SNAKEBITES

RACE AGAINST CANCER 5K ON SEPT. 28: The D-backs’ 12th annual Race Against Cancer 5K presented by Dignity Health Cancer Institute and benefiting cancer research and patient care is on Sunday, September 28 at Chase Field...registration is now open at dbacks.com/race.

NL WILD CARD RACE: The D-backs — who trailed by 10.0 games in the NL Wild Card race on August 1 — are fifth, 1.0 game behind with the fourth-place Reds and 3.0 games behind the third-place Mets and 1.0 game ahead of the Giants (sixth, 4.0 GB).

SNAKE BITES: The D-backs are 5-3 in their last 8 games.

- Zac Gallen**, in his last 9 starts, since Aug. 2, is 5-2 with a 2.68 ERA (16 ER in 53.2 IP), an opponent .202 AVG (40-for-198)/.602 OPS, 14 walks and 42 strikeouts.
 - Has 1 start in each of the last 3 seasons vs. Phillies (1-0, 1.59 ERA, 3 ER in 17.0 IP, .194 AVG, 12 H, 5 BB, 13 K).
- Geraldo Perdomo** has a 9-game hitting streak, since Sept. 9, batting .419 (13-for-31)/1.346 OPS with 3 doubles, 1 triple, 2 homers, 6 RBI, 8 walks and 3 hit by pitches.
- The D-backs are 13-8 in their last 21 games, featuring a trio of 4-game win streaks: Aug. 27-30 @ Brewers and Dodgers, Sept. 2-6 vs. Rangers and Red Sox, and Sept. 13-16 @ Twins and vs. Giants.

LAST GAME: The D-backs lost 8-2 vs. Phillies.

- Ryne Nelson** worked 5.0 innings with 2 runs (5 H, 2 BB, 1 K).
- Ketel Marte** was 3-for-4 with a double and solo homer...is the fourth D-back with 3 straight seasons of 25+ homers, joining Luis Gonzalez (1999-2003), Mark Reynolds (2008-10) and Christian Walker (2022-24).
- Philip Abner**, the team’s first call-up from the 2023 draft class, made his Major League debut with 0.2 scoreless innings (4 BF, 1 H, 1 BB, 2 K)...his first batter faced and first strikeout was Kyle Schwarber.

TO BE THE BEST...: The D-backs’ .563 remaining strength of schedule is the hardest in the Majors ahead of the Cardinals (.552), Twins (.549), Marlins (.547) and Red Sox (.545).

THE RESURGENCE: Since August 1, the D-backs’ 26-19 (.578) record is third in the NL and tied for sixth in the Majors: Phillies (31-15, .675), Brewers (30-16, .652), Guardians (28-17, .652), Mariners (27-17, .614), Athletics (25-18, .581), **D-backs (26-19, .578)**, Yankees (26-19, .578).

DEFENSE RULES (h/t FIELDING BIBLE): **Blaze Alexander’s** 10 defensive runs saved (DRS) lead the team, ahead of Corbin Carroll (7 DRS) and Tim Tawa (7)...for context, the Major’s Top 3 are Ceddane Rafaela/BOS (22), Ernie Clement/TOR (20) and Patrick Bailey/SF (20).

- Alexander’s 10 DRS are tied for the most the last 2 seasons with 2024’s Gabriel Moreno (10), Geraldo Perdomo (10), Ketel Marte (10) and Kevin Newman (10).
- 2023’s Top 3 were Gabriel Moreno (20), Lourdes Gurriel, Jr. (13) and Christian Walker (9).

VS. NL EAST: **Corbin Carroll** has reached base safely in 13 straight games vs. NL East teams, since May 1, batting .306 (15-for-49)/1.034 OPS, 2 doubles, 4 home runs, 9 RBI and 9 walks.

- Geraldo Perdomo** has reached base safely in 38 of his last 41 games vs. NL East, since July 29, 2024, batting .305 (46-for-151)/.863 OPS with 10 doubles, 5 homers, 30 RBI and 24 walks.

HOME SWEET HOME: **Corbin Carroll** has hit safely in 8 straight games at a .393 clip (11-for-28)/1.149 with 3 doubles, 1 triple, 1 homer, 5 RBI and 5 walks.

- James McCann** has hit safely in 5 of his last 7 home games (.320 AVG, 8-for-25, .800 OPS).
- Ildemaro Vargas** has hit safely in 4 of his last 5 home games (.357 AVG, 5-for-14, .946 OPS, 1 BB).

VS. PHILLIES: The D-backs are 9-6 at home vs. Phillies since 2021, including taking 3 of 4 last Aug. 8-11.

- Geraldo Perdomo** has reached base safely in 8 of his 9 last games vs. Phillies, hitting .438 (14-for-32)/1.079 OPS with 5 doubles, 4 RBI, 3 walks and 3 stolen bases.
 - Has reached base safely in 8 straight home games vs. Phillies (.448 AVG, 13-for-29, 1.086 OPS, 3 BB).
- Gabriel Moreno**, since June 15, 2023, has reached base safely in 6 straight games vs. Phillies (.444 AVG, 8-for-18, 1.167 OPS, 1 BB).
- Corbin Carroll**, since Aug. 9, 2024, has reached base safely in 7 straight games vs. Phillies (.286, 8-for-28, .833 OPS, 1BB).

START ME UP: The D-backs starting rotation is among the best in the Majors since Aug. 27, ranking tied for first with 13 quality starts, tied for second with 10 starters wins, third with a 2.73 ERA and 41 runs allowed, fifth with an opponent .636 OPS and 122.0 innings.

GABI DISHIN’ IT: **Gabriel Moreno** has reached base safely in 9 straight games, hitting .364 (12-for-33)/1.094 OPS with 2 doubles, 2 homers, 6 RBI and 8 walks.

SERIES-LY SPEAKING: The D-backs are 7-1-1 in their last 8 series, since Aug. 18, and 10-3-1 in their last 14 series, since Aug. 1.

HOME SWEET HOME: The D-backs’ 6 straight home series wins, since Aug. 8, are tied for the third-longest streak in club history (also: May 23-July 8, 2003 and May 1-24, 2006) behind 7 straight (Aug. 8-Sept. 25, 2011) and 8 straight (Aug. 3-Oct. 4, 2001).

1 OF 10: **Corbin Carroll** (30 2B, 17 3B, 30 HR) is the 10th player (12th time) in Major League history to reach 30+ doubles, 15+ triples and 30+ homers in a season:

Babe Ruth (1921), Lou Gehrig (1927), Jim Bottomley (1928), Lou Gehrig (1930), Al Simmons (1930), Lou Gehrig (1931), Chuck Klein (1932), Hank Greenberg (1935), Joe DiMaggio (1937), Stan Musial (1948), Jimmy Rollins (2007), **Corbin Carroll (2025)**

- The only players to reach 30 doubles, 20 triples and 30 homers are Jim Bottomley (1928) and Jimmy Rollins (2007).

YEAR OF THE SNAKE: **Geraldo Perdomo’s** 6.7 bWAR (Baseball-Reference.com) leads NL position players and are second in the Majors to Aaron Judge/NYY (8.6) and ahead of Cal Raleigh/SEA (6.7), Julio Rodríguez/SEA (6.4), Shohei Ohtani/LAD (6.3) and Bobby Witt Jr./KC (6.3).

- Perdomo’s** 6.7 fWAR (FanGraphs.com) is second in the NL to Shohei Ohtani/LAD (7.1) and ahead of Trea Turner/PHI (6.7) and Corbin Carroll/AZ (6.2).

DYNAMIC DUO: **Geraldo Perdomo** (19 HR, 26 SB) and **Corbin Carroll** (30 HR, 29 SB) look to become the seventh teammates in baseball history with 20+-HR, 30+-SB seasons.

CC7 FUN: **Corbin Carroll** (30 HR, 29 SB) is looking to become the first D-back with a 30+-HR/30+-SB season.

- His 77 extra-base hits are fourth in the Majors to Shohei Ohtani/LAD (84), Aaron Judge/NYY (79) and Cal Raleigh/SEA (78) and ahead of with Kyle Schwarber/PHI (76) and Pete Alonso/NYM (75).

NEXT STARTER: LHP EDUARDO RODRIGUEZ (8-8, 5.12)

- On May 4 @ Phillies, did not figure in the 11-9 win in 11 innings (5.1 IP, 4 R-3 ER, 5 H, 4 BB, 10 K).
- Has 4 career starts vs. Phillies (1-1, 3.52 ERA).

AT A GLANCE: Seventh season with the D-backs.

- D-backs' Most Valuable Pitcher by the Arizona BBWAA the last 3 seasons (2022-24) and 4 of the last 5 seasons (2020, '22-'24).
- 2023 NL All-Star starting pitcher.
- Finished in Top 5 in NL Cy Young Voting in 2023 (3rd) and 2022 (5th).

WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW: Has quality starts in 7 of his last 9 starts, going 5-2 with a 2.68 ERA (16 ER in 53.2 IP), opponent .202 AVG (40-for-198)/.602 OPS, 14 walks and 42 strikeouts.

- Is 4.0 innings shy of eclipsing 1000.0 career...would become the fourth starting pitcher who debuted in 2019 to reach 1,000.0+ career innings, joining Logan Webb/SF, Dylan Cease/SD and Merrill Kelly/AZ-TEX.
- Among NL starting pitchers since July 1, his 83.2 innings are sixth (leader is Cristopher Sánchez/PHI at 95.2 IP).
- In 3 career home games vs. Phillies, is 2-0 with a 0.55 ERA (1 ER in 16.1 IP), opponent .148 AVG (8for-54), 0.86 WHIP, 6 walks and 16 strikeouts.
- Has tossed 6.0+ innings in 6 straight starts, 10 of his last 11 starts and 12 of his last 14 starts.
- His 64 wins are third in franchise history, ahead of Merrill Kelly (62) and behind Brandon Webb (87) and Randy Johnson (118).

LAST START: Had a quality start on Sept. 15 vs. Giants, his seventh in his last 9 starts, allowing 1 run in 6.0 innings on 2 hits and 1 walk with 6 strikeouts in the D-backs’ 8-1 win.

- Recorded his 1,000th strikeout as a D-back in the first inning (W. Adames looking).

VS. PHILLIES: Seventh career start, fourth @ Chase Field.

- Took a no decision in his last start on Aug. 10 @ Chase Field, allowing 1 run on 5 hits and 2 walks with 3 strikeouts over 4.1 innings.
- Started 2023 NLCS Game 1 @ Phillies (L; 5 ER in 5.0 IP) and 2023 NLCS Game 5 vs. Phillies (L; 4 ER in 6.0 IP).

1,000TH K AS A D-BACK: Became the third D-backs pitcher to reach 1,000 strikeouts...his 1,005 strikeouts currently rank third in franchise history, behind Randy Johnson (2,077) and Brandon Webb (1,065).

- Recorded his 1,000th career strikeout on July 21 vs. Astros in the fourth inning (Brice Matthews swinging).
- Second pitcher to debut in 2019 and reach 1,000+ career strikeouts, joining Dylan Cease (source: Elias Sports Bureau).
- Among all pitchers since 2019, his 1,048 strikeouts are tied for 11th with Freddy Peralta/MIL...Top 3 are Zack Wheeler/PHI (1,289), Aaron Nola/PHI (1,266) and Gerritt Cole/NYY (1,241)...teammate Corbin Burnes/AZ (1,079) is 10th.

10+ WINS: Is 1 of 4 D-backs to have 4+ consecutive 10+-win seasons with Randy Johnson (1999-2002), Brandon Webb (2005-08) and Zack Greinke (2016-19).

5.0+ INNINGS: Has pitched at least 5.0 innings in 28 straight starts (since April 13), the second-longest streak in the Majors this season, behind Bryan Woo/SEA (30 games) and ahead of Jacob deGrom/TEX (26).

- The franchise record is 35 straight games by Randy Johnson (4x - April 5-Sept. 30, 1999, April 3-Oct. 2, 2001, April 1-Sept. 26, 2002 and April 6-Oct. 2, 2004) and Curt Schilling (April 2-Sept. 5, 2022) followed by Brandon Webb with 34 games (April 2-Sept. 28, 2007), 33 games (April 6-Oct. 2, 2005) and 32 games (April 3-Sept. 26, 2006), Joe Saunders with 31 games (April 16-Sept. 28, 2011) and Merrill Kelly with 29 games (April 6-Sept. 30, 2023).

VS. NL EAST: In his last 6 starts vs. NL East opponents, is 4-1 with a 2.04 ERA (10 R-8 ER in 35.1 IP), opponent .177 AVG (23-for-130), 0.99 WHIP, 12 walks and 33 strikeouts.

- In 15 home starts (7 quality), is 7-4 with a 2.47 ERA (26 R-24 ER in 87.1 IP), opponent .212 AVG (68-for-321) and 89 strikeouts.
- In 14 of his 15 home starts, has allowed 3 or fewer runs.
- In 12 of 15 starts, has walked 2 or fewer batters, including 1 walk allowed in 7 of his last 12 starts.

AT HOME: In his last 7 home starts (6 quality), is 4-2 with a 2.72 ERA (14 R-13 ER in 43.0 IP), opponent .196 AVG (31-for-158), 0.88 WHIP, 7 walks and 43 strikeouts.

VS. RIGHTIES: In his last 10 starts, is holding righties to a .188 AVG (21-for-112)/.570 OPS with 8 walks and 29 strikeouts.

VS. LEFTIES: In his last 6 starts, is holding lefties to a .159 AVG (11-for-69)/.517 OPS with 6 walks and 16 strikeouts.

INNING BREAKDOWN: In his last 8 starts, in innings 3-6, has a 2.32 ERA (8 ER in 31.0 IP) with an opponent .156 AVG (17-for-109)/.512 OPS, 5 walks and 23 strikeouts.

- Is scoreless in 17 of his last 20 outings, is 3-0 with a 1.50 ERA (3 ER in 18.0 IP), an opponent .167 AVG (10-for-60) and 0.83 WHIP (10 H, 5 BB).
- Vs. lefties since Aug. 1, is holding opponents to a .214 AVG (3-for-14) with 0 walks and 1 strikeout.
- Has allowed just 1 home run in his last 21 games (74 BF).
- His 48.4 ground ball percentage ranks seventh by a D-backs relievers in a season since 2021 (min. 50 G)...best marks were Ryan Thompson in 2024 (62.7) and Justin Martinez in 2024 (60.3).
