FEEL THIS MOMENT: After a tough, 2-4 road trip that saw two one-run losses, the Giants return home for their third to last homestand of the season, opening tonight vs. Miami.

- ▶ Despite dropping 10 of their last 16 games, SF is still 18-13 (.581) since July 26, which is tied for eighth-best in MLB.
- ▶ Due to the success of their competitors, SF is 6.5 back of the Braves (73-61) for the final Wild Card spot, and also now behind the Mets (70-64), Cubs (68-66) and Cardinals (67-67)...per *FanGraphs*, SF's playoff chances are now 1.3%.

DON'T STOP THE PARTY: RHP Hayden Birdsong celebrates his 23rd birthday today.

ROSTER MOVES: The Giants made the following roster moves prior to today's game.

- ▶ **IF/OF Brett Wisely** (#0) recalled from Triple-A Sacramento.
- ▶ **IF Thairo Estrada** outrighted to Triple-A Sacramento.
- ▶ **LHP Tyler Matzek** placed on unconditional release waivers.

AY MI DIOS: Dating back to August 9 vs. Detroit, 13 of SF's 18 games have been decided by two runs or fewer, with the Giants going 6-7 (.462) over that span.

- ▶ The Giants have played 70 games this year that have been decided by two runs or fewer, tied for second-most in MLB with Tampa Bay and behind Milwaukee (73 such games)...the Giants, however, are 32-38 (.457) in those contests, the sixth-worst winning percentage in two-run games in MLB.

GIVE ME EVERYTHING: SF plays 24 of its final 27 games against opponents who are currently .500 or better, with the only exceptions being tonight's opponent, Miami (49-85).

- ▶ SF is 34-47 (.420) this year against opponents who are currently at or above .500, 21st of 30 MLB teams.
- ▶ The Giants have the third-toughest remaining schedule in MLB in terms of their opponents' combined win%...SF's remaining opponents have a .536 win%, which trails only the Rockies (.552) and Rays (.539).

I KNOW YOU WANT ME: OF Heliot Ramos leads SF with 65 RBI, which are the most by a Giant at 24 or younger in a season since 24-year-old IF Matt Duffy had 77 RBI in 2015.

- ▶ The last Giants outfielder 24 or younger to log at least 65 RBI in a season was OF Chili Davis in 1984 (81 RBI also at 24).
- ▶ The last time a Giant under the age of 30 led the team in RBI (in a full season) was when IF Brandon Crawford had 84 RBI at 29 years old in 2016...the last time a Giant under the age of 25 led the team was IF Pablo Sandoval (70 RBI in 2011).

MOVE TO MIAMI SAN FRANCISCO: Since the start of the 2018 season, the Giants have won each of their last five home series vs. Miami, going 11-5 with 10 of 16 games being decided by one run (*Stats, LLC*).

- ▶ OF Michael Conforto has a .958 career OPS, 20 home runs and 59 RBI in 94 career games vs. the Marlins, which rank fifth, sixth and eighth among active players (min. 150 PA).

FIREBALL: LHP Blake Snell will open the series for SF...in four home starts since returning from the IL (left groin strain) on July 9, Snell has allowed just six hits and eight walks while striking out 37 in 24.1 shutout innings.

- ▶ Snell has not allowed a run in four-straight home starts, which is the longest streak (by a non-opener) of scoreless starts in franchise history.
- ▶ He is one of 26 pitchers in NL/AL history to have four-straight home starts with zero runs allowed while pitching at least 5.0 innings in each start, and the only of those pitchers to do it twice (also with SD in 2023).
- ▶ Snell is just the second pitcher in the modern era to have 75 or more strikeouts while allowing 20 or fewer hits over a nine-game span, joining 2021 Jacob DeGrom (*Stats, LLC*).
- ▶ The Marlins offer an interesting matchup for Snell, who is coming off a six-walk performance last time out...Miami has a 35.5% O-Swing rate (percent of swings at pitches outside the strike zone), which is the highest mark in MLB...the Marlins also have an MLB-low 6.5% walk rate.

DON'T STOP THE PARTY: The Giants are 13-12 (.520) in August...if they win one of their final two games this month, it would be just the second time the team posted a winning record in August since 2015 (also 2021, 19-9, .679).

- ▶ This season the Giants have scored 37.8% of their runs via a home run, which is the fourth-lowest percentage in MLB...in August, however, the Giants have scored 45.8% of their runs on home runs, which is the eighth-highest mark in MLB.
- ▶ SF entered August with a .256 opposing batting average...this month opponents are hitting .213...the .043 improvement is the second-largest in MLB in August behind only Houston (improved by .049) according to *Stats, LLC*.

TIME OF OUR LIVES: Two SF prospects and one manager earned Complex League honors yesterday.

- ▶ **LHP Jacob Bresnahan**, who was acquired at the trade deadline in exchange for RHP Alex Cobb, was named an ACL All-Star, posting a 2.54 ERA (13er, 46.0ip), 63 strikeouts and a 1.04 WHIP in 11 starts for the ACL Guardians.
- ▶ In the DSL, **IF Jesus Alexander** was named an All-Star, batting .381 with 26 runs, 17 doubles, three triples, five homers, 40 RBI and a 1.034 OPS in 47 games.
- ▶ DSL Giants Black manager **Juan Ciriaco** was named the league's Manager of the Year, going 40-13 (.755).

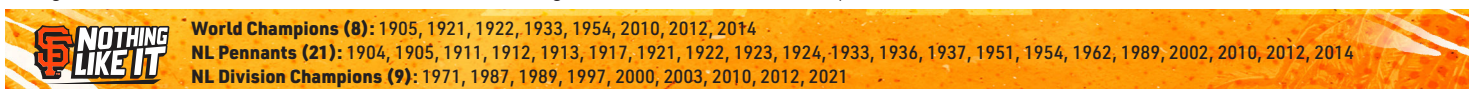
This Date in Giants History

CITY BY THE BLAKE: The reigning NL Cy Young will make his 16th start for SF...Snell joined SF late in the spring on a two-year, \$62 million contract (includes an opt out after the 2024 season).

LAST TIME OUT: Struggled with command in his first start in his home state of Washington since 2018...walked six while allowing two runs on no hits in 3.0 innings...did strike out five Mariners.

VS. MIAMI: Snell is 2-2 with a 3.27 ERA (12er, 33.0ip) and 45 strikeouts in six career starts vs. the Marlins.

👉 Last season, Snell struck out 15 while allowing three runs on nine hits and five walks across two starts against the Marlins (12.0 innings pitched) but did not win either start.

👉 Only three Marlins have history vs. Snell...C Nick Fortes is 0-for-4 with a strikeout, IF Jake Burger is 1-for-3 with two strikeouts and OF Cristian Pache is 0-for-2 with two strikeouts.

A NEW MAN: Even with a rough last outing, Snell has a sub-1.50 ERA over his last nine starts...since returning from the IL on July 9, Snell is 2-0 with a 1.30 ERA (8er, 55.1ip), 75 strikeouts, a 0.76 WHIP and a .111 opposing batting average over that span...prior to this stretch, Snell was 0-3 with a 9.51 ERA (25er, 23.2ip), 31 strikeouts and a 1.94 WHIP in six starts.

👉 His 1.30 ERA over his last nine games is the lowest ERA by a Giant in a nine-game span since **RHP Kevin Gausman** had a 1.11 ERA from May 8-June 23, 2021 (min. 55.0ip).

👉 Snell has 60 strikeouts over his last six starts, which is the most by a Giant since **LHP Madison Bumgarner** struck out 61 from August 5-September 1, 2015...the most strikeouts in franchise history over a seven-start span is held by **RHP Tim Lincecum** with 71 from June 23-July 27, 2009.

👉 Snell is just the second pitcher in the modern era to have 75 or more strikeouts while allowing 20 or fewer hits over a nine-game span, joining Jacob DeGrom, who did so in 2021 (*Stats, LLC*).

👉 Below is a chart of where Snell ranks in MLB since July 1.

DOWN AND OUT: Snell has thrice been on an inactive list...he missed 31 games with a left groin strain during this most recent trip to the IL (June 3-July 9), and paired with his trip to the Paternity List (May 23-May 26) and his first time on the IL with a left adductor strain (April 23-May 22), has missed a total of 59 games.

HOME IS WHERE THE HEAT IS: Although winless at Oracle Park, Snell has performed well with a 3.10 ERA (14er, 40.2ip), 59 strikeouts and a 1.08 WHIP in eight starts.

👉 In four home starts since returning from the IL (left groin strain) on July 9, Snell has allowed just six hits and eight walks while striking out 37 in 24.1 shutout innings.

👉 Snell's streak of four-straight home starts without allowing a run is the longest streak (by a non-opener) of shutout starts in franchise history...**LHP Scott Alexander** (October 1, 2022-August 11, 2023) and **RHP John Brebbia** (July 3, 2022-April 25, 2023) each have five-game streaks as openers.

👉 He is one of 26 pitchers in NL/AL history to have four-straight home starts with zero runs allowed over 5.0 innings, and the only of those 26 pitchers to do it twice (also with SD in 2023).

GOTTA GET AHEAD: Getting ahead has been vital to Snell's success this season...opponents are slashing .122/.208/.180 with a .388 OPS when he gets ahead 0-1 in the count...when he falls behind 1-0, opponents are slashing .274/.400/.474 with an .874 OPS.

CURVE IT: Opponents are hitting .079 (8x101) against Snell's curveball with 57 strikeouts this season...Snell has thrown 273 curveballs since returning from the IL on July 9, holding opponents 5-for-77 (.065) with 44 strikeouts and 74 swing and misses.

WALK IT BACK: This season, Snell has walked 36 batters in 79.0 innings with an 11.2% walk rate...the Marlins have a 35.5% O-Swing rate (percent of swings at pitches outside the strike zone), which is the highest mark in MLB, and a 6.5% walk rate, which is lowest in MLB.

FAST TIMES: Snell's four-seam fastball, which he's thrown 46.4% of the time, has a .214 opposing batting average (24x112) with 32 strikeouts and a .339 slugging percentage...in his last nine starts, however, opponents are 7-for-71 (.099) with zero extra-base hits, 23 strikeouts and a .099 slugging percentage.

NO-NO REVISTED: His no-hitter on August 2 was the 18th in Giants franchise history and first since **RHP Chris Heston** tossed one on June 9, 2015 at the Mets.

👉 Snell is the fifth left-handed pitcher to throw a no-no in Giants history joining **George Wiltse**, **Rube Marquard**, **Carl Hubbell** and **Jonathan Sánchez**.

👉 According to *Sarah Langs* via *Elías*, Snell became the fifth reigning Cy Young winner to throw a no-hitter...the other four are Jake Arrieta (2016), Clayton Kershaw (2014), Bob Gibson (1971) and Sandy Koufax (1964).
