AROUND THE HORN

LOCK IN 2027 TICKETS NOW: D-backs 2027 Advantage Memberships feature Postseason ticket priority, along with discounted ticket plans, preferred seat priority and more, and are available now by placing a deposit at dbacks.com/membership...the 2027 schedule is packed with fan favorites and holiday staples including Mother's Day in May, Father's Day in June and the 4th of July, monthly NL West matchups and exciting Interleague action.

HERE'S THE STORY: The D-backs have won 8 straight home series vs. Rockies (22-5) since Aug 5-7, 2022 and 13 of their last 14 (35-13) since Sept. 25-27, 2020.

- The D-backs are 8-4 in their last 12 games and 18-9 in their last 27 games.
- The D-backs' 18 wins since July 9 are tied for second most in the Majors (also: Braves), behind the Red Sox (22).
- The D-backs are a season-high-tying 7 games over .500 for the sixth time this season (also: 31-24 on May 27, 59-52 on Aug. 1, 60-53 on Aug. 4, 61-54 on Aug. 6 and 62-55 on Aug. 8)...were last 8+ games above .500 the final day of the 2024 season (Sept. 29 at 89-73, 16 games above).
- The D-backs are in their final 3-game set of this 10-game homestand vs. NL West...are 17-13 vs. Padres (5-5), Dodgers (7-6) and Rockies (5-2) this season.
- **Michael Soroka** is making his first start since June 19 vs. Twins (exited after 1.0 inning with a strained left glute).

LAST GAME: The D-backs won 4-2 vs. Dodgers yesterday to secure their first season series win against them since 2018.

- **Eduardo Rodriguez** tossed a quality start to earn his team-leading 11th win...allowed 2 runs over 7.0 frames and set season marks with 9 strikeouts and 115 pitches (5 H, 2 BB, 9 K).
- **Ketel Marte** gave the D-backs a 2-0 lead in the first inning with his 2-run homer (20).
- **Gabriel Moreno's** RBI double in the second inning pushed the D-back lead to 4-0.
- **Kevin Ginkel** recorded his first save since Aug. 9, 2026 with a perfect ninth inning and 2 strikeouts.
- **Taylor Clarke** recorded his career-best 13th hold of the season with a scoreless eighth inning (H, 0 BB).

ROSTER MOVES: The D-backs reinstated RHP **Michael Soroka** from the 15-day injured list (strained left glute), agreed to terms on a 1-year contract with RHP **Zack Littell** (No. 46), optioned RHP **Kade Stroud** to Triple-A Reno following yesterday's game and designated RHP **Paul Sewald** for assignment.

WILD CARD RACE: The D-backs are tied for the second NL Wild Card spot with the Phillies (WC2), 6.0 games behind the Cubs (WC1) and 1.0 ahead of the Padres.

DIVISION WINS: The D-backs' .641 division win pct. (25-14) ranks third in the Majors, behind the Braves (.676, 25-12) and Brewers (.667, 22-11).

SERIES-LY SPEAKING: The D-backs have won or split 8 of their last 9 series (2-2 @ Padres, 3-0 @ Dodgers, 2-1 vs. Cardinals, 2-1 vs. Athletics, 1-2 @ Nationals, 2-1 @ Pirates, 2-1 @ Guardians, 2-2 vs. Padres, 2-1 vs. Dodgers)...does not include the 1-game makeup win on July 23 @ Cardinals.

MINOR LEAGUE SPOTLIGHT: High-A Hillsboro RHP **Wellington Aracena**, today was named Northwest League Pitcher of the Week for Aug. 3-9...the 21-year-old Dominican Republic native tossed 6.0 scoreless innings in relief and earned his first save vs. Tri-City on Aug. 6 (2 H, 0 BB, 5 K).

HOME SWEET HOME: The D-backs' .583 home win pct. (35-25) is sixth in the NL, behind the Braves (.661, 39-20), Brewers (.651, 41-22), Marlins (.600, 36-24), Cubs (.593, 35-24) and Dodgers (.589, 33-23).

- The D-backs are 8-4 in their last 12 home games since July 18...in that span, they rank among the Majors in walks (3rd, 53), OPS (4th, .820), SLG (5th, .467) and OBP (5th, .353).

ON THE ROX: **Corbin Carroll** has a 14-game hitting streak vs. Rockies, batting .379 (22-for-58)/1.230 OPS with 4 doubles, 2 triples, 5 homers, 14 RBI and 8 walks.

PERDOMO SURGE: **Geraldo Perdomo** has hit safely in 9 of his last 10 games at a .400 clip (16-for-40)/1.055 OPS with 1 double, 2 triples, 1 homer, 5 RBI and 4 walks, including reaching base 2+ times in 8 of those.

NOOTBAAR'S NEW DIGS: **Lars Nootbaar** has reached base safely in his first 5 games as a D-back (3 H, 4 BB/.333 OBP) since being acquired on Aug. 3 from the Cardinals, including reaching base 2+ twice.

STARTING PITCHERS: D-backs' starting pitchers, in their last 13 bids since July 27, own a 2.21 ERA (23 R-19 ER in 77.1 IP), opponent .224 AVG (63-for-281)/.592 OPS, with 25 walks and 57 strikeouts.

- Since July 27, the D-backs' rotation ranks among MLB leaders in fewest homers (T-1st, 2), innings (T-2nd, 77.1), ERA (4th, 2.21), earned runs (T-4th, 19) and OPS (5th, .592).

'PEN SPOTLIGHT: **Brandyn Garcia** is scoreless in 20 of his 21 home games, going 0-0 with a 0.49 ERA (1 ER in 18.1 IP), opponent .150 AVG (9-for-60)/.407 OPS, 0.65 WHIP, 3 walks and 14 strikeouts.

- **Juan Morillo** is scoreless in 11 of his last 12 games, going 1-0 with a 0.75 ERA (1 ER in 12.0 IP), opponent .158 AVG (6-for-38)/.425 OPS, 0.75 WHIP, 3 walks and 13 strikeouts.

VS. ROCKIES: The D-backs are 21-4 in their last 25 home games vs. Rockies...took 3 of 4 in their last series @ Chase Field.
