RAY REPORT—The Rays continue a seven-game homestand against the Orioles (0-3, 1 to play) and Cubs (3 to play) tonight at Tropicana Field...have lost three straight games following a three-game winning streak...are 6-6 in their last 12 games on the heels of a season-high six-game losing streak from May 19-25...are 6-12 in their last 18 contests after posting an 11-4 mark in their previous 15 from May 3-18...have fallen a season-high 14.0 games back in the AL East standings, their largest deficit since entering play on Aug. 4, 2022 (14.0)...own sole possession of fifth place in the AL East standings after the calendar flips to June for the first time since the conclusion of the 2016 campaign...the Rays are 0-3 so far during a stretch of 19 games in 20 days from June 7-26.

The Rays did not record a baserunner through five innings for the second time this season in vesterday's 9-2 loss, joining May 26 vs. KC...they yielded three triples, tying the club record from April 5, 2003 vs. NYY.

Tampa Bay has yet to hold a lead this series...the club has led entering the 7th inning just twice in its last 19 games, both coming from June 4-5 at MIA...the Rays have trailed by 3+ runs at some point in six of their last seven games.

The Rays are 1-9 in their last 10 games against AL East opponents after a 9-7 start... they are 3-10 vs. division rivals at Tropicana Field, losing seven straight since their last win on May 11 vs. NYY...it marks their longest streak since falling in a clubrecord eight straight from May 3-10, 2002.

The Rays are looking to avoid being swept for the third time this season (April 26-28 at CWS; May 20-22 vs. BOS)...they have not been swept in a four-game series since June 17-20, 2021 at SEA in a set that featured three walk-off losses...their last four-game sweep at home came from June 30-July 3, 2016 vs. DET...overall, it would mark the 25th time they have been swept in a four-game series.

**TROP FLOPS**—The Rays are 4-12 (.250) at home since May 8, tied with the Mets for the worst mark in the majors...they have been outscored, 83-46 (-37), in those contests, going 4-3 when scoring 4+ runs compared to 0-9 with three runs or fewer...it marks their worst 16-game stretch at Tropicana Field since July 22-Aug. 19, 2017 (also 4-12).

CHECK THE RADAR—The Rays have recorded only six hard-hit balls (95+ mph) over the last two games, five by Yandy Díaz and one by Randy Arozarena...Díaz was responsible for Tampa Bay's only two hard-hit balls yesterday, tallying a pair of singles clocked at 113.9 mph and 108.0 mph...the former marked the highest exit velocity recorded by a Ray since Luke Raley's 114.3 mph homer off Joe Kelly on April 27, 2023 at CWS...on the season, Díaz's 110 hard-hit balls rank fourth in the AL behind TOR Vladimir Guerrero Jr. (119), NYY Juan Soto (116) and KC Bobby Witt Jr. (113).

He has paired the hard contact with a career-low 10.5 pct. whiff rate, second in the majors behind SD Luis Arraez (8.7%)...he has shaved 7.8 pct. off his 2023 mark (18.3%), the largest year-to-year decrease among AL hitters and sixth largest in the majors...CIN Tyler Stephenson (-10.4%) has made the biggest improvement.

Díaz currently has more hits (63) than swings-and-misses (52)...last season, he finished with 173 hits and 184 whiffs.

He is one of three qualified hitters with an average exit velocity of 90.0+ mph (92.5) and a sub-15.0 pct. whiff rate (10.5%), joining LAD Mookie Betts (90.6/13.7%) and KC Vinnie Pasquantino (91.7/14.9%).

HOT HITTERS—Randy Arozarena has reached base in 16 of 30 PA in June, posting the third-best on-base pct. in the majors this month at .533, trailing NYY Aaron Judge (.667) and SD Fernando Tatis Jr. (.537)...Arozarena, who has two multi-hit efforts in his last three games after totaling one in his previous 57 contests, is batting .364 (8-for-22) with 2 2B, 1 RBI and 8 BB over seven games in June.

Yandy Díaz is a riding a season-high 12-game on-base streak, his longest since Sept. 8-21, 2023 (13)...he has a .333 on-base pct., 7 BB and 6 SO during the streak.

Jose Siri is batting .303 (10-for-33) with 3 2B, 3 HR and 9 RBI over his last 10 games... he has 15 RBI in his last 18 games after collecting seven in his first 34 contests.

Brandon Lowe has hit safely in five of six games since June 1, going 7-for-23 (.304) with 1 2B, 1 HR and 7 RBI.

HOMER (UN)HAPPY—The Rays have been out-homered, 7-1, this series and own a -37 (86-49) home run margin on the season, the worst mark in the majors...they have hit the fewest homers (49) and allowed 86 HR, tied with the White Sox for the most in MLB... they have out-homered the opposition just once in their last 18 games (May 30 vs. OAK), posting a -16 (25-9) HR margin in that span...the Rays are 8-2 when out-homering their opponent, 16-11 when home runs are even and 7-21 when being out-homered.

Tampa Bay has recorded 12 wins without the benefit of a home run, tied with San Diego for second most in the majors behind Milwaukee (13).

RALLY RAYS—The Rays 17 comeback wins are tied for fourth most in MLB behind the Yankees (20), Phillies (19) and Orioles (18)...each of their six wins from May 18–June 4 came in come-from-behind fashion, their longest streak since May 8-18, 2013 (8G), per Elias.

The Rays rank among MLB leaders in wins when trailing after six (T2nd, 7), seven (1st, 6) and eight (T4th, 3) frames.

**DOWN TO THE WIRE**—The Rays own the best record in the majors in both one-run games (12-4/.750) and games decided by two runs or fewer (22-9/.710)...they lead the majors in wins by two runs or fewer (22), but their 25 losses by 3+ runs are tied for third most behind the White Sox (29) and Rockies (26).

The Rays have won each of their last six one-run games, their longest single-season streak a seven-game run from Aug. 10–Sept. 2, 2019...they are 13-3 in their last 16 games decided by two runs or fewer.

BIRDS IN THE BAY—The Rays and Orioles continue a 13-game season series with the finale of seven matchups over 11 days from May 31–June 10, with Tampa Bay going 1-5 so far...the clubs will reconvene from Aug. 9-11 in St. Pete and from Sept. 6-8 at Oriole Park...since 2017, the Rays are 73-48 against the Orioles, their most wins against any opponent over that timeframe...however, the Rays have lost 13 of the last 18 meetings and are 13-22 in the last 35 matchups on the heels of a 27-2 stretch in the previous 29.

\*\*Randy Arozarena\* is a career .335 (72-for-215) hitter with 10 2B, 1 3B, 16 HR and 44 RBI in 56 games vs. Baltimore, his most hits, HR and RBI against any opponent... min. 150 AB, the only active players with higher career averages vs. the Orioles are HOU Jose Abreu (.345), HOU Jose Altuve (.339) and AZ Lourdes Gurriel Jr. (.336).

**DOWN ON THE FARM**—A pair of Rays farmhands earned weekly honors for the week of June 3-9...Double-A Montgomery **LHP Ian Seymour** was named Southern League Pitcher of the Week after tossing a 7.0-inning shutout on June 5 vs. Biloxi, earning his third straight win while recording a career high in IP (7.0IP, H, OR, 2BB, 3SO)...**OF Leonardo Pineda** was named the Dominican Summer League Player of the Week after going 9-for-18 (.500) with 3 2B, 1 HR, 7 RBI, 6 BB and 3 SO over his first five professional games.

**TONIGHT'S START**—Pepiot will take the mound for his 11th start of the season tonight, including his eighth at home...was on the 15-day IL from May 6-22 (lower left leg contusion) after being struck by a 107.5 mph comebacker off the bat of NYM **Starling Marte** on May 5...has a 4.60 ERA (15.2IP, 8ER) in three starts since being reinstated, but has held opponents to a .196 (11-for-56) average...is seeking his first home win since April 18 yes 1.04. vs. LAA.

**LAST TIME OUT**—Earned his fifth quality start of the season, including his first since April 29 at MIL, in a winning effort on June 4 at MIA...all three of his runs and five of his six hits came in the 1st inning...had never allowed more than three hits in an inning (Sept. 13, 2023 vs. SD), while his three runs allowed in the frame matched a career high (5x, last: April 1, 2024 vs. TEX)...retired 15 of 16 BF over innings 2-6.

NEW TEAM. WHO DIS?—Pepiot is set to make his first career start against the Orioles...has yet to face a batter on Baltimore's roster...made his first career appearance against a divisional opponent earlier this season on May 22 vs. Boston, his first start since returning from the injured list (lower left leg contusion)...did not factor into that decision after allowing three runs on two hits and four walks with three strikeouts across 4.0 innings.

IS HOME WHERE THE HEART IS?—In seven starts at Tropicana Field this

- season, Pepiot is 1-2 with a 5.24 ERA (34.1IP, 20ER) and 33 strikeouts against 16 walks...in his last five home starts, however, he is 1-0 with a 3.80 ERA (23.2IP, 10ER) after going 0-2 with 8.44 ERA (10.2IP, 10ER) in his first two.

  He has earned a victory in each of his three road starts, posting a 1.50 ERA (18.0IP, 3ER) with 26 strikeouts against zero walks...he joins AZ Randy Johnson (2007) and NYY Mike Mussina (2001) as the only ritchers since 1904 to record 35+50 and 0.PR in their first the only pitchers since 1901 to record 25+ SO and 0 BB in their first three road starts with a franchise.
  - He is the first pitcher in franchise history to throw 6.0+ innings and issue zero walks in each of his first three road starts of a season. Prior to his start on June 4 at MIA, had thrown 6.0+ scoreless innings
  - with no walks in each of his first two road starts, becoming the fifth pitcher since 1901 to accomplish the feat, joining DET **Tarik Skubal** (2024), MIL **Corbin Burnes** (2021), SF **Johnny Cueto** (2018) and PIT Deacon Phillippe (1902).

**HEAT CHECK**—Pepiot has held opponents to a 9-for-90 (.100) clip on his four-seamer, recording 36 of his 59 SO on the pitch...the .100 average is the

lowest mark on any individual pitch in MLB(min. 70AB ending with pitch).

He has produced a 36.9 pct. whiff rate on the four-seamer, the second-highest mark on any MLB pitcher's fastball (min. 150 swings), trailing only OAK Mason Miller's four-seamer (42.2%).

WHIFF YOU PLEASE—Min. 750 swings, Pepiot's 31.1 pct. whiff rate ranks fourth in the AL, trailing DET Jack Flaherty (34.9%), KC Cole Ragans (31.7%) and DET Tarik Skubal (31.4%)...he had a 32.7 pct. whiff rate prior to his IL stint (7GS) compared to 23.1 pct. since his return (2GS).

**TRAFFIC CONTROL**—Min. 50.0 IP, he ranks among MLB leaders in hits per 9.0 IP (5th, 5.85), opp. average (6th, .185) and WHIP (8th, 0.96)...his .181 opp. average against right-handed hitters ranks third in the AL (min. 90AB) behind NYY **Luis Gil** (.144) and TEX **Dane Dunning** (.180).

**2ND FRAME FEATS**—Pepiot has not allowed a run in the 2nd inning, limiting opponents to 3-for-32 (.094) with 14 SO...among AL pitchers to have faced at 30 batters in the 2nd frame, his .094 AVG is second lowest behind HOU Ronel Blanco (.081/.3-for-37).

MEET ME IN THE MIDDLE—He has been at his best in the middle frames of his outings, posting a 1.29 ERA (28.0IP, 4ER) and 0.64 WHIP in innings 2-4 while pitching to a 7.03 ERA (24.1IP, 19ER) and 1.32 WHIP in all other

ODDS AND ENDS—Opposing three- and four-hole hitters are 14-for-45 (.311) with 1 2B, 1 3B, 3 HR and 8 BB...all other spots in the order are a combined 20-for-139 (.144) with 5 2B, 1 3B, 3 HR and 8 BB...when his pitch count sits from 1–15, opponents are 9-for-30 (.300) with 2 HR...when his pitch count sits between 16–75, opponents are 20-for-130 (.154) with 3 HR.
