RAUDI RODRIGUEZ (SRR/LAA) took home MVP honors for the American League with two hits, two RBI, and a walk. His two-out RBI single in the second scored the first run of the game.

KEVIN MCGONIGLE (SCO/DET No. 1/MLB No. 2/SS) turned a walk into a double after a wild pitch on ball four with no runners on base, allowing the MLB No. 2 prospect to make his way to second base in the second inning. McGonigle later scored in that inning for the American League's second run of the game.

AL PITCHING STAFF struck out 11, allowing two earned runs through nine innings. **Luis De León** (PEO/BAL) started on the mound, striking out two in his one inning outing.

BLAKE MITCHELL (SUR/KC No. 2/MLB No. 62/C) had the lone extra base hit of the game, hitting a double in the second inning.

Today's Headlines

Scorpions @ **Rafters**: The Scottsdale Scorpions look on to Friday's Semifinals after having locked up the top seed, on the road against Salt River, who has lost 11 of its last 12 games. RHP **Ryan Murphy** (SF) is making his sixth appearance and fifth start for Scottsdale. He's tossed 14 innings with a 3.86 ERA and 11 strikeouts. In his last outing on Nov. 2, Murphy went four scoreless innings, striking out three en route to winning the Arizona Fall League Pitcher of the Week award.

For Salt River, RHP **Brandon Dufault** (LAA) makes his fifth appearance and third start in the AFL. He has struck out nine in 11 innings, allowing 10 earned runs. He made 14 starts this season for Single-A Inland Empire.

Peoria @ **Surprise**: RHP **Ryan Hawks** (SEA) is making his fifth appearance and third start this fall. In his last outing on Nov. 2, Hawks went three perfect innings, striking out three. His ERA is 1.13 with a 0.88 WHIP in eight innings.

RHP **Winston Santos** (TEX No. 4) is making his second start and fifth appearance this fall. In 14 1/3 innings pitched, Santos has a 2-1 win-loss record while striking out 15. In Double-A and Triple-A this year, he pitched 17 1/3 innings, striking out 26.

Mesa @ **Glendale**: After a seven-game losing streak, the Glendale Desert Dogs have won four in a row. Their pitching staff has held opponents to a .185 batting average against in the streak. They will throw out LHP **Jakob Wright** (LAD No. 28), set to make his fifth appearance (second start) for Glendale. He has struck out eight in 10 1/3 innings. The Dodgers' 2024 fourth-round pick made his professional debut in April with Rancho Cucamonga (A), recording five strikeouts over 3.2 innings against Lake Elsinore (A). The Cal Poly alum made nine total starts this season, missing over two months due to injury.

Toeing the slab for Mesa is RHP **Aiden May** (MIA). He makes his fifth AFL start, having struck out 14 in 13 1/3 innings. His first two starts lasted four innings; his last was 3 2/3. He struck out two batters and allowed two runs. Although he didn't make his pro debut until July 9 of this year, the 2024 fifth round pick made nine starts in his first pro season, striking out 30 in 27 1/3 innings.
