THE TWINS: Have gone 4-2 through six games on their current seven-game homestand, going 2-1 vs. Boston last weekend, followed by a win, a loss and a win against the Mariners the last three nights...today, the Twins will play the four-game series finale against the Mariners... after today's game, Minnesota will travel to Toronto for a short roadtrip with three at Rogers Centre over the weekend.

☞ Twins have won 14 of their last 16 games...since April 22, the Twins lead baseball in wins (14-2), ahead of the Dodgers (13-2) and Phillies (12-4).

☞ Twins have gone 8-2 in their last 10 home games after starting the season 2-6 in their first eight at Target Field.

WE GOT A THING FOR KIRBYS HERE: The Twins beat George Kirby, Kirby Snead and the Mariners last night at Target Field by a score of 6-3...Chris Paddock (4-1) was the starter and winner, allowing one run on eight hits in 5.0 innings pitched, with one walk and 10 strikeouts...Jhoan Duran earned his third save of the season and 20th of his career at Target Field, tying Brandon Kintzler for fourth most in the ballpark's history (since 2010)...the offense recorded seven hits, three being home runs from Carlos Correa (2), Trevor Larnach (3) and Willi Castro (3)...Correa and Larnach went back-to-back in the first inning and Castro hit his in the second inning.

TWINS AND MS: The Twins and Mariners are playing each other for the fourth of seven games this season...after this series, Minnesota will travel to Seattle for three games from June 28-30.

☞ Ryan Jeffers is hitting .349 (15-for-43) with five walks, a .429 on-base percentage, a .558 slugging percentage and a .987 OPS in 15 career games against Seattle.

☞ Carlos Correa has 112 career hits and 113 games played against the Mariners, both his most vs. any opponent...both his 112 hits and 113 games are sixth-most among actives.

☞ Max Kepler is hitting .421 (16-for-38) with eight doubles, two home runs, nine RBI, a .789 SLG and a 1.228 OPS in his last 10 games vs. Seattle, dating back to July of 2023.

SERIES FINALE: The Twins are looking for their sixth series win this season...their five series wins came March 28-31 at Kansas City, April 22-25 vs. Chicago-AL, April 26-28 at Los Angeles-AL, April 29-May 1 at Chicago-AL and May 3-5 vs. Boston (full list to the lower right).

☞ Twins last series win over Seattle was June 13-15, 2022 at T-Mobile Park, winning two of three...last series win over the Ms at Target Field was June 11-13, 2019, taking two of three.

☞ Twins are looking for five consecutive series wins for the first time since they finished the 2023 season (3-1 at Chicago-AL, 2-1 at Cincinnati, 2-1 vs. Los Angeles-AL, 2-1 vs. Oakland and 2-1 at Colorado).

MAXING OUT: Max Kepler enters tonight with a career-high tying 10-game hitting streak, matching his previous high, done twice in 2019...since coming off the Injured List on April 22 (right knee contusion), Kepler has hit .429 (21-for-49) with eight doubles, two home runs, seven walks, 12 RBI, a .491 on-base percentage and a 1.206 OPS in 15 games.

☞ Kepler's streak ties Willi Castro (April 24-May 4) for longest by a Twin this season...a hit today will give Kepler the longest hitting streak for a Twin since Ryan Jeffers hit in 14 straight from July 15-August 9, 2023.

☞ Kepler's 10-game hitting streak is the second-longest active hitting streak in baseball, trailing Jake Cronenworth (12).

☞ Each of Kepler's last six hits have gone for doubles...according to Elias, six straight hits as doubles is longest since Buxton did it from April 16-21, 2019...six doubles this month lead MLB.

BACKSTOP BREAKOUT: Ryan Jeffers is hitting .365 (19-for-52) with eight doubles, four home runs, 15 RBI, four walks, a .433 on-base percentage, a .750 slugging percentage and a 1.183 OPS in his last 15 games, since April 22...Jeffers has reached base safely in a career-high 15-straight, the longest for a Twin since Edoardo Julien reached in 23 straight from September 6, 2023-March 30, 2024...below are Jeffers' ranks among AL catchers (as primary position):

DANNY DARTS UPDATE: Right-handed pitcher Daniel Duarte had successful ulnar collateral ligament revision reconstruction surgery yesterday in Dallas, TX by Dr. Keith Meister...Duarte made two appearances for the Twins in April before landing on the 15-day IL.

PROLIFIC PABLO DAY PREMIERE: Last pitched May 4 vs. Boston, earning his second-straight win and third of the season in Minnesota's 3-1 victory...allowed one run on five hits in 6.0 innings, with one walk and a season-high-tying eight strikeouts...only run came in the first; Tyler O'Neill doubled with two outs, then Wilyer Abreu ended a 10-pitch at-bat with an RBI single...allowed only three more baserunners after the first inning.

- ⚡ Generated a season-high 19 whiffs on 47 swings (40.4%)...improved 2024 whiff rate to 30.8 percent, which ranks in MLB's 81st percentile.
- ⚡ Allowed just three hard-hit balls (95.0+ mph); each resulted in a groundout...induced season-high nine ground balls.

TWO STARTS AGO: Started April 28 at Los Angeles-AL, opposite Reid Detmers, earning his second win of the season in Minnesota's 11-5 victory...allowed four runs on four hits (2 HR) in 5.0 innings, with one walk and a season-high eight strikeouts...retired 14-straight hitters to begin the game, including six strikeouts in innings 1-3...with two outs in the fifth, allowed five-straight baserunners: Logan O'Hoppe double, Jo Adell double, Luis Rengifo home run, Nolan Schanuel home run and Mike Trout walk; induced a Zach Neto popout to end the fifth and didn't return.

- ⚡ Generated 13 whiffs on 42 swings (31.0%).
- ⚡ Angels had five hard-hit balls...went 2-for-5 on those balls, including the Rengifo (95.7 mph) and Schanuel (99.8 mph) home runs.

PABLO VS. SEATTLE: Has made two career starts vs. Seattle, on July 20 and 25, 2023...went 0-1 with a 3.00 ERA (12.0 IP, 4 ER), three home runs allowed, three walks and 15 strikeouts...Julio Rodríguez is the only active Seattle hitter who's homered off López...in the Target Field matchup, on July 25, López allowed two runs in 7.0-inning no-decision; Seattle scored seven runs off Minnesota's bullpen and won 9-7.

- ⚡ Was originally signed by Seattle as an international free agent in 2012; pitched 60 games in the organization before being traded to Miami on July 20, 2017 in a deal that sent David Phelps to Seattle.

HOME/ROAD SPLITS: Making fourth home start of 2024...has gone 1-1 at home with a 4.02 ERA (15.2 IP, 7 ER), a 1.213 WHIP, four walks and 16 strikeouts, compared to 2-1 in four road starts with a 4.50 ERA (22.0 IP, 11 ER), 0.91 WHIP, four walks and 29 strikeouts...has allowed a .254 batting average (15-for-59), .653 OPS and 1.6 percent home run rate at home, compared to .198 (16-for-81), .680 and 5.9 percent on the road...this afternoon is the second of several **Pablo Days** at Target Field this season.

PABLO DAYS: The Twins, in partnership with Pablo and Kaylee López, announced a special 'Pablo Day' ticket package for each of Pablo's home starts at Target Field from **May to September** that includes an exclusive, Venezuela-inspired jersey and philanthropic contributions to three local nonprofits designated by the López family...for more info, visit twins.com/pabloday.

LEFT/RIGHT SPLITS: On May 4, Boston's left-handed hitters went 3-for-12 with a walk and three strikeouts vs. López, while righties went 2-for-10 with a double and five strikeouts...through seven games vs. López this season, left-handed hitters have hit .234 (18-for-77) with a .662 OPS, 27.2 percent strikeout rate and 3.7 percent home run rate, while righties have hit .206 (13-for-63) with a .677 OPS, 33.8 percent strikeout rate and 4.4 percent home run rate.

- ⚡ Lefties have a 35.7 percent hard-hit rate and 86.7 mph average exit velocity vs. López, righties 55.0 percent and 91.0 mph.
- ⚡ Facing right-handed pitching this season, Seattle has hit .223 (202-for-908) with a .664 OPS and 29.0 percent strikeout rate...MLB average vs. righties is .237 with a .695 OPS.

- ⚡ Threw season-high 31 sweepers vs. Boston...Red Sox hitters went 1-for-7 with two strikeouts vs. the pitch, whiffing four times in 12 swings (33.3%).
- ⚡ Boston went 1-for-8 with five strikeouts vs. López's 4-seamer...pitch has allowed the second-lowest batting average in baseball (min. 50 PA), trailing only Ryan Pepiot (.069).
- ⚡ Sweeper has allowed a .267 batting average (26th highest of 29 pitchers, min. 25 PA) but a .202 expected batting average (14th of 29).

DAYTIME DOMINANCE: Has a 3.03 ERA (29.2 IP, 10 ER) in five daytime starts this season, compared to a 9.00 ERA (8.0 IP, 8 ER) in two night starts...only Zack Wheeler and JP Sears have made more daytime starts (6)...the two night starts were López's shortest thus far in 2024 - April 12 at Detroit and April 23 vs. Chicago-AL, both 4.0 innings.

- ⚡ Acquired from Miami on January 20 along with prospects José Salas and Byron Chourio.
- ⚡ Threw 5.1 scoreless innings and won Opening Day start March 30 at Kansas City.
- ⚡ Signed four-year extension April 21, keeping him under contract through 2027 season.
- ⚡ Tossed first career complete-game shutout with 12 strikeouts vs. Kansas City on July 5.
- ⚡ Selected to first All-Star team, pitching a scoreless ninth inning with two strikeouts.
- ⚡ Set another career-high with 14 strikeouts September 10 vs. New York-NL, throwing eight scoreless frames in a 2-0 loss.
- ⚡ Ranked in 98th percentile in baseball in pitching run value (26), 95th percentile in chase percentage (34.3%), 93rd percentile in xERA (3.00).
- ⚡ Earned first Cy Young Award votes of his career and finished seventh in AL voting.
- ⚡ Won Game 1 of ALWCs vs. Toronto on October 3 at Target Field, throwing 5.2 innings as Minnesota snapped an 18-game Postseason losing streak.
- ⚡ Threw 7.0 shutout frames in Game 2 of the ALDS at Houston, earning Minnesota's only win of the series.

Joe Ryan is scheduled to start tomorrow night's series opener in Toronto...last pitched May 5 vs. Boston and took his second loss of the season; allowed three runs on four hits (1 HR) in 6.0 innings, with one walk and five strikeouts...allowed fifth-inning, two-run, go-ahead home run by Ceddanne Rafaela...was his third-straight quality start and fifth of the season...only career appearance vs. Toronto came June 10, 2023 at Rogers Centre; allowed three runs on six hits in 6.0-inning no-decision, with one walk and four strikeouts.
