**THE TWINS:** Have gone 2-2 through four games on their six-game, seven-day roadtrip, going 2-1 in Chicago against the White Sox earlier this week, followed by a loss in San Francisco to the Giants last night...today, they will continue the trip with the second of three at Oracle Park...they will play the series finale tomorrow afternoon and complete the roadtrip and the unofficial "first half" of the season.

☞ Minnesota has gone 46-28 in its last 74 games since April 22, the most wins in the AL and second-most in baseball, trailing Philadelphia (47-25).

☞ The Twins have gone 26-23 on the road this season, winning eight of their last 12 away from Target Field.

**BUMMER IN THE BAY:** The Twins lost to the Giants last night by a score of 7-1 at Oracle Park... Joe Ryan (6-6) was the starter and dealt the loss, allowing five runs on six hits in 5.1 innings pitched, with a season-high three walks and six strikeouts... Josh Staumont allowed his first earned run of the season, snapping his streak of unearned runs allowed at 20.0 innings... it marks the second-longest streak in club history to begin a career, passing Caleb Thielbar (19.2 in 2013); the longest held by Al Worthington (37.1 in 1964)... the offense recorded 10 hits, went 1-for-11 with runners in scoring position and left 10 men on base... Minnesota scored their only run on a Willi Castro groundout in the sixth inning that scored Carlos Correa.

**MY GIANT:** The Twins and Giants are playing each other for the 22nd, 23rd and 24th times in their history this weekend... the Twins are 10-12 all-time against San Francisco, going 4-2 at Target Field, 5-8 at Oracle Park and 1-2 at the Metrodome... dating back to 2017, the Twins have won six of their last 10 over the Giants.

☞ The 22 games played against the Giants are the second-fewest the Twins have played against any opponent in their history (since 1961)... Miami is the only team they have faced less (19 times).

**STARR POWERR:** All-Star Carlos Correa enters today with a .308 batting average, third-best in the AL and fifth-best in baseball, trailing Steven Kwan (.359), Bobby Witt Jr. (.327), Christian Yelich (.327) and Shohei Ohtani (.312)... since June 6, he is hitting .384 (48-for-125) with five doubles, nine home runs, 25 RBI, a .447 on-base percentage, a .640 slugging percentage and a 1.087 OPS with an 11.3% strikeout rate in 32 games.

☞ Correa enters today with a season-long 13-game hitting streak, tied for third-longest of his career... his previous streaks as long were 16 (April 19-May 6, 2019), 15 (June 20-July 7, 2017) and 13 (August 24-September 11, 2016).

**EIGHT-POINT BUCK:** Byron Buxton enters today with an eight-game hitting streak, tying his season-long, previously done from April 19-29... his career-long is 12, from August 10-21, 2017... additionally, in his last 14 games, he is hitting .453 (24-for-53) with nine doubles, five home runs, 15 RBI, a .492 on-base percentage, a .906 slugging percentage and a 1.397 OPS with a 13.6% strikeout rate.

**BEEF, IT'S WHAT'S FOR DINNER:** Reliever Brock Stewart made his second appearance on rehab assignment last night with Triple-A St. Paul, allowing one run on one hit (home run) in 1.0 inning, with two strikeouts... Beef Stew has missed the club's last 64 games with right shoulder tendinitis.

**COOL HAND LUKE:** Twins number five prospect (MLB.com's 94th overall), Luke Keaschall will be representing the Twins in the MLB All-Star Futures Game at 3:10 pm (CT) at Globe Life Field, replacing Brooks Lee... the 21-year-old infielder has split the 2024 season between High-A Cedar Rapids and Double-A Wichita, hitting .327 (102-for-312) with 21 doubles, 11 home runs, 38 RBI, 66 runs scored, 52 walks, 19 stolen bases, a .438 on-base percentage and a .945 OPS in 84 games... the Watsonville, California native was selected by the Twins in the second round (49th overall) of the 2023 First-Year Player Draft out of Arizona State University.

☞ The following players have represented the Twins in the Futures Game since 2013: David Festa in 2023; Spencer Steer and Matt Wallner in 2022; Josh Winder in 2021; Jordan Balazovic and Royce Lewis in 2019; Alex Kirilloff and Lewis Thorpe in 2018; Nick Gordon in 2017; JT Chargois in 2016; José Berrios in 2015 & '14; Max Kepler in 2015; Trevor May, Alex Meyer and Kennys Vargas in 2014; and Byron Buxton and Miguel Sanó in 2013. **FEELING A DRAFT:** The Major League Baseball First-Year Player Draft will take place tomorrow night, starting at 6 pm (CT)... the Twins will select 21st overall (1st round), 33rd overall (compensatory round - Sonny Gray), 60th overall (2nd round) and 69th overall (competitive balance round B) tomorrow night... in the 2023 draft, the Twins selected outfielder Walker Jenkins (5th overall), right-handed pitcher Charlee Soto (34th overall) and infielder Luke Keaschall (49th overall) on day one.

☞ Former first round picks on the Twins current roster or Injured List: Carlos Correa (1st overall by Houston in 2012), Byron Buxton (2nd overall in 2012), Alex Kirilloff (15th overall in 2016), Royce Lewis (1st overall in 2017), Trevor Larnach (20th overall in 2018), Matt Wallner (39th overall in 2019), Austin Martin (5th overall by Toronto in 2020), and Brooks Lee (8th in 2022).

**STIFLED THE 'STROS:** Last pitched July 7 vs. Houston, opposite Spencer Arrighetti, and didn't factor into the decision of Minnesota's 3-2 walk-off win...allowed two runs on three hits in 6.0 innings, with two walks and four strikeouts...allowed both runs in the second inning on two singles and two walks...retired 13-straight batters from innings 2-6.

- ⚡ Induced 10 whiffs on 48 swings (20.8%)...ranks in MLB's 22nd percentile with a 21.7 percent whiff rate this season.
- ⚡ Allowed only three hard-hit balls (95.0+ mph); Houston went 0-for-3 on those swings...Woods Richardson ranks in MLB's 67th percentile with a 36.2 percent hard-hit rate.
- ⚡ Has made five starts with 4.0-or-more innings and zero extra-base hits, tied for ninth most in baseball...has made six starts with 4.0-or-more innings and three-or-fewer hits, tied for 12th most in baseball.
- ⚡ Minnesota is 11-4 in Woods Richardson's starts this season.

**TWO STARTS AGO:** Started July 2 vs. Detroit, opposite Tarik Skubal, and didn't factor into the decision of Minnesota's 5-3 win...allowed three runs on four hits (2 HR) in 5.2 innings, with two walks and four strikeouts...allowed just two baserunners (1 H, 1 BB) through 4.0 innings...in the fifth, Justyn-Henry Malloy hit a solo home run and Ryan Kreidler added a two-run shot...was pulled after a sixth-inning two-out walk; Jorge Alcalá entered and stranded the runner.

- ⚡ Induced nine whiffs on 41 swings (22.0%).
- ⚡ Allowed five hard-hit balls.

**ANOTHER NEW OPPONENT:** Has never faced San Francisco or any of its current hitters...owns four career appearances (3 starts) against the National League (Washington 2x, Pittsburgh and Arizona); has gone 1-1 with a 3.86 ERA (21.0 IP, 9 ER), six walks, 16 strikeouts and a .253 (20-for-79) opponent batting average in those outings.

**HOME/ROAD SPLITS:** Making ninth road start of the season...has gone 2-1 with a 3.38 ERA (40.0 IP, 15 ER), 6.30 strikeouts-per-9.0 innings, 2.03 walks-per-9.0 innings and 1.13 home-runs-per-9.0 innings on the road, compared to 1-0 with a 3.58 ERA (37.2 IP, 15 ER), 8.60 K/9, 3.35 BB.9 and 0.72 HR/9 in seven home starts...has allowed a .245 (37-for-151) batting average and .690 OPS on the road, compared to .191 (26-for-136) BAA and .563 OPS at home.

**REVERSE SPLITS:** Through 15 games vs. Woods Richardson, left-handed hitters have hit .188 (21-for-112) with a .259 slugging percentage, .532 OPS and 20.3 percent strikeout rate, while righties have hit .240 (42-for-175) with a .406 SLG, .691 OPS and 19.9 percent strikeout rate...righties have hit 16 of the 20 extra-base hits vs. Woods Richardson.

- ⚡ On July 7, Houston's lefties went 1-for-4 with one strikeout vs. Woods Richardson, while righties went 2-for-16 with two walks and three strikeouts.
- ⚡ Average exit velocity vs. Woods Richardson: 86.8 mph by lefties, 89.8 mph by righties.
- ⚡ Hard-hit percentage vs. Woods Richardson: 34.1 percent by lefties, 38.1 percent by righties.
- ⚡ Among right handed pitchers, Woods Richardson has allowed the eighth-lowest batting average (.188), sixth-lowest slugging percentage (.259) and seventh-lowest OPS (.532) to left-handed hitters (min. 100 LHB faced).

**THE ARSENAL:** Woods Richardson has used a four-pitch mix this season...here's his 2024 repertoire and results, per Baseball Savant:

- ⚡ On July 7, threw a season-high 45 4-seamers; Houston went 2-for-12 with one strikeout vs. the pitch.
- ⚡ In his last eight starts since May 28, opponents have hit .186 (11-for-59) and slugged .237 vs. Woods Richardson's 4-seamer...in his first seven starts, the pitch allowed a .296 (16-for-54) batting average and .333 SLG.
- ⚡ He's the only pitcher in baseball to throw 500-or-more 4-seamers and not allow a home run on the pitch.
- ⚡ His slider has allowed the seventh-lowest batting average (.183), ninth-lowest SLG (.284) and fourth-lowest hard-hit rate (25.3) in baseball (min. 100 PA).
- ⚡ Ranks in MLB's 89th percentile with a fastball run value of 8, 88th percentile with a breaking ball run value of 5.

**TOMORROW'S STARTER - RHP CHRIS PADDACK (2024: 5-3, 5.18 ERA) // CAREER: 27-24, 4.41 ERA)**

Chris Paddack is scheduled to start tomorrow's series finale at San Francisco...last pitched July 8 at Chicago-AL and didn't factor into the decision of Minnesota's 11-inning, 8-6 win, allowing two runs on three hits (1 HR) in 5.0 innings, with two walks and three strikeouts...was his first start after being reinstated from the 15-day Injured List; missed 14 games with right arm fatigue...has made seven career starts vs. San Francisco, all with San Diego; is 1-1 with a 3.82 ERA (30.2 IP, 13 ER), four walks and 38 strikeouts in those outings.
