FLIGHT PATTERN: The St. Louis Cardinals begin the Merry, Merry Month of May (performed famously by Hollywood Walk of Fame actor / singer **Nelson Eddy**) with a three-game weekend series against the defending back/back World Series Champion Los Angeles Dodgers that kicks off a six-game homestand (LAD-3, MIL-3)...the Cardinals are scheduled to play 15 home games in May...the Cardinals are 55-62 in games played against the Dodgers in the seasons (2025, 2021, 1989, 1982, 1964, 1960 and 1956) that followed their World Series titles.

THE WORD ON THE BIRDS: St. Louis entered today in 3rd place in the NL Central, 2.0 games back of first place Cincinnati ... Tonight's game is their 8th amongst a season-high 17-straight without an off day (4-3 record) ... The Cardinals (-3), Reds, (-3), Rays (-1) and Athletics (-5) are the lone MLB teams with winning records but negative run differentials.

WHAT A MONTH-ISH The Cardinals 18-13 record for March/April was their best since a 19-10 March/April start in 2019 when they were NL Central Champions...St. Louis is one of eight MLB teams with 18+ wins.

EXPECT THE UNEXPECTED: The Cardinals 18-13 mark has surpassed Baseball-Reference's expected W-L of 15-16 despite posting a -3 run differential. Only the Cincinnati Reds (20-11 vs. exW-L of 15-16) have a greater difference in expected W-L.

THE EARLY BIRDS: The following are some of the Cardinals key leaders thru the month of April:

THE MARTIAN: Mars, PA native **JJ Wetherholt** enjoyed an out-of-this-world debut in in his home state at PNC Park in front of his family, friends and West Virginia University Alums posting a .375/.474/.938 slash (1.411 OPS) in the four-game series mop-up. He collected extra base hits in all four games, including a game-tying HR in the 9th on Monday and a lead-off HR off Paul Skenes in yesterday's win...JJ has an extra-base hit in six consecutive games; In the modern era (since 1900), the only Redbird rookies with a longer streak are **George Watkins** (8 games in 1930), **Enos Slaughter** (7-1938) and **Albert Pujols** (7-2001).

TOP CAT: **Wetherholt**, who we learned this week has a pet cat, appropriately named "Cat", has matched **Drew Stubbs** (CIN, 2009), **Randy Kutcher** (SF, 1986) and **Johnny Frederick** (Brooklyn Robins, 1929) for most HR (7) in first 30 career games started as a leadoff man contained within a single season...**JJ** and **Frederick** are the lone LHB's to do so...among players 23 or younger, the Dodgers **Yusial Puig** holds the top mark (8 HR) in first 31 career leadoff games, doing so between 2013-14... prior to JJ's showing, Cardinals HOF legend **Lou Brock** held the top mark among left-handed hitting lead-off batters age 23 or younger with 5 HRs for the Chicago Cubs in his first 31 career leadoff games started between 1961-62.

Dustin May pitched parts of six seasons with Los Angeles (2019-25)...member of the 2020 World Champion Dodgers...originally selected by Los Angeles in the 3rd round of the 2016 MLB Draft.

Lars Nootbaar, **Shohei Ohtani**, **Roki Sasaki**, and **Yoshinobu Yamamoto** were teammates on Japan's Gold Medal-winning team in the 2023 World Baseball Classic.

Andre Pallante was born in Mission Viejo and resides in San Clemente...graduated from San Clemente High School...played college baseball at the Univ. of California, Irvine (2017-19).

Michael McGreevy was born in and resides in San Clemente...graduated from San Clemente High School...played college baseball at the University of California, Santa Barbara (2019-21).

Justin Bruhl pitched parts of three seasons with the Dodgers (2021-23) where he made his MLB debut...played college baseball California Polytechnic State University, San Luis Obispo.

Dean Kiekhefer made his MLB debut at Dodger Stadium (May 14, 2016) ...struck out career-high four of six total batters faced, including first batter, Joc Pederson (looking).

Tommy Edman played parts of five seasons with St. Louis (2019-24)...won a Gold Glove at second base in 2021...selected by the Cardinals in the 6th round of the 2016 MLB Draft.

Lars Nootbaar was born in & resides El Segundo, Calif...Graduated from El Segundo High School... Played college baseball at USC (2016-18).

JoJo Romero was born in Camarillo, CA...graduated from Oxnard (Calif.) High School.

Brant Brown previously served as Dodgers Assistant Hitting Coach and Minor League Hitting Coordinator for five seasons (2018-22).

Victor Scott II made his MLB debut at Dodger Stadium (March 28, 2024)...is the only Cardinal (since 1900) to steal a base in his Major League debut on Opening Day.

Cardinals Hall of Famer **Mark McGwire** was born in Pomona and resides in San Clemente, Calif... graduated from Damien High School in La Verne, Calif...played college baseball at the University of Southern California...served as Dodgers Hitting Coach for three seasons (2013-15).

Cardinals Hall of Famer **Al Hrabosky** graduated from Savanna High School in Anaheim...played college baseball at Fullerton (Calif.) College.

Cardinals broadcaster **Ricky Horton** pitched in 35 games over parts of two seasons (1988-89) for the Dodgers between stints with St. Louis...member of 1988 World Series champion Dodgers.

Hall of Fame Manager **Joe Torre** managed both the Cardinals (1990-95) and Dodgers (2008-10).

Cardinals AGM/Scouting **Randy Flores** was born in Bellflower...graduated from El Rancho High School in Pico Rivera...pitched at the University of Southern California (1994-97).

Ron "Pop" Warner was born in Alhambra, Calif.

Cardinals broadcaster **Mark Sweeney** played his two final MLB seasons with the Dodgers (2007-08)...Was originally selected by the Dodgers in the 39th round of the 1990 MLB draft, but did not sign.

Hall of Famer **Ozzie Smith** graduated from Locke High School in Los Angeles...played college baseball at Cal Polytechnic State Univ., San Luis Obispo.

Cardinals Hall of Famer **John Tudor** pitched two seasons (1988-89) with Los Angeles, where he won a World Series...originally traded by St. Louis to the Dodgers for **Pedro Guerrero** (Aug. 16, 1988).

Cardinals broadcaster **Polo Ascencio** worked for parts of 10 seasons (2008-16) for Dodgers radio and Spanish website.

Dodgers MLB Field Coordinator **Bob Geren** played five minor league seasons in the Cardinals organization (1981-85).

St. Louis Post-Dispatch reporter **Daniel Guerrero** is an Anaheim, Calif. native...earned associates degree in journalism at Fullerton College.

Athletic reporter **Katie Woo** previously covered the Cardinals for five seasons (2021-25).

TONIGHT'S GAME:

- Cardinals 26-year-old Opening Day southpaw starting pitcher makes his team-leading 7th start of the season tonight.
- Tonight's game marks his 127th career Major League appearance and his 60th career start.
- Is making his 8th career appearance (2nd start) against the Dodgers; is 0-5 vs. NL West clubs over his career - the lone division he has yet to post a W against.
- The Cardinals are 14-15 in his 29 career starts at Busch Stadium, where he has gone 10-10 with a 3.96 ERA (145.1 IP/64 ER) with 10 quality starts.
- He pitched 5.0 or more innings in each of his first five starts this season before a 3.1 IP outing last Sat. (4/25) vs. SEA, his shortest start since 7/11/25 at ATL (3.0 IP)
- Still seeking his 1st win of 2026 (0-1), but Cardinals have gone 4-1 in his five no-decisions.

LAST TIME OUT (Saturday, April 25 vs. Seattle): ND, L, 11-9; 3.1 IP, 8 H, 5 R, 5 ER, 1 BB, 3 SO, 3 HR, 64 pitches).

2026 HIGHLIGHTS:

HR DERBY: Surrendered a career-high 3 HR's in 3.1 IP last Sat. (4/25) vs. SEA as the two teams combined for 33 hits and 8 HR's in 11-9 Mariners win.

SPACE DUST: Worked a season high 6.0 IP, allowing just one run on three hits, taking a ND in the Cardinals 7-5 extra inning win on 4/19 at HOU to complete the series sweep of the Astros.

FIRST TO 100: Threw a career high 105 pitches in 9-3 loss vs. CLE on 4/13 in 5.0 IP; He is the lone Cardinals pitcher to reach the 100 pitch plateau thus far.

NO FOOLING: Held the Mets to one run in his second start on April Fools Day, a day after **Andre Pallante** and company shut out New York. Retired the first 12 Mets batters (first time a Cardinal vs. NYM since 1968) and carried a no-hitter through 4.2 innings, longest of his career.

LIBBY'S LID-LIFTER: Made his 1st career Opening Day start and received a no decision vs. TB (3/26) despite pitching 5.0 innings and allowing just one run. Cardinals rallied for a 9-7 win (he exited with game tied 1-1).

LEFTY LIFT-OFFS: Made his 1st career Opening Day start on 3/26 vs. TB, becoming the 1st Cardinals lefty to start on Opening Day since **Donovan Osborne** (4/5/99) vs. MIL - the same year that Libby was born. He became one of just 16 LHP's to make the Opening Day start for the Cardinals since 1901 (MLB).

CAREER:

- Chose to switch to uniform No. 32 prior to 2026 season in honor of Hall of Fame left-handed pitcher **Sandy Koufax**, whom he grew up admiring.
- Was acquired by the Cardinals from the Rays in a four-player trade in 2020 that included Randy Arozarena, with a compensation pick that netted the Cardinals RHP **Tink Hence**.
- Is a career 13-22 with a 4.86 ERA (283.1 IP) in his 59 career starts opposed to 3-3 with a 3.89 ERA (81.0 IP) in 67 career relief appearances.
- Has limited left-handed batters to a .250/.309/.385 (91-364) with a .694 OPS average over his Major League career.
- 2021 Cardinals Minor League Pitcher of the Year, his first season of play in the Cardinals organization.

LIBERATORE vs. LOS ANGELES DODGERS:

- Making his 2nd career start vs. the Dodgers and 8th career appearance.
- Has no decisions and a 6.39 ERA over his seven previous appearances covering 12.2 innings.
- Dodgers are batting .300 in their career against the lefty with 2 HR's, including a HR by **Shohei Ohtani** on 8/6/25 at Dodger Stadium when the two squared off as opposing starters.
- Is 0-5 career vs. NL West clubs - the lone MLB division that he has not yet posted a win against.

NO PAIN, NO GAIN: Was hit by pitch in 5 consecutive games (4/15-20) setting the franchise record and tied for the 2nd-longest streak in MLB history with Doc Gessler (Brooklyn, 1903), one behind Carlos Quentin (2008, CWS) for the MLB record. Is T-2nd in MLB with 7 HBP this season.

LOOKIE AT THE ROOKIE: Hit a pair of home runs vs. CLE (4/14), his first multi-HR game and first by a Cardinal since Masyn Winn (4/30/25 at CIN).
