<u>Lean On Me</u> **Josh Hader** has converted 27 straight save opportunities dating back to last season, the longest active streak in the majors.....his last blown save came on 7/7/21 at New York-NL.

IN THE STANDINGS (39 days): The Brewers have spent the following number of days alone or tied at each position in the NL Central standings: FIRST: 20, SECOND: 7, THIRD: 5, FOURTH: 6, FIFTH: 1.....the team is currently in first place, leading the second-place Cardinals by 2.5 games.

AT HOME: The Brewers are 10-4 at home, going 3-1-1 in series play.....the team went 45-36 at home last season, going 14-10-2 in series play.

ON THE ROAD: The Brewers are 12-9 on the road, going 4-3-0 in series play.....the team went 50-31 on the road last season, going 18-7-1 in series play.....their 50 road wins in 2021 broke the franchise record set by the 1982 team (47-33).

MANAGER: Craig Counsell - the longest-tenured active manager in the National League and third in the majors - is in his eighth season as Brewers manager (551-492) and seventh full season.....he is second in franchise history in managerial wins and games managed (1.043), trailing only Phil Garner (563 wins/1.180 games).....under Counsell. the Brewers made the postseason in four consecutive years (2018-21) for the first time in franchise history.....he was named the 19th manager in franchise history on 5/4/15, replacing Ron Roenicke.....he is signed through 2023....only the Guardians' Terry Francona (10/8/12) and Rays' Kevin Cash (12/5/14) have longer active tenures.

COACHES: First base coach Quintin Berry (2nd season), pitching coach Chris Hook (4th season), third base coach Jason Lane (7th season, 2nd as 3B coach), associate pitching, catching and strategy coach Walker McKinven (3rd season) and bench coach Pat Murphy (7th season) all returned from the 2021 staff....new to the staff is hitting coach Connor Dawson, infield/assistant hitting coach Matt Erickson, bullpen coach Jim Henderson and hitting coach Ozzie Timmons.

LET'S GO TO THE VIDEO TAPE: The Brewers have made six replay challenges this season, going 4-2....their last challenge (won) came on 5/9 at Cincinnati as an out call at second base involving Jace Peterson was overturned.

TONIGHT'S STARTER: #51 - RHP FREDDY PERALTA [6gs, 2-1, 4.40]

PERALTA AT A GLANCE: Freddy Peralta, 25, is making his seventh start of the season and first against the Braves.....Peralta last started last Tuesday at Cincinnati and earned a 5-4 win (5.2ip, 4h, 1r, 1er, 1bb, 8k, 2hbp, 96 pitches).....the team is 4-2 in his starts.....he has 1 quality start.....opponents are batting .231 (25-for-108, 1hr).....Peralta was acquired from Seattle, along with RHP Carlos Herrera and RHP Daniel Missaki, in exchange for 1B Adam Lind on 12/9/15.....on 2/28/20, he signed a 5-year contract through the 2024 season with club options for 2025 and 2026.

FREDDY K-RUEGER: Freddy Peralta has 491 strikeouts in just 365.2 innings pitched during his Major League career (12.08K/9IP).....of pitchers with at least 365.0 innings pitched since 2018 (his first Major League season), Peralta ranks third in strikeouts per 9.0 innings, trailing only **Gerrit Cole** (12.60) and **Max Scherzer** (12.19).....he began his career with a 13-strikeout effort in 5.2 innings on Mother's Day, 5/13/18 at Colorado, in a 7-3 victory.....the 13 strikeouts that day remains his career high.

LAST SEASON: Peralta went 10-5 with a 2.81 ERA in 28 games/27 starts last season.....the team went 18-9 in his starts.....he made 14 quality starts.....the first-time All-Star held opponents to a .165 batting average with 195 strikeouts in 144.1 innings (12.16 K/9IP).....he was on the 10-day injured list from 8/19-9/2 with right shoulder inflammation.

ALL-STAR FREDDY: Peralta made his All-Star Game debut last season, striking out the side - Adolis García, J.D. Martinez and Matt Olson - in the seventh inning.

CAREER: Is 28-14 with a 3.91 ERA in 104 games/56 starts (365.2ip, 159er).....is in his fifth Major League season, all with the Brewers (2018-22).....is 20-13 with a 4.03 ERA as a starter (283.1ip, 127er) and 8-1 with a 3.50 ERA in relief (82.1ip, 32er).....notched his only career save on 7/24/19 vs. Cincinnati.

CAREER AT AMERICAN FAMILY FIELD: Is 16-7 with a 3.39 ERA in 53 games/26 starts (186ip, 70er).....is 1-1 with a 10.13 ERA in 2 starts this season (8ip, 9er).

CAREER ON THE ROAD: Is 12-7 with a 4.46 ERA in 51 games/30 starts (179.2ip, 89er).....is 1-0 with a 2.18 ERA in 4 starts this season (20.2ip, 5er).

CAREER vs. BRAVES: Has gone 2-1 with a 4.41 ERA in 4 games/3 starts (16.1ip, 8er), including a 10-9 victory in his only start last season on 5/16 at American Family Field (6ip. 2h. 0r. 1bb. 8k).....Peralta also started Game 3 of the 2021 NLOS on 10/11 at Truist Park and received no decision in the 3-0 loss (4ip. 3h. 0r. 1bb. 5k).
