Jackson Chourio made his season debut Monday in St. Louis and tied his career high with 4 hits (5x), going 4-for-4 with 2 doubles and a walk....it marked the second time in his career he reached base 5 times (also 6/20/25 at Minnesota).

Feeling at Home

Jackson Chourio has recorded 3 of his 5 career 4-hit games against the Cardinals at Busch Stadium....Chourio has batted .400 (22-for-55) with 6 doubles, a triple, 2 HR and 8 RBI in 13 career games in St. Louis.

IN THE TRAINER'S ROOM: **OF Akil Baddoo** (left quad), **LHP Jared Koenig** (left elbow), **RHP Quinn Priester** (right thoracic outlet), **RHP Brandon Woodruff** (right shoulder), **OF Christian Yelich** (left groin), **LHP Rob Zastryzny** (left shoulder) and **LHP Angel Zerpa** (left forearm) are on the injured list....Baddoo and Zastryzny are on the 60-day IL.

MANAGER: **Pat Murphy** (358g, 208-150, .581) is in his third season as Brewers manager....he was voted NL Manager of the Year in 2024 and 2025....he is one of four managers ever to win Manager of the Year in consecutive seasons, joining the Braves' Bobby Cox (2004-05), Rays' Kevin Cash (2020-21) and Guardians' Stephen Vogt (2024-25)....Murphy was named the 20th manager in franchise history on 11/15/23, replacing Craig Counsell....he signed a multi-year contract extension on 2/20/26.

COACHES: Returning from the 2025 staff is offense & strategy coordinator **Jason Lane** (11th season/1st in current role), pitching coordinator **Jim Henderson** (5th season/1st in current role), field coordinator **Néstor Corredor** (4th season/3rd in current role), pitching coach **Chris Hook** (8th season), bullpen coach **Charlie Greene** (3rd season), lead hitting coach **Eric Theisen** (2nd season/1st in current role) and third base coach **Matt Erickson** (3rd season/1st in current role)....assistant pitching coach **Juan Sandoval**, hitting coach **Guillermo Martinez**, hitting coach **Daniel Vogelbach** and first base coach **Spencer Allen** are all in their first seasons on the coaching staff.

IN THE STANDINGS (41 days): The team has spent the following number of days alone or tied at each spot in the NL Central standings: **FIRST:** 16, **SECOND:** 1, **THIRD:** 5, **FOURTH:** 12, **FIFTH:** 7....the Brewers are currently in fourth place, trailing the first-place Cubs by 5.0 games, the second-place Cardinals by 2.5 games and the third-place Reds by 1.0 game....are ahead of the fifth-place Pirates by a percentage point.

LET'S GO TO THE VIDEO TAPE: The Brewers have made 11 replay challenges this season, going 9-2....their last challenge (won) came on 4/29 vs. Arizona as a safe call at second base involving Nolan Arenado was overturned.

BREWING SUCCESS: The Brewers have qualified for the postseason seven times in the last eight seasons and three seasons in a row....the team was just two games away from making the postseason in nine straight seasons (2017-25), missing out in both 2017 and 2022 by a single game....Milwaukee has won the NL Central in four of the last five seasons and three seasons in a row.

BREWING CONSISTENCY: The Brewers, Astros and Dodgers are the only Major League teams with 86+ wins in each of the last eight full seasons (2017-25)....this does not include the shortened 2020 season....the Brewers have 781 wins since 2017, which ranks fourth in the majors behind the Dodgers (875), Astros (821) and Yankees (813).

SPROAT AT A GLANCE: Brandon Sproat, 25, will be making his seventh appearance and fifth start of the season.....Sproat last pitched last Wednesday in a start vs. Arizona and took a 6-2 loss (4.1ip, 6h, 4r, 4er, 2bb, 5k, 2hr, 82 pitches).....the team is 2-2 in his starts.....he has made 1 quality start.....opponents are batting .286 (28-for-98, 7hr)..... he was acquired from the Mets with INF/DF Jett Williams on January 21 for RHP Freddy Peralta and RHP Tobias Myers.....he entered the 2026 season as the fifth-best prospect in the Brewers organization according to *Baseball America*.....Sproat was selected by the Mets in the second round of the 2023 First-Year Player Draft out of the University of Florida.

LAST SEASON: Sproat entered the 2025 season as the second-best prospect in the Mets organization according to *Baseball America* with his changeup rated best in the system.....he went 8-6 with a 4.24 ERA in 26 games/25 starts at Triple-A Syracuse.....he was named International League Pitcher of the Month for July (5gs, 2-0, 0.67era)..... Sproat was selected by the Mets on September 7 and went 0-2 with a 4.79 ERA in 4 starts.....he made his Major League debut on 9/7 at Cincinnati and carried a no-hitter into the sixth inning but took a 3-2 loss (6ip, 3h, 3r, 3er, 4bb, 7k).

CAREER AT AMERICAN FAMILY FIELD: Is 0-1 with a 6.62 ERA in 4 games/3 starts, all coming this season (17.2ip, 13er).

CAREER ON THE ROAD: Is 0-3 with a 6.41 ERA in 4 games/3 starts (19.2ip, 14er).....is 0-1 with a 7.00 ERA in 2 games/1 start this season (9ip, 7er).

CAREER vs. CARDINALS: Sproat has not faced the St. Louis, Missouri Cardinals.

ODDS & ENDS: Sproat graduated from Pace (FL) High School, where he played football (quarterback) during his freshman and sophomore years in addition to four years of baseball.....he enjoys golf, hunting, fishing and the outdoors.
