Three-Hit Loss

Four Atlanta pitchers combined to allow just three hits last night, but Atlanta fell to New York, 3-2 in 10 innings.

The loss was the first for the Braves when they allowed no more than three hits in over two years, dating to a 1-0, three-hit loss to the Cubs on June 17, 2022.

Last night's game went 10 innings, and the loss was the first this century for Atlanta when allowing no more than three hits in an extra-inning game. The club last lost such a contest on October 2, 1999, allowing just two hits in a 10-inning, 1-0 loss to Florida.

TONIGHT'S GAME: The Braves and Mets tonight continue a four-game weekend series with what is the eighth of 13 total games between the teams this season...The two meet for the final time for a three-game set at Truist Park in Atlanta, September 24-26, in the Braves final homestand of the season.

- A* The Mets walked off with an extra-inning win over the Braves last night, and Atlanta is 3-4 in seven total games versus New York this year...New York was the first team to take a series from Atlanta this season, winning two-of-three games at Truist Park, April 8-11.
- A* Atlanta went 10-3 in 13 games with New York last season, a .769 winning percentage...Since the Mets were founded in 1962, the best single-season winning percentage the Braves have logged against New York is .778, going 14-4 in 18 games with the Mets in both 1964 and 1966.
- A* The Braves have won 19 of the last 27 games with New York dating to the 2022 season, outscoring the Mets 168-112 (+56) over the stretch.
- A* The Braves have taken the season series from their NL East rivals for six consecutive seasons...Prior to last year's 10-3 mark, they went 10-9 in both 2022 & 2021, 7-3 in 2020, 11-8 in 2019 and 13-6 in 2018...Since the start of the 2018 season, Atlanta is 64-42 (.604) against New York overall.
- A* The Braves won the first series between the clubs at Citi Field this season, two-games-to-one... Atlanta went 5-2 against New York here last season, including a 21-3 victory in the first game of a doubleheader here, August 12.
- A* RH Charlie Morton is set for his 25th career appearance against New York and his 24th start... The 6-foot-5, 215-pound right-hander is 7-6 with a 3.58 ERA (52 ER/130.2 IP) in his career versus New York, including two starts earlier this season... The New Jersey native last faced the Mets on May 10 here at Citi Field, and allowed just three hits and one run over 7.0 innings to earn the win.
- A* RH Kodai Senga is set to make his 2024 season debut and the second of his career versus Atlanta... The 6-foot-1, 202-pound native of Aichi, Japan, beat the Braves in his lone career start against them, August 13 of last year, allowing four hits and three runs over 6.0 innings...The right-hander went 12-7 with a 2.98 ERA over 29 starts in his rookie season last year, but has missed the entirety of this season with a right shoulder capsule strain.

LOSS: New York walked off with a 3-2 win in 10 innings last night, and each of Atlanta's last two games in this park have ended in walk-off defeats.

- A* Brandon Nimmo clubbed a walk-off, two-run homer in the ninth to give the Mets a win, 4-3, over the Braves on May 12.
- A* The Braves fell to 7-4 in extra-inning games this season, and last night's defeat stopped a three-game winning streak in such games.

CORNER INFIELD: 1B Matt Olson and 3B Austin Riley combined for four of Atlanta's seven hits last night, including a double by Riley for the club's lone extra-base hit.

- A* Olson and Riley have each collected multi-hit games 35 times as teammates, and last night's loss was just the 13th defeat for Atlanta in such games.
- A* Since Atlanta acquired Olson prior to the 2022 season, no corner infielder in baseball has a higher OPS (.840) than the Braves...The Dodgers, with an .829 OPS from their first and third basemen, rank second.
- A* Atlanta's corner infielders lead all of baseball with 189 homers since the 2022 season, 36 more than any other combo, rank third in runs scored (545) and RBI (519) and fourth in doubles (187).
- A* Last night was Riley's first game since being reinstated from the paternity list, after he and his wife Anna welcomed their second child, William "Beau" Riley, on Tuesday morning...He has batted .258/.327/.455 over 87 games on the season, including a .322/.391/.669 line over his last 34 games dating to June 14.
- A* Olson also had two hits on Wednesday afternoon, and has back-to-back multi-hit games for the fifth time this season...He last had such a run with three straight multi-hit efforts, June 14-16...He is 4-for-his-last-9 in the last two games, after going 4-for-46 over his previous 12 contests.

MORTON'S CURVEBALL: Charlie Morton has thrown 701 curveballs this season, the most by a pitcher in baseball...He utilizes the pitch 41.2% of the time, the highest by a starter in the majors.

- A* The Mets as a club are batting .247 versus curveballs this season, the fifth-best team average against the pitch in baseball...New York's 72 hits against the pitch are tied with Baltimore for most in the majors, and their 11 homers off curves are tied for fourth.
- A* Morton's curveball has a run value of seven, making it the third-most valuable curveball in baseball... Only Aaron Nola (9) and Corbin Burnes (8) have a higher mark on the pitch.
- A* The right-hander has 64 strikeouts via curveball this season, fewer than just Nola (66) on the pitch across the majors...Since rejoining the Braves prior to the 2021 season, Morton's 437 strikeouts via curveball are 95 more than any other pitcher.

BIG FOUR: Charlie Morton goes for Atlanta tonight, after Chris Sale provided 7.1 innings of two-run baseball in the start last night...Morton, Sale, Reynaldo López and Max Fried have combined to go 32-17 with a 2.93 ERA in 73 starts for the Braves this season.

- A* Atlanta is 44-29 in games started by these four.
- A* All other pitchers who have started for the Braves this season have a combined record of 4-15 with a 6.63 ERA in 28 games, and Atlanta is 10-18 as a club.

Today's Game

- Set to make his 19th start of the season and third against New York (NL) this year.
 - Scattered three hits over 7.0 innings of one-run ball with seven strikeouts in his last outing against the Mets in Queens earlier this season.
 - Owens a 2.97 career ERA at Citi Field.
- Held St. Louis to one unearned run over 6.0 frames in his last start.
- Morton recorded his 100th strikeout of the year in his last outing against the Cardinals; joining Hall-of-Famers Phil Niekro, John Smoltz, and Warren Spahn along with R.A. Dickey as the only pitchers in franchise history to do so in a single season at age 40 or older.
- Has made 112 starts since joining Atlanta's staff in 2021; the fourth most in the National league during that span...Trails only Aaron Nola, Patrick Corbin and Logan Webb...Pitching to a 3.82 ERA during that span.
- Joined Justin Verlander, Clayton Kershaw and Max Scherzer as the only active pitchers with at least 15 starts in 14 different seasons.
- Pitching to a 6.00 ERA in the first inning this season.
 - Sporting a combined 3.38 ERA in all other innings.
- Batters are hitting a combined .185 against Morton's curveball and changeup.
 - Conversely hitting a combined .296 against his four-seamer, sinker and cutter.
- Morton is averaging 8.8 strikeouts per nine innings this season...Only Hall-of-Famers John Smoltz, Nolan Ryan and Randy Johnson along with Roger Clemens, Luis Tiant and Orlando Hernández had higher K/9 rates through a season at age 40 or older.
- His 170 quality starts are the seventh most among active pitchers...teammate Chris Sale ranks fifth with 180.
- His 2063.2 innings pitched are the fourth most among active pitchers.
 - Trails only Justin Verlander, Max Scherzer and Clayton Kershaw.
- Struckout Wyatt Langford to reach 1,900 on his career.
 - Morton's 1,981 strikeout are the eighth most among active players.
- Throwing his curveball on 41.2% of pitches; the highest rate in the majors among qualified starters.
 - Morton has struck out 461 hitters with his curveball since the beginning of the 2020; easily the most in the majors.
- Morton has recorded 705 strikeouts since joining Atlanta's staff in 2021, the seventh most in baseball.
 - His rate of 10.16 strikeouts per nine innings is also the sixth highest in the majors during that span among qualified pitchers.

2024 Recap

- With his victory against Pittsburgh on June 28, Morton has recorded a win against all 30 major league clubs over the course of his 17-year MLB career...Since baseball's most recent expansion in 1998 (Arizona and Tampa Bay), he's the 22nd pitcher to accomplish the feat and fourth active, joining Texas' Max Scherzer, New York's (AL) Gerrit Cole and Houston's Justin Verlander...Randy Johnson is the only Hall-of-Famer to have done so.
- Is the 10th pitcher in franchise history to record at least five wins in a season at age 40 or older and first since R.A. Dickey in 2017.
- With his first start this season, Morton became the seventh player in Braves franchise history to pitch for the club in his 20's, 30's and 40's...Joins Hall-of-Famers Warren Spahn, Phil Niekro, Tom Glavine and John Smoltz along with teammate Jesse Chavez and Dick Rudolph.
- Morton became the 13th player in franchise history to start a game at age 40 or older.
 - Prior to Morton, the last Braves pitcher to start a game over the age of 40 was R.A. Dickey in 2017.
 - Six of the 12 other pitchers have been selected into the Hall of Fame (Tom Glavine, Phil Niekro, Gaylord Perry, John Smoltz, Warren Spahn and Cy Young).
- At 40 years, 167 days-old in his start against Cleveland on April 17, became the fifth Braves pitcher over the age of 40, in the Atlanta-era (since 1966), to toss at least 7.0 scoreless frames, joining Hall-of-Famers Phil Niekro (11x) and John Smoltz (3x), along with Dennis Martínez and R.A. Dickey.
- Morton and Chris Sale become the first pair of teammates to have each made an Opening Day start and record the last out of a World Series since Hall-of-Famer Dennis Eckersley and Cy Young award-winner Bret Saberhagen with Boston in 1998. (Research courtesy of Elias Sports Bureau)
 - Morton was the Opening Day starter for Tampa Bay in 2020 and induced a groundout from Corey Seager for the final out in Game 7 of the 2017 World Series with Houston.
 - Sale was the Opening Day starter for the Red Sox (2018-'19) and the White Sox (2013, '14 & '16)...He struck out Manny Machado in Game 5 as the final out of the 2018 Fall Classic with Boston.

- A 16-year major league veteran, entered the 2024 season with a 130-113 record and a 4.00 ERA across 353 games, 352 starts...Fanned 1,880 and pitched three shutouts.
 - Has pitched for Atlanta (2008, '21-23), Pittsburgh (2009-15), Philadelphia (2016), Houston (2017-18) and Tampa Bay (2019-20).
 - Is a two-time All-Star (2018 & 2019) and won the 2017 World Series while with Houston and 2021 World Series with Atlanta.

- **Has yet to allow a barreled ball this season (Statcast)...He's the only pitcher in baseball with at least 100 batters faced and no barrels allowed.**
- Opponents are hitting ground balls off him 56% of the time (league average 43%)...Ranks in the 93rd percentile.
- Was acquired by Atlanta from Chicago on November 16, 2023, in exchange for INF Braden Shewmake, LHP Jared Shuster, INF Nicky Lopez, RHP Michael Soroka and minor-league RHP Riley Gowens.

Jesse Chavez • RHP • 6-1 • 175 • 40 yrs • #60

Saves/Opp: 0/0 **Holds:** 0 **1st Batter/Retired:** 32/17 **Inherited Runners/Scored:** 17/3

- **With RISP, opposing batters are hitting just .068 (3-for-44) off him, which is best in Major League Baseball (min. 40 BF with RISP).**
- Just three of Chavez's 17 inherited runners have scored, the sixth-best percentage (17.6%) in the National League (min. 15 IR).
- Among pitchers with 150 appearances for the Braves in the Atlanta era (since 1966), Chavez's ERA (2.80) ranks eighth behind Craig Kimbrel (1.43), Jonny Venters (2.62), John Rocker (2.63), Greg Maddux (2.63), Mike Remlinger (2.74), Luis Avilán (2.77) and Peter Moylan (2.80...).
- By Run Value, Chavez owns the third most valuable cutter (12 RV) in baseball among both starters and relievers... Emmanuel Clase (CLE, 16) and Garrett Crochet (CWS, 13) are the only pitchers ahead of him...Using the cutter as his primary fastball, Chavez throws the pitch on 52% of his offerings.
- Among the 31 MLB pitchers aged 36-or-older (min. 10 games), Chavez owns the second-best ERA in the National League and third-best in MLB (1.83)...Texas' Kirby Yates (1.22) and Los Angeles' Daniel Hudson (1.49) are the only players to lead him in that regard.
- Reached 1,000 career strikeouts on June 10...Among active primary relievers, his 1,019 strikeouts rank sixth.
- From 2021-present, owns a 2.12 ERA (39 ER/165.2 IP) as a Brave...With other clubs during that period (TEX, CHC, LAA), has pitched to a 7.16 ERA (13 ER/16.1 IP).
- On March 30 was credited with his 50th career win (50-63)...Eleven of those wins have come with Atlanta, second-most of any of his major league clubs (Oakland, 17).

Daysbel Hernández • RHP • 5-10 • 220 • 27 yrs • #62

- All nine of his major league outings have been scoreless this season.
- This season, has pitched to a 2.48 ERA (8 ER/29.0 IP) across 17 relief outings with Triple-A Gwinnett.
- Has posted a 11.17 K/9 at Triple-A this season.
- Earned the win in his MLB debut on July 23 2023 in Milwaukee...Prior to that, the last Atlanta reliever to earn a win in his MLB debut was Jesse Biddle, who beat the New York Mets on April 21, 2018.
- Missed the entire 2022 season due to UCL reconstruction surgery.

Grant Holmes • RHP • 6-0 • 226 • 28 yrs • #66

Saves/Opp: 0/0 **Holds:** 0 **1st Batter/Retired:** 10/7 **Inherited Runners/Scored:** 7/2

- On June 16, pitched 3.0 scoreless innings with two strikeouts and no walks in his major league debut...Holmes is just the second Brave to pitch to those parameters in his major league debut in the Atlanta era (since 1966)... He joined Manny Bañuelos, who did it in a starting nod on July 2, 2015...Just three other pitchers have done it in franchise history.
- Among International League pitchers, his 2.63 ERA ranked fourth at the time of his call-up (min. 40 IP).
- Signed with the Braves organization as a minor league free agent on August 13, 2022.
- Was originally drafted by the Los Angeles Dodgers in the first round (22nd overall) of the 2014 MLB draft...Was traded to the Oakland Athletics on August 1, 2016, along with Frankie Montas and Jharel Cotton in exchange for Rich Hill and Josh Reddick...Holmes was released by Oakland on July 28, 2022.
