YESTERDAY'S NEWS: The Orioles defeated the Twins, 9-2, to secure their 90th win of the season...The O's have won 90 games in back-to-back seasons for the first time since 1982 (94) and 1983 (98)...**Tucker Davidson** made his team debut and secured his first victory in his first MLB outing this season after tossing 4.2 scoreless innings...**Emmanuel Rivera** demolished two home runs, his second career multi-homer game, and doubled as part of a 4-for-4 game; his 11 total bases are the most by an Oriole this season...**Ryan O'Hearn** set a new single-season career high with 15 homers after connecting on a two-run blast in the first inning; he's homered in back-to-back games for the second time this season (3, 4/14-16).
 ⚾ **Jackson Holliday** became the youngest player (20y, 299d) in Orioles history (since 1954) to reach safely five times in a game (3 H, 2 BB) and the youngest MLB player to do so since Juan Soto (20y, 298d) on August 19, 2019 at Pittsburgh (w/WSH).

BE THE NOISE: Fans can now purchase Postseason tickets for potential games at Oriole Park at Camden Yards by visiting Orioles.com/Postseason...It's time for Birdland to set the tone, pack the Yard, and Be The Noise.

WHAT'S TRENDING: The O's clinched a Postseason berth on Tuesday, their second straight year in the playoffs after winning the AL East with an AL-best 101-61 record in 2023...This marks the fourth time in team history that the club has made the playoffs in at least two straight seasons, joining 1996-97, 1973-74, and 1969-71 (3)...On Friday, the Orioles clinched the top Wild Card spot after defeating the Twins, giving the O's a home playoff game on Tuesday at Camden Yards...If the Postseason started today, the Birds would host Detroit...The O's have lost eight of their last 15 and 11 of 19, but won four of five on the road trip...The team is 37-40 (.481) since July 1, 32-33 (.492) since the All-Star break, and 25-27 (.481) since August 1.

⚾ Baltimore is 191-132 (.591) since the start of 2023, the best record in the AL and the third-best winning percentage in MLB during that time, behind the Dodgers (.610, 197-126) and Braves (.598, 192-129); the 191 wins over the last two years are the most by the O's since 1979 (102-57) and 1980 (100-62).

HOMER HAPPY: The Orioles rank tied for second in MLB with 233 home runs, trailing only the Yankees (236)...Baltimore led MLB in homers through June with 139, 16 more than New York-AL, but have hit 94 home runs since, good for 11th in MLB...The O's have hit 200 home runs in a season for the 13th time in team history and this year marks the most by the club since 2016 (253)...The 233 homers this year are the third most in a single season in Orioles history behind the 1996 (257) and 2016 (253) Orioles.

⚾ Baltimore has nine players with at least 10 home runs, tied with the Braves, Dodgers, and Red Sox for the most in MLB this season: **Anthony Santander** (44), **Gunnar Henderson** (37), **Colton Cowser** (24), **Adley Rutschman** (19), **Cedric Mullins** and **Jordan Westburg** (18), **Ryan O'Hearn** (15), **Ryan Mountcastle** (13), and **Ramón Urias** (11); the team record is 10 players, done in 2019, 2000, and 1998.

⚾ Henderson and Santander are one of two duos with at least 35 home runs, along with New York-AL's Aaron Judge (58) and Juan Soto (41); the O's did not have a player reach 35 homers last season, and this year marks the first time since 2016 that the team has had multiple players with 35+ home runs (Trumbo, 47; Davis, 38; Machado, 37).

⚾ The Birds have hit 13 leadoff homers, the most by the club in a single season and second in MLB this year behind the Phillies (15); Henderson has 10 of those, second most in one season by an Oriole behind **Brady Anderson**, who hit all 12 for the club in 1996; Cowser (2) and Westburg (1) have the other three for the O's in 2024.

TOP GUNN: **Gunnar Henderson** is three homers shy of becoming the fourth shortstop (11th occurrence) in MLB history to hit 40 home runs, joining Alex Rodriguez (6x, 1998-2003), Rico Petrocelli (1969), and Ernie Banks (4x, 1957-60)...He passed **Cal Ripken, Jr.** (1991) and **Miguel Tejada** (2004), who held the O's record by a shortstop with 34 entering this season...He would also be the second player in Orioles history to hit 40 homers and steal 20 bases, along with **Brady Anderson** (50 HR, 21 SB) in 1996.

⚾ He was voted the 2024 Most Valuable Oriole by members of the local media; he's the eighth player to earn MVO in back-to-back seasons and the first since **Adam Jones** in 2011-12.

⚾ Henderson earned AL Player of the Week on September 9, the second such award of his career; he slashed .417/.464/.833 (10-for-24) with one double, three homers, six runs scored, five RBI, three walks, and two stolen bases in six games.

⚾ His 118 runs scored are fourth in the AL and sixth in MLB, and are the most by an Oriole since **Roberto Alomar** set the club record with 132 in 1996; he's the sixth player in O's history (since 1954) to score 100 runs in back-to-back seasons after scoring exactly 100 times last year, joining **Manny Machado** (2, 2015-16), Jones (2, 2012-13), **Brian Roberts** (3, 2007-09), Anderson (2, 1995-96), and Ripken, Jr. (3, 1983-85).

⚾ With two runs today, he'd join Alomar, **Frank Robinson** (122 in 1966), and Ripken, Jr. (121 in 1983) as the only players in Orioles history (since 1954) to score at least 120 runs in a season.

⚾ Henderson ranks tied for third in the AL and for fourth in MLB with 8.1 fWAR; that is the best mark by an Oriole since Ripken, Jr. set the club record with 10.6 in 1991; four O's (six occurrences) have finished a season with an 8.0 fWAR, along with Ripken, Jr. (3x; 10.6, 1991; 9.8, 1984, & 8.5, 1983), **Brooks Robinson** (8.1, 1964), F. Robinson (8.2, 1966), and **Jim Gentile** (8.0, 1961).

⚾ He has hit 31 of his home runs when batting leadoff, the second most in Orioles history, behind **Brady Anderson** (35) in 1996.

MASHED TATERS: **Anthony Santander** ranks third in MLB with 44 home runs, trailing New York-AL's Aaron Judge (58) and Los Angeles-NL's Shohei Ohtani (54)...He's the eighth Oriole (ninth occurrence) to hit 40 home runs in a season and the first since **Mark Trumbo** in 2016 (see chart at right)...He's the eighth switch-hitter (12th occurrence) in MLB history to hit at least 40 homers in a season and one of four (five occurrences) with at least 44 (see chart at right).

⚾ His solo home run on Tuesday at New York-AL gave him 100 RBI for the season, the first Oriole to reach that mark since **Jonathan Schoop** (105) in 2017; he's the fourth Oriole switch-hitter to do so, joining **Eddie Murray** (5x, 1980, 82-85), **Ken Singleton** (2x, 1979-80), and **Bobby Bonilla** (1996).

⚾ Santander has hit 35 home runs since the start of June, behind Ohtani (40) and Judge (38) for the most in MLB; no other player has more than 28 during that time.

⚾ His 105 home runs since the start of 2022 rank sixth in MLB during that time and are second in the AL, behind only Judge (157).

⚾ He's the ninth player in O's history with multiple 30-homer seasons, joining **Manny Machado** (3, 2015-17), **Chris Davis** (4, 2012-13, 15-16), **Adam Jones** (2, 2012-13), **Rafael Palmeiro** (4, 1995-98), **Eddie Murray** (5, 1980, 82-83, 85, 87), **Boog Powell** (4, 1964, 66, 69-70), **Frank Robinson** (3, 1966-67, 69), and **Jim Gentile** (2, 1961-62).

HOLY COWSER: **Colton Cowser** is tied for the MLB rookie lead with 24 home runs with San Diego's Jackson Merrill...He's the 10th rookie in team history (since 1954) to hit at least 20 homers and the first since **Gunnar Henderson** (28) last year...He also the ninth rookie in O's history to record 20 doubles and 20 home runs in a season and the first since Henderson (29-28, 28 HR) in 2023...Among rookies, Cowser leads the AL and ranks third in MLB with 4.1 fWAR, behind San Diego's Merrill (5.2) and Pittsburgh's Paul Skenes (4.3)...He's among AL rookies in runs scored (1st, 77), total bases (1st, 223), extra-base hits (1st, 51), walks (2nd, 52), slugging percentage (2nd, .451), RBI (3rd, 69), OPS (3rd, .774), doubles (3rd, 24), and on-base percentage (4th, .323).

⚾ Should he win AL Rookie of the Year, it would mark back-to-back seasons in which an Oriole has taken home the award, joining **Gunnar Henderson** (2023)...Four American League and nine National League teams have accomplished the feat with the Dodgers being the last to do so in 2016 (Bellinger) and 2017 (Seager); the last AL team was the Athletics in 2004 (Crosby) and 2005 (Street).

⚾ His 11 Outs Above Average are more than all other O's defenders combined, per Statcast; eight of those have come in left field, two behind Toronto's Daulton Varsho for the most among MLB left fielders.

⚾ He's one home run shy of becoming the fifth Oriole rookie to hit at least 25 homers in a season, along with Henderson, **Ryan Mountcastle** (33, 2021), **Cal Ripken, Jr.** (28, 1982), and **Eddie Murray** (27, 1977); Mountcastle is the only one of that group who did not win Rookie of the Year.

AGAINST THE TWINS: The Orioles and Twins wrap up the regular season today at Target Field...This marks their first meeting since the O's swept a three-game set at Oriole Park from April 15-17...Baltimore hit nine home runs in the three games, including a walk-off two-run blast by Cedric Mullins to complete the sweep...Since the start of 2022, the Birds are 12-6 (.667) against Minnesota and have won nine in a row dating back to July 2, 2023, the longest winning streak against the Twins since winning 12 straight games from July 21, 1980 (G2) to May 17, 1981; it's the longest winning streak by Baltimore against one opponent since the team won 12 in a row against the Royals from July 26, 2006 to May 10, 2008.

ROSTER MOVES: The O's recalled right-handed pitcher **Colin Selby** from Triple-A Norfolk and designated left-handed pitcher **Tucker Davidson** for assignment today...The Orioles' 40-man roster is at 39 players.

DOCUMENT IT: A documentary focused on the city of Baltimore and the Orioles to air on a streaming network or digital carrier in Spring of 2025...The story of the city coming back from an economic and human catastrophe (the Key Bridge collapse), while a new ownership group and President usher in the next chapter of Oriole excellence...A team that has long been part of the city's DNA and mirrors its resilience...Interwoven are stories from our neighborhoods, our fans, and our schools (starting with Harlem Park Elementary, which the Orioles have adopted)...All combining to tell the riveting story of a City, State, and Major League team making a run for a Championship.
 ⚾ The project is being filmed and produced by Mike Tollin Productions; creator of projects such as "The Last Dance," "The Captain," and "Justice USA," Mike Tollin Productions is the nation's premier production house for sports documentaries and storytelling.

QUICK HITS: Scheduled to make his 24th start (32nd appearance) of the season this afternoon against the Twins...Eight of his 23 starts this season have been scoreless, tied for the second-most such starts in MLB (min. 2.0 IP/GS) behind Arizona's Zac Gallen and Seattle's Bryce Miller (9)...Owns a 3-3 record with a 3.49 ERA (19 ER/49.0 IP) since returning to the Orioles rotation on August 6...Went 4-7 with a 3.92 ERA (47 ER/108.0 IP) for the Samsung Lions last year...Allowed 129 hits (3 HR) and 88 strikeouts in 19 Korean Baseball Organization appearances...Became a free agent following his release from the Lions due to a calf injury...Signed by the Orioles to a minor league contract on October 12, 2023...Made 11 starts with the Venezuelan Winter League after signing with the O's; went 4-2 with a 3.79 ERA (23 ER/54.2 IP) with 62 hits (3 HR) and 24 strikeouts across his 11 outings...Began the season with Triple-A Norfolk...Originally signed by Tampa Bay as an international free agent on July 2, 2006.

LAST TIME OUT: Was dealt the loss on September 22 vs. Detroit after allowing four runs on five hits (3 HR) and one walk with six strikeouts in 5.0+ innings; exited before recording an out in the sixth inning with a runner on, who was stranded...The three home runs match a career high (3x, last: 9/4/24 vs. CWS)...Since returning to the Orioles rotation on August 6, 10 of his 19 runs allowed have scored on home runs; 15 of his 19 runs allowed since rejoining the rotation have come in his last four starts...Has a 7.23 ERA (15 ER/18.2 IP) with seven home runs allowed in four September starts...Threw 80 pitches, 59 strikes.

AGAINST THE TWINS: Scheduled to make his second career start against Minnesota...Did not factor in the decision in his sole career appearance against the Twins on April 17 at Oriole Park after tossing 5.2 scoreless innings on three hits and one hit batter with four strikeouts...Suárez's start against the club marked his Orioles debut and his first MLB appearance since September 26, 2017 at Arizona (w/SF).

AGAINST THE AL CENTRAL: Slated to make his seventh career appearance (5 GS) against the AL Central...Owns a lifetime 0-2 record with a 5.96 ERA (15 ER/22.2 IP) against the division...Will be making his second consecutive start against the AL Central.

DAY MAN: Is 1-2 with a 3.47 ERA (18 ER/46.2 IP) and 38 strikeouts to 13 walks across nine day starts this season; opponents are slashing .261/.313/.450 (47-for-180) off him in his day starts.

LACK OF SUPPORT: Has received three runs or fewer of support in 19 of his 23 starts this season and one or fewer in five of his last nine starts; his 3.72 RSA/9 is the lowest by an O's starter this year (min. 10 GS) and ranks 107th out of 121 total MLB pitchers (min. 20 GS).

SIGN OF RELIEF: Has registered a 1-0 record with a 3.09 ERA (4 ER/11.2 IP) in eight relief outings this season compared to a 7-6 record with a 3.65 ERA (45 ER/111.0 IP) in 22 starts...Three of his four earned runs surrendered as a reliever came in his last appearance out of the bullpen on August 1 at Cleveland.

MR. WORLDWIDE: Pitched three seasons with the Yakult Swallows in Nippon Professional Baseball from 2019-2021...Owns a lifetime 10-8 record with a 3.00 ERA (54 ER/162. IP) and 134 strikeouts in 40 appearances with the Swallows...Also played for Samsung in the Korean Baseball Organization for the 2022 and 2023 campaigns; posted a 3.04 ERA (95 ER/281.2 IP) across 49 appearances (48 GS) with the Lions.

2023 HIGHLIGHTS: Spent the season with Samsung...Did not allow a run in three straight starts (19.0 IP) from July 4-25...Tossed 8.0 scoreless innings on four hits and four walks with four strikeouts on July 25 vs. Kia.
