GABRIEL MORENO SOCCER JERSEY GIVEAWAY TOMORROW: On Saturday, fans can get the newest kit for their collection, courtesy of Diamondbacks BC, with the Gabriel Moreno Soccer Jersey courtesy of Wendy's for the first 20,000 fans inspired by Moreno's love for the world's game and features the team's iconic bright colors with the state flag pattern and a unique team patch on the front.

FATHER'S DAY POLO: On Sunday, the D-backs give dads the gift of baseball and the annual, always-anticipated Father's Day Polo for the first 15,000 dads.

VOTE D-BACKS: In the first update (June 15) for NL All-Star Balloting Phase 1 voting, Nolan Arenado is third (3B), Ketel Marte is seventh (2B), Ildemaro Vargas is seventh (1B), Corbin Carroll is eighth (OF) and Gabriel Moreno is eighth (C)...2026 KONAMI eBaseball MLB All-Star Ballot voting continues thru June 25 (9:00 a.m. AZ) at dbacks.com/vote, the MLB App and the MLB Ballpark App.

HERE'S THE STORY: The D-backs have won or split 5 of their last 6 home series (4W - 1S - 1L) and 9 of their 12 overall (6W - 3S - 3L).

- **Corbin Carroll's** .389 AVG vs. lefties (101 PA) leads the Majors...is 1 of 4 lefties since 2000 to boast a .380+ AVG vs. lefties (min. 100 PA) with Ichiro Suzuki/SEA in 2004 (.404 AVG, 226 PA), Todd Helton/COL in 2003 (.387 AVG, 236 PA) and Barry Bonds/SF in 2002 (.384 AVG, 178 PA).
- **Gabriel Moreno**, since May 13, has reached base safely in a career-high-tying 13 straight games (also: Sept. 7-24, 2025)...has reached base safely in 24 of his last 27 games, including 2+ times in 16 of them, hitting .330 (32-for-97)/.972 OPS with 6 doubles, 5 homers, 15 RBI and 15 walks.
- **Geraldo Perdomo** has reached base safely in 14 of his last 15 games since June 2, hitting .347 (17-for-49)/.886 OPS with 1 double, 1 homer, 4 RBI and 9 walks (7 K).
- **Ketel Marte** has a 7-game hitting streak, hitting .345 (10-for-29)/.855 OPS with 3 doubles and 3 RBI.

LAST GAME: The D-backs won 8-1 vs. Angels Wednesday.

- **Eduardo Rodriguez** (W, 1 ER in 7.0 IP, 3 BB, 5 K) earned his 100th career win in his fifth start of 7.0+ innings with 1 or fewer runs allowed.
- **Corbin Carroll** (1-for-5, HR, 4 RBI) hit his second grand slam (fifth career) in the second inning.
- **Gabriel Moreno** (3-for-3, 2B, BB) reached base a career-high-tying 4 times.
- **Tommy Troy** (2-for-4, 3B, 2 RBI) hit his first career triple in the second inning.

ROSTER MOVES: The D-backs recalled RHP **Yilber Díaz** from Triple-A Reno and placed RHP **Ryne Nelson** on the 15-day injured list (strained right elbow, retro. June 16).

FACING SOUTHPAW STARTERS: Vs. lefty starters, the D-backs' .684 win pct. (13-6 record) ranks third in the Majors, behind the Yankees (.720, 18-7) and Brewers (.714, 15-6).

• Vs. lefty starters at home, the D-backs are 7-3 (.700).

RANKINGS VS. LEFTIES: Vs. lefties, the D-backs rank among MLB leaders in triples (1st, 10), fewest strikeouts (1st, 129), AVG (2nd, .267), SLG (4th, .434), OPS (4th, .760), extra-base hits (T-4th, 67) and runs (5th, 106).

LOVULLO SURPASSES HORNSBY: **Torey Lovullo's** 702 wins in his D-backs' managerial tenure surpassed Hall-of-Famer Rogers Hornsby (701 from 1925-1953) for 105th all-time among MLB managers.

TRIPLE THREAT: **Corbin Carroll** is 1 triple shy of tying Stephen Drew's 52 (773 G) for the club record.

E-ROD NOTCHES 100 CAREER WINS: **Eduardo Rodriguez**, in his 250th career start on Wednesday vs. Angels, became the ninth Venezuelan-born pitcher and 17th active pitcher to reach 100 career wins.

CORBIN BARRELS: **Corbin Carroll's** 2 grand slams this season are tied for most in the Majors with Yordan Alvarez/HOU, Daniel Schneemann/CLE, Tristan Gray/MIN, Harrison Bader/SF and Jeremiah Jackson/BAL.

- His 5 career grand slams (since 2023) are tied for second in franchise history (also: Eugenio Suárez from 2024-25), behind Matt Williams (7 from 1998-2003).

SWIPIN' BAGS: The D-backs are 11-for-12 in stolen bases the last 6 games (1 SB in 2 attempts in prior 14 G).

- Since May 21, the D-backs' 89.5 stolen base pct. (17-for-19) is second in the NL, behind the Cardinals (90.0, 18-for-20).

DEFENSE IS KEY: Since May 1, the D-backs' .994 fielding pct. and 9 errors (3 throwing, 5 fielding, 1 catcher) rank best and fewest, respectively, in the Majors.

- Since May 12, the D-backs' 32 double plays turned are the most in the Majors, ahead of the Royals (30).
- Since May 1, the D-backs are 1 of 3 teams to only have 1 game with 2+ errors (also: Tigers and Dodgers).

OUTFIELD ASSISTS: Since May 15, the D-backs' 7 outfield assists rank tied for second in the NL with the Cubs, behind the Dodgers (8).

- Since 2025, **Corbin Carroll's** 13 outfield assists rank tied for second among NL outfielders (also: Jordan Beck/COL), behind only Andy Pages/LAD (16), ahead of Mike Yastrzemski/ATL (12), Sal Frelick/MIL (12), Jackson Merrill/SD (11) and Jordan Walker/STL (11).

BULLS IN THE PEN: Since May 1, the D-backs bullpen's 23 scoreless games are tied for the most in MLB with the Dodgers (23), ahead of the Braves (21).

RELIEVER FOCUS: Since May 1 among NL relievers (min. 15 G), **Taylor Clarke** (1.20 ERA, 2 ER in 15.0 IP) and **Kevin Ginkel** (1.29 ERA, 2 ER in 14.0 IP) own the seventh and eighth lowest ERA's, respectively.

VS. TWINS: The D-backs will host the Twins at Chase Field for the sixth time ever (2004, '05, '11, '22, '24).
