LEAVING THE HOMESTAND BEHIND: The Orioles wrapped up their first homestand of the season yesterday, dropping both games of the doubleheader to the Mariners and falling to 1-6 in the seven-game stretch...Their lowest winning percentage (.143) in a homestand since also going 1-6 from 9/5-12/2019 vs. TEX and vs. LAD.

⚡ During the homestand, the Orioles slashed .207/.297/.385 (43-for-208) and averaged 4.1 runs per game, while the pitching staff posted a 6.32 ERA (40 ER/57.0 IP).

LIFE ON THE ROAD: The Orioles begin their second road trip of the season tonight, with three games scheduled for Texas and two in Miami...Entering play today, the O's four road wins are tied for the fourth-most in the American League...Seven AL teams currently have a better winning percentage on the road than at home, including Baltimore.

⚡ Among pitchers who have made at least two starts on the road, **LHP John Means'** 0.77 ERA (1 ER/11.2 IP) ranks as the second-lowest in the AL.

⚡ **OF Cedric Mullins** has 12 hits in six road games, the second-most hits on the road in the AL.

WELCOME TO TEXAS: The Orioles and Rangers square off for the first time since September 2019 and first time in Texas since June of 2019; this will be the first series the Orioles have played at Globe Life Field.

⚡ The Orioles are 2-8 in their last 10 games against the Rangers.

⚡ **C Pedro Severino** is a career .357/.438/1.071 (5-for-14) hitter against the Rangers in five career games, including a career-high three home runs on 6/4/19 in Texas.

⚡ **LHP John Means** has made two career starts against the Rangers, posting a 2.13 ERA (3 ER/12.2 IP); has tossed a Quality Start in both of these appearances.

SETTING THE TABLE: **OF Cedric Mullins** saw his 15-game hitting streak, dating back to last season, snapped in yesterday's first game of the doubleheader...Mullins still leads the O's in batting average, hits, doubles, on-base percentage, slugging percentage, and OPS.

⚡ Mullins has led off each game this season, and has gone 6-for-13 in his first at-bats of the game; has gone 11-for-23 when leading off any inning, with his 11 hits leading all of baseball in this category.

⚡ Mullins has gone 7-for-18 (.389) against left-handed pitching to start the season; in Spring Training, he became a full-time left-handed hitter after switch hitting his entire professional career.

HITTING IT HARD: **INF Maikel Franco** has recorded five at-bats with exit velocities of 110+ MPH this season, recording a single (111.4 MPH), ground out (111.3 MPH), home run (111.2 MPH), double (111.0 MPH), and double (110.1 MPH), respectively in these instances...The rest of the O's have a combined four at-bats in which the batted ball resulted in 110+ MPH exit velocities.

⚡ Franco has started each game this season for the O's (11 at third base and two as the DH)...He's started in 78-straight games, dating back to 9/24/19 G2 at WSH.

⚡ Franco has drawn as many walks (7) as times he's struck out this season (7); he's one of two O's to have done so (Stewart 5 walks and 5 strikeouts); his seven walks lead the O's and his .321 OBP ranks third on the team.

HOPING TO CATCH A BREAK: **INF/OF Trey Mancini** has started the season hitting .163... According to *Statcast*, his expected batting average is .262, a -0.099 difference the largest on the Orioles and the sixth-largest difference in the AL.

⚡ Each of Mancini's last three hits have been home runs (4/10 vs. BOS, 4/11 vs. BOS, 4/15 vs. SEA G1).

⚡ Two of Mancini's home runs have been hit with an exit velocity of 110+ MPH (4/10 vs. BOS - 111.9 MPH and 4/15 vs. SEA G1 - 110.3 MPH)

⚡ Mancini's six barreled balls are tied for the sixth-most in the AL

SWINGING AWAY: The Orioles enter play today at 50.2% pitches taken as a team (1858 total pitches/933 pitches taken), the second-lowest percentage in the AL...They have swung and missed 29.9% of the time (277 missed swings/925 total swings), the third-highest percentage in the AL.

⚡ Among qualifiers, **OF Anthony Santander** ranks as the fourth-lowest in the AL among pitches taken at 42.5%; Santander has drawn two walks in 48 plate appearances.

⚡ Santander is swinging at 50.0% of his first pitches of an at-bat, tied for the fourth-highest in the AL, while **OF Cedric Mullins** is swinging at just 14.5% of first pitches in his at-bats, the 12th-lowest percentage in the AL.

CALL TO THE 'PEN:

⚡ **RHP César Valdez** has allowed a .243 opponent slugging percentage since joining the Orioles on August 29 last season (14 games); this is the second-lowest opponent slugging percentage by an AL pitcher in this stretch (min. 20.0 IP).

⚡ **RHP Adam Plutko** has worked 8.1 innings in relief, posting a 2.16 ERA (2 ER/8.1 IP)... his innings out of the bullpen are tied for the fourth-most in the AL.

LOOKING AT THE ROSTER: Here is how the current Orioles 40-man roster was put together (currently have 42 with **INF Chris Davis** and **RHP Hunter Harvey** on the 60-day IL)...13 players were originally drafted by the Orioles...11 were acquired via a trade...Eight players were claimed off waivers...Four were selected in the Rule 5 Draft...Three signed as Major League free agents, two originally signed as minor league free agents and had their contracts selected, and one signed as an International free agent.

LAST START: Suffered his second-consecutive loss of the season in as many starts on 4/11 vs. Boston...Allowed seven runs on eight hits and one walk with four strikeouts through 4.0 innings of his first home start of the year.

QUICK HITS: Is looking to snap a four-game losing streak dating back to last season, his last win came on 9/14/20 vs. Atlanta...Claimed off waivers from Kansas City on 8/9/20 and made his Orioles debut on 8/16/20 vs. Washington...Made just one appearance with the Royals on 7/26/20 at Cleveland...Started as a reliever with Baltimore before moving to the rotation on 8/30/20...Originally selected in the second round of the 2011 First-Year Player Draft by the Milwaukee Brewers.

CAREER VS. TEXAS: Has made one career start against the Rangers, taking the loss on 5/15/19 while with Kansas City...Tossed 5.2 innings and allowed five runs on seven hits and two walks with seven strikeouts...The seven punch-outs are his most against any AL West opponent.

AGAINST THE AL WEST: López last faced an AL West foe on 9/17/19 at Oakland...Is 0-3 in seven career appearances (five starts), and has pitched to a 8.42 ERA (24 ER/25.2 IP) with 11 walks, and 24 strikeouts.

STARTING STRONG: Has made 35 career starts, going 8-17 and pitching to a 6.63 ERA (124 ER/168.1 IP) with 58 walks and 133 strikeouts...López owns a 6.49 ERA (57 ER/79.0 IP) in 16 career starts at home, compared to a 6.75 ERA (67 ER/89.1 IP) in 19 road starts...As a starter, opponents have hit .295 (198-for-671) against him...Started a career-high 18 games for Kansas City in 2019.

WHAT A RELIEF: López is 1-2 in 36 career games as a reliever, owning a 5.24 ERA (40 ER/68.2 IP) with 28 walks and 61 strikeouts...Has held batters to a .277 opponents' average (74-for-267)...Earned his only career save on 8/25/19 at Cleveland, ending the 10th frame with an inning of scoreless relief with two strikeouts...Holds a 6.53 ERA (29 ER/40.0 IP) in 20 relief appearances at home, compared to a 3.45 ERA (11 ER/28.2 IP) in 16 games on the road.

SPRING TRAINING: Owned a 0-1 record with a 2.75 ERA (6 ER/19.2 IP), seven walks, and 17 strikeouts through six games (three starts) during 2021 Spring Training...His longest outing of the Spring was his final start on 3/26 at NYY, where he tossed 5.0 scoreless innings with two hits, one walk, and three strikeouts...Struck out five during a one-hit, scoreless, 3.0 innings of relief on 3/16 vs. TB.

2020 HIGHLIGHTS: Went 2-2 with a 6.34 ERA (27 ER/38.1 IP), 12 walks, and 28 strikeouts in nine games (six starts) for the Orioles...Pitched to a 6.14 ERA (20 ER/29.1 IP) with nine walks and 20 strikeouts in the starts alone...Did not earn a decision in any of his relief appearances...Earned his first win as an Oriole on 9/4 vs. NYY (G2), and his first victory since 9/12/19 vs. Chicago-AL...In his start on 9/14 vs. ATL, López became the first Orioles pitcher to toss at least 7.0 innings in a game last season...Led Baltimore hurlers with 30 runs allowed (27 earned), and ranked third in innings pitched (38.1) and hits allowed (43).

Kremer will be facing the Rangers for the first time in his career...Has faced the AL West just once, in his last start on 4/13 vs. SEA (G2); Did not factor in the decision after tossing 3.0 innings, allowing four runs on four hits and one walk with three strikeouts...Gave up his first-career home run on 4/6 at New York-AL...Made his MLB debut on 9/6/20 vs. NYY, where he earned the win after allowing just one run on one hit and three walks with seven strikeouts through 6.0 innings of work...Kremer started all five 2021 Spring Training games he appeared in, going 0-1 with a 6.32 ERA (11 ER/15.2 IP) with eight walks and 16 strikeouts.
