COLORADO ROCKIES (8-24) vs. PITTSBURGH PIRATES (14-19)

May 4, 2024 at PNC Park, Pittsburgh, PA - 4:05 EDT - GAME #34/HOME #14

LHP AUSTIN GOMBER (0-2, 4.50 ERA) vs. RHP JARED JONES (2-3, 3.18 ERA)

THE PIRATES:...lost 3-2 in the opener of their weekend series against the Rockies...Have lost five straight and eight of their last 10 games (lost a season-high six straight games from 4/15-21)...Have been charged with two errors in their last eight games...Have gone 4-0 in extra innings this season, which is tied for the most second-wins in extra frames in MLB (Cleveland leads with five)...It is Pittsburgh's longest win streak in extra-innings games to begin a season since 2012 (also 4-0)...The last start to a season with a longer streak was 1960 (7-0).

KEEPING UP WITH THE JONES': Jared Jones has pitched 5.0-plus innings and has allowed three or fewer runs in each of his first six big league starts...Dating back to 1900, only one Pirates pitcher has had a longer streak of games, which was Gerrit Cole when he had 10 straight to begin his career in 2013...Nick Maddox also began his career with six such games in 1907.

THE ARMS RACE: The Pirates had four pitchers (Paul Skenes, Jared Jones, Anthony Solometo and Bubba Chandler) coming into 2024 ranked among the top 100 prospects in the game according to MLB Pipeline...That's the most top 100 pitching prospects among all organizations...The Reds and Padres have the second-most at three apiece.

THE HOT CORNER: Ke'Bryan Hayes has recorded the most Defensive Runs Saved (23) among all third basemen in MLB since the beginning of last year according to the Fielding Bible...Colorado's Ryan McMahon ranks second among all third basemen in that time with 19 Defensive Runs Saved...Last year Hayes became the first Pirates third baseman to take home a Rawlings Gold Glove Award and the 20th different Pirates player to take home the award since it was first presented in 1958...Prior to Hayes, the last Pirate to earn a Rawlings Gold Glove was catcher Jacob Stallings in 2021.

INTO THE DRINK: Last night's home runs by Ryan McMahon and Oneil Cruz marked just the third time in PNC Park history that two balls reached the Allegheny River in the same game (Cincinnati's Derek Dietrich did it twice on April 7, 2019, while Texas' Joey Gallo and Pittsburgh's Josh Bell did it on May 3, 2019)...Cruz also reached the Allegheny River on September 6, 2022, with a 422-foot shot...Cruz has now hit safely in each of his last nine starts, going 11-for-33 (.333) with a pair of doubles and home run.

KUDOS FOR KYLE: Kyle Nicolas has tossed 3.0 scoreless innings in three appearances since being promoted from Triple-A Indianapolis on April 26...Since allowing a combined seven runs in 2.1 innings in his first two career appearances in the big leagues, Nicolas has tossed 6.0 scoreless innings while recording a .190 batting average against (4-for-21) in five games.

HUNTING THE GOOD: Hunter Stratton brings a scoreless streak of 8.0 innings into today after tossing 1.2 scoreless frames on Friday...Stratton ranks ninth among all rookie relievers in MLB in ERA (2.76), tied for fifth in strikeouts (18) and first in walks per 9.0 innings (0.55).

THERE'S NO PLACE LIKE HOME: The next outing by David Bednar will make him one of 15 pitchers to appear in 100 career games at PNC Park (Tony Watson has the most with 242)...Bednar is 4-4 with 35 saves and a 2.55 ERA (98.2ip/28er) in his career at PNC Park.

THE RENEGADE: David Bednar has converted each of his last four save opportunities and comes into today with 66 as a member of the Pirates...Bednar's next save will tie him with Matt Capps for the eighth-most in team history.

CLOSING IN ON OROSCO: Aroldis Chapman comes into today with 1166 career strikeouts, which are just three shy of tying Jesse Orosco for the second-most all-time among left-handed relievers (Billy Wagner leads with 1196)...Chapman's 1166 career punchouts are also the 10th-most overall among relief pitchers (Hoyt Wilhelm has the most with 1363).

TAKING A WALK: Pittsburgh is one of four MLB teams to record at least one batting walk in every single game this season, along with the Brewers, Cardinals and Yankees...The Pirates rank third in all of MLB with 132 walks, trailing only the Dodger (148) and Yankees (144)...Special thanks to StatsPerform.

ON THIS DATE IN PIRATES HISTORY

May 4, 1992: The Bucs trailed Cincinnati 5-1 after 5 ½ innings before scoring 11 runs in the sixth inning in a 12-5 win. It was only the second time the Pirates scored 11 runs in an inning in the century (the other was 1942). Andy Van Slyke went 4-for-5 and Jeff King went 3-for-5. The 11-run outburst remains a club record.
