BIRD WATCHING: The St. Louis Cardinals and Miami Marlins play the second game of a three-game weekend series tonight at Busch Stadium ... The Cardinals have gone 1-3 on their six-game homestand against the Miami (0-1) and Arizona (1-2) ... St. Louis is 5-9 over their last 14 games (June 11-present) after winning six in a row.

FLIGHT PATTERN: St. Louis enters today in 3rd place in the National League Central, one half game behind Chicago and 8.0 games back of Milwaukee ... The Cardinals are also one half game behind the Cubs and Padres for the 3rd NL Wild Card spot ... St. Louis (-5), Cleveland (-10), and Arizona (-25) are the only three Major League teams with winning records but negative run differentials.

SLEEPS WITH THE FISHES: The Cardinals boast the 2nd-highest winning percentage against the Marlins of any of their National League opponents with a .594 mark (139-95) ... St. Louis needs to win the final two games of this series with the Fish to avoid their first losing season series to Miami since 2016 (3-4 record).

DOIN' DOUBLE-DIGITS: With a win tonight, **Andre Pallante** would join Milwaukee's **Aaron Ashby** (10-1) as the 2nd Major Leaguer and only starting pitcher with double-digit wins.

• The last Cardinal to become the first MLB starting pitcher to reach 10 wins in a season was **Adam Wainwright** (10-3) on June 13, 2013.

• The Cardinals have won each of Pallante's last six games while Andre is riding a career-best five-game win streak (May 23-present) ... The last Cardinal to compile a 6-game win streak was **Jack Flaherty** (8-game win streak in 2021).

• Pallante's nine wins are most by a Cardinal through their first 15 starts in a season since **Sonny Gray** (9 in 2024) ... The last Cardinal to reach 10+ wins prior to the All-Star break was **Miles Mikolas** (10-3 in 2018).

HEIR JORDAN: Among all qualified Major Leaguers from both 2025 to 2026, 24-year-old **Jordan Walker** boasts the largest increases across all of Major League Baseball in slugging (+.212), home runs (+11), and wOBA (+.110), while ranking 2nd in batting average (+.075) to Miami's **Otto Lopez** (+.089) - *Statcast*

WE'RE GOING STREAKING: **Alec Burleson** has reached base safely in a career high 24 consecutive games (May 30-present), 3rd-longest active in MLB ... **Iván Herrera** has reached base safely in 21 straight games (June 2-present), MLB's 4th-longest active on-base streak and his 2nd-longest of the season following a 25-gamer from April 12-May 9.

• Herrera is the first Cardinal since **Nolan Arenado** (24g & 25g in 2024) to produce multiple 21+ game on-base streaks in the same season and the first Cardinals primary catcher to do so since **Ted Simmons** (31g & 28g in 1973).

JIMMY BALLGAME: Happy 56th birthday to Cardinals Hall of Famer and World Series Champion **Jim Edmonds** ... Others born today include Marlins Hall of Famer **Jeff Conine** (60), **Yordan Alvarez** (29), All Pro Linebacker **Bobby Wagner** (36), actor **Tobey Maguire** (51), **H. Ross Perot** (1930-2019), and **Helen Keller** (1880-1968).

THIS DATE IN CARDINALS HISTORY (June 27, 2022): 25-year-old **Conner Capel** and 29-year-old **James Naile** make their Major League debuts in a 9-0 shutout win over the visiting Miami Marlins at Busch Stadium ... **Adam Wainwright** fans nine over 7.0 innings as rookie **Juan Ypez** homers twice and MVP **Paul Goldschmidt** goes 4-for-4 with a homer off the Big Land Mac sign in left field.

Iván Herrera caught his first MLB shutout against the Marlins, June 27, 2022 at Busch Stadium from **Adam Wainwright** (7 IP), **James Naile** (1 IP) and **Jake Woodford** (1 IP) in a 9-0 win...hit his first career MLB home run on April 4, 2024 vs. Miami.

George Soriano made 72 appearances (1 start) for Miami from 2023-25...signed with the Marlins as an International Free Agent on Aug. 19, 2015.

Jon Jay was born in and resides in Miami...attended Christopher Columbus High School and the University of Miami...served as the First Base/Outfield Coach for Miami for two seasons (2023-24).

Ryne Stanek made 31 relief appearances for the Marlins from 2019-20.

Cardinals Hall of Famer **Édgar Rentería** played for the Marlins from 1996-98 before St. Louis acquired him in a trade on Dec. 14, 1998...signed with Florida as a non-drafted free agent in 1992.

TONIGHT'S STARTER:

- Making his 16th start of the 2026 season tonight and his 77th career start (185th career appearance).
- **Is seeking his 10th win of the season;** the Cardinals have won each of his last six games started while **Andre has a career-best 5-game win streak** dating back to May 23; the last Cardinals pitcher to compile a 6-game win streak was **Jack Flaherty** (8 game win streak in 2021).
- Pallante's nine wins are most by a Cardinal through their first 15 starts in a season since **Sonny Gray** (9 in 2024); the last Cardinals pitcher with 10+ wins prior to the All-Star break was **Miles Mikolas** (10-3) in 2018.
- Has allowed 2-runs or fewer in five of his last six starts dating back to May 17 (2.88 ERA)
- Owns an 8.73 Run Support Average on the road and 3.26 at home ... He's received 3 runs or fewer in 8 of his 9 Home starts, yet 5 runs or more in 5 of his 6 Road starts ... Ranks 11th overall in the NL inruns support average at 5.44.
- His 185th career appearance tonight, passing **Brad Thompson** (2005-09) for 66th all-time among Cardinals pitchers. He has joined **Adam Wainwright** (478 starts), **Carlos Martinez** (274), **Lance Lynn** (206), **Miles Mikolas** (204), **Chris Carpenter** (198), and **Matt Morris** (187) since 2000 to reach both 185 career games pitched for St. Louis while also making 75 or more starts.
- Is 5-0 in six Road starts (St. Louis is 5-1); the Cardinals have won each of this last four Home starts after going 1-4 in his 1st five Home starts.
- Held opposition to 3 hits or fewer in B-2-B starts of 5.2+ IP from June 3-10, the first Cardinal to do so since **Jack Flaherty** (3, Sept. 19-29, 2019).
- **Leads all current Cardinals pitchers in career starts (76), wins (33), and innings pitched (542.2).**
- Had his streak of 10 consecutive starts of 5.0+ IP to begin the season end on May 29 vs. CHC when he exited after 3,0 IP (75 pitches). His 10 starts of 5.0 innings or more to begin a season were the most since **Sonny Gray** ran off 10 straight such starts to begin 2024.
- Alternated Home & Road starts in first 11 starts to begin the season, but that trend ended on May 29-June 7 homestand after consecutive Home starts.
- Made the Cardinals Opening Day Roster for the 5th time (2022-26), tied with **Lars Nootbaar** for most among active Cardinals.

LAST TIME OUT (Monday, June 22 vs. Arizona at Busch Stadium): W, 3-2; 6.0 IP, 6 H, 1 R, 1 ER, 0 BB, 2 SO, 0 HR, 85 pitches.

- Won his single-season high 9th game while stretching his career-best win streak to 5-straight games.
- Allowed the lead-off batter to reach in four of his 6.0 IP, but got 11 of his 18 outs via ground balls.

2026 NOTES:

DRESSED TO THE NINES: Became the 1st Cardinal to win 9 games in 1st 15 starts of a season since Sonny Gray did so in 2024 in 3-2 win over ARI on Mon. (6/22) as he posted his 3rd-straight quality start.

SLIDE ON IN: Is holding opposing batters to a .188 BA (18-96) with his slider, and 32 of his 64 strikeouts this season have come via the slider ... Boasts an 9 Run Value on his slider, T-6th best slider in MLB according to Baseball Savant this season.

COUNT ON ME: Has worked at least 5.0 IP in 14 of his 15 starts this season, allowing 2 runs or fewer in nine of those games.

IF AT FIRST: Has had issues with 1st inning, allowing a .840 OPS, 13 runs and 4 HRs in 1st inning ... Batters are hitting .324 (12-37) when contacting the 1st pitch of an 0-0 at-bat.

SIX & THIRTY: Snapped a 4-game losing skid in games pitched at Busch Stadium as he matched his season total from 2025 with his 6th win of the season on 6/3 vs. TEX; It also marked his 30th career win.

3 TURNS: Pitched into the 7th inning vs. KC (5/17) with a season-high 6.2 innings and 27 batters faced in a 2-0 loss.

THE STATE OF WINNING: With a win in Sacramento (May 12), earned his first MLB in his home state (CA).

BITTER BREW: Allowed four 1st inning runs, including 3-run HR, in 6-2 loss to MIL (5/6), losing his 3rd straight decision at Busch Stadium.

AHOY MATEY: Pitched then season-best 6.0 IP while allowing 1 run in Cards 5-4 win at PNC Park (4/29) in G3 of a 4-game series sweep of Pittsburgh.

TRI-DENT: Fanned 8 Mariners on 4/24 in 5.1 IP, but took the 3-2 loss after Josh Naylor's solo HR in the 6th snapped a 2-2 tie.

SPACE TRAVELER: Earned his 1st road win since 5/16/25 (at KC) in a 7-5 Space City win over the Astros on 4/18 in Houston.

MARCH MADNESS: Made his 2026 season debut vs. NYM (3/31) and gained a 3-0 win as he worked 5.0 scoreless IP, allowing just 3 hits.

CAREER:

- Has made the Cardinals Opening Day Roster for five consecutive seasons (2022-26) after arriving at 2022 Spring Training as a non-roster invitee, his first official invite to Major League Spring Training.
- Is 15-16 in his 39 career games started at Busch Stadium while the Cardinals have gone 20-19 in those games.
- **Since his 2022 MLB debut, boasts the highest ground ball pct. (62.4%) in Major League Baseball among pitchers with 500.0+ IP.** As a starting pitcher (411.0IP), Pallante's 59.2 career groundball pct. currently is the 9th-best in MLB since the stat has been tracked since 1987 (min. 400.0 IP as starter).
- Started vs. San Francisco (June 20, 2024) at Rickwood Field in Birmingham, Ala., tossing 5.1 innings in the 6-5 Cardinals win. Was the first Cardinals starting pitcher to earn a win at a neutral site since Alan Benes vs. San Diego on April 19, 1997 at Aloha Stadium in Honolulu, Hawaii.

PALLANTE vs. MIAMI:

- Makes his 4th career start and 8th career appearance vs. the Marlins; Is 1-2 with a 2.92 ERA covering 24.2 innings pitched.
- His most recent victory was against the Marlins on July 28 at Busch Stadium, limiting Miami to one hit (Graham Pauley single) over 7.0 shutout innings. Snapped a 4-game losing streak, and carried a no-hitter thru his first 5.0 IP.
- In his first start against the Marlins on June 29, 2022 at Busch Stadium, took a no-decision in the Cardinals 4-3 loss. Was in line for the win before the Marlins plated two in the 9th on a two-run Avisail Garcia HR.
- Has just one HR allowed vs. Marlins in his 24,.2 career IP, that coming in his 8/20/25 start at loanDepot Park (Maximo Acosta)
