NATIONALS NEWS

SERIES BUSINESS
The Washington Nationals will take on the Boston Red Sox today in the final game of a three-game set from Fenway Park...Cade Cavalli's career night helped the Nationals even the series with an 8-1 win on Tuesday.

- **Cade Cavalli** struck out a career high 13 in 7.0 innings of one-hit ball without allowing an earned run or issuing a walk...**CJ Abrams** hit his 18th home run of the season and is now just two shy of his career high.
- With a win today, the Nationals would earn just their second series win at Fenway Park in Nationals history (2005-pres.)...Washington's only other series win in Boston was a three-game sweep of the Red Sox from June 8-10, 2012.

WINNING WAYS

The Nationals are 27-18 (.600) on the road this season, the third best road record in MLB behind the Dodgers (30-16, .652) and the Brewers (24-14, .632).

- Washington is 33-27 (.550) since April 25 and are 10-3-1 in their last 13 series since May 12.
- Today's matchup finishes off Washington's stretch of 13 games in 13 days that began on June 19 in Tampa Bay.

WHAT A WEEK, HUH?

Luis García Jr. earned National League Player of the Week honors on Monday after he led the NL in batting average, on-base percentage, slugging percentage, OPS and home runs during the week...García Jr. went 10-for-19 (.526) with six home runs, two doubles, nine RBI, three walks and eight runs scored in six games from June 22-28.

- With his six home runs in six games from June 22-28, García Jr. became just the fourth Major Leaguer since the beginning of the 2022 season to hit six homers in a six-game span joining: **Kyle Schwarber** (May 9-15, 2026), **Eugenio Suárez** (July 12-21, 2025) and **Aaron Judge** (Aug. 20-25, 2024).
- Thanks to his hot streak, García Jr. now ranks tied for fourth in the National League in slugging (.542) and tied for fifth in the NL in RBI (57).

GOING RIGHT AGAINST LEFT

The Nationals rank second in Major League Baseball in OPS (.767) and on-base percentage (.342) against left-handed pitchin while they are third in batting average (.267) against southpaws.

- Washington is 17-11 (.607) against left-handed starters this year, tied for the fifth best winning percentage in Major League Baseball.

ROTATION NOTES

Washington's starting rotation (regardless of opener) has pitched to a 2.65 ERA (15 ER/51.0 IP) over the last 10 games.

- **Foster Griffin** has allowed just four earned runs and no more than one run per game over his last five starts, pitching to a 1.15 ERA with 33 strikeouts and just four walks in 31.1 innings.
- **Zack Littell** is tied for the Major League lead in wins (6) since May 15...Littell is 6-2 with a 3.92 ERA in nine games (seven starts) over that span...He has allowed two runs or less in seven of those nine outings.
- **Cade Cavalli** set a career high with 13 strikeouts at Boston on June 30...He did not allow an earned run and surrendered just one hit.

HOMER HAPPY

Since May 6, the Nationals lead Major League Baseball with 77 home runs ahead of the Phillies (75), White Sox (73) and Athletics (71)...Washington ranks second in slugging (.451) and fourth in OPS (.772) over this stretch.

- The Nationals have hit 114 home runs this season, the fourth-most in team history (2005-pres.) through 87 games behind the 2017 Nationals (125 HR), 2019 Nationals (122 HR) and 2016 Nationals (121 HR).

CORNER BATS

Since May 22, Washington's corner infielders **Luis García Jr.** (13 HR, 32 RBI), **Curtis Mead** (9 HR, 20 RBI) and **Jorbit Vivas** (2 HR, 7 RBI) lead Major League Baseball with 24 home runs and 62 RBI...These stats reflect when they are in the game at one of the corner positions (not PH or DH).

- **Luis García Jr.**'s 13 homers rank second in Major League Baseball over this span, while Mead's 10 (one as DH) are tied for fourth in the National League.
- In addition, **Luis García Jr.** leads Major League Baseball with 35 RBI since May 22.
- **Jorbit Vivas** homered on back-to-back games from June 23-24 for the first time in his career...In his last nine starts, he is hitting .367 (11-for-30) with two homers, seven RBI, three walks and five runs scored.

NAS (H)IM

Nasim Nuñez is 17-for-46 (.370) with a double, two triples, seven RBI, seven walks, seven stolen bases and nine runs scored over his last 16 games...He has hit safely in 11 of the 16 games and has produced six multi-hit efforts.

- He has reached base safely in 18 of 22 games, hitting .338 (23-for-68) with a .408 on-base percentage (8 BB) and a .426 slugging percentage (2 2B, 2 3B).
- His career-long 15-game on-base streak and nine game hitting streak were the longest such streaks by a Nationals player this season.
- On the season, he leads Major League Baseball with 32 stolen bases and trails only **Trea Turner** (35 in 2017) for the most stolen bases prior to the All-Star break in Nationals history (2005-pres.).
