AROUND THE HORN

JOHNSON'S PERFECT GAME 22 YEARS AGO: On May 18, 2004 @ Braves (Turner Field), at 40 years, 251 days, **Randy Johnson** became the oldest pitcher in history to record a perfect game (13 K, 117 P), bettering Cy Young (37 years, 37 days on May 5, 1904) for the franchise's first of its kind... it was the 15th perfect game in modern day regular season history and 16th including Don Larsen's perfect effort for the Yankees in the 1956 World Series...was the first perfect game in the Majors since the Yankees' David Cone on July 18, 1999 vs. Montreal and first in the NL since the Expos' Dennis Martinez on July 28, 1991 @ Dodgers.

SERPIENTES REPLICA JERSEY AND POSTGAME FIREWORKS: On Friday, Postgame Fireworks return with music from My Chemical Romance and Jimmy Eat World to celebrate their upcoming concert at Chase Field on September 6...on Saturday, the first 25,000 fans can get a Serpientes Replica Jersey courtesy of Talking Stick Resort.

MEXICAN BASEBALL HALL OF FAME: On May 12, the Mexican Baseball Hall of Fame (Salon de Fama del Beisbol Mexicano) announced its Mexican Baseball Immortals of Class 2026, featuring the D-backs' own **Erubiel Durazo** and **Rodrigo Lopez** in the "Mexicans in Major Leagues" category... **Durazo**, who was a member of the D-backs' 2001 World Championship team, played 4 seasons (1999-2002) with Arizona and has served as D-backs Special Advisor on Mexico to the President, CEO & General Partner since 2016...**Lopez** pitched for the D-backs in 2010, where he led the team in innings (200.0) and starts (33), and has served as an analyst for D-backs Spanish Radio broadcasts since 2014 as well as general manager of Mexico's 2023 and 2026 World Baseball Classic teams.

HERE'S THE STORY: D-backs' starters have recorded 8 quality starts in their last 12 outings since May 5 and allowed 2 or fewer runs in 8 of those.

- Since May 5, the D-backs' 2.38 ERA ranks fourth in the Majors, behind the Braves (11 G, 1.83), Brewers (10 G, 1.97) and Rays (11 G, 2.28).
- In the span, the D-backs rank among MLB leaders in quality starts (1st, 8), innings (1st, 79.1), innings/G (1st, 6.2), OBP (2nd, .250), OPS (2nd, .584), WHIP (2nd, 0.95), strikeouts (3rd, 69) and opponent AVG (3rd, .193).
- The D-backs have won 2 of their last 3 series (vs. Mets, @ Rockies) and have faced a rubber game in 4 straight series (2-2 in those: L vs. Pirates, W vs. Mets, L vs. Rangers, W vs. Rockies).

LAST GAME: The D-backs won 8-6 @ Rockies yesterday.

- **Michael Soroka** earned his team-leading sixth win (T-2nd in MLB) after allowing 2 runs on 6 hits and 2 walks with 8 strikeouts over 5.2 innings.
- **Corbin Carroll** had his ninth career multi-homer game, first since June 3, 2025 @ Braves, with a 2-run in the fourth and solo in the sixth.
- **Gabriel Moreno** had a season-high 3 hits with 1 walk.
- **Paul Sewald** recorded his 10th save (3rd in NL), reaching double-digits for the first time since 2024 (16).

CONTICELLO NAMED TEXAS LEAGUE PLAYER OF THE WEEK: Double-A Amarillo OF **Gavin Conticello** was named Texas League Player of the Week (May 11-17) after he hit .450 (9-for-20)/1.500 OPS with 2 doubles, 3 homers (including a multi-homer game), 6 RBI and 2 walks over 5 games @ Corpus Christi.

- Is the sixth D-back farmhand to earn a weekly honor in the first 7 weeks.

DIVISION SHOWDOWNS: The D-backs face 13 straight NL West matchups (2-1 from May 15-17 @ Rockies, May 18-20 vs. Giants, May 21-24 vs. Rockies, May 25-27 @ Giants) and 17 of their next 20 (also: June 1-4 vs. Dodgers).

CARROLL SURGE: **Corbin Carroll**, in his last 6 games, is hitting .421 (8-for-19)/1.502 OPS with 3 doubles, 2 homers, 4 RBI, 9 walks (3 K) and 2 stolen bases.

- The last time he had a 6-game span with 5+ extra-base hits and 5+ walks was during his NL ROY season from Aug. 24-29, 2023.

BULLPEN RECENTLY AT HOME: In their last 6 home games, the D-backs' bullpen carries a 0.66 ERA (2 R-1 ER in 13.2 IP) with an opponent .091 AVG (4-for-44)/.285 OPS, 0.44 WHIP, 2 walks and 11 strikeouts.

TRENDING AT CHASE: **Nolan Arenado** has reached base safely in 10 of his last 11 home games, hitting .424 (14-for-33)/1.173 OPS with 1 double, 2 homers, 4 RBI and 7 walks (6 K)...has reached base in 16 of his 20 home games, hitting .339 (21-for-62)/.923 OPS with 1 double, 3 homers, 7 RBI, 8 walks and 1 hit-by-pitch.

- **Corbin Carroll** has hit safely in 3 of his last 4 home games with 1 double, 1 homer and 1 RBI.
- **Ryan Waldschmidt**, in his first 3 home games, is 3-for-8 (.375) with 1 double and 3 RBI.

VS. GIANTS: The D-backs have won or split 7 of the last 9 series (won 5, split 2).

- The D-backs took the season series last year at 7-6...have won 5 of their last 8 home games and went 4-3 @ Chase Field last season.
- Have 4 consecutive season series wins by a single game since 2022 (7-6 from 2023-25 and 10-9 in 2022).

- **Lourdes Gurriel Jr.** has hit safely in 23 straight starts (since June 24, 2023), the longest active streak in MLB vs. Giants, batting .363 (33-for-91)/.991 OPS with 8 doubles, 4 homers, 12 RBI and 7 walks...has reached base safely 2+ times in 14 of the 23 starts.
- **Nolan Arenado** ranks among active leaders in homers (1st, 34), doubles (T-1st, 45), extra-base hits (T-1st, 82), hits (2nd, 178) and RBI (2nd, 115).
- **Corbin Carroll** has a 7-game home hitting streak, batting .345 (10-for-29)/.812 OPS with 1 double, 1 triple, 3 RBI, 2 walks and 1 stolen base...has reached base safely 2+ times in 4 of the 7 games.

- Will make eighth career start vs. Giants...in his last 6 starts, is 2-0 with a 2.21 ERA (9 ER in 36.2 IP), opponent .194 AVG (25-for-129), 0.87 WHIP, 7 walks and 24 strikeouts.
