We're Going Streaking!

The Brewers are the first team in the Major League since the 2019 Astros to produce multiple winning streaks of 10+ games in a season.....the Astros had two 10-game winning streaks that season.....the Brewers are the first National League with multiple winning streaks of 10+ games since the 2017 Dodgers (10 games & 11 games).

Climbing the Charts

The Brewers (74-44) are 30 games over .500 for the first time since they were 95-65 on 10/1/21....the team has not been 31+ games over .500 since it was 95-64 on 9/30/21.

IT WON'T BE THE SAME: This season marks just the second without Bob Uecker on the radio for the Milwaukee Brewers (also 1970).....the 2003 Hall of Famer passed away at the age of 90 on January 16.

AT HOME: The team is a Major League-best 40-20 at home, going 14-5-0 in series play.....are 28-11 in the last 39 games, 17-4 in the last 21 and 7-1 in the last 8 with a 4-game winning streak.....had a season-high 6-game winning streak from 7/7-7/13.

<u>ON THE ROAD</u>: The team is a Major League-best 34-24 on the road, going 10-7-2 in series play....are 24-6 in the last 30 games and 12-1 in the last 13 contests with a season-high 7-game winning streak.

MANAGER: Pat Murphy is in his second season as Brewers manager.....he was voted 2024 NL Manager of the Year after going 93-69 and winning the NL Central division championship.....he is the first manager in franchise history (in either league) to earn the honor.....Murphy was named the 20th manager in franchise history on 11/15/23, replacing Craig Counsell.....he is signed to a 3-year contract through 2026.

COACHES: Associate manager Rickie Weeks (2nd season), field coordinator Néstor Corredor (3rd season/2nd in current role), pitching coach Chris Hook (7th season), assistant pitching 6 strategy coach Jim Henderson (4th season/2nd in current role), bullpen coach Charlie Greene (2nd season), lead hitting coach Al LeBoeuf (1st season), hitting coach Connor Dawson (4th season), hitting coach Eric Theisen (1st season), assistant coach Daniel de Mondesert (2nd season), infield coach Matt Erickson (2nd coach season), first base coach Julio Borbón (1st season), third base coach Jason Lane (10th season/5th in current role)

LET'S GO TO THE VIDEO TAPE: The team has made 20 replay challenges this season, going 13-7.....their last challenge (won) came on 8/4 at Atlanta as an out call at first base involving Andrew Vaughn was overturned.

BREWING SUCCESS: The Brewers have made the postseason six times in the last seven seasons (2018-24) and won the NL Central in four of the last seven, three of four, and two in a row....Milwaukee is one of five teams to make the postseason in at least six of the last seven seasons, joined by the Astros (7), Braves (7), Dodgers (7) and Yankees (6).....the team was just 2 games away from qualifying for the postseaso eight straight seasons (2017-24), missing by a single game in both 2017 and 2022.

BREWING CONSISTENCY: The Brewers, Astros and Dodgers are the only teams with 86+ wins in each of the last seven full seasons (2017-24).....this does not include 2020.....the Brewers have 740 wins since 2017 (4th in MLB/2nd in National League).

SUMMARY: Are 253-196 all time, including 5-3 this season and 65-36 since 2019.....went 7-6 last season.

at MIL: Are 144-79 all time, going 133-69 at American Family Field and 11-10 at County Stadium....are 3-1 this season.....went 3-3 last season and are 34-14 since 2019.

at PIT: Have gone 109-117 all time, going 97-112 at PNC Park and 12-5 at Three Rivers Stadium....are 2-2 this season went 4-3 last season

PERALTA AT A GLANCE: All-Star Freddy Peralta, 29, will make his 25th start of the season and third against the Pirates.....Peralta last started last Tuesday at Atlanta and earned a 7-2 win (5ip, 4h, 1r, 1er, 3bb, 7k, 1hr, 108 pitches).....the team is 15-9 in his starts.....he has 9 quality starts.....opponents are batting .207 (100-for-482, 16hr).....he has 1,090 career strikeouts, trailing only Yovani Gallardo (1,226) and Ben Sheets (1,206) on the all-time franchise list.....Peralta was acquired from Seattle with RHP Carlos Herrera and RHP Daniel Missaki for 1B Adam Lind on 12/9/15.....on 2/28/20, he signed a 5-year contract through the 2024 season with club options for 2025 and 2026.

RIGHT SAID FRED: Peralta is tied with Garrett Crochet (BOS) for the Major League lead with his career-high 13 wins.....he also ranks among National League leaders in opponent AVG (7th, .207), H/9IP (7th, 6.89) and ERA (10th, 3.03).

CAREER: Is 66-41 with a 3.68 ERA and 1 save in 202 games/153 starts (885ip, 362er).....is in his eighth Major League season, all with the Brewers (2018-25).....is 58-39 with a 3.66 ERA as a starter (801ip, 326er) and 8-2 with a 3.86 ERA in relief (84ip, 36er).....was an All-Star in 2021 and 2025.....was the Opening Day starter in 2024 and 2025.

CAREER AT AMERICAN FAMILY FIELD: Is 38-20 with a 3.32 ERA in 107 games/79 starts (474.2ip, 175er)....is 7-1 with a 2.13 ERA in 12 starts this season (67.2ip, 16er).

CAREER ON THE ROAD: Is 28-21 with a 4.10 ERA in 95 games/74 starts [410.1ip, 187er].....is 6-4 with a 4.00 ERA in 12 starts this season [63ip, 28er].

CAREER vs. PIRATES: Is 3-2 with a 3.58 ERA in 24 games/15 starts against the Pirates (93ip, 71h, 42r, 37er, 34bb, 109k, 9hr), including 1-0 with a 3.86 ERA in 2 starts this season (9.1ip, 12h, 5r, 4er, 3bb, 11k, 2hr).
