AT A GLANCE: The Yankees continue their six-game road trip tonight with the final game of a three-game set at Kansas City (2-0 thus far)...will also face the Athletics in a three-game series from Fri.-Sun.

- ▶ Their 33-22 (.600) record is the second-best in the American League and the fifth-best record in the Majors.
- ▶ Have won each of their last three games (since 5/24) and five of their last eight games (since 5/18)...are 25-15 in their last 40 games (since 4/13).
- ▶ Are in a stretch of playing 25 games in 27 days (5/1-27).
- ▶ Including this series, have won or split 10 of their last 13 series (7-3-3 since 4/13) and 13 of their 18 series this season (10-5-3).
- ▶ The Yankees'+82 run differential this season is the best in the AL and the third-best in the Majors.

YESTERDAY'S NEWS: The Yankees defeated the Royals, 15-1, on Tuesday at Kauffman Stadium...**Yankees batters** set season highs with 15R, 24H and 6HR...**RHP Cam Schlichter** (6.0IP, 4H, 1R/ER, OBB, 6K, 1HR) earned his seventh win of the year after allowing only 1R/ER in 6.0IP...**LF Cody Bellinger** (2-for-5, 1R, 1HR, 3RBI) hit a go-ahead solo HR in the first inning and hit a two-run single in the third inning...**DH Ben Rice** (3-for-5, 3R, 1 double, 1RBI, 1BB) reached base a season-high-tying four times and recorded a season-high-tying 3H, including an RBI single in the first inning...**3B Amed Rosario** (4-for-6, 3R, 2HR, 4RBI) recorded his fourth career multi-HR game, hitting a two-run HR in the first inning and a two-run shot in the ninth inning...**SS Anthony Volpe** (3-for-6, 3R, 1 double, 1HR, 2RBI) recorded a season-high 3H, hitting his first HR of the year with a solo shot in the second inning and an RBI single in the third inning...**CF Trent Grisham** (3-for-7, 1R, 1HR, 2RBI) recorded a season-high-tying 3H and drove in two runs, recording an RBI groundout in the third inning and hitting his seventh HR of the year with a solo shot in the seventh inning...**RF Aaron Judge** (2-for-3, 1 double, 1RBI, 2BB) reached base a season-high-tying four times, including an RBI double in the fifth inning...**2B Jazz Chisholm Jr.** (2-for-5, 2R, 1HR, 1RBI, 1BB) reached base three times and hit a solo HR in the eighth inning...**C Austin Wells** (3-for-6, 1R, 1RBI) recorded a career-high-tying 3H, including an RBI single in the eighth inning...**LHP Ryan Yarbrough** (3.0IP, 2H, 1BB) recorded his first save of the year after tossing 3.0 scoreless innings of relief.

- ▶ The Yankees' 14 run differential on Tuesday marked their largest margin of victory since a 16-0 win on 7/6/22 at Pittsburgh.
- BRONX BOMBERS:** Yankees batters set season highs with 15 runs, 24 hits and 6HR on Tuesday at Kansas City...marked their most runs in a game since 4/29/25 at Baltimore (also 15R).
- ▶ **Marked only the 12th time in franchise history and only the third time in the last 52 years (since 1975) the Yankees have recorded at least 24H in a single game** (also 24H on 7/30/11-G2 vs. Baltimore and 25H on 7/22/07 vs. Tampa Bay).
 - ▶ Their 6HR were their most in a game since 8/27/25 vs. Washington (also 6HR).
 - ▶ **Marked the first time in franchise history that each of the Yankees' starters recorded multi-hit games**

FOR STARTERS: Yankees starters have posted a 3.04 ERA (301.2IP, 102ER) and 295K in 55 starts this season...**have allowed 3R-or-fewer in 47 of their 55 starts this season, tied with Milwaukee for the most in the Majors...also marks their second-most in franchise history through their first 55 games of a season**, trailing only their 49 starts in 2022.

- ▶ Have allowed 2R-or-fewer in each of their last six starts (since 5/20), posting a 1.50 ERA (36.0IP, 6ER) over that span...have allowed 1R-or-fewer in four of their last five starts (since 5/21).
- ▶ Have allowed 3R-or-fewer in each of their last seven starts and 15 of their last 16 starts (since 5/9).
- ▶ **Lead the Majors in opponents' SLG (.318), opponents' OPS (.599) and HR/9.0IP (0.75)**, rank second in ERA (3.04, second in AL) and WHIP (1.10, first in AL), third in opponents' BA (.210, first in AL), opponents' OBP (.281, second in AL), fourth in strikeout rate (24.1%, third in AL), fifth in innings pitched (301.2, fourth in AL), tied for sixth in strikeouts (295, third in AL), seventh in K/BB (2.95, fourth in AL) and ninth in BB/9.0IP (2.98, fifth in AL).

RICE RICE BABY: C/INF Ben Rice

reached base a season-high-tying four times and recorded a season-high-tying 3H on Tuesday at Kansas City, including an RBI single in the first inning...has hit .285/.378/.615 (51-for-179) with 39R, 11 doubles, 16HR, 34RBI, 26BB/21BB, 2HP, 2SF and 2SB in 50 games this season...has reached base safely in 37-of-46 starts.

PITCH PERFECT: Yankees pitchers have allowed 3ER-or-fewer in each of their last six games (since 5/20), posting a 1.83 ERA (54.0IP, 11ER) over that span.

ALL RISE: OF Aaron Judge reached base a season-high-tying four times on Tuesday at Kansas City, including an RBI double in the fifth inning...has reached base in 7-of-13PA over his last three games (since 5/24), going 5-for-11 (.455) with 1R, 2 doubles, 1HR, 3RBI and 2BB over that span.

- ▶ Has hit .359/.453/.758 (46-for-128) with 28R, 9 doubles, 14HR, 32RBI, 22BB/21BB and 35B in 34 games vs. the Royals since 2019...has hit 4HR in his last nine games against Kansas City (since 4/16/25) and 12HR in his last 25 games (since 4/29/22).

ALL THAT JAZZ: INF Jazz Chisholm Jr.

reached base three times and hit his sixth HR of the year with a solo shot in the eighth inning on Tuesday at Kansas City...is batting .400/.471/.667 (18-for-45) with 8R, 4 doubles, 1 triple, 2HR, 6RBI, 6BB and 2SB over his last 12 games (since 5/13).

- ▶ Has reached base multiple times in eight of his last 11G (since 5/15).

SAVED BY THE BELL: INF/OF Cody Bellinger drove in three runs on Tuesday at Kansas City, hitting a go-ahead solo HR in the first inning and hit a two-run single in the third inning...has homered in back-to-back games for the first time this season and first since 8/27-28/25 (also 2G)...has hit .326/.393/.500 (15-for-46) with 4 doubles, 2 triples, 22RBI, 7BB and 3SF with RISP this year.

- ▶ Is hitting .316/.411/.621 (30-for-95) with 16R, 10 doubles, 2 triples, 5HR, 22RBI, 16BB, 2SB and 1SF over his last 26G (since 4/28).
- ▶ According to FanGraphs and Sports Info Solutions, leads all Major League LF in DRS (12) and is tied for third in go-ahead RBI (11, tied for first in AL).

MATCHING UP: The Yankees have won each of their last 12 regular season games vs. Kansas City (since 9/11/24), marking their longest winning streak vs. an opponent since their 12-game winning streak vs. Boston from 9/7/19-9/19/20...their last longer streak was a 19-game winning streak vs. Baltimore from 4/4/19-9/4/20-G1.

- ▶ **Including the postseason, the Yankees have won each of their last 13 games vs. the Royals (since 10/9/24) and 15 of their last 16 games (since 9/11/24)...have gone 19-3 against Kansas City since 2024 (16-2 during the regular season and 3-1 in the 2024 ALDS).**
- ▶ Including the postseason, the Yankees are 30-6 in their last 36G vs. Kansas City (since 8/11/21)...are also 33-7 in their last 40G (since 6/23/21) and 38-9 in their last 47G (since 4/19/19).
- ▶ **Including their current series, have won 22 of their last 23 series vs. the Royals** (including the postseason) since 5/25/15, going 56-16 in that span...their 54-17 (.761) record vs. the Royals in the regular season since 2015 is the highest winning pct. by any team vs. an opponent in their league over that span.
- ▶ **Are 20-5 at Kauffman Stadium in their last 25 games since 5/19/18 (including the postseason)**...including the postseason, are 30-12 in their last 42G at Kansas City since 2013.
- ▶ **Are 5-0 vs. the Royals this season...with a win tonight, it would mark just the 11th time in franchise history the Yankees went 6-0-or-better vs. a single opponent in a season**...went 10-0 vs. Kansas City in 1998, 9-0 vs. Cleveland in 1994, 7-0 vs. Minnesota in 2003 and 2009, and 6-0 vs. Kansas City in 2001 and 2025, Minnesota in 2002 and 2024, New York-NL in 2003 and Cleveland in 2007.

TO THE LEFT, TO THE LEFT: The Yankees are 12-5 when facing a left-handed starter this season...have won 10 of their last 11 games when facing a left-handed starter (since 4/18) and 11 of their last 14 games (since 4/13).

SUPER ROSARIO: INF/OF Amed Rosario recorded his fourth career multi-HR game and second of the season on Tuesday at Kansas City (also 2HR on 4/7 vs. the Athletics), hitting a two-run HR in the first inning and a two-run shot in the ninth inning...also set a season high with 4H and tied his season high with 4RBI.

- ▶ Has hit .308/.323/.654 (8-for-26) with 3HR, 14RBI, 2BB and 3SF with RISP this season.
- ▶ Over his last 13 starts (since 4/18), has batted .326/.373/.630 (15-for-46) with 11R, 2 doubles, 4HR, 13RBI, 4BB and 1SF.

HIGH VOLTAGE: INF Anthony Volpe recorded a season-high 3H on Tuesday at Kansas City, hitting his first HR of the year with a solo shot in the second inning and an RBI single in the third inning...is batting .346 (9-for-26) with 6R, 3 doubles, 1HR, 7RBI, 3BB and 2SB over his last seven games (since 5/17).

- ▶ Has reached base in 17-of-37PA over his last nine games (since 5/15), posting a .459 OBP during that stretch (9H, 8BB).

MERRY GRISHMAS: OF Trent Grisham recorded a season-high-tying 3H and drove in two runs on Tuesday at Kansas City, recording an RBI groundout in the third inning and hitting his seventh HR of the year with a solo shot in the seventh inning...is batting .435/.480/.696 (10-for-23) with 2R, 3 doubles, 1HR, 2RBI and 2BB over his last six games (since 5/19).

TONIGHT'S STARTING PITCHER: RHP GERRIT COLE (0-0, 0.00)

RHP Gerrit Cole will make his second start of the season in tonight's series finale at Kansas City...the 35-year-old will pitch on regular four days' rest...made his season debut on Friday vs. Tampa Bay and tossed 6.0 scoreless innings in a no-decision (2H, 3BB, 2K)...marked his first Major League game since 2024 World Series Game 5 vs. the Dodgers...missed the entire 2025 season and the first 51 games of this season recovering from "Tommy John" surgery...the six-time All-Star (2015, '18-19, '21-23) was unanimously named the 2023 American League Cy Young Award winner and has finished in the top-five of Cy Young Award voting six times (first in 2023, second in 2019 and 2021, fourth in 2015 and 2020, and fifth in 2018)...his career 10.35 K/9.0IP ratio (2,253K/1,960.0IP) is the 10th-highest in Major League history (min. 1,000.0IP)...in 126 starts with the Yankees, is 59-28 with a 3.09 ERA (765.0IP, 263ER) and 917K...since 2018, is tied for first in the Majors in shutouts (five), ranks second in strikeouts (1,519), winning percentage (.712, min. 70 decisions), WHIP (1.00) and opponents' OBP (.260), third in wins (94), ERA (2.95), opponents' OPS (.614), complete games (seven) and WAR among pitchers (30.6 - FanGraphs), fourth in K/9.0IP (11.61) and opponents' BA (.204), sixth in K/BB (5.06) and eighth in opponents' SLG (.354)...is the first Yankee in franchise history to record at least 200K in three different seasons...owns two of the Yankees' top three single-season strikeout records and three of the top-eight records (his 257K in 2022 are the most in franchise history, his 243K in 2021 are the third-most in franchise history and his 222K in 2023 are tied for the seventh-most in Yankees history)...was originally selected by the Yankees in the first round (28th overall) of the 2008 First-Year Player Draft but did not sign and went on to play at UCLA for three seasons (2009-11)...was the first overall pick of the 2011 First-Year Player Draft, the 15th pitcher (and 11th right-hander) to be chosen first...is the fifth player selected first overall to play for the Yankees, joining Alex Rodriguez, Darryl Strawberry, Tim Lincecum and Ron Blomberg...signed a nine-year contract extending through the 2028 season with a player opt-out following the 2024 season on 12/18/19.

LAST TIME OUT: Made his season debut on Friday vs. Tampa Bay, tossing 6.0 scoreless innings in a no-decision...marked first Major League start since 2024 World Series Game 5 vs. the Dodgers...retired 15 of his final 17BF (1H, 1BB).

ROAD TO RECOVERY: Missed the first 51 games of this season and the entire 2025 season recovering from "Tommy John" surgery...made only one spring training start in 2025 before undergoing "Tommy John" surgery on 3/11/25...the procedure was performed by Dr. Neal ElAttrache at Cedars-Sinai Kerlan-Jobe Institute in Los Angeles, Calif.

- ✦ Made six combined rehab starts with High-A Hudson Valley, Double-A Somerset and Triple-A Scranton/Wilkes-Barre, going 0-2 with a 4.66 ERA (29.0IP, 28H, 17R/15ER, 3BB, 28K, 6HR)...made his final rehab start with Scranton/WB on 5/16 vs. Syracuse and allowed only 1R/ER in 5.1IP (ND, 6H, 1BB, 6K, 0HR).

2024: Went 8-5 with a 3.41 ERA (95.0IP, 36ER) in 17 starts with the Yankees in 2024...missed the first 75 games of the season on the 60-day injured list with right elbow inflammation...allowed 2R-or-fewer in 12 of his 17 starts, including 10 of his final 13 starts (7/12-9/26) and 11 of his final 15 starts (6/30-9/26)...allowed 1ER-or-fewer in seven of his final nine starts (8/10-G2-9/26), nine of his final 13 starts (7/12-9/26) and 10 of his final 15 starts (6/30-9/26).

- ✦ Went 7-4 with a 2.67 ERA (77.2IP, 23ER) and 80K in his final 13 starts from 7/12-9/26...was 5-3 with a 2.25 ERA (60.0IP, 15ER) and 61K over his final 10 starts of the season from 8/4-9/26.
- ✦ Allowed 19 of his 38R and seven of his 11HR in three of his starts: 6R/4HR on 6/25 at the Mets, 6R/3HR on 7/24 vs. the Mets and 7R/0HR on 9/14 vs. Boston...in his 14 other starts, went 8-2 with a 1.89 ERA (81.0IP, 17ER) and 93K.
- ✦ Went 1-0 with a 2.17 ERA (29.0IP, 27H, 13R/7ER, 10BB, 22K, 1HR) in five postseason starts...allowed 3ER-or-fewer in each of those five starts and 2ER-or-fewer in four of those starts.

IN PINSTRIPE: In 126 starts with the Yankees, is 59-28 with a 3.09 ERA (765.0IP, 263ER) and 917K...has allowed 3ER-or-fewer in 99-of-126 starts, the ninth-most in the AL in that span...has allowed 2ER-or-fewer in 87 starts as a Yankee, tied for the sixth-most in the AL...has recorded 25 scoreless starts as a Yankee, tied for the sixth-most scoreless starts by any AL pitcher in that span.

- ✦ Since 2020, leads the Majors in opponents' OBP (.264), ranks third in WHIP (1.02, second in AL), third in K/9.0IP (10.79, first in AL), fourth in opponents' BA (.211, first in AL) and K/BB (4.88, third in AL), and fifth in winning percentage (.678, first in AL, min. 60 decisions), ERA (3.09, second in AL, min. 700.0IP) and opponents' OPS (.627, second in AL).
- ✦ Was unanimously named the American League Cy Young Award winner in 2023...became the sixth player in Yankees history to win the award, joining Roger Clemens (2001), Ron Guidry (1978), Sparky Lyle (1977), Whitey Ford (1961) and Bob Turley (1958)...was the seventh American League pitcher (11th time) to win the Cy Young Award unanimously, joining Justin Verlander (2011, '22), Johan Santana (2004, '06), Pedro Martinez (1999-2000), Roger Clemens (1986, '98), Ron Guidry (1978) and Denny McLain (1968)...joined Guidry as the only two Yankees to win the award unanimously...has finished in the top-five of Cy Young Award voting in three of his first five seasons he has pitched in pinstripes (first in 2023, second in 2021, fourth in 2020).
