THUNDER ROAD: Have gone 2-4 through six games on their nine-game, 10-day roadtrip, taking two of three in Houston last weekend, followed by a three-game sweep at the hands of the Yankees in the Bronx from Tuesday-Thursday...tonight, Minnesota will continue the trip with the first of three at PNC Park against the Pirates and play Pittsburgh through the weekend.

⚡ Despite the three-game losing streak, the Twins have still gone 26-16 since April 22, tied with Los Angeles-NL (26-14) for the third-most wins in baseball since that date, trailing New York-AL (30-12) and Philadelphia (30-11).

THE USUAL NEW YORK CITY SERENADE: The Twins lost to the Yankees in New York last night by a score of 8-5, suffering the three-game sweep, their fifth of the season...Pablo López (5-6) made the start and was issued the loss, allowing seven runs on four hits in 4.0 innings pitched, with four strikeouts and career-high six walks — four of which scored...the offense recorded 10 hits, compared to the Yankees' seven, marking the first time this season the Twins lost when outpitching their opponent (23-1)...Carlos Correa and Carlos Santana each had two of the 10 hits...Correa drove in two runs and hit his fifth home run of the season...Christian Vázquez also homered, marking his second of the year.

THE BOSSES: Pirates manager Derek Shelton served as the bench coach for two seasons in Minnesota, spending 2018 under Paul Molitor and 2019 under Rocco Baldelli...Shelton managed two games for the Twins on July 28 and 29, 2018 at Boston, losing both as Molitor traveled to Cooperstown for the Hall of Fame Induction Ceremony...Shelty was Rocco's hitting coach in Tampa Bay in 2010 and they were both on Tampa's coaching staff together from 2015-16...below are a few of their head-to-head numbers as managers, since 2020 (Shelty's first season):

I'M ON FIRE: Wednesday night's home run at Yankee Stadium from Royce Lewis made him the first player in club history (since 1961) to homer in each of his first three games...the previous streak was two, done nine times previously, most recently by Byron Buxton in 2021...a home run tonight and he will become the seventh player in baseball history to homer in each of their first four games to start a season...nobody has ever homered in their first five (since 1900 - Elias confirmed):

THE RIVER (OR THREE): The Twins are 25-17 all-time against the Pirates, going 2-4 at Three Rivers Stadium (1998-2000), 8-4 at the Metrodome (1997-2009), 8-4 at PNC Park (2006-20) and 7-5 at Target Field (2015-23)...the Twins have won nine of their last 13 games vs. Pittsburgh, dating back to April of 2018.

⚡ These two last played in a three-game series at Target Field from August 18-20, 2023 as the Twins took the series 2-1.

⚡ The last time the Twins visited PNC Park was for two games in 2020, splitting the series.

⚡ Max Kepler is hitting .316 (12-for-38) with five doubles, one home run, eight RBI, six walks, a .400 on-base percentage, a .526 slugging percentage and a .926 OPS in 10 career games vs. the Bucs.

⚡ Carlos Santana began 2023 with Pittsburgh, playing in 94 games before being traded to Milwaukee at the deadline, in exchange for minor league infielder Johnny Severino.

⚡ Alex Kirilloff was born in Pittsburgh and attended Plum Senior High School, approximately 18 miles northeast of PNC Park...he grew up a fan of all Pittsburgh professional sports teams, his favorite Pirate being Andrew McCutchen.

BR-IL-LIANT DISGUISE: The Twins are 4-4 in Interleague Play this season...they played a two-game series in Milwaukee from April 2-3 (1-1), a three-game series at Target Field against Los Angeles (1-2) and a three-game series at Washington (2-1)...after this series, their next IL opponent will be the Rockies at Target Field from Monday-Wednesday.

⚡ Only the Dodgers have played fewer Interleague games than the Twins this season, playing six, compared to the Twins' eight.

⚡ Trevor Larnach has three doubles, one triple, five home runs, 19 RBI, a .611 slugging percentage and a .904 OPS in 17 games against the NL since the start of last season.

⚡ Ryan Jeffers is hitting .296 (29-for-98) with five doubles, nine home runs, 18 RBI, a .415 on-base percentage, a .622 slugging percentage and a 1.038 OPS vs. NL opponents since the start of 2023...Jeffers' IL OPS ranks 10th in baseball since the start of last season.

HUNGRY HEART: In 32 career road games, Royce Lewis is hitting .387 (46-for-119) with 12 home runs, 34 RBI, a .714 slugging percentage and a 1.165 OPS...he enters tonight with a 13-game hitting streak on the road...in fact, in his last 16 road games, dating back to August 23, 2023, he has slashed .386/.485/.860 (1.345 OPS) with nine home runs, 23 RBI and has homered in every road series he has appeared in (7 series).

INDE-PEN-DENCE DAY: Over the last 15 games, the Twins relievers have gone 4-0, 1.88 ERA (52.2 IP, 11 ER) with 16 walks, 44 strikeouts, a .174 opponent batting average, 12 holds and seven saves in seven opportunities...their .174 opponent batting average, .241 on-base percentage and .227 wOBA in that span all lead baseball, while their .255 slugging percentage ranks second.

⚡ Joao Duran appeared just once on this trip (Sunday at Houston)...he enters today 10-for-10 in save opportunities, one of two relievers in baseball with a save percentage of 100% (min. 10 opps), joined by San Diego's Robert Suarez (17-for-17).

⚡ Griffin Jax has also appeared once on the trip (also Sunday at Houston)...Jax's percentile rankings in all of MLB: 98th in xERA (2.14), 97th in hard-hit% (27.6), 96th in whiff% (35.9), 95th in K% (33.7), 94th in xBA (.193), and 91st in both chase% (33.8) and avg. fastball velo (96.8).

GLORY DAYS: On this day in 1977, the Chicago White Sox selected Harold Baines with the first pick in the First-Year Player Draft, pitcher Bill Gullickson was taken with the second pick by the Montreal Expos, and the Milwaukee Brewers selected University of Minnesota infielder Paul Molitor with the third pick...Molitor made his major league debut the next season with Milwaukee on April 7, 1978 vs. Baltimore en route to a Hall of Fame career.

LAST TIME OUT: Last pitched on June 1 at Houston and took his fourth loss of the season in Minnesota's 5-2 defeat...allowed five runs and eight hits (4 HR), two walks and four strikeouts — his eight hits allowed, five runs and four home runs surrendered are all season highs...allowed a home run in four of the five innings he pitched in, only throwing a scoreless inning in the fourth.

☞ First time allowing five-or-more runs since his last start of 2023 at Colorado on September 29, when he allowed six runs.

TWO STARTS AGO: Made the start on May 27 against the Kansas City Royals...earned his fourth victory of the season and 30th of his career...improved to 6-0 vs. Kansas City, his most wins against any opponent in his career...allowed just one base runner in the first 5.0 innings before allowing three hits and a run — on a Vinnie Pasquantino single — in the sixth...allowed one run on four hits, no walks and nine strikeouts in 7.0 innings...generated 15 swings and misses on 49 swings (30.6%).

☞ Threw the hardest pitch of his career at 96.6 mph, a ball to Nelson Velázquez.

VS. PITTSBURGH: Facing Pittsburgh Pirates for the first time in his career...has made six starts against the National League Central, going 2-3, 5.04 ERA (30.1 IP, 17 ER), nine walks, 38 strikeouts a, 1.15 WHIP and a .228 (26-for-114) opponent batting average.

☞ His last win against an NL Central opponent came on May 13, 2023 vs. Chicago-NL...allowed no runs on four hits, one walk and 10 strikeouts in 6.0 innings.

☞ Making second Interleague start of the season...the first came against Washington on May 21 earning the victory allowing no runs on three hits, two walks and six strikeouts in 7.0 innings.

☞ Making 15th career Interleague start...in previous 14 he is 6-6, 6.08 ERA (71.0 IP, 48 ER), 21 walks, 79 strikeouts a 1.41 WHIP and a .274 (79-for-288) opponent batting average.

☞ After making the start today he will have pitched in four of the five NL Central stadiums: Chicago-NL, St. Louis, Cincinnati and Pittsburgh.

BACK ON THE ROAD: Through six starts on the road in 2024, Ryan has gone 2-1 with a 2.48 ERA (36.1 IP, 10 ER), seven walks, 37 strikeouts and six home runs, compared to 2-3, 4.29 ERA (35.2 IP, 17 ER), four walks, 40 strikeouts and five home runs in six home starts.

☞ In 34 career road starts, he is 14-11, 4.13 ERA (191.2 IP, 88 ER), 177 hits, 45 walks and 199 strikeouts...Twins are 21-14 in Ryan's 35 road starts.

☞ Since making his debut in 2021, he leads all Twins pitchers with 14 road wins...behind him are Griffin Jax and Bailey Ober tied with (9).

☞ Lost his first road game of the season in his last start.

LEFT-RIGHT SPLITS: In 2024, left-handed hitters have slashed .209/.250/.349 with nine extra-base hits, including four home runs, six walks and 38 strikeouts in 136 plate appearances vs. Ryan, while right-handed hitters have slashed .243/.268/.458 with 10 doubles, seven home runs, five walks and 39 strikeouts in 149 plate appearances.

☞ Over his career, lefties are batting .208 (151-for-731) with 28 doubles, four triples and 24 home runs and a .629 OPS...right-handed hitters are batting .242 (196-for-809) with 49 doubles, no triples and, 43 home runs with a .745 OPS.

☞ In his last start against Houston, left-handed hitters hit .500 (3-for-6) with three home runs, two walks and no strikeouts.

THE ARSENAL: Ryan has primarily used a four-pitch mix in 12 starts this season...has leaned on his 4-seam fastball and split finger the most, combining to throw the two pitches 79 percent of the time in his last start against the Astros...here is Ryan's 2024 repertoire, per Baseball Savant:

☞ In his last start five starts against Toronto, New York-AL, Washington, Kansas City and Houston, hitters have gone 3-for-36 vs. the split finger with eight strikeouts.

☞ Right-handed hitters are hitting .246 (15-for-61) with four home runs and 20 strikeouts against the 4-seam fastball in 2024...left-handed hitters are hitting .180 (9-for-50) a double, a triple, a home run and 18 strikeouts.

RUNNERS ON: With runners in scoring position vs. Ryan, opponents are hitting .255 (12-for-47) with two home runs, one walk and 13 strikeouts...with the bases empty, opponents are hitting .201 (38-for-189) with seven home runs, eight walks and 57 strikeouts.

NIGHT AND DAY: Making his sixth night start of the season...has gone 3-0 with a 2.59 ERA (31.1 IP, 9 ER) in his previous five nighttime starts this season, compared to 1-4 with a 3.98 ERA (40.2 IP, 18 ER) in the daytime.

CLIMBING THE LADDER: Enters today with 455 career strikeouts, 29th in Twins history (1961-present)...next up is Tyler Duffey in 28th place with 466.

QUALITY STARTER: Has recorded six quality starts in his last eight starts...leads the Twins with eight quality starts this season and ranks tied for 10th in the American League (t-14th in MLB)...has allowed three-or-fewer earned runs in 10 of his 12 starts.

TOMORROW'S STARTER - RHP SIMEON WOODS RICHARDSON (2024: 2-0, 3.05 ERA // CAREER: 2-1, 3.67 ERA)

Right-hander Simeon Woods Richardson is set to start the second game of the three-game series in Pittsburgh...last pitched on June 2 in Houston, and didn't factor into the decision of Minnesota's 4-3 win, allowing three runs on three hits (2 HR), two walks and six strikeouts in 4.1 innings; two home runs allowed are tied for a season high (May 11 at Toronto)...making his seventh road start of the season and is 1-0, 3.49 ERA (28.1 IP, 11 ER), seven walks, 18 strikeouts, a 1.20 WHIP and a .252 (27-for-107) opponent batting average in his six prior starts...has never faced the Pirates or any National League Central team.
