**TONIGHT'S TILT...**the Mariners play the first of a 3-game series against the Washington Nationals as the final leg of the road trip...Seattle previously saw the Orioles (2-2) and Tigers (1-2) on the trip...following an off day on Monday, the Mariners will return to T-Mobile Park for a 6-game homestand against the Orioles (3 G, June 16-18) and Red Sox (3 G, June 19-21)...tonight's game against the Nationals will be televised and streamed live on **Mariners.TV** with **Aaron Goldsmith** and **Ryan Rowland-Smith** on the call, with **Brad Adam** serving as field reporter...the game will also be broadcast live on **Seattle Sports (710 AM)** with **Gary Hill Jr.** and **Shannon Drayer** on the call.

**ODDS & ENDS...**the Mariners fell to the Orioles by a 7-5 score last night, splitting the 4-game series 2-2... despite the loss, Seattle is 11-5 (.688) since May 25, tied for the 3rd best record in MLB during that span (also: Dodgers and Brewers).

- **Best In The West** - The Mariners (36-34) are in first place in the American League West Division, 1.0 game ahead of the second place Rangers (34-34).
- **Mamma Mia, Dom!** - In 10 games to begin June, **Dominic Canzone** is batting .393 (11x28) with 5 runs, 2 doubles, 2 home runs and 3 RBI, reaching base at a .414 clip and slugging .679 for a 1.093 OPS in 29 plate appearances.

★**BE A STAR: VOTE MARINERS**★...voting is underway for the 2026 MLB All-Star Game on July 14 at Citizens Bank Park in Philadelphia...fans can submit up to 5 ballots per day until the conclusion of Phase One (June 25)...Phase Two, which takes the finalists at each position, will run from June 29-July 2 before the All-Star rosters are announced on July 4...for more information and to vote, visit [Mariners.com/Vote](http://Mariners.com/Vote).

**FOREVER YOUNG...**Cole Young last night went 3-for-5 with a leadoff home run, his first career leadoff homer and his 5th home run of the season...at 22 years and 317 days, he became the 3rd youngest player in franchise history with a leadoff home run, joining **Julio Rodríguez** (7x) and Spike Owen (1x) (*h/t Sarah Langs*)...over his last 14 games since May 27, Young is batting .316 (18x57) with 7 runs, 2 home runs, 5 RBI, 2 walks and just 6 strikeouts, reaching base at a .344 clip and slugging .421 (.765 OPS) in 62 plate appearances...he has hit safely in 13 of his last 14 games during that span, including a career-high 11-game hitting streak from May 27 to June 8.

**RANDY AROZARENA: UNA ESTRELLA...**Randy Arozarena has produced offensively this season, batting .290 (75x259) with 45 runs, 18 doubles, 1 triple, 7 home runs, 33 RBI, 27 walks and 18 stolen bases, getting on base at a .380 clip and slugging .455 for an .835 OPS in 69 games...Randy leads AL outfielders (min. 200 PA and 50% G as OF) in hits, stolen bases, and doubles and ranks 3rd in batting average, 3rd in fWAR (2.4), 4th in OBP and 6th in OPS... Arozarena is 1 of 3 players with 25+ extra-base hits and 15+ stolen bases this season (26 XBH, 18 SB), joining José Ramírez-CLE (27 XBH, 24 SB) and Bobby Witt Jr.-KC (27 XBH, 24 SB).

**SMOOTH SAILING...**during the Mariners current 11-5 stretch (5/25-c), the pitching staff ranks T-1st in the Majors with a 3.36 ERA (54 ER, 144.2 IP)...Seattle pitchers also rank T-1st in MLB with a 1.08 WHIP during that span (also: Dodgers)...also during the span, the Seattle offense ranks 6th in MLB in batting average (.273), 5th in slugging (.469), 9th in OPS (.795) and 2nd in home runs (30).

**BIG TEX ON THE MOUND...**Bryce Miller has been incredible to start the season, posting a 1.33 ERA (4 ER, 27.0 IP) with 29 strikeouts and a 0.78 WHIP over 5 appearances (4 GS) this season...Miller has thrown 5.0+ IP with 1-or-fewer hits allowed in each of his last two starts, doing so in back-to-back games for the 3rd time in his career and first since Sept. 18-23, 2024.

**ANOTHER REHAB ROUND-TRIPPER FOR CAL...**Cal Raleigh (right oblique strain) made his 3rd rehab appearance and 2nd appearance with Triple-A Tacoma last night, going 1-for-4 with a 3-run home run while catching for 8.0 innings...during his current rehab assignment, he is 4-for-10 with 3 home runs and 9 RBI...Raleigh will make his next rehab appearance on Saturday with Tacoma...fans with a **Mariners.TV** subscription have access to **MILB.TV** and can watch Raleigh, along with Mariners top prospects like **Kade Anderson**, **Ryan Sloan**, **Lazaro Montes**, and others in the farm system.

**J-ROD'S STAR POWER...**Julio Rodríguez last night went 2-for-4 with a walk and 1 RBI...in 70 games this season, he is batting .254 (72x283) with 14 doubles, 13 home runs, 34 RBI and 9 stolen bases, reaching base at a .314 clip and slugging .442 (.756 OPS)...among qualified AL center fielders (min. 50% G as CF), he ranks T-5th in doubles, 4th in home runs, T-3rd in extra-base hits (27), 5th in RBI and T-6th in stolen bases...Julio has made the All-Star Game in 3 of his first 4 seasons and has the chance to make it 4 of 5.

**RECENT MOVES...**the Mariners yesterday selected RHP **Michael Rucker** from Triple-A Tacoma and designated RHP **Domingo González** for assignment...on Wednesday, the Mariners reinstated INF/OF **Miles Mastrobuoni** from the 60-day Injured List (right calf strain) and recalled Gonzalez from Triple-A Tacoma...as corresponding moves, INF **Ryan Bliss** was optioned to Triple-A Tacoma and RHP **Matt Brash** was placed on the 15-day Injured List (right lat strain, retroactive to June 9)...to clear space on the 40-man roster for Mastrobuoni, RHP **Yosver Zulueta** was designated for assignment...on Tuesday, the Mariners recalled RHP **Nick Davila** from Triple-A Tacoma and placed RHP **Cooper Criswell** on the 15-day Injured List (right shoulder strain).

**MARINERS POST-GAME ALUMNI HOME RUN DERBY SET FOR AUGUST 7...**the Mariners announced the club will hold its first ever Alumni Home Run Derby, with participants including Hall of Famer **Ichiro Suzuki**, Mariners legend **Mike Cameron**, broadcasters **Ryan Rowland-Smith** and **Ryon Healy**, Bullpen Coach **Austin Nola**, local radio host **Bucky Jacobsen** and former Mariner **Stefen Romero**...all fans with a ticket to the game on Friday, Aug. 7 will have access to the Alumni Home Run Derby.

**ON THE UPCOMING HOMESTAND...**following Monday's off day, the Mariners return to T-Mobile Park for a 6-game homestand against the Orioles (3 G, June 16-18) and Red Sox (3 G, June 19-21)...highlights on the homestand include Stars and Stripes Soccer Jersey Day on Thursday, Juneteenth Celebration and Fireworks Night on Friday, where Seattle will wear their Steelheads Jerseys, and Father's Day on Sunday.

**AS YOU MAY KNOW...**Cole Young last night hit his first career leadoff home run, his 5th homer of the year...**YOU MAY ALSO KNOW...**the Mariners have hit 7 leadoff home runs this season, which is the most in the Major Leagues, ranking ahead of the next closest Dodgers and Twins (6 HR), but...**DID YOU KNOW?**...the Mariners join the New York Mets as one of only two teams in MLB to have 4 different players hit leadoff home runs this season?...Seattle has gotten contributions from Young, **J.P. Crawford** (3 HR), **Rob Refsnyder** (1 HR) and **Brendan Donovan** (2 HR) this season...Crawford's 3 leadoff homers rank T-5th in the Majors this season.

ABOUT BRYCE MILLER...

- The 27-year-old right-handed pitcher is set to make his 6th appearance (5th start) of the season and the 80th (79th start) of his career...it marks his 1st career start against the Nationals.
- Is in his 4th season with Seattle; selected by Seattle in the 4th round (113th overall) of the 2021 MLB First-Year Player Draft; signed by Mariners scout Derek Miller on July 20, 2021.
- Played 3 seasons at Texas A&M from 2019-21.
- Was born in Mount Pleasant, Texas and attended New Braunfels High School in New Braunfels, Texas.

**LAST TIME OUT...**W#2 on June 6 at Detroit, throwing 6.0 scoreless innings with only 1 hit allowed, 2 walks, and 9 strikeouts...threw 94 pitches and 64 strikes...has logged back-to-back games with 1-or-fewer hits and 2-or-fewer walks allowed over 5.0+ IP...is the only pitcher to have done so this season... is also the only Mariners pitcher all-time to record such starts in back-to-back games...the Mariners rotation has combined for 14 such games in 2026, the most in MLB this season, 5 games ahead of the Dodgers 9.

**UNCHARTED TERRITORY...**will be making his first career appearance against the Nationals...they are 1-of-2 teams, not including the Mariners, that he has yet to face...the Mariners are scheduled to play the Pirates, the only other team he has not faced, later this month...Miller is 9-4 with a 3.01 career ERA (40 ER, 119.2 IP), a 1.019 WHIP, and a K/BB of 3.09 in inter-league games.

**WHAT A STRETCH...**is 5th pitcher in MLB all-time to have 4-or-fewer runs, 5-or-fewer walks, 27.0+ IP and 29+ strikeouts through their first 5 games of the season (last: Frank Viola, 4/11/1990-5/2/1990).

**THE ROAD SO FAR...**in his last 6 road appearances (8/31/25-c), has allowed 3-or-fewer runs over 5.0+ innings pitched...the Mariners are 4-2 over those 6 games...allowed only 3 base runners on a hit and 2 walks with no runs in his first 6.0 inning outing of the season in his last road start (6/6 at DET)...owns a 2.20 ERA (4 ER, 16.1 IP) with a 1.041 WHIP and a K/BB of 5.33 in 3 road appearances this season.

**BACK AND BETTER THAN EVER...**recorded 5.0+ innings with 2-or-fewer runs allowed in each of his first 5 appearances this season...marks the first time in his career he has recorded 5+ such outings in a row...is 1-of-5 pitchers to start the season with 5+ consecutive such games...his 1.33 ERA (4 ER, 27.0 IP), 5 walks, 16 hits, and 21 base runners allowed through his first 5 outings are all best marks over a 5 game span to start the season since Miller's 2023 debut season (5/2/23-6/6/23) where he had a 1.15 ERA (4 ER, 27.0 IP) with 3 walks, 13 hits and 17 base runners allowed...his 29 strikeouts tie his career best mark through the first 5 games (also: 2023).

**BRYCE BESTS ALL...**is dominating lefty batters through his first 5 appearances this season ranking 12th in WHIP (0.79) and opponent batting average (.152) against left handed hitters in the AL (min. 10.0 IP)...also owns a 3.5 K/BB and a 9.0 K/9...historically matches up better against right handed batters...ranks T-8th, in WHIP (0.96) and BB% (4.6), matching **Logan Gilbert** in both marks, while ranking 14th in K/BB (5.4) against right handed batters among AL pitchers since 2023 (min. 100.0 IP)...ranks 2nd in K/BB (15.0) and 13th in WHIP (0.77) against RHH this season.

**KEEPING THE PATHS CLEAN...**owns a career 10.22 base runners per 9, ranking 11th lowest in MLB since 2023 (min. 400.0 IP), just ahead of **George Kirby** (10.36)...his 7.00 base runners per 9 this season is the 5th lowest in MLB in 2026 (min. 15.0 IP)...his 20 career games with 4-or-fewer base runners allowed over 5.0+ IP (last: 6/6 at DET) since 2023 rank T-6th in MLB, joining rotation-mates **Bryan Woo** (T-1st, 24 G) **Logan Gilbert** (3rd, 23 G), **Luis Castillo** (T-8th, 18 G) and **George Kirby** (T-10th, 17 G) in the top 10 most such games in MLB over that span.

**WHAT THE NUMBERS ARE SAYING...**through 5 outings this season, is posting career-high marks in whiff rate (29.3), chase rate (35.8), strikeout rate (29.3), and hard hit rate (5.1), which ranks in the top 2% of pitchers this season, while his walk rate (5.1) is sitting 3.6 points better than his 8.7 mark last season.

**CRACKING THE WHIP...**ranks 3rd among Mariners all-time WHIP leaders (min. 400 IP) with a 1.105 WHIP...his 110 walks are the 5th fewest through a starting pitchers first 79 games with the Mariners (min. 400.0 IP) while his 364 hits allowed are 3rd fewest...has recorded 2 outings of 1-or-fewer hits and 1-or-fewer walks over 5.0+ IP this season (last: 5/31 vs. ARI)...he is 1-of-3 pitchers to have multiple such games this season, along with Paul Skenes-PIT and Drew Rasmussen-TB.

**BEWARE THE 4-SEAM...**owns a career .285 opponent OBP and a .223 opponent average on his 4-seam...his OBP on his primary pitch ranks 10th in MLB among pitchers that have thrown 2000+ 4-seam fastballs since 2023...his 472 swing and misses on his 4-seam are 7th most in the AL since 2023... through his 5 appearances this season, he has increased the average velocity of his four-seamer to 96.6 mph compared to 94.8 mph last season...on May 19, fired a 99.3 mph 4-seamer for a strike, marking the fastest pitch thrown of his career, just passing his previous career-high of 99.2 mph thrown in his first start of the season (5/13 vs. HOU)...has logged 15+ pitches over 97 mph in 3 of his 5 outings...prior to the start of this season his career-high was 10 pitches above 97 mph on Aug. 6, 2023 vs. LAA.

**GOING THE DISTANCE...**has pitched 6.0+ innings in 31 career games, including his last start, and 5.0+ innings in 63 of his 79 career outings...the Mariners are 39-24 when he pitches 5.0+ innings and 24-7 when he pitches 6.0+ innings compared to 2-8 when he tosses fewer than 5.0 innings... on May 25 at ATH pitched 5.0+ innings out of the pen, becoming the first Mariners pitcher to log 5.0+ innings of relief and earn the win since Tommy Milone on September 18, 2019 at Pittsburgh.
