BIRD WATCHING: The St. Louis Cardinals continue an eight-game homestand into the All-Star Break against first place teams in the National League Central (Milwaukee) and East (Atlanta). The Cardinals open a three-game series with the Atlanta Braves tonight televised on Apple TV. This three-game series will take the Cardinals into the All-Star Break and complete their season series with the Braves.

FLIGHT PATTERN: St. Louis enters play in 3rd place in the National League Central, 10.5 games behind first place Milwaukee, and 3.5 games behind 2nd place Chicago. The 'Birds are 5-6 into a stretch of 14 games over 13 days without an off day leading into the All-Star Break (June 30-July 12), all against teams currently in playoff position (2-1 at Braves; 2-1 at Cubs; 5 vs. Brewers 1-4; and 3 vs. Braves).

CARDINALS SIGN JJ WETHERHOLT THROUGH 2034: Prior to tonight's game, the Cardinals signed INF **JJ Wetherholt** to an eight-year contract extension keeping him in St. Louis through 2034. Wetherholt, the Cardinals first round selection (7th overall) in the 2024 MLB Draft, out of West Virginia University is batting .267 with 13 HR and 36 RBI, while playing in 87 games this season. He ranks in the Top 5 of almost every rookie offensive category while anchoring the lead-off spot in the Cardinals lineup and the second base position.

A BRAVE NEW WORLD: The Cardinals lead the Braves in the season series taking 2-of-3 in the Battery a week ago. St. Louis is one of three teams with a winning record at Truist Park against the Braves this season along with San Francisco (2-0) and Washington (2-1).

THE MAIN EVENT: With tonight's game on Apple TV+, the Cardinals have now appeared on national television 15 times in their first 93 games this season (16% of the schedule). Their record stands at 8-6: FOX/FS1 (3-4), NBC/Peacock (2-1), Apple TV (1-1), ESPN (1-0), TBS (1-0).

LEAHY LIVING LARGE ON THE BIG STAGE: Tonight's Cardinals starting pitcher **Kyle Leahy** is making his 6th start in a nationally televised game. In his previous five starts on the big stage, Leahy is 2-1 with a 3.86 and 24 strikeouts over 23.1 innings. He earned wins at DET (4/5) and last Saturday at CHI (7/4), while taking a loss vs. BOS (4/11) and no decisions at CIN (5/23) and vs. CHI (5/30).

A BRAVE NEW WORLD: With a three-run home run (#22) into Big Mac Land last night, **Jordan Walker** contined to lead Major League Baseball with 73 RBI. Walker became the 8th MLB player and 1st Cardinal to post a line of 100 hits, 22 HR, 73 RBI and 12 SB pre All-Star Break and the most recent since Cleveland's **José Ramírez** in 2024.

WALKER JOINS HR DERBY FIELD: All-Star OF **Jordan Walker** announced he will participate in the Home Run Derby at Citizens Bank Park on Monday. The last Cardinals player to participate in the event was **Albert Pujols** in Los Angeles in 2022. St. Louis is one of nine MLB teams who have yet to crown a champion with Pujols' 2nd place in 2003 as the highest finish. Walker is the 13th instance a Cardinal has participated joining a list that includes **Jack Clark** (1985), **Ray Lankford** (1997), **Mark McGwire** (1998-99), **Pujols** (2003, 07, 09, 22), **Jim Edmonds** (2003), **Matt Holliday** (2010, 11) and **Carlos Beltrán** (2012).

WHAT'S ON DRAFT?: Saturday afternoon, the Cardinals will participate in Day 1 of the Major League Baseball amateur draft. With seven picks, the Cardinals have the most selections of any team on the first day. The first pick will be at No. 13, followed by 32 (Competitive Balance Round-A), 50 (2nd Round), 68 & 72 (CB-B), 86 (3rd) and 114 (4th). The Competitive Balance picks came from market size (Round A) and from the **Brendan Donovan** trade (Round B from Seattle & Tampa Bay).

ATLANTA CONNECTIONS

Chip Caray previously served as the play-by-play voice of the Braves for 20 seasons on Bally Sports South and Bally Sports Southeast (2010-22), TBS and Peachtree TV (2005-2009) and on TBS and the Atlanta Braves Radio Network (1991-1992)..... his father, **Skip Caray**, was part of Braves broadcasts from 1978-2008.

Jordan Walker was born in Stone Mountain, Ga... Graduated from Decatur (Ga.) High School, where he was a 2019 and 2020 Gatorade High School Player of the Year.

George Soriano spent three weeks this offseason with Atlanta; was claimed by the Braves off waivers from Baltimore (Jan. 9, 2026) and then claimed by Washington off waivers (Jan. 30, 2026).

Kyle Leahy's uncle, **Thomas Leahy**, pitched in the Braves minor league organization (1991-93).

Blaze Jordan and **Austin Riley** graduated from DeSoto Central (Miss.) High School.

Austin Riley made his MLB debut vs. the Cardinals (May 19, 2019 at Truist Park).

Riley O'Brien's grandfather, **Johnny O'Brien**, was drafted by NBA's Milwaukee Hawks, who later became the St. Louis Hawks, and are now the Atlanta Hawks.

Cards.TV Director **Tom Mee** was selected by Atlanta in the 12th round of the 1977 MLB Draft...played two minor league seasons in the Braves system (1977-78) and was teammates with **Brian Snitker**.

As compensation for **Marcell Ozuna** signing with Atlanta in 2020, St. Louis selected **Alec Burleson** in the 2nd round of the 2020 MLB draft.

JoJo Romero (Aug. 21, 2020 at Truist) and **Jon Jay** (April 26, 2010 at Busch III) made their MLB debuts vs. the Braves.

Dylan Dodd pitched three seasons (2019-21) at Southeast Missouri State University and one season with the Hannibal (Mo.) Hoots of the Collegiate Summer Prospect League.

Hall of Fame Manager **Joe Torre** played for & managed both the Cardinals (1969-74 & 1990-95) and Braves (1966-68 & 1982-84)...traded to St. Louis from Atlanta for **Orlando Cepeda** (Mar. 17, 1969).

TONIGHT'S START:

- The 29-year old makes his 18 start of the season (19th career) and 116th career appearance. First 97 appearance of his career came in relief.
- Tonight is his 6th start during a nationally televised game, following Easter Sunday on NBC/Peacock Sunday Night Baseball in Detroit, April 11 vs. Boston on FOX, Game 2 of a Doubleheader at Cincinnati on May 23 at on FOX, May 30 vs. the Cubs on FOX, and July 4 at Chicago's Wrigley Field on FOX.***
- His seven wins this season are a career high and rank 2nd on St. Louis to **Andre Pallante** (10).
- Is six outs away from reaching 88.1 innings pitched, a new MLB career high.
- Has allowed just one run over his last three starts (0.55 ERA) since June 23, and is 4-1 with a 3.00 ERA (57.0 IP), and 51 strikeouts in his last 11 starts since May 1.
- Four of his seven wins this season have come on the road: April 5 at Detroit, April 17 at Houston, April 28 at Pittsburgh, and July 4 at Chicago Cubs.
- Kyle's 97 career relief appearances before his 1st career Major League start (Sept. 28, 2025 at CHI) were the most by a Cardinal since **Jordan Hicks** (April 21, 2022 at Miami) who made his 1st career start after having made 114 career relief appearances.

LAST TIME OUT (Saturday, July 4 at Wrigley Field): W, 3-0; 5.0 IP, 3 H, 0 R, 0 ER, 2 BB, 6 SO, 0 HR - 77 pitches.

- Hurled 5.0 scoreless innings through the Wrigley Field fog as the Cardinals handed the division-rival Cubs a 3-0 shutout on Independence Day.
- Scattered three singles and struck out six on only 77 pitches and marks his thrd scoreless start this season.
- Following a 49-minute pre-game rain delay, rookie JJ Wetherholt homered on the first pitch of the game off Shota Imanga . The game was also halted for 15 minutes after the 6th inning due to heavy fog combined with smoke from nearby fireworks.

2026 HIGHLIGHTS:

2-AND-Q: Ranks 4th among all MLB pitchers in batting with 2 out & RISP with a .105 BA (4-36)... trails CIN's **Chase Burns** (.079), TB's Nick Martinez (.098), & ARI's **Eduard Rodriguez** (.098). *min. 40 batters faced*

EN GARDE: Ranks T-4th among NL pitchers with his 22 Opponent's Sword Swings (Max Meyer-MIA, 1st with 29). A “sword” swing is an expression of the art of forcing a batter to take an uncomfortable, awkward swing.

AIR BENDER: Boasts average swing & miss distances of 5.8 inches on his curveball and 5.7 inches on his sweeper.

FISH IS THE DISH: Snapped a six-game stretch without a win in his last start vs. MIA (6/28) tossing 5.0 innings allowing one run on two hits; kept the Marlins from their first Cardinals sweep in 30 years.

PARK PLACE: Each of his first six road games took place at Parks (Petco Park, Comerica Park, Daikin Park, loanDepot park, PNC Park, Great American Ball Park). His start at Target Field on June 12 ended the string.

CENTRAL FOCUS: Earned wins in three of his six starts against NL Central opponents this season (April 28 at PIT, May 4 vs. MIL, July 4 at Chicago) to improve to 5-1 in his career against divisional opponents.

DECISIONS, DECISIONS Has earned the decision in 11 of his 17 starts, but just two decisions in his last 8 starts.

STRETCHING OUT: Has worked at least 5.0 innings in 14 of his 17 starts on the year, including a career-high 6.1 innings on 6/22 vs. Arizona.

SNAKE CHARMER: Blanked the Diamondbacks on just 3 hits over his career single-game high 6.1 IP on 6/22 vs. ARI, but took a no-decision while exiting the game with a scoreless tie.

OH MOTHER: Blanked the Padres over his 5.0 IP on just 2 hits on May 10 (Mother's Day), and was in line for the win before the Padres Nick Castellanos tied the game with a 2-out, 2-strike 2-run HR to tie the game at 2-2, and then SD won it in the 10th, 3-2.

ALL EYES ON US: Drew back-to-back starting assignments in nationally televised games on Easter Sunday on NBC/Peacock Sunday Night Baseball in Detroit and April 11 vs. Boston on FOX. Made the start on 5/23 [2] at Cincinnati on FOX in national telecast Memorial Day weekend.

EASTER DELIGHT: Gained his 1st win of the season on April 5, allowing 2 runs over 5.0 IP in the Cardinals 5-3 Easter win over the Tigers. He threw a career-high 97 pitches as he earned the winning decision as a starter for the 1st time - all while helping to prevent a series sweep by Detroit.

IT'S COLDER IN BOULDER: Colorado native worked in game time temps of 42° on Easter Sunday in Detroit, his third career MLB appearance in temperatures 45° and below, two shy of matching Cards announcer **Brad Thompson** (5) for T-3rd among Cardinals in the frosty temps.

CAREER:

- Graduated from Erie (Colo.) High School. Named Boulder County POY and was selected to play at the High School Futures Game at Coors Field.
- Played college baseball at Colorado Mesa Univ. in Grand Junction, CO, going 22-2 with a 3.13 ERA (204.1 IP), 188 K and six complete games.
- Allowed nine home runs to 852 total batters faced while pitching in high altitude (Grand Junction is 4,583 ft above sea level).
- Posted a 13-0 record with a 1.41 ERA during his sophomore season, earning First Team All-American, First Team Academic All-American, and was the South Central Regional Tournament MVP.
- His father, Tim Leahy, played college basketball at Kansas State University and his uncle, Thomas Leahy, pitched in the Braves organization (1991-93) advancing to Durham (High-A).

LEAHY VS. ATLANTA:

- Makes his 6th career appearance and 1st start against Atlanta. Career 0-0 with a 2.35 ERA (7.2 IP) and one save in five relief outings.
- Converted his first career save on July 20, 2024 at Truist Park, ending the game with 2.0 innings.
- Lifetime 1-2 with a 5.40 ERA (15.0) in three starts against the NL East (1 vs. Mets and 2 vs. Marlins).
