METSCELLANEOUS: The Mets were off on Monday...On Sunday, the Mets dropped the final game of their four-game series with the Marlins, 2-0...They have lost each of their last three games and finished their 10-game homestand 4-6...The Mets were shut out for the 11th time this season, which is tied with Pittsburgh for the most games in the majors...New York has been held to five or fewer hits 30 times this season...That is tied for the second-most such games in the majors this season and they fall to 2-28 in those contests...Are now 4-6 against the Marlins this season and 17-19 against NL East foes overall...The Mets start a nine-game road trip against the Guardians (three games).

MANAEA ON A MISSION: Sean Manaea is set to make his 10th start of the season...He allowed two runs on five hits with two walks and four strikeouts in his last outing on July 29 vs. Atlanta... Since returning to the rotation on June 13, Manaea has made nine starts and is 1-4 with a 3.88 ERA (21 ER/48.2 IP) with 13 walks and 43 strikeouts...Prior to that, he appeared in 14 games for the Mets and 1-1 with a 5.02 ERA (24 ER/43.0 IP) with 17 walks and 45 strikeouts.

ON THE ROAD AGAIN: The Mets are in the midst of a nine-game road trip...They are 22-32 away from Citi Field this season...They have posted a 4.11 ERA, while batting .232/.298/.379 on the road this year.

GUARDIANS-METS NOTES: The Mets have lost six straight games to the Guardians dating back to May 20, 2024...This comes after they won seven straight against the Guardians from April 17, 2016-May 21, 2023.

BLAME IT ON THE BENGE: Carson Benge batted .302/.371/.430 with 11 runs, five doubles, two homers, nine RBI, nine walks, six steals and an .801 OPS in 23 games in July...His 107 hits are tied for the third-most by a rookie this year and are tied for the second-most in the National League.

LINSANITY: Francisco Lindor has reached base in 12 of his last 14 games dating back to July 19...Over that span, he is slashing .340/.435/.660 with six runs, three doubles, one triple, four homers, 13 RBI, nine walks and a 1.096 OPS...He has reached base at least three times on nine times this season and four of those instances have occurred over his last 14 games.

THIS DAY IN 1986: The Mets fell to the Cubs, 4-2, at Wrigley Field... Ron Darling took his fourth loss of the season, allowing all four runs over 6.0 innings of work...The Mets were held to five hits including two from Kevin Mitchell...This season, the Mets will celebrate the 40th anniversary of the 1986 World Series Champions..The Mets will also host a 1986 World Series Reunion and Celebration to celebrate the 1986 title today.

NEW SKIPPER: Andy Green has been named Interim Manager for the remainder of the 2026 season...Green, who joined the Mets organization in 2023 and previously served as Senior Vice President, Baseball Development, managed the San Diego Padres from 2016-19, guiding the club to a 274-366 (.428) record...The 48-year-old played parts of four Major League seasons with the Diamondbacks (2004-06) and appeared in four games with the Mets in 2009...He will wear #70...The Mets are 12-19 since Green took the helm.

LAST TIME OUT: Fired 6.0 innings on July 29 (G1) against the Braves (6.0 IP, 5 H, 2 ER, 2 BB, 1 HR, 4 K) and allowed two runs on five hits over 6.0 innings while recording four strikeouts...Has posted quality starts in three of his last four outings...For his career, 219 of his 266 Major League appearances have come as a starter and over those starts, he is 75-66 with a 4.08 ERA (546 ER/1203.1 IP) and 1124 strikeouts.

RIGHTING THE SHIP: Overall, this season, Manaea is 2-5 with a 4.42 ERA (45 ER/91.2 IP) and has 88 strikeouts over 23 appearances (nine starts)...Over his last 15 appearances dating back to May 10, he has pitched to a 3.63 ERA (28 ER/69.1 IP) with 64 strikeouts...He has held opponents to a .244 (64-262) average while posting an 8.31 K/9 IP over that span...Comparatively, he pitched to a 6.85 ERA (17 ER/22.1 IP), and batters were hitting .312 (29-93) off him during his first eight appearances of the season.

VS. CLEVELAND: Will make his eighth career start against the Guardians today...Is 3-1 with a 3.66 ERA (16 ER/39.1 IP) and 42 strikeouts lifetime against Cleveland...In three of his seven career starts against the Guardians, he has completed 7.0 innings and allowed three or fewer earned runs in six of his seven appearances...Three of his starts against Cleveland have been quality starts.

HOW SWEEP IT IS: This season, he has thrown his sweeper 31.1% of the time...He is one of 17 qualified pitchers who have thrown their sweeper at least 30.0% of the time...He has generated a 30.7% whiff rate on his sweeper...35 of his 88 strikeouts this season have come via the sweeper.

CAREER: Over the course of 11 Major League Seasons with the Athletics, Padres, Giants, and Mets he has an 81-71 record, a 4.11 ERA (610 ER/1336.2 IP), and 1272 strikeouts in 266 games and 219 starts...His 1272 career strikeouts are the ninth-most among active left-handers...He re-signed with the Mets on a three-year contract in December 2024....The Valparaiso, Indiana native was originally drafted in the first round by the Kansas City Royals in 2013 out of Indiana State University.

- His last appearance with the Mets came on July 31 vs. Miami (5.0 IP, 6 H, 2 ER, 2 K, HR) where he fired 5.0 innings in relief and only allowed two runs...Marked his longest outing since September 28, 2024 at Toronto and his second career relief appearance of at least 5.0 innings (also: 4/3/23 at OAK).
- Has made 11 appearances (nine starts) for Triple-A Syracuse this season and he is 2-0 with a 4.56 ERA (26 ER/51.1 IP)...His last appearance with them came on July 26 at Scranton Wilkes-Barre and he fired 2.0 scoreless innings in relief...His season-high in terms of pitches is 90 on June 16.
- His last appearance with the Mets came on July 20 at Milwaukee and he allowed one run over 2.2 innings (2.2 IP, 2 H, ER, 2 K, BB)...Was his longest relief outing since September 18, 2024 at Los Angeles-NL while with Miami.
- Got the final out of the ninth inning on eight pitches against Boston on July 10 (0.1 IP).
- Was selected to the Major League roster on July 8 and he made his Mets' debut that same night against Kansas City....He allowed one run over 1.0 inning while recording a strikeout (1.0 IP, H, ER, K, BB)...Prior, his last Major League appearance came on April 8, 2025 at Citi Field while with Miami.
- Before joining the Mets, had made 62 career Major League appearances (16 starts) between Cleveland (2022-2024) and Miami (2024-2025) and he is was 5-8 with a 4.38 ERA (73 ERA/150.0 IP).
- Was drafted by Cleveland in the seventh round of the 2019 MLB First-Year Player Draft out of Georgia Tech.

- Was selected to the Major League roster and recalled prior to today's game...Any appearance would mark his Major League debut.
- Has pitched in 34 games this season between Single-A St. Lucie (rehab appearances), High-A Brooklyn (rehab appearances) and Triple-A Syracuse and he is 2-3 with a 3.77 ERA (18 ER/43.0 IP)...25 of his appearances have been with Syracuse, where is 2-2 with a 3.27 ERA (12 ER/33.0 IP).
- Over five minor league seasons in the Mets system he is 12-9 with a 2.78 ERA (49 ER/158.2 IP) and 244 strikeouts.
