TODAY'S GAME: SF has dropped three of its last four games entering play today and is back at a season-worst 26-games under .500 for a second time this year...the Giants are 1-0 vs. Atlanta, 1-2 vs. Pittsburgh and 0-1 against the Mets on this three-city swing.

- ▶ The Giants are in the midst of a stretch in which they play 23 games in 24 days from August 18-September 9...SF's lone off day, which they used to fly to Atlanta, was last Sunday...the Giants are 7-11 in the first 18 games of this stretch.
- ▶ Last night's loss dropped SF to 25-48 (.342) on the road this season, the lowest road winning % in the Majors just below the Angels (23-44, .343).
- ▶ SF has won each of its last two series here at Citi Field and has won three of its last five dating to 2021 (series wins in 2021, 2024 and 2025)...yesterday's loss, however, clinched another season-series loss to the Mets, SF's fourth in the last five years.

GO RANDY, IT'S YOUR BIRTHDAY: RHP **Randy Rodríguez** turns 27 today.

ROSTER MOVES: RHP **Joel Kuhnel** (#54), who was claimed off waivers yesterday from Milwaukee, reported and is active for today's game...RHP **Ryan Walker** was optioned to Triple-A Sacramento.

TODAY'S STARTER: RHP **Anthony Molina** takes the hill for the second time on this trip after starting (and winning) the first game of this road trip on Monday in Atlanta...the former Brave allowed three runs on six hits over 5.0 innings in SF's 7-3 win at Truist Park.

- ▶ Molina joined the Giants organization on August 2 after being acquired for RHP Tyler Mahle but did not see action at the Major League level with SF until last week...in two games (one start), he's 2-0 with a 2.89 ERA (3er, 9.1ip), seven strikeouts and one walk.

WHITE HOT: IF Rafael Devers logged his 12th career game with five or more RBI and his eighth career game with three or more extra-base hits last night with his 3-for-4 day yesterday...Devers is 19-for-46 (.413) over his last 12 games with a .518 OBP, .935 SLG and a 1.453 OPS...he has seven homers, three doubles, 18 RBI, 14 runs scored and nine walks in this 12-game span.

- ▶ His 26 home runs since June 6 are second-most in MLB, behind only CHC's Pete Crow-Armstrong (30).
- ▶ Devers has 20 more games to try and hit seven more homers to reach 40, something no Giant has done since **Barry Bonds** hit 45 in 2004...the Giants own the second-longest active drought since the club's last 40-homer season behind only the Pirates, who last had a 40-homer season from Willie Stargell in 1973.
- ▶ Through 70 games (a stretch ending June 12), Devers hit .230 with nine HRs and a .409 SLG...in the 72 games that have followed, he's hit .284 with 24 homers and a .613 SLG.
- ▶ The 29-year-old has 34 doubles and 33 homers...the last Giant with at least 34 doubles and 33 homers in a season was Hall of Famer **Jeff Kent** (42 doubles, 37 homers in 2002).

UPS AND DOWNS: Since the start of SF's last homestand on August 24, the Giants are averaging 5.75 runs per game, fourth-best in MLB in that time behind only the Cubs (6.82), Brewers (5.91) and Twins (5.90)...the club's .779 OPS in this stretch is sixth-best in MLB.

- ▶ Scoring five typically has been a recipe for success for SF in 2026 as they are 41-12 in such games.
- ▶ The Giants, however, are 6-6 in this 12-game stretch while they are averaging 5.75 runs per game...on the other side the Giants are permitting an average of 5.50 runs/game, third-highest in the Majors since August 12 behind only the Cardinals (6.10) and Reds (6.80).

YOUTH MOVEMENT: The Giants enter today tied for the MLB lead with 15 players having made their debuts this season (also: White Sox)...the club can match their San Francisco era (since 1958) record of 16 players if **C Zach Morgan** gets into a game.

- ▶ Of the 28 players on SF's active roster today, nine have made their MLB debut this season... additionally, 13 of the 28 players on the Giants active roster still have rookie status.

MO MONEY: The 24-year-old from San Joaquin, VZ, was acquired the night before the trade deadline from the Atlanta Braves in exchange for RHP Tyler Mahle...this marks Molina's third season in the Majors (2024-2025 with Colorado) and 2026 with Atlanta and SF.

LAST TIME OUT: Tied his career-high with 5.0 innings pitched while logging a career-high six strikeouts in a win at Atlanta on August 31... Molina, who began the season in the Atlanta system, earned his second win in as many games since being called up by the Giants.

WHAT'S BEEN WORKING: Since joining the Giants, Molina has held opponents to a .158 average (3x19) off his four-seamer with five strikeouts...vs. his changeup, opponents are 0-for-6 with a strikeout.

VS. THE METS: Has pitched two games vs. the Mets in his career, allowing four runs (three earned) over 3.0 innings...Bo Bichette is 2-for-4 while Marcus Semien is 0-for-2 with two strikeouts.

WITH THE GIANTS: Was recalled by SF on August 24...has made two appearances for the Giants, earning the win in both games...he has a 2.89 ERA (3er, 9.1ip), seven strikeouts and a 0.86 WHIP in the two games with the Giants.

WITH THE BRAVES: Pitched in three games for Atlanta this year prior to being traded (May 1, June 14 and June 16), posting a 5.40 ERA (3er, 5.0ip), two strikeouts and a 1.40 WHIP...oddly enough, Molina was on the Braves roster for the original games of this series back in June and pitched against SF in the June 16 game, surrendering a homer to **Willy Adames** in the 8th inning...Molina was originally claimed off waivers by Atlanta from Colorado on December 5, 2025 before being outrighted on December 19.

THIS SEASON IN TRIPLE-A: Has spent the majority of this season in Triple-A for Gwinnett (Atlanta) and Sacramento (SF)...in total, he was 3-2 with a 3.55 ERA (25er, 63.1ip), 65 strikeouts and a 1.22 WHIP in 21 games (12 starts) at the Triple-A level.

LAST SEASON: Went 1-1 with a 7.27 ERA (28er, 34.2ip) and 24 strikeouts in 17 games (one start) for the Rockies in 2025...had a .351 opposing batting average (52x148) and a 1.67 WHIP... in 15 starts at Triple-A Albuquerque, he went 4-5 with a 6.59 ERA (51er, 69.2ip), 30 walks and 51 strikeouts.

WORLD CHAMP: Pitched for 2026 World Baseball Classic Champion Team Venezuela, making two appearances out of the bullpen.
