RECENT REDBIRDS: The St. Louis Cardinals continue their first road trip since the All-Star break this evening when they open a two-game series at Cleveland's Progressive Field...it will be the Cardinals first visit to Cleveland since 2015...the Cardinals, who were off yesterday, posted a 10-6 win on Sunday at Cincinnati to claim one win in the 3-game weekend set with the Reds...the Redbirds completed their first homestand of the season's second half with a 5-2 mark (2-1 vs. SF, 3-1 vs. CHI) and by doing so had climbed above .500 (49-48) for the first time since June 20 (36-35)...the Cardinals have won or split five of their last seven series since June 28 (13-9 record)...St. Louis began the day in 3rd place in the NL Central, 8.0 games behind 1st place Milwaukee.

TRANSACTION: The Cardinals recalled OF **Lane Thomas** from Memphis (AAA) today and optioned RHP **Johan Oviedo** to the triple-A club...the right-handed hitting Thomas was batting .265, 4 HR's & 20 RBI in 30 games at Memphis. He's appeared in 32 games with St. Louis in 2021, most recently on June 20.

TRADE: The Cardinals announced a trade with Toronto on Sunday afternoon, acquiring RHP **T.J. Zeuch** in exchange for cash considerations. The 6-7, 245-pound Zeuch (pronounced ZOYK) was then optioned to Memphis (AAA). The 2016 No. 1 draft choice of Toronto has appeared in 13 games (7 starts) for the Blue Jays since debuting in 2019.

ROOKIE HOMERS: **Dylan Carlson** on Sunday became the 34th Cardinals rookie to hit 10 homers, and is just one shy of matching **Tommy Edman**'s STL rookie mark of 11 by a switch-hitter, set in 2019. Carlson's 10 rookie HR's match **Stan Musial**'s rookie tally from 1942.

GOLDY 3 HITS SHY OF 1,500: **Paul Goldschmidt** had his 21-game on-base streak snapped on Sunday, one shy of **Tyler O'Neill**'s team season-high streak of 22...Goldy, who last week attained his 10-year MLB service milestone, is in need of just 3 hits for 1,500 career.

ROAD TO RECOVERY: **Miles Mikolas** (right forearm), made his first injury rehab start on Sat. for Memphis (AAA), throwing 3.0 perfect IP (29 pitches) in his first game action since May 22. **Jack Flaherty** (left oblique) is slated to begin a rehab tonight in a start for Memphis. Flaherty last pitched on May 31.

BADER TATERS: Sunday marked the 8th multi-hit game of July for **Harrison Bader**, and his 5th in the last seven games. Bader is batting .362 (25-69) since returning from the I.L. (rib fracture) on July 1, including a 1.030 OPS, just shy of **Paul Goldschmidt**'s 1.031 July mark.

KIZ CATCHES: **Andrew Knizner** caught all three games of the weekend series at Cincinnati while **Yadier Molina** was sidelined by neck tightness. Knizner had 3-walk games on both Sat. & Sun. tying the club mark for consecutive 3-walk games, done 20 times, but never by a catcher. On Friday he matched his season high with 2 hits (4th time) and also matched his career-high with 2 RBI.

STADIUM TOUR: **Adam Wainwright** is slated to make his first career appearance at Cleveland's Progressive Field tonight, his team record 33rd venue pitched in, four more than **Matt Morris**' 29...**Joe Smith** (HOU) is the current active MLB leader with 37...**Wade LeBlanc** has worked in 32 different stadiums.

BEALE STREET BOOGIE: The Memphis Redbirds (AAA) won their franchise record 15th consecutive game on Sunday with a 9-3 win over the Louisville Bats, the Reds Triple-A affiliate. The Redbirds are 36-36 on the season.

INNINGS EATERS: Four of the Cardinals position players rank 1st or 2nd in the NL in innings played at their respective positions: Molina (617.2-2nd), Goldschmidt (815.1-2nd), Arenado (820.1-1st), Carlson (832.1-1st). IF/OF Tommy Edman (824.1) ranks 7th overall in the NL in innings played.

THAT'S A SWITCH: **Dylan Carlson** (92 hits) and **Tommy Edman** (101) are looking to become the first pair of Cardinals switch-hitters with 100+ hits in a season since **Carlos Beltran** & **Rafael Furcal** did so in 2012. They'd be the youngest Cardinals switch-hitting duo to do so since **Gregg Jefferies** (25 yrs) & **Mark Whiten** (26 yrs) in 1993.

THIRD SMACKER: **Nolan Arenado** was a double shy of hitting for the cycle on Sunday, hitting his team-high 20th homer and upping his RBI total to a team leading 61. Arenado leads NL 3rd basemen in HR's (20) and doubles (27), and ranks 2nd in RBI to **Manny Machado**'s 65. Arenado has now hit 20-HR's in 5 of the last 6 seasons (missed during 2020 shortened season).

CLEVELAND CONNECTIONS

Yadier Molina was teammates with **Roberto Pérez** and **Eddie Rosario** for runner-up Puerto Rico in the 2017 World Baseball Classic.

Andrew Miller pitched parts of three seasons in Cleveland (2016-18)...named 2016 ALCS MVP.

Tommy Edman and **Cal Quantrill** were teammates at Stanford University for two seasons (2014-15).

Phil Maton was born in Paducah, KY...his favorite team growing up was the Cardinals.

T.J. McFarland was selected by Cleveland in the 4th round of the 2007 MLB draft...pitched five seasons (2007-12) in the Indians organization.

Indians Asst. Hitting Coach **Victor Rodriguez** played two seasons (1986-87) with AAA-Louisville in the Cardinals organization.

Oscar Mercado was originally selected by the Cardinals in the 2nd round of the 2013 MLB draft...traded to Cleveland for minor league outfielders **Conner Capel** and **Jhon Torres** (July 31, 2018).

Indians VP of Medical Services **Lonnie Soloff** attended St. Louis University...began baseball career with the Cardinals in 1996 as part of the PBATS internship program.

Terry Francona played in 86 games in 1990 with the Louisville Redbirds (AAA), including five at pitcher...his father, **Tito Francona**, played parts of two seasons (1965-66) with St. Louis...became a Cardinal via trade by the Indians in exchange for a player to be named (Dec. 15, 1964)...originally signed by the St. Louis Browns before the 1952 season (MLB debut for Baltimore in 1956).

Indians Director, Hitting Development **Alex Eckelman** played parts of five seasons in the Cardinals minor league organization (1997-2001).

Cardinals Director of International Operations and Admin **Luis Morales** previously worked four years with the Indians as Venezuelan Scouting Coord.

Cleveland Baseball Operations Vice President **Eric Binder** pitched part of the 2011 season in the Cardinals minor league organization.

Cardinals broadcaster **Ricky Horton** spent the 1991 season in the Indians minor league organization as a pitching coach and pitcher between Colorado Springs (AAA) and Canton-Akron (AA).

Cardinals Administrator of Baseball Information & Media Services **Chris Tunno** graduated from nearby Canfield (Ohio) High School.

The Cardinals and Indians played in Major League Baseball's inaugural Civil Rights Game on March 31, 2007 at AutoZone Park in Memphis, Tenn.

The Cardinals and Indians played an exhibition at League Park in Cleveland during the 1936 All-Star Game break (July 6), a game where 17-year-old pitcher **Bob Feller** made his unofficial debut with eight strikeouts in 3.0 innings.

The Cleveland Spiders were rivals of the St. Louis Browns in the American Association (1888-89) and National League (1892-99)...before the 1899 season, Spiders owners **Stanley** and **Frank DeHass Robison**, who also owned the St. Louis franchise, transferred Cleveland's best players (future Hall of Famers **Cy Young**, **Bobby Wallace**, and **Jesse Burkett**) to St. Louis and formed the St. Louis Perfectos...the Spiders endured the worst season in pro baseball history (20-134) and were disbanded as the NL contracted to eight teams.

The Cardinals won their 10,000th regular season game as a member of the National League with a 4-0 victory over Cleveland at Busch Stadium (June 25, 2018).

TONIGHT'S GAME

- Making team-high 20th start of 2021 & 413th career appearance (346th career start).
- Tonight's start is his 3rd since the All-Star break. Adam owns a career mark of 67-37, 3.42 ERA post All-Star and 28-8, 2.67 ERA in 63 career games (51 starts) in July.
- He and Yadier Molina will make their 293rd career start as batterymates tonight, 4th all-time (since records were kept in 1908) in Major League history. The pair are 13 games behind the Chicago White Sox duo Red Faber and Ray Schalk (306) for third place. Wainwright's next most frequent battery mate is Tony Cruz (17).
- Enters tonight's game as the 3rd-oldest active player (39.331) in the National League (4th in MLB), while Yadier Molina (39.014) is the 4th-oldest. Rich Hill (41.138) and former Cardinal Albert Pujols (41.192) are older.
- Is making his 25th career start after turning age 39, ranking 4th-most in Cards history.
- Is 3-2, 5.35 ERA in 7 road starts this season; 4-4, 2.70 ERA in 12 home starts.
- Is 85-45 in career games following a Cardinals loss, including 3-2 in six starts this year.
- His 94 career home wins rank 4th all-time in franchise history and trail only Clayton Kershaw (99) among active N.L. pitchers. At .614, he's one of just 15 Cardinals with a .600+ career win pct. at home (min. 60 decisions).
- Ranks 6th in the NL in Home ERA (2.79) and 4th in Home wins (15) from 2019-21.

LAST TIME OUT

- Exits game with 2-1 lead thru 7.0 innings, but Cubs tie it at 2-2 in 9th before Cardinals walk off a 3-2 win in the 10th on Yadier Molina's game-winning hit.

- Recored his 100th strikeout of the season in 7/16 start vs. SF giving him his 9th season with 100 or more strikeouts, 2nd all-time in Cardinals history trailing only Bob Gibson (14). Chris Carpenter, Matt Morris and Dizzy Dean rank T-3rd with six seasons each.
 - Has recorded nine starts tossing 100 or more pitches this season, most on the Cardinals (Flaherty, 2nd, 6) and T-6th among MLB pitchers. He's 3-2 with a 1.63 ERA in those games.
 - Recorded a team-leading six consecutive quality starts streak that ended on 7/6 at SF.
 - Threw 8.0 innings in a no decision at COL (7/1) allowing just two runs. It marked his third start of the season in which he pitched 8.0 or more innings and did not earn a win.
 - Enjoyed a solid month of June, ranking among NL monthly leaders in ERA (2.45-11th), Opp. BA (.202-13th), WHIP (0.94-9th), HR/9 IP (0.55-7th), SO/BB ratio (5.00-8th).
 - Recorded his 100th career pre All-Star break win on 6/20 at ATL, as he became only the 5th active pitcher to do so (Verlander, Greinke, Scherzer, Lester).
 - Posted two double-digit strikeout games: at ATL 6/20, 11 K & at WSH 4/20, 10 K, to bring his career total to 12.
 - Is MLB co-leader in sac. bunts (7) with Zach Davies-CHI & Antonio Senzatela-COL. Had a career single-season high 9 sac bunts in both 2007 & 2013.

- Making his first career appearance at Progressive Field and logging the 33rd ballpark of his regular season career (since 2005).
- After tonight, his only remaining active MLB ballparks to not appear in regular season play include Target Field, Fenway Park, and Globe Life Field. Waino never appeared at Original Yankee Stadium, Globe Life Park, or HHH Metrodome before replacement stadiums were constructed since he entered MLB.
- Waino's other MLB stadium notables include Mexico's Monterrey Stadium (2019 vs. Reds), Fenway Park (2013 World Series), RFK Stadium, Sun Life Stadium, Shea Stadium, Turner Field, Busch Stadium II (MLB debut & only career appearance), and Target Field (started 2014 MLB All-Star Game).
- Faced the Indians on Aug. 30, 2020 at Busch Stadium on his 39th birthday while teaming up with Yadier Molina who was playing in his 2,000th career game. Wainwright threw a four-hit complete game, allowing two runs in a 7-2 Cardinals win. Became the oldest pitching battery in Cardinals history to team up for a complete game. Also completed the cycle in making a start against every team (except St. Louis).
- Went 5,178 days between his first (6/27/06) and second (8/30/20) appearance against the Indians. Today marks 48 days since his third appearance.
- Making his 38th career Interleague start (44th app.) and has held his opposition to two runs or fewer in 19 of 37 starts. His 37 career starts in Interleague games ranks T-10th among active pitchers with Zack Greinke leading the way at 65.
- Career 9-5 with a 3.38 ERA in 17 career starts (23 app.) vs. AL Central opponents.
- Has made 17 career Interleague road starts (23 app) in AL Stadiums, going 8-6 with a 4.67 ERA. Converted his first career MLB save May 19, 2006 at KC.
