**RECENT REDBIRDS:** The St. Louis Cardinals and visiting Cleveland Guardians play the second game of a three-game series tonight at Busch Stadium ... The Cardinals are 1-3 over their current six-game Interleague homestand against Boston (1-2) and Cleveland (0-1) ... After winning three in a row, St. Louis has dropped three straight and enter play today in fourth place in the NL Central Division, 2.0 games behind first place Pittsburgh.

**PUSHARD REHAB:** The Cardinals announced that RHP **Matt Pushard** will begin his 30-day injury rehabilitation assignment with Memphis (AAA) today ... The 28-year-old Rule 5 draftee was placed on the 15-day injured list on March 30 with right knee patellar tendinitis.

**JUST ANOTHER MANIC MONDAY:** According to *MLB's Sarah Langs*, the 10 MLB matchups yesterday averaged a combined 14.4 runs per game, highest on a single day with at least 10 games since July 18, 1936 (14.6 runs), and the highest on a day before June in the last 130 years.

- The only other March/April days in Major League history with 10+ games and as many runs per game as last night were April 19, 1890, (14.4) and April 21, 1890 (15.7).

**LET THE KIDS PLAY:** The Cardinals enter today with the youngest active roster (average age 26.8), while Cleveland ranks tied for the 5th-youngest at 27.8. - *ESPN*

**WALKER'S WORLD:** **Jordan Walker** leads Major League Baseball in Home Runs (8), Slugging (.767), Total Bases (46), and Isolated Power (.433), while ranking among MLB leaders in Runs Scored (15, T-4th), Average Exit Velocity (96.2mph, 5th), Hard-Hit % (68.3, 4th), Barrels/PA % (16.7%, 2nd), Extra-Base Hits (10, T-4th), OPS (1.161, 4th), and Offensive bWAR (1.5, T-1st).

- J-Walk is slashing .405/.450/.973 (15-37) with seven home runs and a 1.423 OPS over his current nine-game hitting streak (April 4-present), tied for MLB's 3rd-longest active hitting streak.
- The 23-year-old Walker and 21-year-old **Albert Pujols** (8 in 2001) are the only two Cardinals to hit 8+ homers in March/April before turning age 24 ... 2006 **Albert Pujols** (14 HR) holds the March/April record for Cardinals of any age.
- With another homer tonight or tomorrow, Walker would join **Albert Pujols** (11 in 2006) as the only two Cardinals with 9+ HR in the first 17 or 18 games of a season, surpassing **Stan Musial** (8 in 1954), **Mark McGwire** (8 in 1998), & **Scott Rolen** (8 in 2004).
- The last three Major Leaguers with 9 HR in his club's first 17 games of the season were 28-year-old **Aaron Judge** (2020 Yankees), 31-year-old **Khris Davis** (2019 Athletics), and 23-year-old **Cody Bellinger** (2019 Dodgers).
- Walker has gone yard in seven of his last nine games, six-of-seven, and three straight on two occasions ... The last Cardinal to homer in four consecutive was **Nolan Arenado** (5 in a row from May 12-16, 2023) ... The last two Cardinals with 8 homers over a 10-game stretch were **Marcell Ozuna** (April 6-17, 2019) and **Matt Carpenter** (July 14-25, 2018).
- 2009 **Albert Pujols** (47 HR) was the last Cardinal to lead all of Major League Baseball in home runs.
- Walker (8 HR) has accounted for 47.1% of the Cardinals home run total (17 HR) this season, highest percentage through the first 16 games of the season since **Albert Pujols** belted 11 of St. Louis' 22 homers (50%). - *Orf*

#### CLEVELAND CONNECTIONS

**José Fernín** signed with Cleveland as an International Free Agent (July 2, 2015)...played six minor league seasons in the Guardians organization before being purchased by St. Louis (Nov. 9, 2022).

**Justin Bruhl** was acquired by St. Louis from the Guardians in exchange for cash considerations on Jan. 6, 2026 after Cleveland had acquired him from Toronto for cash (Dec. 17, 2025).

**Julio Rangel** spent 11 years in the Cleveland system as a Cultural Development Coordinator (2007-08), Mental Skills Coordinator (2009-10), Lower Level Pitching Coordinator (2011-15), and Assistant Field Coordinator (2016-17).

**Shawn Armstrong** made 11 relief appearances for the Cardinals during the 2024 season.

Cardinals Asst. GM **Rob Cerfolio** and Farm Director **Larry Day** both previously worked in the Guardians Player Development department for 10 seasons (2015-24) before joining St. Louis.

Cardinals broadcaster **Ricky Horton** spent the 1991 season in Cleveland's minor league system as a pitching coach and pitcher between Colorado Springs (AAA) and Canton-Akron (AA).

**Dean Kiekhefer** was originally selected by Cleveland in the 37th round of the 2007 MLB Draft out of Oldham High School (Ky.), but did not sign.

**Dustin May** and **Nolan Gorman** were teammates for the NL in the 2019 SiriusXM All-Star Futures Game at Progressive Field in Cleveland.

Cleveland Sr. VP of Medical Services **Lonnie Soloff** attended St. Louis University...began his baseball career with the Cardinals in 1996 as part of the PBATS internship program.

Guardians Sr. VP Hitting **Alex Eckelman** played parts of 5 yrs. in the Cards MiLB system (1997-2001).

**Jordan Walker** was named Player of the Game at the 2019 MLB High School All-Star Game at Cleveland's Progressive Field.

**Matt Swanson** tallied his first career win on June 28, 2025 at Cleveland after pitching a scoreless inning of relief in a 9-6 victory.

Guardians Manager **Stephen Vogt** notched his first MLB hit on a home run vs. St. Louis on June 28, 2013 while with Oakland.

The Cardinals and Cleveland played in MLB's inaugural Civil Rights Game on March 31, 2007 at AutoZone Park in Memphis, Tenn.

Guardians Replay Coord. **Gunnar Wilhelmly** attended the Univ. of Missouri, earning two undergraduate degrees (2016) and a Master's of Statistics (2018)...worked for the Mizzou Baseball team for five and a half years as Student Mgr., Graduate Asst., and Mgr. of Advanced Technologies.

Cleveland AGM **Eric Binder** pitched part of the 2011 season in the Cardinals minor league system.

Guardians Special Assignment Scout **Doug Carpenter** was the international scouting supervisor for the Cardinals from 1998-2000.

Cleveland Amateur Scouting Coordinator **David Compton** served as a fourth coach for the Double-A Springfield Cardinals in 2015.

**Bill Veeck** was a former owner of both Cleveland (1946-49) and the St. Louis Browns (1951-53).

**Bryan Schapiro** is an Akron, Ohio native...graduated from the University of Akron.

Guardians MiLB Strength/Conditioning Coordinator **Josh Kesel** was born in St. Louis...was the co-founder and performance director of Premier Pitching and Performance in St. Louis.

Guardians Sr. Player Acquisitions Scout **Kevin Cullen** coached at the Univ. of Missouri and Univ. of Central Missouri before joining Cleveland in 2007.

Cleveland Team Physician **Mark Schickendantz** earned his medical degree from Saint Louis University School of Medicine in 1986.

Cardinals Baseball Info. & Media Serv. Mgr. **Chris Tunno** graduated from Canfield (Ohio) High School.

The Cardinals & Indians played an exhibition at Cleveland's League Park during the 1936 All-Star break, when 17-year-old **Bob Feller** made his unofficial debut with 8 strikeouts in 3.0 innings.

The Cleveland Spiders were rivals of the St. Louis Browns in the American Association (1888-89) and National League (1892-99)...before the 1899 season, Spiders owners **Stanley** and **Frank DeHass Robison**, who also owned the St. Louis franchise, transferred Cleveland's best players (future Hall of Famers **Cy Young**, **Bobby Wallace**, & **Jesse Burkett**) to St. Louis and formed the Perfectos...the Spiders endured the worst season in pro baseball history (20-134) and were disbanded as the NL contracted to eight teams.

The Cardinals won their 10,000th regular season game as a member of the National League with a 4-0 victory over Cleveland at Busch Stadium (June 25, 2018), becoming the 6th NL franchise to reach that plateau, following the Braves, Cubs, Dodgers, Giants, and Pirates. The Yankees also boast 10,000 wins.

- The 25-year-old righty is making his 4th start of the 2026 season tonight, 23rd career start (25th career game).
- **The Cardinals are 15-7 (.681 win pct.) in his 22 career games started**, losing consecutive games that he has started just once.
- Has made 13 career appearances (11 starts) at Busch Stadium where he is 5-3 with a 4.09 ERA (66.0 IP).
- **Has a 13.0 scoreless innings streak at Busch Stadium over two starts that dates back to 2025.**
- Lifetime 7-2 with a 3.38 ERA (69.1 IP) in 12 career road starts.
- Went 4-0 with a 2.45 ERA in 5 Spring Training starts, striking out 16 to just 2 walks but did allow a team-high 6 HR's
- Led MLB with his 4 Spring Training wins and ranked in top 10 in ERA (2.45), Opp. BA (.229) and WHIP (0.98)

LAST TIME OUT (Wed., April 8 at Washington) W, 6-1; 6.0 IP, 4 H, 1 R, 1 ER, 0 BB, 1 SO; 91 pitches.

2026 HIGHLIGHTS:

**CURLY W:** Limited the Washington Nationals to just 4 baserunners over his 6.0 IP in 6-1 win at Nationals Park on 4/8, retiring his final 11 batters faced in order. Walked none and struck out one to earn his 1st win of the season.

**NO FREE PASSES:** Has issued zero walks over his last 11.0 IP and his .032 walks/batters faced ranks 2nd best in NL to the Dodgers Yoshinobu Yamamoto (.030).

**FAITH IN FIELDERS:** Has MLB's lowest percent (13.9) of swing & miss.

**SNAPPY WHIP:** His 0.78 walks + hits per innings pitched ratio is best in NL.

**"NO" NEWS IS GOOD NEWS:** Retired the first nine batters en route to 6.0 no-hit innings in his first start of the season vs. TB (3/28) in a no decision the Cardinals won in 10 innings (6-5).

**FIRST IMPRESSIONS:** Became the first Cardinal to throw 6.0+ no-hit innings in a completed start since **Erick Fedde** on April 9, 2025 at Pittsburgh (6.0 IP). Since 1961, the Cardinals record for the longest hitless inning streak as a starter (excluding any possible intervening relief appearances) to begin a season is 8.0 IP by **Daniel Ponce de Leon** - July 23, 2018 (7.0 IP) and Aug. 21, 2018 (1.0 IP) - *Elias*

**JOINING THE LEGENDS:** Became the second pitcher in Cardinals history to throw a hitless start in one of the first two starts of the season (**Jack Flaherty** 4/1/23 vs. TOR) and the 14th time in MLB a pitcher has in a start of 6.0 or more innings. **Emerson Hancock** (SEA) followed with 6.0 no-hit innings vs. CLE the next day.

**OPENING ACT:** The 2026 season marks his 1st time making the Cardinals Opening Day roster.

McGREEVY vs. CLEVELAND:

- Is making his 1st career appearance/start against Cleveland and just his 5th career Interleague appearance (1-1, 1.88 ERA, 28.1 IP).
- This is his 3rd Interleague opponent in his four starts this year, having already faced Tampa Bay and Detroit.
- Has two previous starts vs. AL Central teams having faced the White Sox and Tigers. Made his Major League debut in an Interleague meeting with Texas in 2024.

**NEWS TO KNOW: Leads the team with 9 app. and has 8.1 IP;** gained his 1st Hold with the Cardinals last Wed. (4/8) win at WSH; made his Cardinals debut on Opening Day (3/26)...had 2.0 scoreless IP vs. Rays on 3/29...Made his 2nd career Opening Day roster and 1st since 2022 with the Dodgers.

**LARGE INHERITANCE:** Has inherited 9 baserunners (T-2nd in NL) including three he stranded vs. BOS last Sat. (4/11).

**GIVE ME A FIFTH:** Former non-drafted free agent is pitching for his 5th Major League club, previously appearing in 94 total games with LAD (65), TOR (15), COL (7) and PIT (7) ... Signed as a free agent with the Reds in 2024, but did not pitch in an MLB game.
