LAST TIME OUT: Last pitched on lune 1 at Houston and took his fourth loss of the season in Minnesota's 5-2 defeat...allowed five runs and eight hits (4 HR), two walks and four strikeouts – his eight hits

when he allowed six runs.

TWO STARTS AGO: Made the start on May 27 against the Kansas City Royals...earned his fourth victory opponent in his career...allowed just one base runner in the first 5.0 innings before allowing three

VS. PITTSBURGH: Facing Pittsburgh Pirates for the first time in his career...has made six starts against the National League Central, going 2-3, 5.04 ERA (30.1 IP, 17 ER), nine walks, 38 strikeouts a, 1.15 WHIP and a .228 (26-for-114) opponent batting average.
