On Base

Michael Harris II and Ozzie Albies each extended their on-base streaks to 15 games yesterday, tied for the fourth-longest streaks in Major League Baseball.

The only longer active streaks belong to Bryce Harper (PHI, 33 games), Miguel Vargas (CWS, 17 games) and Heriberto Hernández (MIA, 17 games).

Albies' streak is his second-longest this season behind an 18-gamer than spanned April-May. Harris II hasn't recorded a longer single-season streak since September 2024, when he reached in 17 straight.

TONIGHT'S GAME: The Atlanta Braves and Washington Nationals today begin a two-game midweek series to round out their season slate against one another...The Braves won a pair of four-game series over the Nationals from April 20-23 (3-1) and July 30-August 2 (4-0).

 The Nationals handed the Braves their first home series loss of the season from May 22-24, taking two-of-three games...Entering that set, Atlanta was a perfect 8-0-0 in home series and 14-1-1 in series play overall.

 With eight wins over Washington this season, Atlanta has already captured the season series...The Braves have won the season set over the Nationals eight times in the last nine seasons, dating to 2018... The Braves are 85-51 (.625) in 136 total games against the Nationals in that span...In that span, their only losing season against the club occurred in 2024 (5-8, .385).

 Jake Irvin is set to make his fourth start against Atlanta this season, marking the second time he has made four starts against the team in a single campaign (also 2024)...Since 2020, only one other pitcher has done so multiple times: Aaron Nola (PHI; '21, '22, '24)...Irvin, a 6-foot-6, 234-pound right-hander, has started against the Braves 10 times throughout his 107-start, major-league career, going 3-4 with a 4.08 ERA (24 ER/53.0 IP)...His ERA against the Braves is nearly a full point lower than his career ERA (5.03)...Since Irvin's major-league debut in 2023, he has started more games against Atlanta than any other player in MLB.

AJ SMITH-SHAWVER: Is set to make his fourth major-league start this season as he returns from Tommy John surgery...In his last turn, on August 26, he covered 5.0 innings in a no-decision against the Los Angeles Dodgers...The Braves won, 6-5, at Truist Park.

 The right-hander from Colleyville, TX, has made three previous starts against Washington, more than he's made against any other club...He's 1-0 with a 4.40 ERA (7 ER/14.1 IP) all-time against the Nationals...He began his career with 11.1 scoreless innings against the team before allowing all seven earned runs in his most recent appearance on May 22, 2025.

YOUNG STARTERS: AJ Smith-Shawver is one of four pitchers, 23-or-younger, to appear for Atlanta this season, joining RHP Didier Fuentes, RHP Owen Murphy and RHP JR Ritchie...Only one other team has had as many pitchers that young: the Chicago White Sox (4).

 Each of the aforementioned pitchers has made a start for the Braves...No other major-league team has had more than two 23-year-olds (or younger) make a start this season...The last Atlanta club to have at least four such pitchers make a start was the 2021 iteration, when RHP Ian Anderson, LHP Kyle Muller, RHP Bryse Wilson and RHP Huascar Ynoa each started before turning 24.

WITHIN THE DIVISION: Atlanta enters this National League East matchup against Washington with the best intradivision record in Major League Baseball (27-13, .675)...The Milwaukee Brewers rank second at 22-12 (.647).

 The Braves' .675 intradivisional winning percentage would finish as the team's third-best in the Divisional Era (since 1969)...The club finished with a higher mark in 1993 (.705) and 1999 (.686).

 Following this series, Atlanta has 10 games remaining against NL East foes: seven against Philadelphia and three against Miami...The Braves are 5-1 (.833) versus the Phillies and 8-2 (.800) versus the Marlins this season.

CATCHERS: Atlanta's catching tandem of Sean Murphy and Drake Baldwin went 3-for-7 yesterday evening, reaching base four times in eight plate appearances... The duo has combined to bat .407/.448/.685 (22-for-54) with nine extra-base hits, nine runs and nine RBI dating to August 23.

 Since Murphy returned from the injured list on August 3, Baldwin has played 13 games as Atlanta's designated hitter and batted .412/.429/.618 in these contests...He has hits in 12 of the 13 games, and multi-hit efforts in 10 of them...Regardless of position, Baldwin's 11 multi-hit games since then are tied for second in MLB.

 Since August 23, Murphy has hit .400/.478/.800 with two doubles, two homers, five runs and four RBI...The Braves are 6-1 in games he has appeared in since August 20...Since joining Atlanta in 2023, the Braves have played to a 144-110 (.567) record in games wherein Murphy starts at catcher.

 Since the 2023 season, the Braves have garnered 15.7 fWAR from its primary catchers, the second most in the National League and fourth most in the majors behind the Seattle Mariners (21.7), Milwaukee Brewers (21.0) and Toronto Blue Jays (18.8).

ROSTER MOVE: The Braves today selected INF Kyle Farmer and RHP Blake Burkhalter to the major-league roster, and transferred RHP Robert Suarez to the 60-day injured list.

 Burkhalter, 25, was drafted by the Braves in the second round of the 2022 MLB First-Year Player Draft out of Auburn University...Across 16 games with Triple-A Gwinnett this season, the right-hander has pitched to a 3-1 record and a 1.48 ERA (4 ER/24.1 IP)...His first appearance will mark his major-league debut.

 Farmer, 36, rejoins the Braves after appearing in 12 games for the club earlier this season...He made the team out of spring training before being released on July 21...He subsequently re-signed with the organization and has slashed .256/.306/.256 (23-for-90) across 24 games with Triple-A Gwinnett since July 29.

Makes his fourth start of the season and the 19th of his major league career, in the opener of a two-game series at Washington...Atlanta is 1-2 in his three turns.
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Will make his fourth career start against the Nationals and enters play 1-0 with a 4.40 ERA (7 ER/14.1 IP) all-time against the club...Has not faced Washington in 2026.
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His lone previous outing in Washington came May 22, 2025, when he was charged with a career-high seven runs on eight hits over 3.0 innings in a no-decision.
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Earned the win in his other meeting with the Nationals, working 6.0 innings of one-unearned-run ball May 15, 2025 at Truist Park in a 5-2 victory...It was one of his two quality starts that season, both of which came at home.

Last pitched August 26 against Los Angeles (NL), allowing three runs on five hits over 5.0 innings in a no-decision Atlanta won 6-5...Marked his longest outing since May 15, 2025.
- 🍷

Was recalled from Triple-A Gwinnett on August 18 and makes his third start since rejoining the Braves.

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Went 1-0 with a 1.64 ERA (2 ER/11.0 IP) and 13 strikeouts over two starts with Gwinnett after being optioned July 30, allowing three hits and no home runs.

Has pitched to a 5.48 ERA (27 ER/44.1 IP) with a 1.58 WHIP over 10 career road starts, compared to a 2.70 mark (13 ER/43.1 IP) and a 1.11 WHIP across eight turns at Truist Park.

🍷

Eight of his 10 strikeouts this season have come on the splitter, against which opponents are hitting .217 (5-for-23) without a home run...Thirty-three of his 42 strikeouts came on the pitch in 2025, when hitters managed a .143 average (10-for-70) against it.

🍷

All nine of the earned runs charged to him this season have scored with men on base...Opponents have hit .240 (6-for-25) with the bases empty, and he has not been scored upon over 6.0 innings in that situation.

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Five of those nine earned runs have come in the fifth inning, where opposing hitters are 4-for-8...He has not allowed a run in the first, holding batters hitless in 10 at-bats.

2026

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Was placed on the 15-day injured list March 25 with right elbow reconstruction and transferred to the 60-day injured list April 3.

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Did not appear in a spring training game.

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Made five rehab starts from June 30 to July 23, going 1-0 with a 1.53 ERA (3 ER/17.2 IP) with 21 strikeouts and five walks...Built his pitch count from 41 in the first outing to 86 in the last.

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Made his season debut July 29 at New York (NL), allowing two runs over 4.1 innings in a no-decision, his first major league start since May 29, 2025.

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Was optioned to Triple-A Gwinnett on July 30 and recalled by Atlanta on August 18.

Made two starts for Gwinnett during the option, going 1-0 with a 1.64 ERA (2 ER/11.0 IP) and 13 strikeouts...Fanned seven over 5.1 innings in his most recent outing, August 11 against Norfolk, allowing one hit.

🍷

Received a no-decision August 19 at Minnesota, allowing five hits and four runs over 4.1 innings...Retired 12 of the 16 batters he faced over the first four innings before four of the five he faced in the fifth reached base.

🍷

Tossed 5.0 innings August 26 against Los Angeles (NL), allowing three runs on five hits and three walks with three strikeouts in a 6-5 Atlanta win...It was his first start at Truist Park since May 15, 2025, and Tommy Edman's two-run homer in the third was the first he has surrendered this season.

Career Recap

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Became the youngest pitcher to make his first start for Atlanta since Julio Teheran on May 7, 2011...Just one pitcher in baseball started at a younger age in 2023, with Eury Pérez making five such starts for Miami.

Just one Atlanta pitcher has started any playoff game at a younger age...Steve Avery made four starts in the 1991 playoffs, including two in the World Series, between 21 years, 179 days and 21 years, 195 days old.

🍷

At 20 years, 207 days old, he became the youngest Braves starting pitcher to earn a win since Steve Avery (20 years, 132 days) on August 24, 1990 against Chicago (NL).

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Beat Colorado on June 15, 2023...It was just the sixth time in Atlanta franchise history (since 1966) that a pitcher his age or younger was credited with a win.

Drafted by Atlanta in the seventh round of the 2021 MLB June Amateur Draft out of Colleyville Heritage High School in Colleyville, Texas...Born in Fort Worth, Texas.
