SUNDAY'S NEWS: The Orioles lost to the Tigers, 4-3, dropping the rubber game and the season series against Detroit...**Ramón Urias** and **Jordan Westburg** returned from the Injured List and both tallied hits, including a game-tying RBI double by Westburg in a three-run fifth inning...**Cedric Mullins** hit a two-run homer to put the O's on the board.

BE THE NOISE: Fans can now purchase Postseason tickets for potential games at Oriole Park at Camden Yards by visiting Orioles.com/postseason...It's time for Birdland to set the tone, pack the Yard, and be the noise.

WHAT'S TRENDING: The O's trail the Yankees by 6.0 games in the AL East, needing to win out with New York losing out to earn their second straight division title...The club holds the top Wild Card spot ahead of the Tigers and Royals (+4.0 games), Twins (+5.0 games), and Mariners (+5.5 games)...Baltimore can clinch a Postseason berth tonight with a win and a loss by either Kansas City or Minnesota, and can lock up a home series in the Wild Card round as early as tomorrow...The Birds hold head-to-head tiebreakers with the Royals and Mariners (both 4-2), lose a tiebreaker with the Tigers (2-4), and are 3-0 against the Twins with three games remaining...The O's have lost seven of their last 10 and 10 of 14...The team is 33-39 (.458) since July 1, 28-32 (.467) since the All-Star break, and 21-26 (.447) since August 1...Since the start of 2023, Baltimore is 187-131 (.588), the best record in the AL and the third-best winning percentage in MLB during that time, behind the Dodgers (.607, 193-125) and Braves (.594, 189-129).

☞ New York leads the division at 92-64 (.590); an AL East winner has not finished the season with a record under .600 since Boston won the division in 2017 and 2016 with a 93-69 (.574) record.

HOMER HAPPY: The Orioles are tied for second in MLB with 225 home runs with the Dodgers, behind only the Yankees (229)...Baltimore led MLB in homers through June with 139, 16 more than New York-AL, but have hit 86 home runs since, tied for 15th in MLB...The O's have hit 200 home runs in a season for the 13th time in team history and this year marks the most by the club since 2017 (232).

☞ Baltimore has nine players with at least 10 home runs, tied with the Dodgers and Red Sox for the most in MLB this season: **Anthony Santander** (43), **Gunnar Henderson** (37), **Colton Cowser** (22), **Adley Rutschman** (19), **Cedric Mullins** and **Jordan Westburg** (18), **Ryan Mountcastle** and **Ryan O'Hearn** (13), and **Ramón Urias** (10); the team record is 10 players, done in 2019, 2000, and 1998.

☞ Henderson and Santander are one of two duos with at least 35 home runs, along with New York-AL's Aaron Judge (55) and Juan Soto (40); the O's did not have a player reach 35 homers last season, and this year marks the first time since 2016 that the team has had multiple players with 35+ home runs (Trumbo, 47; Davis, 38; Machado, 37).

☞ The Birds have hit 13 leadoff homers, the most by the club in a single season and second in MLB this year behind the Phillies (15); Henderson has 10 of those, second most in one season by an Oriole behind **Brady Anderson**, who hit all 12 for the club in 1996; Cowser (2) and Westburg (1) have the other three for the O's in 2024.

TOP GUNN: **Gunnar Henderson** is three homers shy of becoming the fourth shortstop (11th occurrence) in MLB history to hit 40 home runs, joining Alex Rodriguez (6x, 1998-2003), Rico Petrocelli (1969), and Ernie Banks (4x, 1957-60)...He passed **Cal Ripken, Jr.** (1991) and **Miguel Tejada** (2004), who held the O's record by a shortstop with 34 entering this season...He would also be the second player in Orioles history to hit 40 homers and steal 20 bases, along with **Brady Anderson** (50 HR, 21 SB) in 1996.

☞ He was voted the 2024 Most Valuable Oriole by members of the local media; he's the eighth player to earn MVO in back-to-back seasons and the first since **Adam Jones** in 2011-12.

☞ Henderson earned AL Player of the Week on September 9, the second such award of his career; Henderson slashed .417/.464/.833 (10-for-24) with one double, three homers, six runs scored, five RBI, three walks, and two stolen bases in six games.

☞ His 116 runs scored are fourth in the AL and sixth in MLB, and are the most by an Oriole since **Roberto Alomar** set the club record with 132 in 1996; he's the sixth player in O's history (since 1954) to score 100 runs in back-to-back seasons after scoring exactly 100 times last year, joining **Manny Machado** (2, 2015-16), Jones (2, 2012-13), **Brian Roberts** (3, 2007-09), Anderson (2, 1995-96), and Ripken, Jr. (3, 1983-85).

☞ He's on pace to score 121 times; Alomar, **Frank Robinson** (122 in 1966), and Ripken, Jr. (121 in 1983) are the only players in Orioles history (since 1954) to score at least 120 runs in a season.

☞ He ranks third in the AL and fourth in MLB with 8.1 fWAR; that is the best mark by an Oriole since Ripken, Jr. set the club record with 10.6 in 1991; four O's (six occurrences) have finished a season with an 8.0 fWAR, along with Ripken, Jr. (3x; 10.6, 1991; 9.8, 1984, & 8.5, 1983), **Brooks Robinson** (8.1, 1964), F. Robinson (8.2, 1966), and **Jim Gentile** (8.0, 1961).

☞ Henderson has hit 31 of his home runs when batting leadoff, the second most in Orioles history, behind **Brady Anderson** (35) in 1996.

MASHED TATERS: **Anthony Santander** is the eighth Oriole (ninth occurrence) to hit 40 home runs in a season and the first since **Mark Trumbo** in 2016 (see chart at right)...He's the eighth switch-hitter (12th occurrence) in MLB history to hit at least 40 homers in a season, along with New York-NL's Carlos Beltrán (2006), Houston's Lance Berkman (2: 2002, 06), Texas' Mark Teixeira (2005), Atlanta's Chipper Jones (1999), New York-NL's Todd Hundley (1996), San Diego's Ken Caminiti (1996), and New York-AL's Mickey Mantle (4: 1956, 58, 60-61)...Mantle is the only switch-hitter in MLB history to hit 50 homers, when he did so in 1956 (52) and 1961 (54).

☞ He's one RBI shy of 100 for the season; no Oriole has reached that mark since **Jonathan Schoop** (105) in 2017; the last Baltimore switch-hitter to do so is **Bobby Bonilla** (116) in 1996.

☞ Santander has hit 34 home runs since the start of June, behind Los Angeles-NL's Shohei Ohtani (39) and New York-AL's Aaron Judge (35) for the most in MLB during that time; no other player has more than 27 besides those three; Santander's 43 homers rank third in MLB this season behind Judge (55) and Ohtani (53).

☞ His 104 home runs since the start of 2022 rank sixth in MLB during that time and are second in the AL, behind only Judge (154).

☞ He's the ninth player in O's history with multiple 30-homer seasons, joining **Manny Machado** (3, 2015-17), **Chris Davis** (4, 2012-13, 15-16), **Adam Jones** (2, 2012-13), **Rafael Palmeiro** (4, 1995-98), **Eddie Murray** (5, 1980, 82-83, 85, 87), **Boog Powell** (4, 1964, 66, 69-70), **Frank Robinson** (3, 1966-67, 69), and **Jim Gentile** (2, 1961-62).

HOLY COWSER: **Colton Cowser** leads AL rookies and is second among MLB rookies with 22 home runs, trailing San Diego's Jackson Merrill (24)...He's the 10th rookie in team history (since 1954) to hit at least 20 homers and the first since **Gunnar Henderson** (28) last year...He also the ninth rookie in O's history to record 20 doubles and 20 home runs in a season and the first since Henderson (29-2B, 28 HR) in 2023...Among rookies, Cowser leads the AL and ranks third in MLB with 3.9 fWAR, behind San Diego's Jackson Merrill (5.1) and Pittsburgh's Paul Skenes (4.2)...He's among AL rookies in runs scored (1st, 74), total bases (1st, 212), extra-base hits (2nd, 48), walks (2nd, 51), RBI (3rd, 64), OPS (3rd, .767), slugging percentage (3rd, .443), and doubles (T-3rd, 23).

☞ His 11 Outs Above Average are more than all other O's defenders combined, per Statcast; eight of those have come in left field, two behind Toronto's Daulton Varsho for the most among MLB left fielders; Detroit's Riley Greene is the next closest left fielder with four OAA.

AGAINST THE YANKEES: The Orioles and Yankees wrap up their season series with three games at Yankee Stadium tonight through Thursday...The O's are 6-4 against the Yanks this year and a victory in the next three games would mark the second straight season winning the season series against New York-AL for the first time since doing so in three straight years from 2015-2017.

☞ Prior to the series between the teams from July 12-14 at Oriole Park, the O's had gone 22 straight sets against AL East opponents without a series loss, going 16-0-6 in series and 49-23 (.681) overall during that time; that was the longest streak by a team against its own division without a series loss since divisions were introduced in 1969, per the *Elias Sports Bureau*; the Birds have gone 2-4-1 in series and 11-12 (.478) overall since.

DOCUMENT IT: A documentary focused on the city of Baltimore and the Orioles to air on a streaming network or digital carrier in Spring of 2025...The story of the city coming back from an economic and human catastrophe (the Key Bridge collapse), while a new ownership group and President usher in the next chapter of Oriole excellence...A team that has long been part of the city's DNA and mirrors its resilience...Interwoven are stories from our neighborhoods, our fans, and our schools (starting with Harlem Park Elementary, which the Orioles have adopted)...All combining to tell the riveting story of a City, State, and Major League team making a run for a Championship.

☞ The project is being filmed and produced by Mike Tollin Productions; creator of projects such as "The Last Dance", "The Captain", and "Justice USA", Mike Tollin Productions is the nation's premier production house for sports documentaries and storytelling.

ROSTER MOVES: The O's reinstated infielder **Ryan Mountcastle** from the 10-day Injured List (left wrist sprain) and optioned outfielder/designated hitter **Eloy Jiménez** to Triple-A Norfolk today...Right-handed pitcher **Craig Kimbrel**, who was designated for assignment on Wednesday, was released.

QUICK HITS: Scheduled to make his 24th start of the season tonight against the Yankees...Reinstated from the 15-day Injured List (right triceps strain) prior to the game on July 3; placed on the IL on May 24, retroactive to May 21...Made three rehab starts with Triple-A Norfolk, pitching to an 11.42 ERA (11 ER/8.2 IP) with nine strikeouts to four walks...Went 13-5 with a 4.12 ERA (79 ER/172.2 IP), allowing 171 hits (27 HR) with 55 walks and 157 strikeouts across 32 starts in his 2023 campaign...The O's were 24-8 in his starts and his career-high 13 wins were tied for sixth in the American League... Acquired by the Orioles along with INF Breyvic Valera, OF Yusniel Diaz, RHP Zach Pop, and INF Rylan Bannon in exchange for INF Manny Machado on July 18, 2018...Originally selected by the Dodgers in the 14th round of the 2016 First-Year Player Draft out of UNLV.

LAST TIME OUT: Suffered the loss on September 18 vs. San Francisco after allowing five runs (4 ER) on seven hits (2 HR), with seven strikeouts in 6.0 innings...Surrendered a leadoff home run to Mike Yastrzemski to begin the game, the fifth leadoff blast he has allowed in his career (last: 6/18/23 at CHC, Tauchman)...Completed 6.0 innings for the sixth time in his last seven starts after doing so just once in nine starts between May 12-August 8...Threw 86 pitches, 58 strikes.

AGAINST THE YANKEES: Slated to make his 12th career start against New York-AL... Owns a lifetime 3-3 record with a 4.63 ERA (29 ER/56.1 IP) against the Yankees...Has held the Pinstripes to two runs in both of his starts against the club this season, pitching to a 1-0 record with a 3.09 ERA (4 ER/11.2 IP).

AGAINST THE AL EAST: Has gone 10-12 with a 4.50 ERA (96 ER/192.0 IP) in 38 appearances (37 GS) against the AL East in his career...Is 2-1 with a 3.10 ERA (10 ER/29.0 IP) against the division this season; AL East foes are slashing .186/.308/.333 (19-for-102) off Kremer this year.

ON THE ROAD AGAIN: Is 4-5 with a 3.94 ERA (28 ER/64.0 IP) in 12 road starts compared to 3-5 with a 4.45 ERA (30 ER/60.2 IP) in 11 starts at Oriole Park this season...Has held opponents to one earned run in two of his last three starts away from Oriole Park.

NIGHT OWL: Has pitched to a 5-6 record with a 4.57 ERA (41 ER/80.2 IP) in 15 night starts compared to 2-4 with a 3.48 ERA (17 ER/44.0 IP) in eight starts during the day...Opponents are slashing .222/.308/.373 (68-for-306) off him at night and .229/.283/.371 (39-for-170) during the day.

SWEET VICTORY: In Kremer's 29 career outings in which he earned the win, he has posted a 1.58 ERA (31 ER/176.1 IP) compared to the 8.09 ERA (125 ER/139.0 IP) he owns in 30 career losses...In wins, opponents are slashing .194/.253/.291 (122-for-628) compared to .311/.379/.526 (183-for-589) in losses.

RIGHTY TIGHTY: In his last 20 starts since April 19, Kremer has held right-handed hitters to a .196/.266/.276 (39-for-199) slash line with 10 doubles, two home runs, 18 walks, two hit batters, and 47 strikeouts...Has held right-handers to a .608 OPS on the season.

2023 HIGHLIGHTS: Earned the win on September 28 vs. Boston, clinching the AL East...Collected his 300th career strikeout on September 17 vs. Tampa Bay, matching Chuck Estrada and Daniel Cabrera as the fifth-fastest Orioles by appearances (69) to reach the mark...Kremer pitched to a 5-1 record with a 3.09 ERA (28 ER/81.2 IP) and seven quality starts in his final 15 outings last season...Logged four straight quality starts from August 10-29, the longest such streak of his career...Pitched for Team Israel in the 2023 World Baseball Classic; made the start in Team Israel's 3-1 win over Team Nicaragua in Pool Play on March 12, 2023 at loanDepot park in Miami (4.0 IP, 3 H, BB, K).

POSTSEASON EXPERIENCE: Kremer made his Postseason debut last season, taking the loss in Game 3 of the ALDS against the Texas Rangers on October 10...Allowed six runs on seven hits and one walk (1 BB) in 1.2 innings...The six earned runs marked the most amount that Kremer had given up in a game since June 30 vs. Minnesota (7 ER)... It was his shortest outing since June 24, 2021 at Toronto (0.1 IP).
