BIRDLAND BITES: Baltimore continues a six-game road trip today through Toronto (1-0, 2 to play) and New York-NL (3 to play)...The Birds are coming off a 2-5 homestand, having been swept in a four-game set by the Red Sox before taking two of three from the Guardians...Baltimore is 3.0 games behind Cleveland for the final Wild Card spot with Toronto (2.0 GB) and Texas (3.0 GB) also in the mix.

- Five of Baltimore's seven runs last night came in the second inning...Each of the first six Oriole batters in the frame recorded a base hit...According to the *Elias Sports Bureau*, it marked the first time Baltimore accomplished the feat since September 25, 2024 at New York-AL in the first inning (Henderson, Westburg, Santander, Cowser, Mountcastle, O'Hearn).
- The Birds are 10-for-18 (.556) with runners in scoring position in their last two games after going 5-for-39 (.128) over their previous six games.
- Baltimore has scored 5+ runs in four straight contests, one shy of their season-best five-game run from August 9-14.
- Dylan Beavers** hit his first career leadoff home run and became the third Oriole to do so this season, joining Taylor Ward (2x) and **Gunnar Henderson**...Beavers is the second Oriole to ever hit a leadoff homer off Max Scherzer, joining **Colton Cowser**, who took Scherzer deep on March 29, 2025 at Rogers Centre...Baltimore is the only AL team to hit multiple leadoff HRs against Scherzer in his career.
- Beavers has recorded a career-high-tying three RBI in back-to-back games, becoming the third Oriole to do so this year, joining **Christian Encarnacion-Strand** (8/16-17) and **Coby Mayo** (4/21-22).

BIRDS OF A FEATHER: The O's have hit multiple home runs in a team-record-tying five straight games at Rogers Centre since September 14, 2025, joining their run from September 6, 2015-June 12, 2016.

- Colton Cowser** has hit safely in each of his last seven games against Toronto, including an RBI in each of the last five contests, batting .455 (10-for-22) with two doubles, three home runs, six runs, and nine RBI.
- The last Oriole to record an RBI in six straight games against the Blue Jays was **Ryan Mountcastle** (6 G, 6/14-8/15/22).

COBY BEEF: **Coby Mayo** has reached base safely in a career-best 15 straight games, slashing .288/.362/.654 (15-for-52) with one double, six home runs, 13 runs, 13 RBI, and five walks.

- It is tied for the sixth-longest active streak in MLB, including tied for second longest in the AL behind HOU's Isaac Paredes (18 G).
- Mayo's .586 slugging percentage since the All-Star break is the highest in the AL (min. 100 AB) and of TB's Victor Mesa Jr. (.583).
- Mayo is batting .316/.380/.735 (43-for-136) with nine doubles, 16 home runs, and 33 RBI this year against left-handed pitching...He leads the majors in home runs, slugging percentage, and OPS (1.115) against lefties...The 16 homers are the second most in a season off lefties by an Oriole trailing Gary Roenicke hit 18 in 1983.

POLAR VORTEX: **Pete Alonso** ranks among AL leaders in RBI (1st, 97), home runs (4th, 34), total bases (4th, 273), OPS (5th, .853), slugging percentage (T-5th, .494), extra-base hits (T-6th, 58), runs (8th, 88), and hits (9th, 147).

- Alonso has started all 148 O's games this year, tied for the most starts in MLB along with PHI's Bryce Harper and ATL's Matt Olson...The last Oriole to start every team game in a season was Jonathan Schoop in 2016.
- He's played in 564 consecutive games, the second-longest active streak in the majors behind ATL's Matt Olson (930 G).
- Alonso leads HOU's Yordan Alvarez (96) for the most RBI in the AL...He looks to become the eighth player in franchise history (since 1954) to lead the AL in RBI, joining Chris Davis (138 RBI, 2013), Miguel Tejada (150 RBI, 2004), Eddie Murray (78 RBI, 1981), Lee May (109 RBI, 1976), Frank Robinson (122 RBI, 1966), Brooks Robinson (118 RBI, 1964), and Jim Gentile (141 RBI, 1961).
- According to *STATS Perform*, since RBI became official in 1920, the only players to lead the AL in RBI in their first year playing in the Junior Circuit (including ties) are TEX's Josh Hamilton (130 RBI, 2008), CWS' Dick Allen (113 RBI, 1972), BAL's Frank Robinson (122 RBI, 1966), BOS' Dick Stuart (118 RBI, 1963), and BOS' Ted Williams (145 RBI, 1939).

PLAYING THE LONG GAME: The Birds have hit 44 homers since August 9, second most in MLB during that time behind the Cubs (58).

- During its most recent road series in Colorado, Baltimore hit only one homer during the three-game set...Prior to that, the Orioles had homered in 13 of their last 15 road games, totaling 27 long balls from August 8-30.

PATIENCE IS A VIRTUE: The O's lead the AL and rank fourth in the majors with 546 walks this season behind the Cubs (622 BB), Brewers (611 BB), and Dodgers (562 BB)...The White Sox and Yankees are tied for second in the AL with 528 free passes.

- The team's 31 games with 6+ walks are the most by a Baltimore club since 1999 (35).
- The Birds are averaging 3.97 pitches per plate appearance, ranking second in MLB behind the Brewers (3.98).

'PEN PALS: Oriole relievers own a 2.25 ERA since August 21, fourth lowest in MLB behind the Padres (2.09), Guardians (2.14), and Braves (2.20)...Their nine saves during that period lead the majors ahead of the Astros and Pirates (both 8).

- Josh Walker** hasn't allowed a run in 16 games (14.0 IP) since August 6...It's the longest scoreless streak, by games, by an Oriole since **Yennier Cano** (17 G) from April 14-May 17, 2023.
- Eleven Baltimore pitchers have recorded at least one save this season, breaking the franchise record since saves became an official statistic in 1969...The Birds are one of seven teams in MLB to have at least 11 players tally at least one save this year, led by the Cubs (14).

NIP AND TUCK: The Orioles are 48-51 in games decided by three runs or fewer, tied for the most such games in the majors this year with the Guardians (52-47)...The .485 winning percentage in those games ranks 18th in the majors.

- Baltimore is 16-22 in one-run games this year...The .421 winning percentage ranks 25th in the majors.

QUICK HITS: Bradish is scheduled to make his 29th start of the season and 96th of his career today...Made six starts in his return from Tommy John surgery last season, going 1-1 with a 2.53 ERA (9 ER/32.0 IP) on 23 hits (3 HR), 10 walks, and one hit batter with 47 strikeouts... Acquired from Los Angeles-AL along with RHP Kyle Brnovich, RHP Isaac Mattson, and RHP Zach Peek in exchange for RHP Dylan Bundy on December 4, 2019.

⚡ Agreed to terms on a five-year contract with the O's on July 18, extending him through 2031.

LAST TIME OUT: Suffered the loss on September 6 vs. Boston after allowing three unearned runs on two hits (1 HR) and four walks with three strikeouts across 4.0 innings...Threw 85 pitches, 55 strikes.

⚡ Marked his seventh start of the season in which he threw 4.0 innings or fewer (last: 3.0 IP, 8/2 vs. PHI).

BIRTHDAY BOY: Today, Bradish celebrates his 30th birthday...It marks the first time he will make an MLB start on his birthday.

⚡ The last O's starter to win on his birthday was **Cade Povich**, who did so earlier this season at Camden Yards on April 12 vs. San Francisco.

BLUE BIRDS: Bradish has made 10 career starts opposite Toronto, going 2-4 with a 4.94 ERA (28 ER/51.0 IP).

⚡ In two starts this season, is 1-1 with a 4.09 ERA (5 ER/11.0 IP)... Owns a 6.93 ERA (19 ER/24.2 IP) across five starts at Rogers Centre, compared to a 3.08 ERA (9 ER/26.1 IP) in five outings at Camden Yards.

FIRST-INNING FOCUS: Bradish has allowed only two runs in the opening frame this season, during which opponents are slashing .191/.276/.277 (18-for-94) with five doubles, one home run, 10 walks, and 34 strikeouts.

⚡ His two runs allowed in the first inning are tied with two others for the second fewest in MLB (min. 15 GS) behind SD's Casey Mize (1).

SLIDE AWAY: Bradish's .563 slugging percentage on his slider is the third-highest mark in MLB (min. 100 AB ending in pitch) ahead of ATH's Jeffrey Springs (.680) and CWS' Luis Castillo (.584)...In 2025, he held a .156 slugging percentage on the pitch over six starts.

⚡ Overall, his breaking balls (slider, curveball) own a negative 11 run value, which ranks in the bottom two percent of MLB... Opponents are slashing .251/.318/.490 (60-for-239) with 12 doubles, three triples, and 13 home runs on his breaking pitches.

WALK DON'T RUN: His 10.4 percent walk rate is tied for the third-highest mark in MLB and is the highest mark of his career (9.2%, 2024).

⚡ His 14 games with three or more walks are sixth most among MLB starters ahead of SD's Robbie Ray (16) and MIN's Taj Bradley, CLE's Joey Cantillo, TOR's Dylan Cease, and AZ's Merrill Kelly (all 15).

FOUR SEAM FOCUS: Opponents are slashing .500/.611/.714 (7-for-14) with one double and one triple off his four seamer in his last seven starts since August 2 after hitting .235/.235/.353 (4-for-17) with one triple on the pitch over four games in July...Bradish opened the season holding opponents to a .308/.400/.400 (20-for-65) slash line on his four seamer with three doubles and one home run over 17 starts from March-June.

BEHIND THE EIGHT BALL: Bradish owns a 56.1 percent first-pitch strike rate, the lowest mark in MLB among qualified pitchers behind CHC's Shota Imanaga (56.6%)...Threw 10 of 19 (52.6%) first pitches for strikes in his last start on September 6 vs. Boston.

BREAKING BRAD: Over two starts from June 17-22, Bradish allowed one run over 15.2 innings with 21 strikeouts to become the third pitcher in franchise history (since 1954) to have 20+ strikeouts and no more than one run allowed over a two-start span in a single season, joining Mike Mussina (2000) and Erik Bedard (2007).

Owns a 5.48 ERA (14 ER/23.0 IP) in 25 career games against TOR...Only allowed one run in 12 games (11.2 IP) against the Blue Jays from 8/3/23-7/29-25 but has allowed eight earned runs over his last six games (3.1 IP) against them

Made his 60th appearance of the season on 9/2 at COL...He is now the eighth pitcher in Orioles history (since 1954) with four seasons of at least 60 appearances (2023-26)...Appeared in a career-high 72 games in 2023
