LHP Jake Bennett (7-5, 3.17 ERA) vs. RHP Bubba Chandler (5-8, 4.26 ERA)

THE PIRATES: will begin a six-game homestand vs. Boston (Friday-Sunday) and Detroit (August 17-19) with tonight's series opener vs. the Red Sox at PNC Park (their first home interleague games since June 23-25 vs. Seattle)...Wrapped up a brief, three-game road trip to Miami (1-2, Tuesday-Thursday) with a 13-1 win on Thursday at loanDepot park (it marked their largest win since a 14-2 victory on July 5, 2024 vs. New York-NL and their largest road win since a 16-1 victory on April 29 [G2], 2023 at Washington)...Have hit 149 home runs (they hit 117 home runs all of last season)...Have the most hits (1090) in all of Major League Baseball (Los Angeles-NL, 1067, ranks second on the list)...Have scored the third-most runs (617) in all of Major League Baseball, behind Washington (662) and Chicago-NL (634), after scoring 583 runs all of last season... Have struck out the third-most batters (1137) in all of Major League Baseball, behind Philadelphia (1208) and Milwaukee (1186).

AMERICAN SPIRIT: Pittsburgh will host Boston (Friday-Sunday) and Detroit (August 17-19) during this six-game homestand at PNC Park...The Pirates are 10-2 at home during interleague play this season...They swept a three-game series from April 3-5 vs. Baltimore, won two of three games from April 17-19 vs. Tampa Bay, swept a three-game series from May 29-31 vs. Minnesota and won two of three games from June 23-25 vs. Seattle...Pittsburgh has also won seven straight home interleague series, dating back to its three-game sweep from July 21-23, 2025 vs. Detroit (the team has never won eight straight home interleague series).

IRON CITY BRYAN: Bryan Reynolds has played in each of Pittsburgh's 123 games this season and 132 straight team games (he missed his last game last season on September 17 vs. Chicago-NL)...Per the Elias Sports Bureau, that is tied with Andrew McCutchen (2011) for the fourth-longest such streak by any Pirates player since 1989, trailing only Jason Bay (307 games, 2004-06), Bobby Bonilla (189 games, 1989-90) and Kevin Young (142 games, 1998)...He is also on pace to be the seventh Pirate (10th instance) in the Expansion Era (since 1961) to play in all of the team's games in a year and the first since Bay (162 games, 2005).

YOU COMPLETE ME: Braxton Ashcraft pitched his first career complete game after tossing just 85 pitches in Pittsburgh's 13-1 win on Thursday at Miami...It marked the first 9.0-inning complete game by a Pirate since Mitch Keller (May 6, 2024 vs. Los Angeles-AL) and the first such complete game on the road since Johan Oviedo (August 28, 2023 at Kansas City)...Ashcraft became the third Pittsburgh pitcher (since pitch counts began being tracked in 1988) to throw a 9.0-inning complete game on 85 or fewer pitches, joining Doug Drabek (80 pitches, September 30, 1990 at St. Louis) and Jeff Karstens (83 pitches, July 15, 2011 at Houston)...He also became the first Major League pitcher (since 1988) to do that while striking out at least 10 batters during the complete game.

GO WITH THE FLO: Rafael Flores Jr. posted his first career multi-homer game after hitting two three-run homers on Thursday at Miami...He was the ninth Pirates catcher (11th instance) with at least six RBI in a game (since RBI became official 1920) and the first since Francisco Cervelli (April 25 [G1], 2018 vs. Detroit)...Flores Jr. also became the fifth Pittsburgh catcher (sixth instance) to have at least two home runs and six RBI in a game (since 1920) and the first since Don Slaught (July 2 [G1], 1993 at Cincinnati)... Per the Elias Sports Bureau, he joined Tony Peña (August 31, 1984 at Cincinnati) and Slaught as the only Pirates catchers ever to hit multiple home runs with multiple men on base in a game...He was the first Buc to hit multiple homers in the eighth inning or later of any contest since Andrew McCutchen (July 30, 2017 at San Diego).

FROM THE TOP DOWN: Pittsburgh's No. 7-9 hitters (Jake Mangum, Jared Triolo and Rafael Flores Jr.) combined for eight hits (including a double, a triple and three homers), 10 RBI and eight runs on Thursday at Miami...It was the first time the Pirates got at least eight hits and 10 RBI from their bottom three hitters in the order since Brant Brown, Jose Guillen and Mike Benjamin combined for eight hits & 10 RBI in a 15-3 victory on June 9, 1999 at Detroit.

SHIPPING UP TO BRYAN: Bryan Reynolds is 17-for-40 (.425) with two doubles, six home runs, 13 RBI, eight walks and a 1.435 OPS in his 12 career contests against Boston...He has the fourth-highest batting average against the Red Sox (minimum 40 at-bats) in MLB since August 16, 2022 (his first game against Boston)...He trails only Jake Mangum (.476), Chicago (NL)'s Alex Bregman (.457) & Los Angeles (NL)' Freddie Freeman (.438) on the list.

August 14, 2015: Clint Hurdle became the ninth manager in franchise history to reach the 400-win mark as the Pirates secured a 3-2, 10-inning win over the Mets at Citi Field. Gregory Polanco broke a 1-1 tie with his 10th-inning single that scored Starling Marte, while Aramis Ramirez added to the lead with a sacrifice fly that scored Francisco Cervelli. Mark Melancon secured his 36th save in 37 attempts.

HOW ACQUIRED: Selected in the third round of the 2021 Draft.

LAST TIME OUT: Chandler won a 9-0 decision after allowing four baserunners (three hits and one walk) while striking out five batters over 6.0 scoreless innings on August 8 vs. New York (NL)...His 2.36 ERA (26.2ip/7er) in his last five starts (since July 11 [G2] vs. Milwaukee) ranks 11th in the National League in that stretch (minimum 26.2 innings).

HOMER HIATUS: Chandler allowed nine home runs over 74.0 innings of work (1.09 home runs per 9.0 innings) in his first 15 games (14 starts) from March 31-June 19... He has allowed one home run across 42.1 innings in his last eight starts, dating back to June 25 vs. Seattle (it came from Washington’s Luis García Jr. on July 5)...Chandler is one of only five Major League pitchers with at least 42.1 innings and only one home run allowed during that stretch, along with Baltimore’s Shane Baz (45.1ip), St. Louis’ Andre Pallante (47.1ip), Miami’s Eury Pérez (49.1ip) and Arizona’s Brandon Pfaadt (47.2ip).

AMERICAN MAN: Chandler is 4-2 with a 2.95 ERA (36.2ip/12er) in seven career interleague starts...He has gone 3-0 with a 1.10 ERA (16.1ip/2er) and a .158 batting average against (9-for-57) over three career home starts against the American League.

RIGHT ON: Chandler has limited right-handed hitters to a .217 batting average against (44-for-203) and a .600 OPS this season...The only righthanders to take him deep were Chicago (NL)’s Dansby Swanson (April 12) and San Francisco’s Heliot Ramos (May 10).

WHAT A RELIEF: Chandler allowed just one hit and struck out seven batters over 5.1 innings out of the bullpen on June 7 at Atlanta...He became only the second Pirates reliever in the Modern Era (since 1901) to pitch at least 5.0 innings, strike out at least seven batters and allow one or zero hits in an appearance...Chandler joined Bill Swift, who did that over his 7.1 innings out of the bullpen on July 28 (G2), 1935 vs. St. Louis.

GIMME FIVE: Chandler struck out a career-high 11 batters in 5.0 innings on May 22 at Toronto...He joined Erik Bedard (May 3, 2012 at St. Louis) as the only Pirates in the Modern Era (since 1901) to have at least 11 strikeouts in an outing of 5.0 or fewer innings...Chandler also became one of 11 Major Leaguers (since earned runs became an official stat in both leagues in 1913) to have at least 11 strikeouts and zero earned runs in an outing of 5.0 or fewer innings (he was only the fourth rookie to accomplish that).

A BIT OF BOTH: Chandler went 2-1 with a 5.12 ERA (19.1ip/11er) in four starts and 2-0 with a 2.25 ERA (12.0ip/3er) in three relief appearances in 2025...Nine of the 11 runs he allowed as a starting pitcher came during his first career start (Sept. 7 vs. Milwaukee).

FINISHING STRONG: Chandler went 2-0 with a 1.08 ERA (16.2ip/2er), 19 strikeouts (zero walks issued), a .123 batting average against (7-for-57) and a 0.42 WHIP over his final three starts of the 2025 season, including 5.2 innings of one-run ball in his final start on September 27 at Atlanta (he is a native of Lawrenceville, GA, located approximately 30 miles from Truist Park)...He became the first Pittsburgh pitcher during the Modern Era (since 1901) to make three consecutive starts with one or zero runs allowed, zero walks issued and at least six strikeouts...Chandler also joined Milwaukee’s Corbin Burnes (four starts) in 2021, Arizona’s Zac Gallen (three starts) in 2023 and Detroit’s Tarik Skubal (three starts) last season as the only Major League pitchers during the Modern Era to make at least three consecutive starts with four or fewer hits allowed, one/zero runs allowed, zero walks issued and at least six strikeouts.
