TO LEAD NL ALL-STARS: Torey Lovullo and his coaches will lead the NL for the 2024 All-Star Game on Tuesday, July 16 in Texas: Jeff Banister (Bench), Dave McKay (1B), Tony Perezchica (3B), Brent Strom (Pitching), Mike Fetters (Bullpen), Dan Carlson (Asst. Pitching), Joe Mather (Hitting), Damion Easley (Asst. Hitting), Rick Short (Asst. Hitting), Drew Hedman (Asst. Hitting) and Ryan DiPanfilo (Athletic Trainer). **SNAKEBITES**

THE NL CHAMPS: The 2023 National League Champion D-backs captured their second NL pennant and made their second trip to the World Series, first since winning it all in 2001, in their seventh Postseason berth ('99, '01, '02, '07, '11, '17, '23) last season.

LAST GAME: The D-backs scored 12 runs on 16 hits, including 5 doubles and 4 home runs, and 7 walks in a 12-4 victory @ Dodgers.

- Cristian Mena made his Major League debut (3.0 IP, 4 R-4 ER, 4 H, 3 BB, 2 K) and **Bryce Jarvis** got the win with 2.1 shutout frames (1 H, 2 BB, 1 K).
- Christian Walker had a career-high-tying 4 hits with 1 double, 2 homers, 4 RBI and 1 walk, his 12th career multi-homer game (second vs. Dodgers) and seventh career 4-hit game (last: June 13, 2023 vs. Phillies). • His 5 times on base (4 H, 1 BB) tied for his second-most for the fifth time (high is 6 times on July 17, 2019 @ Rangers).
- His 4 hits tied his career high for the 12th time.

ROSTER MOVES: The D-backs recalled RHP Joe Jacques from Triple-A Reno and optioned RHP Cristian Mena to Reno following last night's game.

2 ALL-STAR NODS, 2 ALL-STAR STARTS: Ketel Marte is now a 2-time All-Star after being named the fan-elected National League starting second baseman, besting Luis Arraez/Padres 55% to 45%, for his second career All-Star appearance and start (also: 2019).

- Joins Paul Goldschmidt as the only D-backs with multiple fan elections...is the D-backs' eighth fan-elected start for a position player.
- Was NL 2B leading vote-getter in Phase 1 Voting (1,853,424 votes) and finalist, ahead of Luis Arraez/Padres (1,760,593 votes), and won the
- Phase 2 voting with 55 percent of the votes to Arraez's 45 percent. • Second straight season the D-backs have had at least 1 starter...last
- year, D-backs outfielder Corbin Carroll was a fan-elected starter and Zac Gallen was named the NL's starting pitcher.

FUTURES GAME: Triple-A Reno INF Deyvison De Los Santos and Single-A Visalia OF Druw Jone were named to the NL Futures roster for the 2024 All-Star Futures Game to be played on Sat., July 13 in Texas.

COURTESY @OPTASTATS: The D-backs are the first team in baseball history to allow multiple homers before even getting an out but then shut out their opponent the rest of the way and win by 8+ runs.

SERIES WINS: The D-backs have won or split 7 of their last 9 series overall since May 30, going 5-2-2, including 1-1-2 on the road with series splits @ Mets and Padres then a series win @ Nationals and a series loss @ Phillies.

JULY NOTES: Ketel Marte has reached base safely in 13 straight games in July, since July 20, 2023, batting .373 (19-for-51)/1.103 OPS.

• Has hit safely in 16 of his last 22 games in July, since July 6, 2023.

• Gabriel Moreno has hit safely in 6 of 10 July games as a D-back (with a PA), batting .387 (12-for-31)/1.132 OPS.

VS. NL WEST: Christian Walker, Ketel Marte and Lourdes Gurriel Jr. are batting a combined .324 (106-for-327)/.946 OPS with 21 doubles, 19 home runs and 61 RBI vs. NL West.

WHAMMO-WHACKO: Christian Walker has homered in back-to-back games for the fourth time this year (also: May 21-22 @ Dodgers; May 31-June 1 @ Mets; June 12-13 vs. Angels).

- Has done 3 straight games 3 times (May 16-17 @ Dodgers; Aug. 14 @ Rockies and Aug. 15-16 @ Giants; Aug. 14-16 @ Rockies).
- ♦ Has a career-high-tying 4 straight multi-hit games (third time), batting .647 (11-for-19)/2.037 OPS with 3 doubles, 3 homers, 8 RBI and 2 walks (1 K).
- Has reached base safely in 9 of his last 10 road games, hitting .318 (14-for-44)/1.007 OPS with 3 doubles, 4 homers, 9 RBI and 1 walk.

OIS ROLLING: The D-backs offense in its last 8 games, since June 25, ranks among NL teams in AVG (4th, .274) OPS (2nd, .804), runs (3rd, 43) and extra-base hits (4th, 28).

♦ The D-backs offense over the last month+, since June 1, ranks among NL teams in AVG (3rd, .274), OBP (1st, .347), OPS (3rd, .795), SLG (3rd, .449), runs (T-2nd, 152) and extra-base hits (3rd, 94).

MARTE'S PART-AY CONTINUES: Ketel Marte leads all second basemen with a 4.4 bWAR, .514 SLG, .870 OPS, 38 extra-base hits, 50 RBI, 167 total bases, is tied for first with 17 homers and 11 defensive runs saved, second with 19 doubles, tied for second with a 1.4 dWAR and third with 93 hits.

His 4.4 bWAR is second in the NL to Shohei Ohtani/ LAD (4.9) and seventh in the Majors.

ELIAS SAYS: Courtesy Elias Sports Bureau, Christian Walker's 17 home runs at Dodger Stadium are the most by a visiting player since 2018 and are third most by a visiting player at any venue since 2018:

- The D-backs are 7-4 in their last 11 games vs. NL West, 2-1 at home and 5-3 on the road.
- Over the last 2 seasons, the D-backs are 45-36 vs. NL West, with a 24-15 home record and 21-21 road mark.

BASH BROS: Ketel Marte and Lourdes Gurriel Jr., in their last 13 games, since June 18, have combined to hit .343 (35-for-102)/.989 OPS with 13 extra-base hits (6 2B, 1 3B, 6 HR), 20 RBI, 9 walks and 16 runs.
