing .359/.405/.641 (14-for-39)...in losses, they are slashing a combined .111/.186/.148 (6-for-54).
- ▶ Here at home in the early going the Giants have been held to three runs or fewer in four of their five games (one run or fewer in three of the five).
- ▶ Through eight games, SF's offense overall is slashing .218/.281/.318 for a .599 OPS...the .218 clip is fourth-lowest in the National League ahead of only Arizona (.209), Cincinnati (.200) and San Diego (.192)...the .599 OPS is second-lowest in the NL ahead of only the Padres (.554).

ARRAEZ AND SHINE: IF Luis Arraez

owns a .409 career batting average against the Mets after going 1-for-4 in last night's win...the .409 clip is

highest among active players against the Mets (min. 75 PA)...the full top-five that includes another Giant is listed to the right courtesy of *Sports Info Solutions*.

- ▶ Arraez is riding an eight-game hitting streak versus the Mets dating to July 28 of last year, slashing .387/.429/.548 with two extra-base hits and five RBI during the run...he also has multiple hits in 14 of his 23 career starts against the Mets.

50 FOR 5: IF Matt Chapman's next home run will be the 50th of his Giants career...per *Stats, LLC*, there have only been 10 Giants players with 50 or more homers as third basemen.

- ▶ Chapman, who enters today with 290 games played in a Giants uniform, could become just the second Giants player this century with at least 50 home runs in his first 300 games with the team, joining former **OF Mike Yastrzemski**.

GIGANTES JERSEYS



The San Francisco Giants officially unveiled their new Gigantes jerseys on March 18 and are wearing them on-field for the first time for tonight's game versus the Sultanes. This iteration of the Gigantes uniform features a jersey and cap designed by Bay Area artist Jesse Hernandez. First worn on the field in 2005, Gigantes is a symbol of pride, culture, community and a recognition of the Giants rich Latino heritage with more than 200 players representing nine Latin American countries.

In 2026, Gigantes gets a bold redesign. Off the field, Fiesta Gigantes will expand beyond the traditional single-gameday celebration, coming to life every Saturday home game with live music, cultural performances, themed festivities, specialty food and beverage items and giveaways. Forever Giant and World Series Champion **Sergio Romo** will serve as the Gigantes ambassador, reflecting his strong connection to the Giants, passion for baseball and pride of Latino culture. Additional Latino-focused events these Sultanes de Monterrey exhibition games on March 23 and 24 and the Fuerza Regida concert on June 20.

WITH SAN FRANCISCO: Roupp enters his third season with San Francisco and made his third career Opening Day roster...he is slated to make his second start of the season tonight after earning the win his first time out.

LAST START: Went up against the Padres in San Diego in his first start last Monday...was instrumental in the Giants' first victory of the season, as he recorded seven strikeouts over 6.0 scoreless innings (two hits) and earned the win...marked Roupp's first career start with 6.0+ scoreless innings. 7+ strikeouts, and two-or-fewer hits allowed

CACTUS LEAGUE: Made five Cactus League starts and posted a 0-2 record with a 4.15 ERA (6er, 13.0ip)...he struck out 15 batters over his 13.0 innings of work...he also started in the Giants' 8-2 victory over the Sultanes de Monterrey in March 24's exhibition matchup at Oracle Park, tossing 5.1 innings, allowing two earned runs on four hits with six strikeouts.

VS. THE METS: Roupp has made just one appearance in his career against the Mets, as he came on in relief of RHP Sean Hjelle on April 24, 2024... he allowed three runs on three hits over 1.1 innings in the Mets' 8-2 victory at Oracle Park.

2025 SEASON: Was the Giants' fourth starter for most of the season...had his year cut short after suffering a left knee bone bruise in his start on August 20 at San Diego...the injury shut his season down and he went 7-7 with a 3.80 ERA (45er, 106.2ip), 102 strikeouts and 45 walks allowed in 22 starts (eight quality outings)...the Giants went 12-10 in his outings.

HOME VS. ROAD: Had a 2.63 ERA (14er, 48.0ip) in nine starts at Oracle Park in 2025 compared to a 4.76 ERA (31er, 58.2ip) in 13 starts on the road...his 2.63 home ERA ranked as the 14th-lowest among NL pitchers with at least 40.0 innings pitched.

THROWING A CURVE: Roupp's curveball was very effective as opponents were just 29x147 (.197) with 49 strikeouts and a 35.8% whiff rate in 2025...he relied on his curveball 35.7% of the time in 2025...opponents hit .305 (84x275) vs. everything else he throws.

AIN'T NOBODY GOT TIME FOR THAT: With the bases empty, Roupp averaged 11.9 seconds between pitches in 2025, which was tied for the second-quickest in the Majors...Cincinnati's Brent Suter was quickest with only 11.5 seconds between pitches with the bases empty...league average in 2025 was 15.8 seconds...when Roupp had runners on, he averaged 16.0 seconds between pitches, still below the league average of 18.7 seconds.

#47 RYAN BORUCKI ▶ LHP

(bohr-RUCK-ee)

Pitch Arsenal: Slider, Sinker, Split Finger, Sweeper
Last Game: 4/1 at SD; 0.2ip (3 pitches)

- ▶ Made his fourth career Opening Day roster (also with the Pirates in 2025 and 2024 and with the Blue Jays in 2021).
- ▶ Signed a Major League contract with the Giants on March 21 after opting out of his minor league deal with the White Sox on March 20...was in camp with the Sox as an NRI and went 2-0 with eight strikeouts and a 0.67 WHIP over 6.0 shutout innings.
- ▶ Appeared in 39 games at the Major League level in 2025 for Pittsburgh (35 games) and Toronto (four games) and was a combined 1-3 with a 4.63 ERA (18er, 35.0ip).
- ▶ Left-handed batters were 7-for-60 (.117) with two extra-base hits (both doubles) off him last season...has held lefties to a .179 clip (67-for-374) in his MLB career.

#34 JT BRUBAKER ▶ RHP

(BROO-baker)

Pitch Arsenal: 4-Seam FB, Sinker, Slider, Cutter, Changeup
Last Game: 4/3 vs. NYM; 1.1ip, 3h, 3r, 3er, 2bb, 2k, hr (38 pitches)

- ▶ His homer allowed to NYM's Francisco Alvarez last night was the first he'd allowed since October 4, 2022 (also vs. the Mets), a span of 35.2 innings at the MLB level in that time.
- ▶ Made his fourth career OD roster (also: 2020-2022 with Pittsburgh).
- ▶ Began 2025 on NYY's injured list with left rib fractures...made six rehab appearances before appearing in 12 games with NYY (3.38 ERA, 6er, 16.0ip)...was then DFA'ed on Aug. 5.
- ▶ Signed a minor league contract w/SF on Aug. 13 and made five appearances (one start) with SF, posting a 4.26 ERA (6er, 12.2ip) with 12 strikeouts and a 1.26 WHIP.

#93 MATT GAGE ▶ LHP

Pitch Arsenal: Slider, 4-Seam FB, Sinker, Splitter
Last Game: 4/3 vs. NYM; 1.2ip, 2h, bb, 2k (37 pitches)

- ▶ Made his first career Opening Day roster...has appeared in four of SF's first eight games, tossing 4.2-scoreless innings.
- ▶ Has not allowed a HR in his last 38.1 innings dating to June 11, 2023, the 10th-longest active streak in MLB.
- ▶ Signed an MiLB deal with SF on July 2, 2025 after spending the first half of the year in the Tigers organization.
- ▶ Went 0-1 with a 3.91 ERA (11er, 25.1ip), 24 strikeouts and a 1.50 WHIP in 27 games (two starts) for the Giants last season.
- ▶ He's the first wearer of #93 in SF Giants history...#93 is the highest player-worn uniform number in SF-era history, passing No. 87 (worn by RHP Dan Otero in 2012).
- ▶ Originally was a 10th-round pick of the Giants in 2014 before his career journey brought him back to SF last season.

#45 CALEB KILIAN ▶ RHP

(kill-EE-en)

Pitch Arsenal: 4-Seam FB, Sinker, Slider, Curveball
Last Game: 4/3 vs. NYM; 0.1ip, k (5 pitches)

- ▶ Appeared in three games for SF (all lopsided losses) but has thrown 3.0 combined innings with no hits allowed, no walks and four strikeouts.
- ▶ Made his first career Opening Day roster after returning to the Giants organization on a minor league deal with a spring invite.
- ▶ Dealt with a right shoulder strain for most of the 2025 season while with the Cubs organization.
- ▶ During his rehab last season, he changed his diet to add more muscle and got his weight up to 215 pounds...he also tinkered with his mechanics after talking with roommate and former Giants farmhand Wil Jensen.
- ▶ Originally drafted by the Giants in the eighth round of the 2019 draft and was one of the organization's top prospects when he was dealt to the Cubs at the trade deadline in 2021 along with OF Alexander Canario in exchange for IF/OF Kris Bryant.

#68 ERIK MILLER ▶ LHP

Pitch Arsenal: Slider, 4 Seam FB, Sinker, Changeup
Last Game: 4/3 vs. NYM; 0.2ip, 2h, 2r, 2er, bb, k (26 pitches)

- ▶ Made his third career Opening Day roster (all with San Francisco).
- ▶ Has not allowed a homer in his last 47.2 innings dating to August 14, 2024, the sixth-longest active streak in MLB.
- ▶ Missed the beginning of camp with lower back tightness...made his first appearance on March 13...made four appearances total.
- ▶ Had a 1.02 ERA (2er, 17.2ip) in his final 21 outings last season (May 12-July 2) before hitting the injured list with a left elbow sprain on July 3...did not pitch for SF the rest of the year.
- ▶ Walked 20 batters in 30.0 innings in 2025 (15.6% walk rate).

#46 BLADE TIDWELL ▶ RHP

Pitch Arsenal: 4-Seam FB, Sinker, Sweeper, Slider, Splitter
Last Game: 4/2 vs. NYM; SV, 3.0ip, 2h, 2k (37 pitches)

- ▶ Recalled Thursday with RHP José Buttó being placed on the IL... logged his first career save in his Giants debut Thursday night pitching against the team that drafted him.
- ▶ Pitched one game for Triple-A Sacramento on March 29, drawing the start vs. El Paso while spinning 2.2 hitless/shutout innings.
- ▶ Played for Giants MGR Tony Vitello while at the Tennessee...is from Loretto, TN, which has a population of about 1,700 people.
- ▶ Was selected by the Mets in the second round of the 2022 Draft.
- ▶ Made his MLB debut with the Mets on May 4, 2025 at St. Louis as part of a doubleheader...pitched four total games with the Mets before being traded at last year's deadline alongside RHP José Buttó and OF Drew Gilbert in exchange for RHP Tyler Rogers.
- ▶ Went 6-4 with a 3.62 ERA (39er, 97.0ip) with 111 strikeouts over 21 games between Triple-A Sacramento and Triple-A Syracuse.

#74 RYAN WALKER ▶ RHP

Pitch Arsenal: Sinker, Slider
Last Game: 4/2 vs. NYM; 0.2ip, k (12 pitches)

- ▶ Made his third Opening Day roster (all with SF)...has appeared in four of SF's first eight games.
- ▶ In 24 save opportunities last season, he owned a 7.06 ERA (17er, 21.2ip)...in his 44 non-save situations games he had a 2.50 ERA (11er, 39.2ip)...has the most experience as a closer of any player in this current bullpen group.
- ▶ Last season, his 87.0 mph avg. exit velo ranked in top 7% of MLB.
- ▶ Enjoyed his best stretch of the 2025 season from July 4-September 3 where he posted a 1.64 ERA (4er, 22.0ip) in 23 games.

#67 KEATON WINN ▶ RHP

Pitch Arsenal: 4-Seam FB, 2-Seam FB, Splitter, Slider
Last Game: 3/30 at SD; 1.0ip, 3k (13 pitches)

- ▶ Has made three appearances and tossed 3.0-scoreless innings with six strikeouts.
- ▶ Made his second career Opening Day roster (also 2024 with SF).
- ▶ Spent most of the first half of 2025 on the injured list dealing with right shoulder tendinitis.
- ▶ Appeared in seven games with SF last season exclusively out of the pen, posting a 4.50 ERA (5er, 10.0ip) with nine strikeouts...prior to 2025, he had started 17 of his 21 games at the big league level.
- ▶ Overall, was 1-1 with a 8.49 ERA (22er, 23.1ip) in 14 games (three starts) with Triple-A Sacramento in 2025.

- ▶ Is 2-for-18 (.111) in five home games early on in 2026.
- ▶ Made his eighth Opening Day roster, second with the Giants.
- ▶ Last season became the first Giants player to reach 30 home runs in a season since **Barry Bonds** had 45 home runs in 2004...he became the first Giants infielder and right-handed hitter to reach 30 homers in a season since **Jeff Kent** (37 homers in 2002).
- ▶ Has 36 hits, 31 runs, eight doubles, eight homers, 25 RBI and an .806 OPS in 39 career games vs. the Mets.
- ▶ Led SF with 30 homers and 12 steals, becoming the first SS to lead the Giants in both categories in a season since **George Davis** in 1897.
- ▶ His 143 home runs as a shortstop since 2021 are most in the Majors ahead of NYM's Francisco Lindor (139).
- ▶ His 26 go-ahead RBI were fifth-most in the NL last season.

- ▶ Hit safely in six of his first eight games this season.
- ▶ Has a career .978 OPS and .409 batting average (38x93) vs. NYM.
